BRAXTON BERRIOS: Wide receiver/punt returner **Braxton Berrios**, a waiver claim at final cutdowns this season, leads all qualified punt returners (minimum 1.25 returns per game) in punt return average this season. **Berrios**, in his first season playing after missing all of his rookie year with an injury, has averaged 11.1 yards per punt return this season, including 12 returns of at least 10 yards, tied for the second most in the league.

MAN OF THE YEAR

JONOTTHAN HARRISON: The New York Jets announced **Jonotthan Harrison** as its nominee for the **WALTER PAYTON NFL MAN OF THE YEAR AWARD**. Considered one of the league's most prestigious honors, the Walter Payton NFL Man of the Year Award recognizes an NFL player for outstanding community service activities off the field, as well as excellence on the field.

Harrison has continuously shown his commitment to the nation's bullying crisis through his willingness to reflect on his own experiences of being bullied and raising awareness about this issue through social media and speaking engagements. As a result, **Harrison** has helped bring the conversation about bullying to the forefront and encourage youth to become educated on the signs of bullying and what they can do to help prevent it from happening to their peers. Harrison's passion for this campaign led him to become a Global Ambassador for Stomp Out Bullying, the leading national nonprofit dedicated to changing the culture for all students. Through this partnership, he has been able to reach those who need to hear his story the most by regularly speaking with kids at schools.

"I am humbled to be amongst this contingent of selfless honorees," said **Harrison**. "The opportunity to represent the Jets organization, my family and my community means so much to me. Growing up, I was an easy target for bullies. The daily harassment I endured helped shape me to become who I am today."

"Jonotthan's strength and vulnerability to speak out about his personal struggles growing up, has brought awareness to our community and young students who are experiencing similar hardships," said New York Jets President **Hymie Elhai**. "We are extremely honored to have Jonotthan as a part of our organization and proud of him as he continues to serve as a role model through our STOMP Out Bullying program."

As a nominee, **Harrison** will wear a Walter Payton NFL Man of the Year helmet decal through the end of the season in recognition of his accomplishments on and off the field. In addition, Harrison will receive a donation of \$40,000 in his name to the charity of choice. Harrison has chosen to support STOMP Out Bullying. The winner of the Walter Payton NFL Man of the Year award will receive a \$250,000 donation to the charity of their choice.

For the second year in a row, all 32 team winners will be highlighted as nominees and recognized for their important work during the weekend leading up to Super Bowl LIV. The 2019 Walter Payton NFL Man of the Year will be announced during NFL Honors, a two-hour primetime awards special to air nationally on Feb. 1, the eve of Super Bowl LIV, on FOX. NFL Honors will be at the Adrienne Arsht Center in downtown Miami.

Fans are encouraged to participate in the fifth annual Charity Challenge, a social media campaign designed to support and promote team nominees. Fans can vote on Twitter by using #WPMOYChallenge followed by their favorite nominee's last name. The player whose unique hashtag is used the most between Dec. 12 and Jan. 12 will receive a \$25,000 contribution to their charity of choice, while the second and third place finishers will receive \$10,000 and \$5,000 donations. 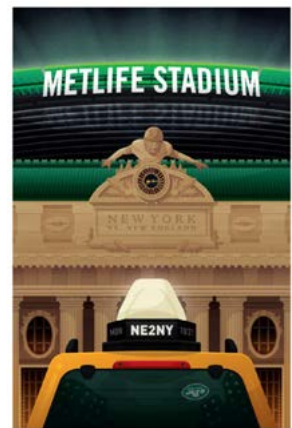
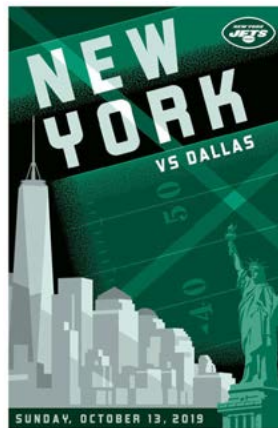
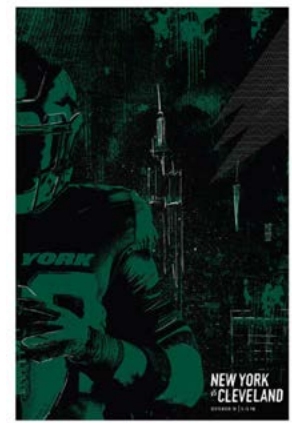

