CAVS QUICK FACTS

Cleveland is playing Portland for the 2nd and final time this season. It is the Cavs fourth game of a 5-game Western Conference road trip (DEN, PHX, UTA, POR, MIN). With a win, The Cavs would have their fourth straight win over Portland for the first time since winning six straight from Jan. 2008 to Jan. 2010. Cleveland **LEADS THE NBA in defensive rating (109.2)** and is also **allowing the fewest PPG in the NBA (106.8 PPG)**. Cleveland is also T-2nd in the NBA in points in the paint allowed per game (45.4).

Earlier this season on Nov. 23, the Cavs beat the Blazers 114-96 (+18), marking Cleveland's largest margin of victory over Portland since winning 112-88 (+24) on Dec. 15, 2004 vs. POR. **The Cavs have held their opponents under 100 points in an NBA best 14 games this season and are 13-1 when holding their opponent under 100 PTS.**

MILESTONES: With his 5th rebound of the game on Jan. 10 at Utah, **KEVIN LOVE (4,459 REB)** passed Anderson Varejao (4,454 REB) for sole possession of 6th place on the Cavaliers all-time rebounds list. **CARIS LEVERT** needs just two more triples to reach 500 career three-pointers. With his third steal of the game on Jan. 10 at Utah, **DONOVAN MITCHELL** recorded his 500th career steal.

DONOVAN MITCHELL finished with a game-high 46 PTS on 14-27 (.518) shooting from the field, including 11-11 from the free throw line, a team-high tying 6 AST, 5 REB and a game-high tying 3 STL in 36 MIN on Jan. 10 during his first game back in Utah. **Mitchell's 46 PTS were the second-most PTS in a players first road game vs. their former team in NBA history (John Williamson had 50 PTS on April 4, 1978).** It was his 5th game this season with 40+ PTS and **he is just the 2nd Cavs player in team history to record 5+ games of 40+ points in a season (LeBron James, 5 times).** He is 1 of 3 NBA players this season with 130+ 3FGM on .400+ shooting from beyond the arc (Stephen Curry, Buddy Hield) and also ranks 2nd in the NBA in triples made (143), shooting a career-high .404 3FG% (143-354). He is averaging career highs this season in points (29.3 PPG), FG% (.489 FG%), 3FG% (.404 3FG%), FT% (.881 FT%) and minutes (36.5 MPG).

DARIUS GARLAND recorded 21 PTS, a team-high tying 6 AST and 5 REB in 38 MIN on Jan. 10 at UTA. It was his 17th game this season with 20+ points. Garland currently ranks 7th in the NBA in APG (7.8 APG) and is **one of two players in the NBA this season averaging 20.0+ PPG, 7.0+ APG and shooting .390+ 3FG% (Tyrese Haliburton).**

EVAN MOBLEY contributed 12 PTS, 7 REB and a game-high 4 BLK in 37 MIN on Jan. 10 at UTA. It was Mobley's third game this season with 4+ blocks and 9th game of his career.

BENCH HELP: **CARIS LEVERT** finished with 12 PTS, 5 REB, 2 AST and 1 BLK in 37 MIN off the bench on Jan. 10 at UTA. LeVert has scored 10+ points in a season-long seven straight games. **LAMAR STEVENS** contributed 11 PTS on 5-6 (.833) shooting from the field, 3 REB, a career-high tying 3 STL and 2 BLK in 25 MIN off the bench on Tuesday night in Utah. It was his 7th game this season with 10+ PTS.

HUSTLE NUMBERS: **KEVIN LOVE LEADS THE NBA** in charges drawn (16). **JARRETT ALLEN** ranks 4th in the NBA in contested shots per game (11.8) and **EVAN MOBLEY** ranks 6th (11.0). Mobley also **LEADS THE NBA** in contested three-pointers per game (4.0).

CAVS NOTES: The Cavs shot 41-74 (.554) from the field, their fourth straight game shooting at least .530 from the field. That is tied for the longest such streak in franchise history (4 straight from March 8-16, 1993 and Jan. 14-21, 1989)...Cleveland shot 12-27 (.444) from beyond the arc, marking the 10th time this season shooting .400+ from three-point range. The Cavs have made 10+ triples in 15 of their 18 games this season...The Wine and Gold held Portland to 96 points on 35-78 (.449) shooting from the field, the fifth time this season holding their opponent to under 100 points...**DONOVAN MITCHELL** finished with a game-high 34 points on 11-18 (.611) shooting from the field, including 6-10 (.600) from beyond the arc, two rebounds and team-high two steals in 31 minutes. Mitchell's 5 3FGM in the first half (5-7, .714) are tied for his 2nd-most triples in an opening half in his career...**DARIUS GARLAND** recorded his third double-double of the season with 24 points, including 4-9 (.444) shooting from beyond the arc and a season-high tying 12 assists in 36 minutes. Garland had six of his assists in the first quarter, tying his career high for assists in an opening quarter...**JARRETT ALLEN** tallied his ninth double-double of the season with a season-high 24 points on 10-12 (.833) shooting from the field, a game-high 13 rebounds, two assists and one steal in 36 minutes of play...**EVAN MOBLEY** chipped in his fifth double-double of the season (three in his last four games) with 10 points, 12 rebounds, three assists and a game-high three blocks in 35 minutes of play...**LAMAR STEVENS** contributed 12 points on 3-5 (.600) shooting from the field in 28 minutes of play.

