## CAVS QUICK FACTS

🏆 Cleveland is playing Chicago for the third of four matchups this season (Feb. 11 vs. CHI). Cleveland **LEADS THE NBA** in defensive rating (108.4) and is also **allowing the fewest PPG in the NBA this season** (106.2 PPG). Cleveland is currently tied for the most home wins in the NBA this season (16-4), their best home start since 2016-17 (18-2). The Cavs are 6-3 against Central Division foe this season.

🏆 Cleveland has defeated Chicago in both of its matchups this season, including a 128-96 (+32) win in their first matchup at CHI on Oct. 22, marking the Cavs first win of the season. **The 32-point victory for the Cavaliers was the largest win over the Bulls in team history.**

🏆 **MILESTONES: KEVIN LOVE** needs 1 FG to pass Campy Russell (2,480 FGM) for 10th on the Cavs all-time field goals made list.

🏆 **CARIS LEVERT** contributed a game-high 23 PTS on 10-19 (.526) shooting from the field, 7 REB, 4 AST and 1 STL in 37 MIN on Dec. 31 at CHI. It was LeVert's seventh game this season with 20+ points and he has recorded 20+ points in his last three consecutive starts. **In his last six career games against the Bulls (since Dec. 26, 2021) LeVert is averaging 25.0 PPG, 6.3 APG and 5.2 RPG in 37.3 MPG.**

🏆 **KEVIN LOVE** chipped in 20 PTS, including 5-11 (.454) shooting from beyond the arc, 9 REB, 1 STL and 1 BLK in 34 MIN during his second start this season on Dec. 31 at CHI. It was his third time this season with 20+ PTS and third time with 5+ triples.

🏆 **DONOVAN MITCHELL** has recorded 20+ PTS in 26 of his 33 games this season as well as 30+ PTS in 16 games, (13-3). Mitchell has also recorded 5+ triples 12 times this season, tying him for the 2nd-most games in a season with 5+ triples in Cavs history. He is 1 of 3 NBA players this season with 120+ 3FGM on .400+ shooting from beyond the arc (Stephen Curry, Buddy Hield) and also ranks 5th in the NBA in triples made (124), shooting a career-high .411 3FG% (124-302).

🏆 **DARIUS GARLAND** ranks 6th in the NBA in assists per game this season and is also 8th in the NBA in point-assist double-doubles (8). Garland is also one of 10 players in the NBA this season with 3+ 40-point games and he joins Donovan Mitchell as the only pair of teammates in the NBA with 3+ 40-point games this season.

🏆 **JARRETT ALLEN** contributed a game-high 10 REB to go with 6 PTS, 2 STL and 2 BLK in 35 MIN on Dec. 31 at CHI. Allen is 1 of 7 players in the NBA averaging 13.0+ PTS and 10.0+ REB this season. Allen has recorded a steal in a season-long six straight games.

🏆 **BENCH HELP: CEDI OSMAN** chipped in 12 PTS on 4-7 (.571) shooting from the field, including 3-5 (.600) shooting from beyond the arc, 4 REB and 2 AST in 24 MIN off the bench. It was his 16th game this season with 10+ PTS. **ISAAC OKORO** recorded 11 PTS on 3-5 (.600) shooting from the field, a season-high tying 7 REB, 1 STL and 1 BLK in 23 MIN. It was the 7th time in his career with 7+ REB.

🏆 **HUSTLE NUMBERS: KEVIN LOVE LEADS THE NBA** in charges drawn (16). **JARRETT ALLEN** ranks 3rd in the NBA in contested shots per game (12.3) and **EVAN MOBLEY** ranks 6th (11.1). Mobley also **LEADS THE NBA** in contested three-pointers per game (4.1).