The Jets have named **Nga Warren**  **GATORADE** of Tilden Educational Campus in Brooklyn, NY the recipient of the New York Jets High School Coach of the Year award presented by Gatorade. Through Gatorade's partnership, the monetary award to benefit the school's football program has doubled to \$4,000. **Coach Warren** will receive a Gatorade kit, containing a cooler, fuel bars, Gatorade powder mix, squeeze bottles and much more. Coach Warren played quarterback and wide receiver while in college at Indiana State University. He began coaching in 2003 at Pebblebrook High School in Mableton, GA as an assistant. In 2009, Warren became the head coach at Franklin K. Lane High School in Brooklyn, NY. During his time at Franklin K. Lane, **Coach Warren** won the 2012 PSAL City Championships. In 2019, **Coach Warren** was named head football coach of Tilden Educational Campus. In addition to his coaching duties, Warren serves as a career and technical education teacher at Transit Tech High School in Brooklyn, NY.

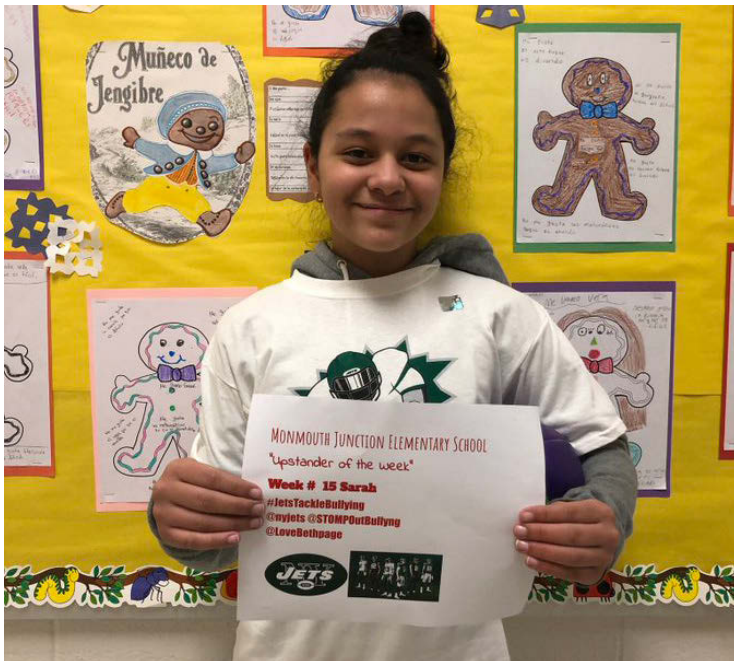


For each of the 16 weeks during the season, the Jets have asked schools to submit a photo and description of a student that is an Upstander.

LG 71 ALEX LEWIS 4th Season

Acquired via trade during training camp, has started at left guard since Week Five. Part of an offensive line that helped pave the way for the consecutive 400-yard efforts at WAS (11/17) and vs. OAK (11/24).

C 78 JONOTTHAN HARRISON 3rd Season

Veteran center who joined the Jets as a free agent in 2017. Has played in 82 career games, including 39 starts. Has appeared in all 14 games this season (eight starts). Helped protect QB Sam Darnold vs. OAK (11/24), who recorded 315 passing yards.

RG 77 TOM COMPTON 7th Season

Veteran offensive lineman who joined the Jets this year. Has played in 99 career games, including 35 starts. Has appeared in all 14 games this season, including starting in the win vs. OAK (11/24) when the offense produced a season high 401 total yards.

