Lakers forward **LeBron James** played 11 seasons for Cleveland (2003-2010, 2014-2018), winning an NBA title with the team in 2016 and left as the franchise's all-time leader in games played (849), points scored (23,119), rebounds (6,190), assists (6,228), steals (1,376), field goals made (8,369), three-pointers made (1,251), free throws made (5,130) and triple-doubles (64)... Lakers forward LeBron James is from Akron, Oh and attended nearby High School St. Vincent-St. Mary...Lakers Assistant Coach **Phil Handy** was an assistant coach with the Cavaliers from 2013-2018 and was part of the Cavs 2016 NBA Championship coaching staff...Cavaliers Assistant Coach **J.J. Outlaw** worked for five seasons (2011-16) with the Los Angeles Lakers as a player development coach and video coordinator...Cavs Senior Basketball Advisor **Bernie Bickerstaff** was an assistant coach for the Lakers under Mike Brown in 2012-13...Cavs forward **Kevin Love** played college ball at UCLA in Los Angeles... Lakers guard **Russell Westbrook** and Cavs forward **Kevin Love** were teammates in college at UCLA... Cavs guards **Evan Mobley** and **Isaiah Mobley** both played collegiately for USC...Cavs center **Robin Lopez** and Lakers forward **Anthony Davis** were teammates on the New Orleans Hornets during the 2021-13 season...Lakers guard **Patrick Beverley** play for the Houston Rockets while Cavs head coach J.B. Bickerstaff was on Houston's coaching staff from 2012-2016...

CAVS NOTES: All five starters for the Cavaliers scored in double figures in the win: **Darius Garland** (29 PTS), **Donovan Mitchell** (25 PTS), **Evan Mobley** (15 PTS), **Caris LeVert** (15 PTS) and **Jarrett Allen** (14 PTS)...Cleveland outscored Boston tonight in the paint 56-42 (+14)...Cleveland finished with a season-low 11 turnovers in the win...**DARIUS GARLAND** chipped in his first double-double of the season with a team-high 29 points, including 5-11 (.454) shooting from beyond the arc, a game-high 12 assists, five rebounds, three assists and a game-high three steals in 42 minutes during his first home appearance of the season. Garland scored 14 of his points in the first quarter, marking his career-high for points in an opening quarter (4-6 FG, 3-3 3FG). It was the fourth game in his career he has recorded 25+ PTS, 10+ AST and 3+ STL...**DONOVAN MITCHELL** finished with 25 points, six assists, four rebounds, one steal and two blocks in 44 minutes...**JARRETT ALLEN** recorded his fifth double-double of the season with 15 points on 6-11 (.545) shooting from the field, a team-high 14 rebounds, and two blocks in 36 minutes of play...**CARIS LEVERT** tallied 15 points, including 3-7 (.429) shooting from three-point range, eight rebounds and four assists in 46 minutes. LeVert has scored in double figures in six of his seven games this season...**EVAN MOBLEY** contributed 15 points on 7-8 (.875) shooting from the field, seven rebounds and two assists in 32 minutes of play. Mobley has recorded double-digit scoring efforts in all seven games this season.

CAVS NOTES: Cleveland shot 23-50 (.460) from beyond the arc in the game, including 9-16 (.562) in the first quarter and 8-13 (.615) in the fourth quarter. Cleveland entered the game leading the NBA in three-point percentage and are shooting 88-206 (.427) on the season. Cleveland's 23 triples were the second-most made three pointers in a regular season game in franchise history (Cleveland shot 25-46 from three-point range on March 3, 2017 at Atlanta)...Cleveland dished out a season-high 33 assists, their most since April 10, 2022 vs. MIL (39 AST)...The Cavs had two players make 8+ triples in the game (Donovan Mitchell – 8-13 3FG; .615 3FG% and Kevin Love – 8-13 3FG; .615 3FG%). It was just the second time in NBA history for teammates to each finish with 8+ triples in a game (Zach LaVine – 9 3FGM and Coby White – 8 3FGM on Feb. 10, 2021 vs. NOP). Dean Wade also made 6 3FG in the game, marking the second time since the NBA adopted the 3-point line in 1979-80 that three teammates made 6+ three-pointers each in a game...**DONOVAN MITCHELL** finished with his first double-double of the season, contributing a game-high 38 points on 12-20 (.600) shooting from the field, including 8-13 (.615) shooting from beyond the arc, a career-high 12 assists, three rebounds, two blocks and one steal in 37 minutes. It was Mitchell's second career game with 30+ points and 10+ assists (37 PTS, 10 AST on March 2, 2022 at HOU)...**KEVIN LOVE** recorded a season-high 29 points while shooting 8-13 (.615) from beyond the arc and eight rebounds in 22 minutes off the bench. Love scored 18 PTS on 5-7 (.714) shooting from beyond the arc in the fourth quarter, his most triples in a final frame in his career. Love's 8 three pointers tied his career high for triples in a game (five times). His 29 points were also his third-highest scoring total off the bench for his career...**DEAN WADE** chipped in a career-high 22 points on 8-11 (.727) shooting from the field, including 6-8 (.750) shooting from beyond the arc, four rebounds and three assists in 33 minutes. It was the second time in his career making 6+ triples in a game (shot 6-10 3FG on May 1, 2021 vs. MIA). It was also the second time in his career scoring 20+ points in a game (21 PTS on April 11, 2021 vs. NOP).

