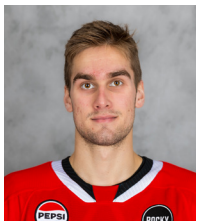
Tonight's Game

The Rockford IceHogs open the home slate of the 2023-24 season with a matchup tonight against the Chicago Wolves. Rockford enters the stand-alone weekend game with six days of rest since the team's split with the San Jose Barracuda in California on last Friday and Saturday.

This evening is the first of 12 meetings this season between the IceHogs and the Wolves. The teams will only square off three times before the New Year, and six of the encounters will take place in the last two months of the season.

Chicago announced earlier this year that the team would ditch its NHL affiliation with the Carolina Hurricanes and become the first non-NHL affiliated AHL team since the 1993-94 season. This move has left the Wolves mostly devoid of NHL prospects, but Chicago has used its situation to sign experienced players such as Chris Terry and Cory Conacher.

During media time outs in the first, second, and third periods, the IceHogs will tonight announce the inaugural class of the Rockford IceHogs Ring of Honor. Three individuals who have made significant contributions to the IceHogs and to hockey in the Stateline will be honored.



Player Spotlight

Louis Crevier, 22, enters his second season with the IceHogs after he was taken in the seventh round of the 2020 NHL Draft by the Blackhawks. The 6-foot-8 defenseman skated in 62 games with the IceHogs last season.

Last Game

The IceHogs suffered their first defeat of the season at the hands of the San Jose Barracuda last Saturday at Tech CU Arena in California. The puck was dropped to start period one just 16 hours after the Hogs and Cuda wrapped up the season opener the night before.

After a sluggish first period by both sides, Rockford answered San Jose's first goal by opening the second period with a pair of goals just 1:12 apart from Joey Anderson and Brett Seney. Anderson's goal came on a wrap-around, and Seney deflected in a David Gust shot on the power play.

1:14 after the Hogs took a 2-1 lead, Justin Bailey scored on a breakaway for San Jose, and the Barracuda continued to score six straight goals, including three in the middle frame and three more in the third period.

Series History

Tonight marks the 180th meeting between the IceHogs and the Wolves, and up to tonight, Rockford has won almost exactly half of the previous matchups. Entering this evening's affair, the Hogs are 90-73-11-5 against their I-90 rivals.

Last season, Rockford was 5-6-1-0 against Chicago and beat the Wolves 6-3 in a crucial game on Apr. 11 to maintain the final playoff spot in the standings. Despite that defeat, Chicago won four of the final five matchups of the season against Rockford and finished just one point behind the IceHogs in the Central Division playoff standings.

Last season was the first year that the Wolves were not eligible for the postseason since they were left out of the 2016 Calder Cup Playoffs.

Fireworks to Start the Season

With seven goals against San Jose last Friday to start the season, the IceHogs scored their most ever goals in a season opener in the team's AHL era. The UHL IceHogs hung eight scores on Quad City on Oct. 15, 2004 in an 8-4 win. Rockford scored seven or more goals three times in the 2022-23 season, with the most recent occurrence coming on Dec. 17 against Iowa in a 7-3 win.

Extra Special Teams

Rockford's power play and penalty kill were both outstanding in last weekend's set of games against San Jose. The IceHogs converted at a 50% (4/8) clip on the man-advantage through two games in California with three power-play goals in Friday's 7-2 win and one power-play strike in Saturday's 7-2 loss. The penalty kill was a perfect 4/4 in Saturday's game and was stalwart in Friday's win with the exception of a late 5-on-3 goal scored by the Barracuda when the Hogs were already up 7-1 late in the third. Overall, the IceHogs' PK allowed just one power-play goal in eight chances and tacked on a shorthanded empty-netter. Rockford was the only AHL team with three power-play goals in the first weekend of the season.

Impressive Debut

Rookie goaltender Drew Comnesso put on a show in his professional debut. The former Boston Terrier stopped 34 of 36 San Jose shots last Friday, and the second goal he allowed only reached the back of the net after it was accidentally tipped by an IceHogs defenseman. Comnesso's 34 saves were the most in an IceHogs debut since Arvid Soderblom stoned 40 shots on Oct. 16, 2021 against the Chicago Wolves. Comnesso also recorded an assist in his debut and became the only other IceHogs goaltender to post an assist in their AHL debut along with Lars Johansson who accomplished the feat on Oct. 14, 2016 against Cleveland in a 2-1 loss. Johansson assisted Tanner Kero's goal along with Viktor Svedberg at 17:36 of the third period. Comnesso earned his assist with Brett Seney on David Gust's second goal on Friday.

Well That's a First

Nolan Allan, Drew Comnesso, Ethan Del Mastro, Jalen Luypen, Ryder Rolston, and Antti Saarela all made their AHL debuts last Friday in San Jose. For all but Saarela, it was their first professional regular season action of any kind. In the third period of Friday night's game, Luypen stole the puck behind the San Jose net and fed Ryder Rolston for the first point for both players. Rolston registered seven goals with Notre Dame last season, and Luypen picked up 39 points (18G, 21A) in 38 games with the Tri-City Americans in the WHL in 2022-23.

Old Teammates with the Wolves

IceHogs David Gust and Josh Healey played together on the 2020-21 Chicago Wolves squad. The pair also played together for four seasons at Ohio State. Gust picked up four points (2G, 2A) in 16 games that season, while Healey notched six points (2G, 4A) and 70 penalty minutes in 33 contests. The pair also played against one another extensively in 2017-18 and 2018-19 when Gust played with the Bakersfield Condors and Healey skated with the Stockton Heat. Healey's Heat won the series in 2017-18 with a 7-2-0-1 record, but Gust's Condors won the next season with an 8-2-0-0 mark.