RT 75 CHUMA EDOGA Rookie

Third-round selection who started every game from Week Five to 12, splitting his starts between right and left tackle. Helped protect Sam Darnold, who returned after missing three games and threw for 338 yards vs. DAL (10/13). Missed the last three weeks due to an injury.

TE 87 DANIEL BROWN 5th Season

Has totaled four receptions for 40 yards and one touchdown after appearing in all 14 games this season.

WR 82 JAMISON CROWDER 5th Season

Has registered 707 receiving yards on a team-high 66 receptions. Only the second player to produce 75+ receiving yards and a receiving TD in three consecutive games (Week 9-11) this season.

WR 18 DEMARIUS THOMAS 10th Season

Recorded first touchdown as a Jet vs. MIA (12/8). The four-time Pro Bowler ranks third in receiving yards (9,763) and third in receiving touchdowns (63) among active wide receivers in the league. Missed last week at BLT (12/12) due to an injury.

QB 14 SAM DARNOLD 2nd Season

Since Week 10, the team captain ranks in the top 10 across the league in passing yards (1,565), passing touchdowns (11) and QB rating (96.1). Has thrown multiple touchdowns in four of the last five games.

RB 26 LE'VEON BELL 6th Season

Became the fastest player (63 career games) to reach 8,000 yards from scrimmage when he surpassed the total in his first play as a Jet. Has averaged 121.0 yards per game played in his career, the third best in NFL history among all players with at least 50 games played. Rushed for a season-high 87 yards last week at BLT (12/12).

WR/RB 88 TY MONTGOMERY 5th Season

Unrestricted free agent signing who has seen action at both running back and wide receiver in his career. Has averaged 4.63 yards per carry since entering the league (2015).

P 4 LACHLAN EDWARDS 4th Season

Set single-season franchise records in net punting average in each of the last two seasons (40.5 and 40.8), opening the 2019 season vs. BUF (9/8) by matching his single-game best with five punts inside the 20-yard line, including one downed at the two-yard line which led to a safety on the ensuing play. Has registered 104 punts inside the 20 since entering the league, tied for the seventh most among all NFL punters.

K 9 SAM FICKEN 1st Season

Connected on a 44-yard walkoff field goal vs. MIA (12/8), winning the game 22-21. At home vs. NYG (11/10), converted a 53-yard field goal, marking the longest of his career.

JOE DOUGLAS was named general manager of the New York Jets by Christopher Johnson on June 7, 2019. In introducing him, Johnson stated that Douglas is, “The right person, at the right time,” for the franchise, someone who shared Johnson’s vision not just for the team, but the entire organization.

In his 20th season in the league, Douglas has put in the work and paid his dues, working as both a pro and college scout in Baltimore, Chicago and Philadelphia, and helping shape three different Super Bowl championship rosters.

“My first steps and priorities here are simply to engage and connect with the entire organization,” Douglas said during his press conference. “Adam Gase and I share a vision of building a team and I look forward to partnering with him and getting this program to a place where we are consistently competing for championships each and every year.

“To Jets nation, you are getting a general manager that is a relentless worker, someone that understands a winning culture, someone that is going to strive to put a product on the field each Sunday that competes for greatness and that I hope will make you proud.”

Before joining the Jets, Douglas spent the previous three seasons as the vice president of player personnel with the Eagles. In Philadelphia, he was a key component in acquiring many of the players that helped win Super Bowl LII, including the game’s MVP, quarterback Nick Foles.

Using every avenue to help improve the team, Douglas was part of a front office that acquired the players who scored all but two of the team’s postseason touchdowns, including four of the five touchdowns in the Super Bowl. A trio of 2017 unrestricted free agent signings - LeGarrette Blount, Foles and Alshon Jeffery - as well as a pair of street free agents - Patrick Robinson and Torrey Smith - all contributed scores on the team’s title run. The Eagles’ leading receiver in the Super Bowl, running back Corey Clement, was signed as an undrafted free agent, while the team’s leading rusher in the game, running back Jay Ajayi, joined the club as a midseason trade.