CAVS NOTES: The Cavs trailed by as many as 15 points in this victory. It marks their first come-from-behind win after trailing by 15+ points in Boston since Nov. 14, 2014...The Cavaliers shot 16-35 (.457) from beyond the arc in the win...The win marks Cleveland's best start (4-1) since the 2016-17 season (5-0)...**DONOVAN MITCHELL** finished with a game-high tying 41 points on 15-26 (.576) from the field, including 5-9 (.556) from beyond the arc, four rebounds, three assists and one steal in 46 minutes of play. It was Mitchell's 10th career game with 40+ points (first with Cleveland) and joined Caris LeVert (41 PTS) as the first pair of Cavaliers teammates with 40+ points in a regular season game in franchise history...**CARIS LEVERT** finished with 41 points on 12-21 (.571) shooting from the field, including 11-12 (.545) shooting from the charity stripe, seven assists, four rebounds, and three steals in 43 minutes. LeVert's 42 points are the most he has scored since joining the Cavaliers last season and it was the fourth game of his career with 40+ PTS. LeVert joined Donovan Mitchell (41 PTS) as the first pair of Cavaliers teammates with 40+ points in a regular season game in franchise history...**JARRETT ALLEN** tallied his fourth double-double of the season with 12 points, a game-high 11 rebounds and two assists in 40 minutes of play. Allen also recorded his 4,000th career point in the victory...**EVAN MOBLEY** recorded his first double-double of the season with 19 points on 7-12 (.583) shooting from the field, 10 rebounds, three assists, one steal and two blocks in 42 minutes.

CAVS NOTES: The Cavs had six players finishing with double-digit scoring efforts, including all five starters: Evan Mobley (22 PTS), Jarrett Allen (18 PTS), Donovan Mitchell (14 PTS), Cedi Osman (14 PTS), Dean Wade (12 PTS), Caris LeVert (10 PTS)...**JARRETT ALLEN** finished with his third double-double of the season with 18 points, a game-high 16 rebounds (seven offensive rebounds), one steal and one block in 30 minutes. With his sixth rebound of the game, Allen secured his 3,000th career rebound and is the only active NBA player aged 25 or younger with 3,000 career rebounds. He is also just the third active player age 26 or younger with 3,000+ career rebounds (Karl-Anthony Towns, Domantas Sabonis) [via Elias Sports Bureau]. It was Allen's first game this season with 15+ PTS and 15+ REB (recorded 10 games last season with 15+ PTS and 15+ REB)...**EVAN MOBLEY** chipped in a team-high 20 points on 9-15 (.600) shooting from the field, three rebounds, three assists, one steal and one block in 34 minutes of play...**CEDI OSMAN** contributed 14 points, seven rebounds, three assists and one block in 31 minutes off the bench. Osman had recorded 10+ points off the bench in all four games this season, becoming the second Cavalier since 1985-86 to record 10+ points off the bench in the Cavs first four games of the season (Jordan Clarkson, 2018-19)...**DONOVAN MITCHELL** tallied 14 points, four rebounds, and a game-high eight assists and two steals in 37 minutes of play.

