### CAVS QUICK FACTS

Cleveland is playing Milwaukee for the third of four matchups this season (Jan 21 vs MIL). Cleveland **LEADS THE NBA** in defensive rating (106.7) and is also **allowing the fewest PPG in the NBA this season** (104.4 PPG). Cleveland **currently has the best home record in the NBA this season (15-2), their best home start since 2015-16 (15-2)**. Cleveland also has the 3rd best record in the NBA at 21-11 and have won 4 straight games, outscoring their opponent 111.3 to 100.0 (+11.3) over the last four games.

In Monday night's win over Utah, the Cavs **shot a season-best 43-70 (.614) from the field**, the 3rd time this season shooting .600+ from the field. They also had 7 players finish in double-figures for this 1st time this season and held the Jazz to just 99 PTS, marking the 12th time this season holding their opponent to under 100 PTS which leads the NBA for most times holding an opponent to under 100 points.

**MILESTONES: JARRETT ALLEN** needs two more blocks to record his 500th career blocked shot...**CARIS LEVERT** is 13 points shy of 5,000 points for his career.

**DONOVAN MITCHELL** finished with a team-high 23 PTS on 8-12 (.667) shooting from the field and 2 REB in 23 MIN on Dec. 19 vs. UTA. He has recorded 20+ PTS in 24 of his 28 appearances this season. **Mitchell has recorded 5+ triples 11 times this season, marking the 3rd-most games with 5+ triples in Cavaliers history and has scored 30+ PTS in 15 games this season, ranking T-6th in the NBA for 30-point games (12-3)**. He is 1 of 2 NBA players this season with 100+ 3FGM on .400+ shooting from beyond the arc (Stephen Curry) and **also ranks 5th in the NBA in triples made (110), shooting a career-high .431 3FG% (110-255)**.

**DARIUS GARLAND** chipped in 17 PTS on 7-11 (.636) shooting from the field, a game-high 8 AST and 1 STL in 30 MIN on Dec. 19 vs. UTA. Garland **ranks 5th in the NBA in assists per game this season and is T-5th in the NBA in point-assist double-doubles (8)**.

**CEDI OSMAN** chipped in 22 PTS on 8-10 (.800) shooting from the field, 2 REB and 1 STL in 24 MIN off the bench on Monday night. He scored 20 of his points in the 4th quarter, including shooting 5-6 (.833) from beyond the arc in the quarter. **His 20 fourth quarter points and five fourth quarter triples were both career high's for any quarter**. It was his third game with 20+ points off the bench this season.

**JARRETT ALLEN** tallied his 12th double-double of the season with 20 PTS on 7-11 (.636) shooting from the field, a game-high 11 REB, 2 AST, 1 STL and a game-high 3 BLK in 30 MIN. It was his fifth 20-10 game this season and third game with 3+ blocks.

**EVAN MOBLEY** is one of four players in the NBA averaging 15.0+ PTS, 9.0+ REB, 2.5+ APG and 1.0+ BLK (Joel Embiid, Giannis Antetokounmpo and Anthony Davis). He is the youngest player in the NBA averaging 15.0+ PTS and 9.0+ RPG (21 years old) and has also scored in double figures in 28 of his 32 games this season.

**HUSTLE NUMBERS: KEVIN LOVE LEADS THE NBA** in charges drawn (14). **JARRETT ALLEN** ranks 3rd in the NBA in contested shots per game (12.2) and **EVAN MOBLEY** ranks 6th (11.6). Mobley also **LEADS THE NBA** in contested three-pointers per game (4.3).

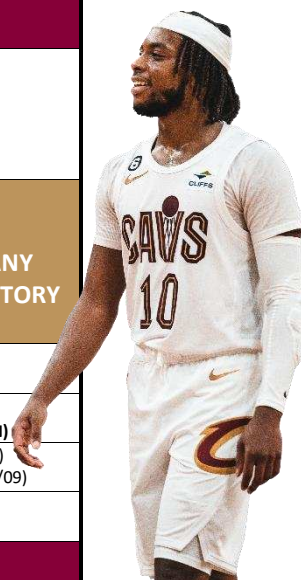

Hernandez-Brito, known as Rafa "El Alcalde" (The Mayor) is the first Hispanic sportscaster to have called finals in all three major sports and the NCAA Final Four in the U.S. He is a syndicated sportscaster in the US and Latin America with the ability to call all major sports, showcasing an extensive career in sports radio and television in the Hispanic market. His road to the microphone is an American dream, a testament of his hard work, dedication, and transparency, which are the pillars to his success.



Rafa was the voice of the New Jersey Nets 1997-2001 and also called the basketball games for St. John's University Men's basketball during the same period. He was the first Spanish voice of the Brooklyn Nets in 2010-2012. In 2016 Rafa became the Public Address Announcer and the voice of legendary Azteca Stadium in Mexico City for the annual edition of NFL Mexico games and continues to serve as the Hispanic voice of the NCAA Final Four Tournaments.