Prior to joining the Eagles, Douglas spent a season as the director of college scouting for Chicago (2015), first working with Gase, the then offensive coordinator for the Bears.

Entering the NFL as a player personnel assistant (2000) the year Baltimore won Super Bowl XXXV, Douglas ascended within the Ravens organization, holding various posts in the organization’s scouting department, serving as a national scout (2012-15), Southeast area scout (2009-11), East Coast area scout (2008) and Northeast area scout (2003-07), helping add a number of prominent players via the draft, including the Super Bowl XLVII MVP, quarterback Joe Flacco, as well as a number of Pro Bowl players - Ben Grubbs, C.J. Mosley, Justin Tucker and Marshal Yanda.

An All-Atlantic 10 selection, Douglas started 45 consecutive games at tackle for the University of Richmond. Following his collegiate playing career, he transitioned into a volunteer assistant coach role with the Spiders in 1999.

As an offensive and defensive lineman at Lee-Davis (VA) HS, Douglas was recognized as a two-time all-state honoree.

He and his wife, Shannon, have two daughters, Addison and Leighton, and a son, Thomas.

ADAM GASE was named the head coach of the New York Jets by Chairman & CEO Christopher Johnson on January 11, 2019. For Gase, he becomes the 17th full-time coach in franchise history.

Under Gase, starting quarterbacks have produced 38 games with a 100+ passer rating, a number that would tie him for 10th among all NFL franchises since 2013 – higher than the total of all three franchises he’s worked with in that span. Additionally, every quarterback (Peyton Manning, Jay Cutler, Ryan Tannehill, Matt Moore and Brock Osweiler) who has started at least two games for him has produced a 100+ passer rating performance. Since 2013 (his first season calling plays), nine different running backs have produced 100-yard games under Gase, while in his three seasons as Miami’s head coach, the Dolphins ground game averaged 4.36 yards per carry, the 10th best average in the league, and Miami running backs accounted for a 4.49 average, the third best in the league. Additionally, Dolphins running backs have 33 carries of 20+ yards in that span, tied for the fourth most in the league.

Beginning with his first season in Denver (2009), he has coached 16 different players to the Pro Bowl, including 12 offensive players — multiple players at offensive line, wide receiver and running back.

Prior to his appointment as Jets head coach, Gase spent 16 seasons as a coach in the NFL, the last six calling plays for three different franchises, including record-setting offensive output as the offensive coordinator of the Denver Broncos (2013), his first season calling plays in the NFL. In his last position, Gase spent three seasons (2016-18) as the head coach for the Miami Dolphins, where he compiled a 23-25 record and led the franchise to a postseason berth in his first season.

As the Dolphins head coach, he posted a 20-6 record in one-score games (+/- eight points), a .769 winning percentage, the best among any team in the league. Buoyed by the fact that his team registered the sixth most touchdowns in the fourth

quarter of close games (+/- seven points), Gase also saw his quarterbacks post the 10th highest passer rating in those scenarios.

In his first season under Gase’s leadership (2016), Tannehill posted the most efficient season of his NFL career, completing 67.1% of his passes for a 7.7 yards per attempt average and a 93.5 passer rating, all career highs, while also leading the league with a red zone passer rating of 119.7 as the Dolphins broke an eight-year playoff drought.

Before his time in South Florida, Gase spent a season as the offensive coordinator with the Chicago Bears (2015), improving the team’s rushing yardage ranking from No. 27 the season before to No. 11. Under his tutelage, Cutler finished the season with the highest passer rating (92.3) of his career, threw seven fewer interceptions than the previous season, and posted a single-season-best 2.3 percent interception rate.

