## Tonight's Game

The Rockford IceHogs look to sweep the opening weekend on the road against the San Jose Barracuda with a win tonight. This evening marks the sixth all-time meeting between the two sides, and the second of four encounters this season.

Six IceHogs made their AHL regular season debuts last night at Tech CU Arena, including goaltender Drew Comness who pulled out 34 saves in the winning effort. There are 10 total rookies on the IceHogs' current roster.

Mixed in with the new faces, several returners contributed to last night's 7-2 win. The IceHogs feature proven producers at the AHL level up front in David Gust, Joey Anderson, Brett Seney, and Anders Bjork. All three played for the Chicago Blackhawks in the NHL last season.

Rockford faces a young San Jose team tonight with seven San Jose Sharks draft picks on the roster. The Barracuda rank as the fourth-youngest team in the AHL with an average age of 23.6 years. The IceHogs are the third-youngest team to start 2023-24 with an average of 23.5 years.



## Player Spotlight

Ethan Del Mastro, 20, made his professional debut last night against San Jose and recorded a +1 rating. The defenseman won a gold medal with Team Canada at the 2023 IIHF World Junior Championship last January.

## Last Game

The IceHogs rolled the Barracuda 7-2 last night at Tech CU Arena. The game hinged around a key play in the second period when Ozzy Wiesblatt lined up Rockford's Kale Howarth and was given a 15-minute match penalty for a check to the head. After Howarth was attended to and taken back to the dressing room, the Hogs were able to strike place on the ensuing five-minute power play and take a 4-1 advantage.

Rockford's second line of Anders Bjork, Joey Anderson, and Mike Hardman looked strong early and cashed in with a Hardman goal later in the first period.

Rookie goaltender Drew Comness made his pro debut in net last night and stopped 34 of 36 San Jose shots. The former BU Terrier was also credited with an assist on David Gust's second goal of the game in the second period.

## Series History

Prior to last night, Rockford and San Jose last played on 3/31/18 at the then-BMO Harris Bank Center. The IceHogs won the game in 5-3 fashion thanks to four consecutive goals to close out the contest. The Barracuda took a 3-1 lead when Brad Mashinter and Caleb Herbert scored just 32 seconds apart in the second period, but Lance Bouma lit the lamp 41 seconds into the third frame to give Rockford life and start the comeback.

Tonight is just the sixth all-time meeting between the two sides. Rockford holds a 4-1-0-0 record in the series, and the IceHogs' only loss of the series to date came on Jan. 15, 2016 in a 5-2 decision.

Rockford was the first team to ever play against the 'San Jose Barracuda'. In the Cuda's inaugural game on Oct. 9, 2015, the Hogs topped them 4-2 in California.

## Notes

### Fireworks to Start the Season

With seven goals against San Jose to start the season, the IceHogs scored their most ever goals in a season opener in the team's AHL era. The UHL IceHogs hung eight scores on Quad City on Oct. 15, 2004 in an 8-4 win. Rockford scored seven or more goals three times in the 2022-23 season, with the most recent occurrence coming on Dec. 17 against Iowa in a 7-3 win.

### Right Where He Left Off

David Gust led the IceHogs in scoring with 59 points (26G, 33A) last season, and he's tied for the team lead to begin the new circuit. The winger posted 15 multi-point games last season to lead all IceHogs, and six of those efforts involved at least three points. In the season opener for 2022-23 against Manitoba, Gust also recorded a three-point night to start the campaign (1G, 2A). The former Ohio State Buckeye netted one goal at even strength and one on the power play last night. His five-on-five goal was assisted by Brett Seney, one of his running mates from last year, and rookie goaltender Drew Comness.

### Impressive Debut

Rookie goaltender Drew Comness put on a show in his professional debut. The former Boston Terrier stopped 34 of 36 San Jose shots, and the second goal he allowed only reached the back of the net after it was accidentally tipped by an IceHogs defenseman. Comness's 34 saves were the most in an IceHogs debut since Arvid Soderblom stoned 40 shots on Oct. 16, 2021 against the Chicago Wolves. Comness also recorded an assist in his debut and became the only other IceHogs goaltender to post an assist in their AHL debut along with Lars Johansson who accomplished the feat on Oct. 14, 2016 against Cleveland in a 2-1 loss. Johansson assisted Tanner Kero's goal along with Viktor Svedberg at 17:36 of the third period. Comness earned his assist with Brett Seney on David Gust's second goal on Friday.

### Well That's a First

Nolan Allan, Drew Comness, Ethan Del Mastro, Jalen Luyten, Ryder Rolston, and Antti Saarela all made their AHL debuts last night in San Jose. For all but Saarela, it was their first professional regular season action of any kind. In the third period of Friday night's game, Luyten stole the puck behind the San Jose net and fed Ryder Rolston for the first point for both players. Rolston registered seven goals with Notre Dame last season, and Luyten picked up 39 points (18G, 21A) in 38 games with the Tri-City Americans in the WHL in 2022-23.