CAVS NOTES: Cleveland shot 17-33 (.515) from beyond the arc and entered the game ranked 2nd in the NBA in three-point percentage. It was the 5th time this season the Cavs made 15+ triples in game...The Cavs outscored the T-Wolves in second chance points 22-6 (+16)...**DARIUS GARLAND** finished with a **career-high 51 points** on 16-30 (.533) shooting from the field, including 10-14 (.714) shooting from beyond the arc, a team-high six assists, two rebounds and one steal in 40 minutes. His **10 three-pointers** were a **career-high** and he became the third Cavs player in team history with 10+ threes in a game (Kyrie Irving, 11-19 3FG on Jan. 28, 2015 vs. POR and C.J. Miles, 10-14 3FG on Jan. 7, 2014 vs. PHI). With his fourth triple of the game, Garland made his 400th career three-pointer, reaching that mark quicker than any other player in Cavaliers history (188 games, previous was 226 games by Kyrie Irving). It was the second time in Garland's career scoring 40+ points (41 PTS on March 8, 2022 at IND). Garland scored a career-high 27 of his points in the 4th quarter, including 6-10 (.600) shooting from beyond the arc, marking the 2nd time scoring 20+ points in a quarter for his career. **His 27 fourth quarter points were the most points in a 4th quarter in team history and the 2nd-most points in any quarter by a Cavs player in team history** (Kevin Love, 34 PTS in 1st. Q on Nov. 23, 2016). Garland's 51 points are the most points by a Cavaliers player since LeBron James scored 57 PTS on Nov. 3, 2017. Garland is the fourth Cavs player in team history to score 50+ points (LeBron James – 9 times, Kyrie Irving – 2 times and Walt Wesley – 50 PTS on Feb. 19, 1971 vs. CIN)...**LAMAR STEVENS** contributed a season-high 15 points on 5-10 (.500) shooting from the field, six rebounds and one block in a season-high 30 minutes during his first start of the season...**KEVIN LOVE** tallied 14 points, five rebounds and four assists in 29 minutes during his first start of the season. It was the 6th time this season scoring 10+ points. With his third triple of the game, Love made his 1,500th career three-pointer and currently sits at 42nd on the NBA's all-time three-pointers made list...**CARIS LEVERT** recorded 13 points on 6-12 (.500) shooting from the field, five rebounds, five assists and one block in 28 minutes. He has recorded 10+ points in 11 of his 13 games this season...**EVAN MOBLEY** contributed a season-high tying 13 rebounds in 32 minutes. It was his third game this season with 10+ rebounds..

CONNECTIONS

Cavs forward **Kevin Love** spent six seasons with Minnesota (2008-2014) and averaged 19.2 points on .451 shooting, 12.2 rebounds and 2.5 assists in 32.8 minutes per game in 364 games (282 starts) over with the Wolves; in 2013-14, Love made 190 three-pointers, setting Minnesota's franchise record for three-pointers made in a season, while also setting the team's mark for points per game (26.1), and free throws made (520) and attempted (633) at that time...Timberwolves guard **D'Angelo Russell** played his collegiate career at The Ohio State University...Cavs guard **Isaac Okoro** (Atlanta, GA), and Wolves guard **Anthony Edwards** (Atlanta, GA), were both born in the state of Georgia...Cavs Head Coach **J.B. Bickerstaff** was an assistant coach for the Timberwolves for four seasons (2007-2011)...Cavs center Evan Mobley and forward Isaiah Mobley as well as Timberwolves guard **Jordan McLaughlin** both played college ball at USC...Wolves forward **Taurean Prince** played 29 games for the Cavaliers during the 2020-21 season...Cavs center **Jarrett Allen** and Wolves guard **D'Angelo Russell** were teammates on the Brooklyn Nets from 2017-2019...Timberwolves assistant coach **Micah Nori** is from Middletown, Ohio...Cavs guard **Donovan Mitchell** and Wolves center **Rudy Gobert** were teammates on the Utah Jazz during the previous five NBA seasons.