Prior to Chicago, Gase served on the Broncos staff in a variety of roles, including offensive coordinator (2013-14), quarterbacks coach (2011-12) and wide receivers coach (2009-10) as Denver won four AFC West titles, three playoff games and an AFC Championship.

In two seasons as the offensive coordinator (2013-14), Gase oversaw a record-setting offense that produced over 430 yards per game, including 315.8 yards per game passing and 34 points per game, all the best in the league over that span. In 2013, they set NFL single-season records for most points scored (606) and most passing yards (5,444), while five different players (three wide receivers, a tight end and a running back) all scored 10+ touchdowns.

Additionally, Manning established single-season NFL records in passing yards (5,477) and passing touchdowns (55), earning NFL Most Valuable Player honors for his efforts. In three seasons under Gase (2012-14), Manning posted a 131-to-35 touchdown to interception ratio, completing 67.7% of his passes for a passer rating of 107.8.

In his first season as the team's quarterbacks coach (2011), Gase oversaw quarterbacks Kyle Orton and Tim Tebow, as the latter helped guide the team to a division title and a postseason berth. Under Gase, Tebow ran for 660 yards and six touchdowns, at the time, the ninth-highest rushing total by a quarterback since the merger.

He initially served on Denver's staff as the team's wide receivers coach (2009-10). In those years, he coached a pair of Pro Bowlers, first wide receiver Brandon Marshall (2009), who produced 101 receptions for 1,120 yards and 10 touchdowns, and then wide receiver Brandon Lloyd (2010), who led the league with 1,448 yards on 77 receptions (18.8 average).

Before joining the Broncos staff, Gase spent one season with San Francisco as an offensive assistant under Offensive Coordinator Mike Martz, assisting an offense that saw running back Frank Gore produce over 1,000 yards rushing.

Gase entered the NFL ranks with the Detroit Lions in 2003, serving as scouting/coaching assistant for three seasons under Steve Mariucci before becoming an offensive quality control coach in 2006 and the quarterbacks coach in 2007 under Rod Marinelli. In his season as quarterbacks coach, Jon Kitna posted 4,068 passing yards, the second-highest total of his 14-year career, finishing sixth in the league in passing yards.

Gase began his coaching career as a defensive graduate assistant at LSU in 2000. He spent the following two seasons on the recruiting staff for Head Coach Nick Saban, winning a Southeastern Conference championship in 2001 and helping recruit a group of players that won the BCS National Championship in 2003.

Gase attended Michigan State University from 1996-99 earning a bachelor's degree. He and his wife, Jennifer, have a daughter, McKenzie, and two sons, A.J. and Wyatt.

- In his two seasons in MIA, the defensive line produced 140 quarterback hits, the seventh-best total in the NFL, including seasons of 10 or more by four different players.
- The seventh-overall selection in the 2001 NFL Draft, he spent 13 seasons in the NFL and was named to the 2011 Pro Bowl.

- While an offensive coordinator for DET (2015-18), his offense ranked in the top four league-wide in both receptions and receiving yards.
- First worked with Gase as an offensive assistant in DEN (2013). That season, the offense ranked first in the NFL in multiple categories, including total yards per game (465.3), total touchdowns (76) and points per game (37.9), and set an NFL single-season record with 606 points scored.