### An Apple a Day...

Forward Joey Anderson grabbed three assists last night on the first, second, and fourth goals scored by Rockford. All three helpers served as the primary assists on their respective goals as well. Anders Bjork and Mike Hardman, Anderson's two linemates, along with David Gust were the recipients of Anderson's generosity. He racked up three assists on two separate occasions with the Toronto Marlies last season, and totaled eight multi-point efforts in just 30 games with Toronto in 2022-23. The former third-round pick by New Jersey tabbed three points in two regular season games with Rockford last season.

## Anders Sorensen - Head Coach

In October of 2023, Sorensen it was announced that Sorensen would be inducted into the Illinois Hockey Hall of Fame. The Swede enters his 10th season with the Blackhawks' organization in 2023-24, and has seen 28 players make their NHL debuts after spending time in Rockford.

The 2022-23 campaign marked Sorensen's first full season as an AHL head coach. In his second year as the head man on the Rockford bench, he led the IceHogs to their second consecutive Calder Cup Playoff appearance and their eighth in team history.

Sorensen led Rockford to a 35-26-4-1 record during the 2021-22 season after assuming the interim head coach role, helping the IceHogs qualify for the Calder Cup Playoffs for the seventh time in team history. Prior to becoming head coach, Sorensen spent three seasons as an assistant coach with the IceHogs from 2018-21, and five seasons as a development coach for the IceHogs and Chicago Blackhawks from 2014-18. The Södertälje, Sweden native also spent three seasons as an assistant coach for the Södertälje SK of HockeyAllsvenskan from 2011-13 before serving as an interim head coach in October 2013. Along with his contributions to the Blackhawks organization, Sorensen spent several seasons with the Chicago Mission, one of the top AAA teams in the Chicagoland area, and helped develop NHL talents such as Ryan Hartman, Vinnie Hinostroza, and Nick Schmaltz.

Sorensen played for the Mobile Mystics and Baton Rouge Kingfish of the ECHL during the 1999-2000 season, totaling four points (3G, 1A) over 37 games.

## Jared Nightingale - Assistant Coach

Nightingale enters his second season as an assistant coach with Rockford after he served as the IceHogs team captain during the 2013-14 season, his lone playing campaign with the organization. In 67 games, the Jackson, Michigan, native, scored on goal and three assists for four points and led the team with 114 penalty minutes. Overall, he played in 674 professional games in the AHL and ECHL, totaling 102 points (23G, 79A).

Following his playing career, Nightingale moved behind the bench as an assistant coach in the junior hockey ranks starting in 2017-18. Most recently, he served as the assistant coach with the Flint Firebirds of the OHL for the past two seasons, where he helped the club to a 6-5-0 record to start this season. He was also a member of the Saginaw Spirit coaching staff during the 2019-20 season. The former 6-foot-3, 205-pound defenseman was also behind the bench with the US National Team Development Program in the USHL in 2018-19.

## Rob Klinkhammer - Assistant Coach

Klinkhammer also enters his second season as an assistant coach with Rockford after he skated with the IceHogs from 2008-12 and ranks eighth all time in games played with 242 appearances. The Canadian recorded 44 goals and 65 assists for 109 points during his time in the Stateline. During the 2010-11 season, the Lethbridge, Alberta, native became the 36th IceHogs player to reach the NHL when he made his debut with the Chicago Blackhawks on Dec. 8 vs. Dallas.

Over parts of seven seasons in the AHL (2007-13, 15-16), Klinkhammer totaled 236 points (96G, 140A) in 423 games with Norfolk, Rockford, Binghamton, Portland and Bakersfield and dressed in 193 career NHL matchups over six seasons with Chicago, Edmonton, Pittsburgh, Arizona and Ottawa adding 22 goals and 21 assists for 43 points.

Before moving into the coaching ranks, he spent the last six seasons overseas in the KHL with five different clubs and registered 157 points (81G, 76A) in 269 games. In 2017-18, he won the KHL's Gagarin Cup with Ak Bars Kazan and claimed a bronze medal with Team Canada in the 2018 Olympics in Pyeongchang.

## Matt Smith - Developmental Goaltending Coach

Smith enters his first season with the IceHogs in 2023-24. The Waterloo, Ontario native spent the last two seasons as the goaltending coach with the Soo Greyhounds in the OHL after previously spending seven seasons with the OHL's Guelph Storm where he helped goaltenders Nico Daws and Garrett Sparks reach the NHL.

Smith also founded his own goalie program, Matt Smith Goaltending, at age 19 and has helped dozens of netminders earn chances at the pros and NHL contracts.
