



The Frontier League is the oldest, active independent league, forming in 1993. With recent expansion, it is now the biggest professional, independent baseball league in North America.

FRONTIER LEAGUE NEWS



The Frontier League announced on November 18 they will be adding a Pitch Clock in all ballparks for the 2023 season. The clock, which will limit the time pitchers and hitters take between pitches, is designed to increase the action and reduce the down time in Frontier League games.

The new rules will require pitchers to wait no longer than 14 seconds between pitches when there are no runners on base. If there are runners on base, they will have 18 seconds to deliver the ball to home plate. Batters must be in the box and ready to hit at the 9 second mark. Violation of these time parameters can result in a called strike or ball depending on the offender.

The rule changes also include limits on the number of disengagements (pick-off attempts, stepping off the pitching rubber, etc.) a pitcher can make per at-bat. Once a runner is on base, the pitcher is allowed two disengagements. If the pitcher makes a third pick-off attempt, for example, and does not pick-off the runner, a balk will be called, and the baserunner(s) will advance one base.

"The League Directors are committed to offering the best possible entertainment to Frontier League fans, and we believe the addition of a pitch clock will help achieve this goal", stated Frontier League President Eric Krupa. "These two changes will increase the pace of Frontier League games and provide our fans a more enjoyable experience when they come out to our ballparks or watch our games on FloSports."

There will be a grace period to start the Frontier League season, with warnings issued but no penalties enforced. The automatic ball, strike, or balk will be fully enforced beginning with games on Tuesday, May 30.

"I am very excited to see these new additions," Otters manager Andy McCauley said. "I feel this will help with the pace of play and make the games more entertaining for all levels of baseball fans."

Over the years, the Frontier League has adopted other rules that mirror what MLB has implemented in affiliated baseball to improve the pace of games. Previous changes included the adoption of rules to require a batter to keep one foot in the batter's box and limits on the number of mound visits each team was allowed during games.

The Frontier League will kick off the 2023 season on Thursday May 11th . The League is the largest and longest tenured MLB Partner League, featuring 16 teams stretching from St. Louis to Quebec City, Canada.

FORMER OTTERS PITCHER SAWYER SIGNS WITH CARDINALS





After an astounding 2022 season, former Evansville Otters closer Logan Sawyer was signed by the St. Louis Cardinals in October.

Sawyer, a Knoxville, Tennesee native, signed with Evansville ahead of the 2021 season. During the 2021 season, Sawyer matched an Otters single-season record for saves (25).

"Logan earned this opportunity," Otters pitching coach Max Peterson said. "He is one of the hardest workers I've ever seen - always trying to get better and work on his craft. He will go down as one of the best relievers in Evansville Otters and Frontier League history. I am so happy for Logan and his family, we wish him the best."

The righty dominated the Frontier League in 2022, allowing just 1 unearned run on 11 hits in 29+ innings of work. Sawyer struck out 39 batters while allowing just three walks. He finished the year with a 2-1 record and 0.00 ERA. With 22 saves in 2022, Sawyer moved to second all-time in Otters history with 47.

"I couldn't be happier for Logan," Evansville manager Andy McCauley said. "After a remarkable two years for the Otters, he certainly deserves this opportunity with the Cardinals. We wish him the best of luck."

The 2022 Frontier League relief pitcher of the year returns to affiliated

baseball for the first time since 2016 when he was in the Rockies affiliation after being drafted by Colorado in 2014.

"The Evansville Otters gave me a chance when nobody else did," Sawyer said. "Max [Peterson] and Andy [McCauley] deserve so much credit for this. From the front office down, the whole organization does things the right way."

In his two seasons with Evansville, Sawyer allowed 47 hits across 66+ innings with a 1.63 ERA, the sixth-best career ERA in Otters history. He struck out 87 total batters and gave up nine walks. Sawyer was a Frontier League All-Star in each of his two seasons in Evansville.

"The Cardinals are a phenomenal organization," Sawyer added. "I know I am going to have a chance to go over there and compete right away and that is all I could ask for."

The Otters have sent 87 players to affiliated organizations out of Evansville.

OTTERS RECOGNIZE CAREERS OF STAR DUO



EVANSVILLE, Ind. - The Evansville Otters would like to congratulate outfielders Elijah MacNamee and Miles Gordon as they move away from their baseball playing careers.

"Miles and Elijah were valuable additions to our team and the community," Evansville Field Manager Andy McCauley said. "We wish them well with whatever their future holds."

MacNamee, a Cypress, TX native, has been a fan-favorite since arriving in Evansville in 2019. Defensively, MacNamee has been stealing opponent hits and runs in right field his entire career. At the plate, however, consistency has been key. In his three seasons with Evansville, he's put together a .290 batting average, with 229 hits, 38 doubles, eight triples, 18 home runs and 105 RBI. Throw in his 89 walks and his career on-base percentage is over .300.