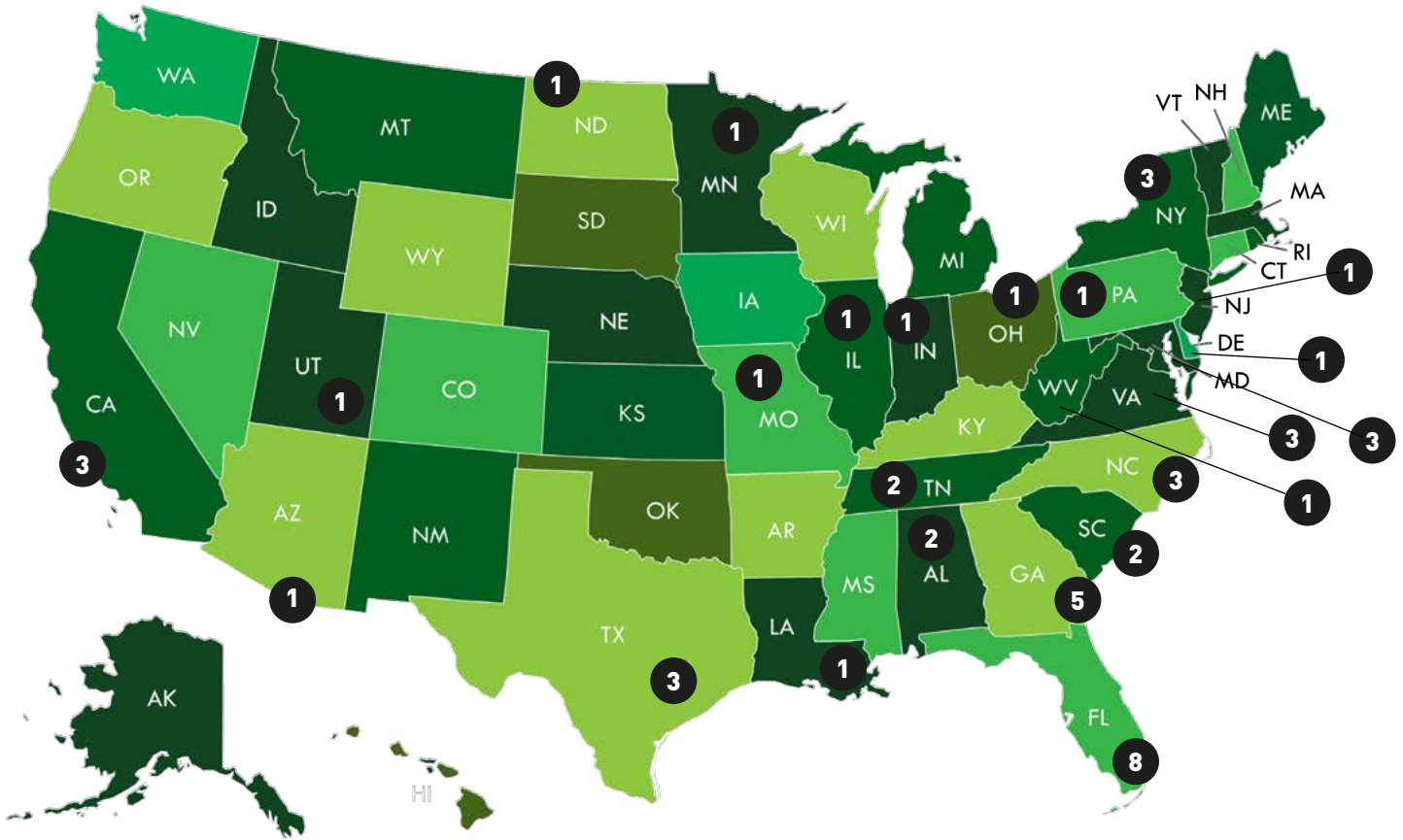

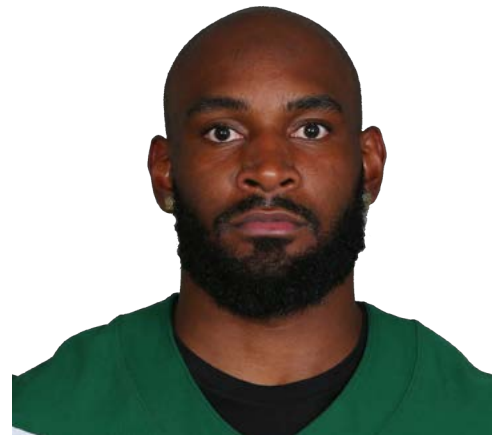