CAVS NOTES: **DONOVAN MITCHELL** recorded a game-high 37 points, a team-high tying four assists, five rebounds, a game-high three steals and one block in 44 minutes. It was his third consecutive game with 30+ points, becoming just the third player in NBA HISTORY to record 30+ points in his first three games with a new team (Wilt Chamberlain, eight straight in 1959-60 with PHI and Glenn Robinson, three straight in 2002-03 with ATL) [via Elias Sports Bureau]. Mitchell is the first Cavs player to record 35+ PTS, 5+ REB, 3+ STL and 1+ BLK in a game since LeBron James on Nov. 3, 2017 vs. WAS (57 PTS, 11 REB, 3 STL, 2 BLK)...**JARRETT ALLEN** finished with 15 points, a game-high 14 rebounds, three assists and two blocks in 38 minutes. It was Allen's second double-double of the season (13 PTS, 10 REB on Oct. 19 at TOR)...**CEDI OSMAN** recorded 16 points on 6-10 (.600) shooting from the field, including 3-5 (.600) shooting from beyond the arc, three assists, and one steal in 32 minutes off the bench. Osman became the fourth player in Cavs history to record three straight games with 15+ points off the bench to start a season (Campy Russell in 1976-77, Austin Carr in 1978-79 and Jordan Clarkson in 2018-19). 

DOUBLE-DOUBLE JA: **JARRETT ALLEN** has already posted **5 double-doubles** and is averaging **12.3 points (.545 FG%), a career-high 12.0 rebounds and 1.14 blocks in 33.1 minutes**.

MARVELOUS MOBLEY: **EVAN MOBLEY**, last year's runner-up for the NBA Rookie of the Year award, is off to a solid start. Through 7 games, the second-year pro is averaging **15.7 points (.589 FG%, .786 FT%), 6.1 rebounds, 2.1 assists, 1.00 steals and 1.00 blocks in 34.2 minutes**, while posting 1 double-double.

Cleveland finished as the No. 8 seed in the Eastern Conference and played in its first ever NBA Play-In Tournament. The Cavs 44 wins were the most since the 2017-18 season (50-32).

JUMP, JUMP: Cleveland had the **2nd-highest jump in win percentage in the NBA this past season** (highest in the Eastern Conference) at +.231 (.306 to .537) behind only the Minnesota Timberwolves +.242 (.319 to .561).

ON THE DEFENSIVE: The Cavs finished the season ranking **5th in the NBA in defensive rating (108.9)** and **5th in the NBA in opponent PPG (105.7)**. They were also **8th in opponent FG% (.452)** and **3rd in the NBA in second chance points allowed per game (12.5)**.

DG THE ALL-STAR PG: Darius Garland completed the regular season averaging **career-highs in points (21.7)**, **assists (8.6)**, **rebounds (3.3)**, **steals (1.31)**, **FG% (.462)**, **FT% (.892)**, **double-doubles (29)** and **minutes (35.7)**. He finished **3rd place in the NBA's Most Improved Player award voting** and was an NBA All-Star for the first time in his career.

- Garland joined LeBron James as the only players in Cavs history to finish a season with **20.0+ PPG and 8.0+ APG**.

- Garland earned **NBA Eastern Conference Player of the Week** honors for the week of Jan. 10-16 and had a stretch of five straight games with at least 10 assists in January (Jan. 15-24), becoming just the second Cavs player to accomplish that feat since 2003 (LeBron James).
- Additionally, Garland became the **4th-youngest player in Cavaliers history to notch a triple-double in a win at Utah on Jan. 12** (LeBron James, Brad Daugherty, Kyrie Irving) and just the **3rd player in NBA history to have a game of at least 27 points, 18 assists and five rebounds before age 22** during Cleveland's victory at Oklahoma City on Jan. 15 (Trae Young, Luka Dončić).

- The Cavs had two All-Stars in the game (JARRETT ALLEN and DARIUS GARLAND), Cleveland's 10th time with multiple All-Stars in the event, as both stars played for Team LeBron. Allen finished with 10 PTS, 9 REB, 1 STL and 2 BLK in 24 MIN while Garland tallied 13 PTS, 3 AST and 2 STL in 24 MIN.
- The 2022 NBA All-Star Weekend in Cleveland opened up on Friday, Feb. 18, with EVAN MOBLEY and ISAAC OKORO playing for Team Barry in the Rising Stars. The Cavs duo helped Team Barry win the mini-tourney. Mobley totaled 18 PTS and 11 REB in the event, while Okoro added 6 PTS.

He was the first Spanish voice of the Brooklyn Nets in 2010-2012.