"First off, I want to thank the Otters for giving me three incredible seasons," MacNamee said. "I cannot thank the coaching staff enough for giving me a chance to pursue my dream. To the fans, I want to thank you for being so awesome and welcoming throughout this journey. Good luck to the Otters and I hope to see you bring home some more hardware!"

MacNamee joined the Otters following his senior season at Mississippi State. While with Mississippi State, he was a member of two College World Series appearances in 2018-19, and a member of a Super Regional appearance in 2017. During his Mississippi State tenure, he earned the nickname 'Big Hit Mac,' which carried on to his days in Evansville. In his collegiate career at Mississippi State, MacNamee batted .287 with 113 runs, 37 doubles, 17 home runs, 116 RBIs, and 60 walks in 170 games played and 154 games started. He also had a career .441 slugging percentage and a .367 on-base percentage.

Gordon, from Oakville, Ontario in Canada, signed with the Otters heading into the 2021 season. In his two years working the Otters' centerfield, Gordon has worked to a .257 batting average with the help of 33 doubles, nine triples, 10 home runs and 71 RBI. In 2022, Gordon had a team-high 20-game hit streak during the season.

"I want to thank the Evansville Otters for welcoming me with open arms," Gordon said. "From the staff, fans and teammates, I couldn't have asked for a better past two years. I wish nothing but the absolute best to the Otters in the future and will be following them on their quest to bring the Frontier League Championship back to Bosse [Field] where it belongs."

Upon joining Evansville, Gordon brought with him five seasons of experience with the Cincinnati Reds organization. Gordon played for the Arizona League Reds, Pioneer League Billings Mustangs, Florida State League Daytona Tortugas, and the Midwest League Dayton Dragons from 2015-2019. Overall, with the Reds organization, Gordon batted .242 with 13 home runs and 99 RBIs in 908 at-bats. In 253 games played, Gordon scored 130 runs, had 68 totals extra-base hits, and swiped 47 bags.


In his time with the Reds, Gordon played with former Otters pitcher Randy Wynne in Dayton in 2019 and roomed with former Otters outfielder Logan Taylor in 2018. Gordon was drafted by the Reds in the fourth round of the 2015 MLB June Amateur Draft out of St. Ignatius of Loyola Catholic Secondary School in Oakville, Ontario.

The Otters are excited for the future for these two men and thank them for their time in Evansville.

ADVANCE TICKET SALES

Advance tickets may be purchased in person at the Otters office Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and on Saturday/Sunday (provided the Otters play at home). Tickets may also be purchased online at evansvilleotters.com or by phone using Visa, MasterCard, American Express, or Discover.

The Otters have a Heritage Federal Credit Union ATM located inside the tunnel of the main entrance.

AUTOGRAPHS

Players will be available immediately after the game to sign autographs near the home dugout on the first base side of the concourse.

BEER

Beer is available on the concourse, in the picnic vending areas, and from waiting vendors. Indiana law prohibits the sale of alcohol to or the consumption of alcohol by minors. The Evansville Otters reserve the right to refuse service to any individual without notice. Please drink responsibly.

Fans are welcome to park in the Bosse Field parking lot at no cost or on the adjacent streets (as allowed by law). However, fans who park in an area where baseballs may inflict damage to their automobile do so at their own risk. The Evansville Otters are not liable for any damage to automobiles while parked in the Bosse Field parking lot or on the street.

CREDIT CARDS

The Evansville Otters accept American Express, Discover, VISA, and MasterCard at the ticket office, gift shop, and all concession stands.

FIRST AID & SAFETY

The first aid station is located in the main office at the Main Gate. Representatives of the Vanderburgh County Sheriff's Department are on duty patrolling the stadium during the game to assist fans.

FOOD AND BEVERAGE CARRY-INS

Frontier League rules prohibits fans from bringing any cooler, cans, bottles, food, or beverages into Bosse Field.

Fans are welcome to keep any ball that is hit or thrown into the stands during the game. However, any ball or bat entering the stands can be dangerous, and fans should be alert at all time.

The team store is open Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on non-game days and from 9 a.m. through the end of the game on game days.

LOST AND FOUND

All found items are to be taken to the Otters Front Office at the Main Gate. Call (812) 435-8686 to see if your lost item has been found.

PRESS BOX

Fans are not permitted to enter the press box. Special announcements such as birthdays and anniversaries may be purchased by the end of the 2nd inning at the team store.

RAIN CHECKS

If you have tickets from a rain out date, those tickets are now rain checks which may be exchanged for any remaining regular season game this season, based on availability. Tickets may be exchanged in the Front Office. No rain checks will be offered if five innings have been completed or if the Otters are ahead after 4 1/2 innings of play. No refunds will be given.

RESTROOMS

Restrooms are located under the stands near the first base and third base concession stands.

SMOKING

Pursuant to city ordinance, smoking is not permitted in the stadium. You can find a smoking area outside the gates on the first and third base side of the concourse.
