CAVS QUICK FACTS

Cleveland is playing New York for the second of four matchups this season (Jan. 24 at NYK and March 31 vs. NYK). **Cleveland is 12-4 this season against Eastern Conference opponents and are 9-1 at home (4th best home record in the NBA).** The Wine and Gold rank 2nd in the NBA in defensive rating (107.5) and 7th in the NBA in offensive rating (114.3) this season.

In Wednesday night's 113-85 win over the 76ers, the Cavaliers **shot a season-high 45-74 (.608) from the field**, including shooting **16-17 (.941) in the second quarter**, the highest FG% in a quarter for the Cavaliers since play-by-play data was tracked in 1997-98 [via Elias]. Philadelphia's 85 points were also the lowest points total for any Cavaliers opponent this season.

The Cavs rank **3rd in the NBA in 3FG% (.385)** and have made **267 3FGM**, the second-most triples through 22 games in team history. Donovan Mitchell also ranks **T-3rd in the NBA in triples made this season (76)** and is shooting a career-high **.422 3FG% (76-180)**.

MILESTONE ALERT: With his first triple of the game on Wednesday night vs. Philadelphia, **CEDI OSMAN** (543 3FGM) passed Danny Ferry (543 3FGM) for sole possession of **8th on the Cavs all-time three-pointers made list**.

CARIS LEVERT finished with a game-high 22 PTS on a season-high 8-11 (.727) shooting from the field, including 3-4 (.750) shooting from beyond the arc, 6 REB, 4 AST and 1 STL in 33 MIN off the bench on Nov. 30 vs. PHI. It was his third game this season with 20+ points

DARIUS GARLAND chipped in 21 PTS on 9-16 (.562) shooting from the field, including 3-4 (.750) shooting from beyond the arc, a game-high 9 AST and 2 REB in 31 MIN on Nov. 30 vs. PHI. Garland is averaging a **career-high 22.8 PPG**, 8.1 APG, 2.3 RPG and 1.25 steals in a **career-high 35.6 MPG** and is shooting a **career-best .418 3FG% (46-110)**. He ranks **5th in the NBA this season in assists per game** and has recorded 10+ AST in 5 games this season.

EVAN MOBLEY tallied 16 PTS on 8-10 (.800) shooting from the field, a game-high 8 REB, 3 AST and 1 BLK in 24 MIN on Nov. 30 vs. PHI. Mobley has recorded 10+ points in 19 of his 22 games this season. His **800 FG%** was his **second-highest shooting percentage of the season (7-8 FG, .875% on Nov. 2 vs. BOS)**. Mobley is averaging 11.6 rebounds in his last eight games since Nov. 18.

DONOVAN MITCHELL has recorded 30+ points in 11 games this season and ranks **T-6th in the NBA for 30-point games**. He is averaging a career-high 28.4 PPG (**8th in NBA**), 5.1 APG, 4.0 RPG and 1.45 SPG in a career-high 36.4 MPG. **Mitchell is 1 of 2 NBA players this season with 75+ 3FGM on .400+ shooting from beyond the arc (Stephen Curry). Cleveland is 8-3 this season when Mitchell scores 30+ points.**

ISAAC OKORO chipped in 11 PTS on 5-7 (.714) shooting from the field, 5 REB, 2 AST and a game-high tying 3 STL in 22 MIN off the bench on Nov. 30 vs. PHI. It was his third game this season with 10+ PTS and 10th game of his career with 3+ STL.

HUSTLE NUMBERS: KEVIN LOVE ranks 2nd in the NBA in charges drawn (10). **EVAN MOBLEY** ranks T-4th in the NBA in contested shots per game (11.7) and **JARRETT ALLEN** ranks 7th (11.4). Mobley ranks **T-2nd in the NBA in contested three-pointers per game (4.1)**

