CAVS QUICK FACTS

Cleveland, winners of 5 straight games, is playing BOS for the second of four matchups this season (March 1 at BOS, March 6 vs. BOS). The Cavs took down the Celtics in overtime 132-123 on Oct. 28 in BOS, trailing by as many as 15 PTS. It marked the first comeback win after trailing by 15+ points in BOS since Nov. 14, 2014. **Donovan Mitchell** and **Caris LeVert** each scored 41 PTS in the win.

The Cavaliers LEAD THE NBA in three point percentage, shooting 88-206 (.427) so far this season. They are the 2nd team in NBA history to shoot .420+ 3FG% on 85+ 3FGM through the first SIX games of a season (MIL shot 108-246; .439 - 2020-21 season). The Wine & Gold shot 23-50 (.460) from beyond the arc in Sunday's win vs. NYK, marking the 2nd-most triples in a regular season game in Cavs history (Cleveland shot 25-46 from three-point range on March 3, 2017 at Atlanta).

The Cavs had two players make 8+ triples in Sunday's win vs. NYK (**DONOVAN MITCHELL** - 8-13 3FG; .615 3FG% and **KEVIN LOVE** - 8-13 3FG; .615 3FG%). It was just the second time in NBA history for teammates to each finish with 8+ triples in a game (Zach LaVine - 9 3FGM and Coby White - 8 3FGM on Feb. 10, 2021 vs. NOP). **DEAN WADE** also made 6 3FG in the game, marking the first time in NBA history a trio of teammates has made 22+ triples in a game. Wade currently ranks 2nd in the NBA in 3FG% (15-24, .667).

DONOVAN MITCHELL finished with his first double-double of the season with a game-high 38 PTS on 12-20 (.600) shooting from the field, including 8-13 (.615) shooting from beyond the arc, a CAREER-HIGH 12 AST, 3 REB, 2 BLK and 1 STL in 37 MIN. It was Mitchell's second career game with 30+ PTS and 10+ AST (37 PTS, 10 AST on March 2, 2022 at HOU). Mitchell shot 5-7 (.714) from beyond the arc in the 1st quarter, marking the 2nd time in his career making 5+ triples in a quarter (7-9 3FG in the 3rd Q on March 16, 2022 vs. CHI).

KEVIN LOVE recorded a season-high 29 PTS while shooting 8-13 (.615) from distance and 8 REB in 22 MIN off the bench on Sunday vs. NYK. Love scored 18 PTS on 5-7 (.714) shooting from beyond the arc in the 4th quarter, his most triples in a final frame in his career. Love's 8 three pointers tied his career high for triples in a game (five times). His 29 PTS were also his 3rd-highest scoring total off the bench for his career. Love also leads the NBA this season in charges drawn (7).

DEAN WADE chipped in a career-high 22 PTS on 8-11 (.727) shooting from the field, including 6-8 (.750) shooting from beyond the arc, 4 REB and 3 AST in 33 MIN on Sunday vs. NYK. It was the second time in his career making 6+ triples in a game (shot 6-10 3FG on May 1, 2021 vs. MIA). It was also the second time in his career scoring 20+ points in a game (21 PTS on April 11, 2021 vs. NOP).

The Cavaliers rank 4th in the NBA in offensive rating this season (116.9) and 3rd in the NBA in Defensive rating (105.3).

DARIUS GARLAND averaged career-highs in PTS (21.7 PPG), AST (8.6 APG), REB (3.3 RPG), STL (1.31 SPG), FG% (.462), FT% (.892), double-doubles (29) and MIN (35.7 MPG) during the 2021-22 season. He finished 3rd in the NBA's Most Improved Player voting and was an NBA All-Star for the 1st time in his career. He was 1 of 4 players in the NBA last season to average 20.0+ PPG, 7.0+ APG and .460+ FG% (Trae Young, Nikola Jokic and Dejounte Murray).

CAVS NOTES: The Cavs trailed by as many as 15 points in this victory. It marks their first come-from-behind win after trailing by 15+ points in Boston since Nov. 14, 2014...The Cavaliers shot 16-35 (.457) from beyond the arc in the win...The win marks Cleveland's best start (4-1) since the 2016-17 season (5-0)...**DONOVAN MITCHELL** finished with a game-high tying 41 points on 15-26 (.576) from the field, including 5-9 (.556) from beyond the arc, four rebounds, three assists and one steal in 46 minutes of play. It was Mitchell's 10th career game with 40+ points (first with Cleveland) and joined Caris LeVert (41 PTS) as the first pair of Cavaliers teammates with 40+ points in a regular season game in franchise history...**CARIS LEVERT** finished with 41 points on 12-21 (.571) shooting from the field, including 11-12 (.916) shooting from the charity stripe, seven assists, four rebounds, and three steals in 43 minutes. LeVert's 42 points are the most he has scored since joining the Cavaliers last season and it was the fourth game of his career with 40+ PTS. LeVert joined Donovan Mitchell (41 PTS) as the first pair of Cavaliers teammates with 40+ points in a regular season game in franchise history...**JARRETT ALLEN** tallied his fourth double-double of the season with 12 points, a game-high 11 rebounds and two assists in 40 minutes of play. Allen also recorded his 4,000th career point in the victory...**EVAN MOBLEY** recorded his first double-double of the season with 19 points on 7-12 (.583) shooting from the field, 10 rebounds, three assists, one steal and two blocks in 42 minutes.

ON THE DEFENSIVE: The Cavs finished the season ranking **5th in the NBA in defensive rating (108.9)** and **5th in the NBA in opponent PPG (105.7)**. They were also **8th in opponent FG% (.452)** and **3rd in the NBA in second chance points allowed per game (12.5)**.

OG THE ALL-STAR PG: Darius Garland completed the regular season averaging **career-highs in points (21.7), assists (8.6), rebounds (3.3), steals (1.31), FG% (.462), FT% (.892), double-doubles (29) and minutes (35.7)**. He was the first Spanish voice of the Brooklyn Nets in 2010-2012.
