## CAVS QUICK FACTS

🏆 Cleveland is playing Sacramento for the first of two matchups this season (Dec. 9 vs. SAC). The Cavs won the season series over the Kings last season (2-0) for the first time since the 2015-16 season (2-0). **Cleveland enters the game 8-2 and 2nd in the East standings.**

🏆 The Cavs **LEAD the NBA in PPG differential (+10.9)** and rank **2nd in the NBA in 3FG% (.399)**. **Cleveland's 134 3FGM are the MOST triples through 10 games in team history.** **Donovan Mitchell is 6th in the NBA in triples made this season (37) and is one of four players in the NBA shooting .450 3FG% on 35+ 3FGM** (Kevin Huerter - 35-68, .515 | Bojan Bogdanovic - 36-77, .468 | Desmond Bane - 39-85, .459).

🏆 **MILESTONE ALERT: KEVIN LOVE** needs six triples to reach 1,500 3FGM for his career. Love would pass Manu Ginobili (1,495 3FGM) for 42nd on the all-time 3-pointers made list. **DONOVAN MITCHELL** needs five triples to reach 1,000 3FGM for his career. **DARIUS GARLAND** needs six three pointers to reach 400 3FGM for his career.

🏆 **DONOVAN MITCHELL** recorded a game-high 30 PTS on 10-15 (.667) shooting from the field, including 8-11 (.727) shooting from beyond the arc and 2 AST in 39 MIN on Nov. 7 at LAC. **It was just the 4th time in Allen's career he has grabbed 20+ REB.** **Allen ranks 4th in the NBA in rebounds per game (12.2 RPG) and T-2nd in the NBA in double-doubles (7).** Allen has recorded 10+ rebounds in 8 of his 10 games this season as well as six multi-block games (four straight).

🏆 **DARIUS GARLAND** tallied his second double-double of the season with 19 PTS, a game-high 12 AST and 1 STL in 38 MIN on Nov. 7 at LAC. Garland dished out 8 AST in the first half, tying his career-high for assists in an opening half.

## CONNECTIONS

Golden State Head Coach **Steve Kerr** played for the Cavaliers in 188 games over four seasons (1989-1993) and shot .472 (133-282) from the three-point line during his stint...Warriors guard **Stephen Curry** was born in Akron, Ohio; His father, **Dell Curry**, played for the Cavaliers during the 1987-88 season; Cavs assistant coach **Luke Walton** was the assistant coach for the Warriors from 2014-16 and during the 2015-16 season appointed as the interim head coach Walton guided the Warriors to a 19-0 run, winning the NBA Western Conference Coach of the Month; Walton received his first championship as a coach with the Warriors in 2015... Cavs forward **Kevin Love** and Warriors forward **Kevon Looney** played their collegiate basketball at UCLA...Warriors forward **Andrew Wiggins** was selected by the Cavaliers in the first round (1st overall) of the 2014 NBA Draft and was traded to the Minnesota Timberwolves before playing a game with the Cavaliers in a deal that included Cavs forward Kevin Love... Cavs guard **Ricky Rubio** and Warriors forward **Andrew Wiggins** were teammates on the Minnesota Timberwolves from 2014-2017... Warriors guard **Ryan Rollins** played collegiately for Toledo in Toledo, Ohio...Warriors guard **Donte Divincenzo** and Cavs center **Robin Lopez** were teammates on the Milwaukee Bucks during the 2019-20 season.
