CAVS QUICK FACTS

- Cleveland is playing New Orleans for the second and final matchup this season (W, 113-103 vs. NOP on Jan. 16). Cleveland has won 4 straight games since Feb. 2, all of which are by 15+ PTS. It is the longest streak of wins by 15+ PTS for the Cavs since Jan.29-Feb. 4, 2010 (also 4 straight wins). The Cavs have the 5th-best record in the NBA (35-22, .614) and have won 25 of their games this season by 10+ points, marking the most double-digit wins in the NBA this season.

MOST WINS IN THE NBA BY 10+ POINTS

1.) CLEVELAND CAVALIERS - 25 wins 2.) Boston Celtics - 21 wins

- The Cavs LEAD THE NBA in defensive rating (109.0) and are also allowing the fewest PPG in the NBA this season (106.2 PPG). The Cavs have held their opponents under 100 PTS in an NBA-best 18 games (17-1).

- MILESTONES: KEVIN LOVE (1,995 AST) needs 5 AST to reach 2,000 AST for his career. CEDI OSMAN (591 3FGM) is nine triples away from making his 600th career three-pointer.

- JARRETT ALLEN recorded his 23rd double-double of the season with a game-high 20 PTS on 9-13 (.692) shooting from the field, a game-high 16 REB (including a season-high 9 OREB) and 1 BLK in 30 MIN on Feb. 8 vs. DET. Allen has recorded a double-double in 4 of his last 5 games, averaging 18.6 PPG, 11.8 RPG and 1.40 BPG in 33.8 MPG over that span. Cleveland is 17-6 this season when Allen records a double-double. Allen is shooting a .648 field goal percentage this season, the 2nd-highest FG% in the Eastern Conference.

- EVAN MOBLEY tallied 19 PTS on 7-14 (.500) shooting from the field, 8 REB and 3 AST in 32 MIN on Feb. 8 vs. DET. Mobley is 1 of 4 NBA players this season averaging 15.0+ PPG, 8.0+ RPG, 2.5+ APG and 1.0+ BPG, joining Joel Embiid, Kristaps Porzingis and Alperen Sengun. It was Mobley's 13th game this season with at least 19 PTS and 8 REB (9 games of 17 PTS and 9 REB all of last season).

- RAUL NETO tallied a season-high-tying 14 PTS, a season-high 8 AST, and a season-high 4 STL in 36 MIN of play during his first start of the season. It was the 5th time in his career he had recorded 4+ steals.

- DARIUS GARLAND is shooting a career-best .415 3FG% (122-294), marking the 8th best three-point shooting percentage in the East. He is the ONLY player in the NBA this season averaging 20.0+ PPG, 8.0+ APG and shooting .400+ 3FG% and also ranks 6th in the NBA in assists per game (8.1 APG). Garland is also averaging a career-high 22.0 PPG this season.

- DONOVAN MITCHELL ranks 8th in the NBA (3rd in the Eastern Conference) in triples made (166), shooting a career-high .386 3FG% (166-430) and is one of four NBA players with 160+ triples on .380+ 3FG% (Buddy Hield, Stephen Curry, Klay Thompson). Mitchell's 166 3FGM this season are the 7th-most triples made in a season by a member of the Cavaliers.

- In his last 17 games since Jan. 8, ISAAC OKORO is shooting 58-94 (.617) from the field and 24-48 (.500) from beyond the arc, giving him the 2nd-best three-point percentage in the NBA over that span.

CAVS NOTES: Cleveland trailed 81-78 entering the fourth quarter and opened the final frame on a 11-0 run to regain the lead and eventually secure the 113-103 win over New Orleans. The Cavs trailed by as many as 13 points in the game, marking their 11th win when trailing by 10 points or more this season...The Cavs outscored the Pelicans in the paint 52-40 (+12) and outscored them in second chance points 19-8 (+11)...**DARIUS GARLAND** tallied his 10th double-double of the season with a game-high 30 points, including shooting 5-10 (.500) from beyond the arc, a game-high 11 assists, six rebounds and one steal in 40 minutes of play. It was Garland's fourth game this season with 30+ points and his first game this season with 30+ points and 10+ assists. It was also the third time in his career recording 30+ points, 10+ assists and 5+ rebounds. It was the fifth time this season Garland made 5+ triples in a game. Garland scored 25 of his points in the second half on 7-14 (.500) shooting from the field and 4-6 (.667) shooting from beyond the arc, marking the fourth time in his career with 25+ points in a half...**JARRETT ALLEN** contributed his 17th double-double of the season with 24 points on 9-12 (.750) shooting from the field, a team-high 11 rebounds, five assists, two steals and one block in 37 minutes of play...It was his 10th game this season with 20+ points and his seventh game this season with 20+ points and 10+ rebounds. Allen scored 18 of his points in the 2nd half on 6-7 (.857) shooting from the field, marking his highest scoring total in the 2nd half this season...**EVAN MOBLEY** finished with 19 points on 8-10 (.800) shooting from the field, eight rebounds and one block in 40 minutes of play. It was the fourth time this season Mobley recorded .800+ FG% on 8+ field goal makes...**ISAAC OKORO** contributed 11 points on 4-8 (.500) shooting from the field, four rebounds and two steals in 29 minutes of play. It was his 11th game this season with 10+ points...**DONOVAN MITCHELL** chipped in 11 points and one block in 22 minutes before exiting the game with a left groin strain in the third quarter.

CAVS NOTES: With the 113-85 (+28) win over Detroit, Cleveland secured their 23rd home victory of the season and entered the game with the 4th-best home record in the NBA this season. It was Cleveland's 25th victory this season by 10+ points, which leads all NBA teams for double-digit wins this season...Cleveland held Detroit to 85 points on 30-81 (.370) shooting from the field. The 85 points allowed was tied for the lowest by a Cavs opponent this season (Nov. 30 vs. PHI)...The Cavaliers outscored the Pistons 37-17 (+20) in the fourth quarter, marking the second time this season outscoring their opponent by 20 or more points in the final quarter...The Cavs allowed just 14 points in the opening quarter, tying their season-low for points allowed in the 1st quarter. Cleveland's 32-14 (+18) lead in the opening quarter was also a season-high for largest lead entering the second quarter this season...The Cavaliers outscored the Pistons in the paint 70-32 (+38), marking the third time this season the Cavs have recorded 70+ points in the paint. 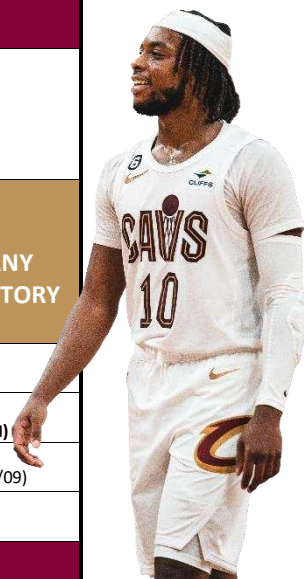
