- 2. Salt River losers of six straight turned the table on the scorching hot Glendale squad last night at Camelback Ranch, snapping the Desert Dogs' seven game winning streak with a 7-2 victory. Jace Jung (INF/Detroit) hit his first #AFL23 homer in the effort, totaling two hits and three RBI.
- 3. Benny Montgomery (OF/Colorado) went 1-2 with an RBI, run scored and three walks. Him and Sterlin Thompson (OF/Colorado) are both hitting .362 for Salt River in #AFL23.
- 4. Eight of the nine Rafters in the starting lineup had a hit last night against Glendale, but Jung was the only one with multiple hits.
- 5. Kyle Manzardo (INF/Cleveland) had another double in Peoria's setback against Scottsdale, going 1-4 in the effort. Jakob Marsee (OF/San Diego) paced the Javelinas with three hits.
- 6. Speedy on the bases, Victor Scott II (OF/St. Louis) was granted a slow jog after belting his first #AFL23 homer against Peoria Thursday. He went 2-5 with two runs scored.
- 7. Jimmy Crooks (C/St. Louis) had his best offensive performance of the #AFL23 season so far, going 2-4 with a walk and three RBI.
- 8. Scottsdale native Matt Kroon (INF/Philadelphia) went 2-4 with three runs scored in the Scottsdale win and Oliver Dunn (INF/Philadelphia) belted his second homer of the fall season.
- 9. Mesa has won two straight games for the first time this season. Kevin Alcántara (OF/Chicago Cubs) is 5-9 this week with a double, a homer, four RBI and just one strikeout. The Solar Sox won 5-2 over Scottsdale.
- 10. #AFL23 will play a doubleheader at Hohokam Park Saturday, returning for the first time in more than a decade.

Hohokam Doubleheader

The Arizona Fall League is playing a Doubleheader this Saturday Hohokam Stadium, Spring Training home of the Oakland Athletics.

Salt River and Glendale will play at 3:30 and Peoria will face Mesa at 6:30. Both games at Hohokam will be seven inning, show-and-go contests. The 12:30 p.m. game between Surprise and Glendale will also be seven innings.

Media availability will be limited to 3-5 minute postgame interviews. There will not be pregame media availability for any of the teams.

Today's Headlines

Surprise @ **Peoria** - The Saguaros are back in action Thursday after a day off yesterday. They activated Daniel Lynch IV (LHP/Kansas City) this morning for his first #AFL23 outing. Lynch has spent parts of three seasons in the Major Leagues, tossing 52.1 innings over nine relief outings in 2023. He had a 4.64 ERA - his lowest of any year in MLB - while striking out 34 and walking 16.

Lynch pitched four outings for Surprise in the 2019 AFL season prior to his MLB debut. Lynch tossed a 1-1 record with a 3.86 ERA in 14 innings pitched, striking out 19 and walking four. He pitched for two squads at the Minor League level in 2023, tossing six outings with a 3.63 ERA in 22.1 innings pitched. Lynch struck out 24 and walked five in the Minor Leagues last season.

He is opposed by Ryan Webb (LHP/Cleveland), who is 2-1 with a 6.97 ERA with 21 strikeouts and seven walks. He has thrown 202 pitches (122 strikes) over his 10.1 innings pitched.

Mesa @ **Glendale** - The Solar Sox had the day off Wednesday and are back tonight in Glendale as winners of two straight games. Glendale had its sevengame winning streak snapped last night in a 7-2 setback against Salt River at Camelback Ranch.

Tyler Guilfoil (RHP/Houston) has a 1-2 record with a 12.91 ERA in three #AFL23 starts. He has thrown 7.2 innings and allowed 12 runs on 11 hits, striking out seven and walking five. Guilfoil has thrown 151 pitches (88 strikes) with a WHIP over two and a .355 batting average against.

Glendale sends Ben Casparius (RHP/Los Angeles Dodgers) out for his sixth outing and first start this fall season. He has allowed 12 runs on 11 hits in 8.0 innings pitched in #AFL23. Casparius has struck out 11 and walked five on 153 pitches (100 strikes).
