GAME PREVIEW

Louisville City FC has lost just once in its last 12 games. FC Tulsa — the club that dealt that defeat — visits Lynn Family Stadium at 7:30 p.m. Saturday in a highly anticipated rematch.

Both previous meetings between the sides have been thrillers that lit up the scoreboard. Back on June 19, LouCity scored three times in the opening 10 minutes, then managed to hang on for a 3-2 victory. Tulsa was likewise quick out of the gates when registering a 3-2 win of its own July 10 over the boys in purple.

Both those previous contests were played in Oklahoma. Now the series between a pair of clubs in playoff positions moves to Lynn Family Stadium. Since venues were permitted to go to 100% capacity, LouCity has out-scored visitors there a combined 19-6 and dropped points only once via a draw.

First place in the USL Championship's Central Division, Louisville is 11-3-3 overall, sporting a +17 goal differential and dynamic attack. Thirteen different players have scored — best in the league — with LouCity seven points clear of second-place Birmingham Legion FC.

FC Tulsa slipped after beating the boys in purple, dropping four straight until a victory last weekend over Birmingham. The club still sits third in the Central Division at 7-8-1, but it's a difference of only three points between its position and seventh on the table.

FC Tulsa will travel to Louisville once more on Sept. 3 to conclude the season series. Before then, here's more of what to watch for Saturday.

A HOME FORTRESS

LouCity only recently passed the midpoint of its 32-game season. Yet the club has already played 11 of its 16 home games, going 8-1-2 at Lynn Family Stadium. That includes an unbeaten record since June 12, the new venue's first 100% capacity game. Average attendance of 9,865 is best in the USL Championship.

SCORING SPREE

The 2021 season has been filled with positive streaks for LouCity, among them a run of scoring a goal in 12 straight games dating back to a 1-0 loss at Atlanta United 2 on June 6. The club record remains the 2016 squad's 16 straight games with a goal.

GOALS IN BULK

What's the "magic number" for the boys in purple? So far, LouCity is unbeaten when scoring three or more goals. Impressively, the club has reached that mark six times (5-0-1) in 17 games of a season when offense has rarely been in short supply.

A LEADING MAN

Forward Cameron Lancaster, who has set the league on fire since his early days with LouCity, entered elite company in last Saturday's win over Sporting KC II when registering his ninth goal of the season. That made 60 in his USL career, with the Englishman one of six to reach that mark.

COMING INTO HIS OWN(BY)

Lancaster has provided the goals, while winger Brian Ownby continues setting them up. He has paced the attack since returning to the starting lineup in June, racking up a league-leading seven assists to go with three goals of

his own. Ownby had one apiece in the SKC II win, handling a 75th-minute cross from Jorge Gonzalez to give Lancaster an open look at the face of goal.

LETHAL LOANEE

Speaking of, the Portland Timbers (MLS) loan forward Gonzalez has emerged has a major contributor for LouCity since coming back from injury. He slotted a shot in top open scoring against SKC II in first half stoppage time before crossing in ahead of Lancaster's milestone moment. Gonzalez has two goals and an assist in six appearances.

BONE'S IN THE ZONE

Midfielder Corben Bone tallied his fourth assist of the season last weekend when finding Gonzalez before the opening goal. That's nothing new for the veteran in his second year with the club. A consistent chance creator, Bone ranks fifth in the Eastern Conference in that category with 29 on the season.

DEFENSIVE STRIDES

Offense has made LouCity tough to beat, but the boys in purple have shown more signs of being a complete team in recent weeks. Over its last six games, LouCity has conceded only five goals and not allowed more than a goal in a game playing mostly with newcomer goalkeeper Parker Siegfried between the posts. The four games prior to that saw 10 goals conceded.

MILESTONES ON THE HORIZON

Brian Ownby is one appearance away from 100 Louisville City FC regular season appearances.

“Hell of a second half. I spoke to the players about the importance of starting well ... but I didn’t feel for the first 40 minutes there that we played to the ability that we needed to — small details that we can continue to work on. I’m happy with the result. Unbelievable atmosphere again — certainly gives us a push even after they score a goal. I know we’ve been talking about it lately, but that’s why it’s so important to play in this place with these fans.”

FAMILIAR FACES

A similar trend to years past, Louisville City FC once again returned the core of its roster, retaining 18 members off the 2020 LouCity roster. Of that 18 also includes nine of the 11 starters that led the boys in purple through streaks measured eight winning and 13 unbeaten into the club’s sixth-straight Eastern Conference Finals appearance in as many years.

HEAD COACH DANNY CRUZ

After three years as the club's top assistant, Danny Cruz was given full reign of the boys in purple and appointed interim head coach on April 27, 2020.

Since joining the club as a full-time assistant in September of 2018, Cruz made an immediate impact, seeing LouCity win its second straight USL Championship Final, the first club in league history

to accomplish such a feat.

In his time with LouCity, Cruz has gone on to further establish a challenging style of play for the boys in purple, playing out of the back with double-digit passing sequences known to confound opposing squads.

"We are excited for Danny to take the reins of LouCity — a well-earned opportunity," said LouCity president Brad Estes. "The momentum of this organization is unwavering, and we will continue to support our players and staff in their mission to fill the trophy case."

In January of 2020, the Petersburg, Va., native's title was updated to include the role of technical director. In addition to his role as a coach, Cruz works to retain and sign players, plus manages first team opportunities for members of the club's youth academy.

Cruz played professional soccer from his 2009 MLS SuperDraft selection until he joined the Real Monarch SLC in 2018 as an assistant coach. Over the course of his pro career, Cruz registered 137 Major League Soccer appearances including time with the Houston Dynamo, D.C. United and the Philadelphia Union. Cruz was a starter on the 2011 Houston Dynamo squad which squared off against the David Beckham and Landon Donovan-led L.A. Galaxy team in the 2011 MLS Cup. Cruz also trained under Hackworth in Philadelphia, registering 70 career appearances while scoring seven goals. Cruz also had experience playing with the Des Moines Menace, Minnesota United, San Francisco Deltas and Real Monarchs SLC before joining their coaching ranks.

Since moving to Louisville, Cruz and his wife, Brittney, have also welcomed a son, Santiago, into their family.



ASSISTANT COACH SIMON BIRD

The Lincoln, England, native was a star at the University of Louisville from 2001-04, earning Conference USA Player of the Year in 2003, and had a six-year professional career in England before returning as a University of Louisville Assistant Coach from 2009-12. A fixture on the local soccer scene, Bird has worked as Oldham Soccer Club's Director of Coaching and Kentucky Fire Juniors Boys Director. Bird

holds an A License from the U.S. Soccer Federation and is a Qualified Teacher for High School Physical Education and Sports Science.
