

#### #10Things (Twitter-Friendly Notes)

- 1. The Salt River Rafters dethroned the Peoria Javelinas 7-4 last night at Salt River Fields. The Javelinas were held to their lowest run total of the season while Salt River held Peoria to just 3-14 with RISP. Peoria had been averaging 11 runs per game
- 2. Justice Bigibe (OF/Detroit) was 3-5 with three RBI in the win, while Jack Brannigan (INF/Pittsburgh) drove in two runs on two doubles, while also scoring twice.
- 3. On a night where the Major League Club set home run records in the playoffs, Salt River also received its first homer from the top-ranked Arizona Diamondbacks prospect in #AFL23, Ivan Melendez (INF/Arizona).
- 4. MLB Pipeline No. 58 Kyle Manzardo (INF/Cleveland) belted a homer for the third straight game. In his last three contests, Manzardo is hitting .384 (5-13) with three homers, eight RBI and six runs scored. His homer last night traveled 460 feet.
- 5. The Scottsdale Scorpions engineered some ninth inning magic last night, scoring four runs to win the game. The win snapped a three-game skid.
- 6. Surprise won 16-1 over Glendale last night. The Saguaros have scored 17 and 16 runs on each of the last two nights.
- 7. Peyton Wilson (INF/Kansas City) belted two home runs and had four RBI in the effort. Michael Trautwein (C/Cincinnati) also swatted two blasts of his own, totaling five RBI.
- 8. Every player in the Surprise lineup recorded a hit and four had a multi-hit effort in the victory.
- 9. Despite the Mesa setback, Kevin Alcántara smacked a massive homer than went over 440 feet, his second blast of #AFL23.
- 10. The AFL is readying for its first Goodyear Tripleheader this Saturday. All three games are seven-inning contests.

### Today's Headlines

**Surprise** @ **Salt River** - Surprise's offense has put up 33 runs over the last two days and will send Trent Palmer (RHP/Toronto) to the mound Thursday. Palmer only tossed 7.2 innings in MiLB last season, pitching to a 2.35 ERA with eight strikeouts. Palmer is making his second appearance of the fall season.

J.C. Flowers (RHP/Pittsburgh) faces a Saguaros offense that has put up 33 runs in their last two games. Flowers has made two appearances in #AFL23 (one start). He has a 1-0 record with a 6.00 ERA through 6.0 innings pitched, throwing 92 pitches over the two outings (53 strikes).

With Peoria's first loss of the season Wednesday night, Surprise is now tied with Salt River at 2.5 games back of the league lead.

**Scottsdale** @ **Glendale** - Christian McGowan (RHP/Philadelphia) made one AFL start, tossing 4.0 shutout innings, allowing three hits while striking out two and walking one. He threw 41 pitches (26 strikes) in the effort.

The best staff in #AFL23 through week one, the Desert Dogs' pitching has struggled the last two days. Jordan Carr (LHP/Minnesota) threw four shutout innings in his lone fall start, allowing three hits while striking out one and walking none. He threw 49 pitches (35 strikes) in the effort.

**Mesa** @ **Peoria** - Tyler Guilfoil (RHP/Houston) gets his second nod of the #AFL23 season. He threw 84.0 innings with a 3.21 ERA and 123 strikeouts to 37 walks in the regular season. Guilfoil faces the top-ranked offense in the Fall League.

Ryan Webb (LHP/Cleveland) is 1-0 with 2.0 innings and two hits allowed in the Fall League. He struck out five and walked three in the effort.