CAVS NOTES: The Cavs had six players finishing with double-digit scoring efforts, including all five starters: Evan Mobley (22 PTS), Jarrett Allen (18 PTS), Donovan Mitchell (14 PTS), Cedi Osman (14 PTS), Dean Wade (12 PTS), Caris LeVert (10 PTS)...**JARRETT ALLEN** finished with his third double-double of the season with 18 points, a game-high 16 rebounds (seven offensive rebounds), one steal and one block in 30 minutes. With his sixth rebound of the game, Allen secured his 3,000th career rebound and is the only active NBA player aged 25 or younger with 3,000 career rebounds. He is also just the third active player age 26 or younger with 3,000+ career rebounds (Karl-Anthony Towns, Domantas Sabonis) [via Elias Sports Bureau]. It was Allen's first game this season with 15+ PTS and 15+ REB (recorded 10 games last season with 15+ PTS and 15+ REB)...**EVAN MOBLEY** chipped in a team-high 20 points on 9-15 (.600) shooting from the field, three rebounds, three assists, one steal and one block in 34 minutes of play...**CEDI OSMAN** contributed 14 points, seven rebounds, three assists and one block in 31 minutes off the bench. Osman had recorded 10+ points off the bench in all four games this season, becoming the second Cavalier since 1985-86 to record 10+ points off the bench in the Cavs first four games of the season (Jordan Clarkson, 2018-19)...**DONOVAN MITCHELL** tallied 14 points, four rebounds, and a game-high eight assists and two steals in 37 minutes of play...**DEAN WADE** recorded 12 points on 4-7 (.571) shooting from beyond the arc, three rebounds and one steal in 30 minutes during his first start of the season...**CARIS LEVERT** tallied 12 points, six assists, two rebounds and one steal in 33 minutes. LeVert has recorded 10+ points in all four games this season.

CAVS NOTES: Cleveland shot 23-50 (.460) from beyond the arc in the game, including 9-16 (.562) in the first quarter and 8-13 (.615) in the fourth quarter. Cleveland entered the game leading the NBA in three-point percentage and are shooting 88-206 (.427) on the season. Cleveland's 23 triples were the second-most made three pointers in a regular season game in franchise history (Cleveland shot 25-46 from three-point range on March 3, 2017 at Atlanta)...Cleveland dished out a season-high 33 assists, their most since April 10, 2022 vs. MIL (39 AST)...The Cavs had two players make 8+ triples in the game (Donovan Mitchell – 8-13 3FG; .615 3FG% and Kevin Love -8-13 3FG; .615 3FG%). It was just the second time in NBA history for teammates to each finish with 8+ triples in a game (Zach LaVine – 9 3FGM and Coby White – 8 3FGM on Feb. 10, 2021 vs. NOP). Dean Wade also made 6 3FG in the game, marking the second time since the NBA adopted the 3-point line in 1979-80 that three teammates made 6+ three-pointers each in a game...**DONOVAN MITCHELL** finished with his first double-double of the season, contributing a game-high 38 points on 12-20 (.600) shooting from the field, including 8-13 (.615) shooting from beyond the arc, a career-high 12 assists, three rebounds, two blocks and one steal in 37 minutes. It was Mitchell's second career game with 30+ points and 10+ assists (37 PTS, 10 AST on March 2, 2022 at HOU)...**KEVIN LOVE** recorded a season-high 29 points while shooting 8-13 (.615) from beyond the arc and eight rebounds in 22 minutes off the bench. Love scored 18 PTS on 5-7 (.714) shooting from beyond the arc in the fourth quarter, his most triples in a final frame in his career. Love's 8 three pointers tied his career high for triples in a game (five times). His 29 points were also his third-highest scoring total off the bench for his career...**DEAN WADE** chipped in a career-high 22 points on 8-11 (.727) shooting from the field, including 6-8 (.750) shooting from beyond the arc, four rebounds and three assists in 33 minutes. It was the second time in his career making 6+ triples in a game (shot 6-10 3FG on May 1, 2021 vs. MIA). It was also the second time in his career scoring 20+ points in a game (21 PTS on April 11, 2021 vs. NOP).

CAVS NOTES: With the 113-85 win (+28), Cleveland secured its largest win over the 76ers since winning 114-85 (+29) on Feb. 18, 2014 at PHI. 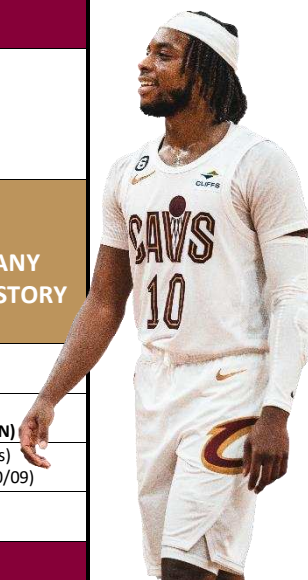

His road to the microphone is an American dream, a testament of his hard work, dedication, and transparency, which are the pillars to his success.



Rafa was the voice of the New Jersey Nets 1997-2001 and also called the basketball games for St. John's University Men's basketball during the same period. He was the first Spanish voice of the Brooklyn Nets in 2010-2012. In 2016 Rafa became the Public Address Announcer and the voice of legendary Azteca Stadium in Mexico City for the annual edition of NFL Mexico games and continues to serve as the Hispanic voice of the NCAA Final Four Tournaments.
