### **MATCH PREVIEW**

This Wednesday, May 3, at 7:00 p.m., Angel City plays their second Challenge Cup game on the road against OL Reign. The game will stream live in the US on Paramount+ and internationally on NWSLSoccer.com; an English-language radio broadcast will be available on iHeart.

#### Matchup

Angel City also faced the Reign in their first Challenge Cup game on April 19, losing 0–2. Following that result—and San Diego's 1–0 win against Portland—the Reign are in first place in the west, followed by San Diego, Portland, and Angel City.

Seattle's most recent result was a come-from-behind 2–2 draw against Louisville over the weekend. Louisville went up 2–0 in the first half with goals by forward Paige Monaghan and midfielder Savannah DeMelo. Forward Megan Rapinoe got one back with a nice finish on a 69th-minute penalty kick, and forward Jordyn Huitema equalized in the last minute of regulation with a header on a beautiful lofted ball from defender Alana Cook.

ACFC also earned a tie in their last game, away at Portland on Saturday night. In that game, the two teams traded goals, with ACFC forward Alyssa Thompson getting on the board first, and Portland then going up 2–1 with a penalty scored by forward Hina Sugita and a 65th-minute go-ahead goal by forward Morgan Weaver. A Thorns own goal by defender Natalia Kuikka and a header put away by midfielder Julie Ertz looked to be the last word on the night—until Portland goalkeeper Bella Bixby improbably equalized on a corner kick in the last play of the game.

Historically in the Challenge Cup, the Reign have finished in the top two in their division for the last three years running, and finished third in the West division in 2020. They have never made it past the first knockout round of the tournament; last year they were eliminated in the semifinals after losing the penalty shootout following a nil-nil draw with Washington.

Last year, Angel City's inaugural season, the Challenge Cup was held as a preseason tournament. The team finished fourth in the West, earning a 1-1-4 record (W-L-D).

Hucles Mangano, a two-time Olympic gold medalist and World Cup Champion, manages all operations, recruiting, and player development staff, as well as oversees Head Coach Freya Coombe, Assistant Coach Beck Tweed, Assistant Coach Eleri Earnshaw, and Head of Goalkeeping Daniel Ball.

On the business side, Angel City is thrilled to have the incredible support of some of the greatest brands in America that align with the team's commitment to making an impact on and off the field. ### INAUGURAL SEASON OPENER

Angel City's inaugural season opener on April, 29, 2022 drew 22,000 fans to Banc of California Stadium. The sellout crowd was the second biggest for a season opener in NWSL history; the record holder is this week's opponent, the Orlando Pride, who drew 23,403 fans to their inaugural opener in 2016 at what is now Camping World Stadium.

The inaugural match attendance also:

• Outpaced attendance at 18 out of 28 MLS season openers in the 2022 season

• Was larger than the total capacity of all but four NWSL stadiums

- Was the fifth-largest crowd for a standalone NWSL game in regular-season history (last season OL Reign drew 27,278 to a doubleheader with the Seattle Sounders)
- Makes Angel City the second non-Portland team—after Orlando—to break into the top 10 best-attended NWSL games
- Was equal to roughly 1/9 the population of Cary, North Carolina, where the Courage are based.

### NATALIE PORTMAN FOUNDER, ACTRESS AND ACTIVIST

Angel City Football Club is founded by Academy Award-winning actress and activist Natalie Portman, technology venture capitalist Kara Nortman, media and gaming entrepreneur Julie Uhrman, and Seven Seven Six founder and former Executive Chair of Reddit, Alexis Ohanian. Portman, who is on the board of Times Up, attended the Times Up Connect event and witnessed Abby Wambach speak about her playing career and the US Women's National Team's fight for equal pay. Natalie was riveted and engaged in conversations about the pay equity issue in women's sports. She approached Nortman, also on the Times Up board and a women's soccer fanatic. One day at lunch, Portman asked Nortman there wasn't a professional women's soccer team in LA, which led them down a path neither could have envisioned. In August 2019, Julie Uhrman was brought on by Portman and Kara Nortman to run the company and help them fulfill their mission and passion for bringing a professional women's sports team to Los Angeles as part of the National Women's Soccer League (NWSL).



JULIE UHRMAN CO-FOUNDER AND PRESIDENT

Julie Uhrman is the Co-Founder and President of Angel City Football Club (ACFC). ACFC is one of the only majority femalefounded and run professional sports teams in the world and, in 2021, was named one of the world's most innovative companies by Fast Company Magazine. In addition to leading ACFC day to day, Uhrman is active in the Los Angeles sports and technology communities. She is a board member of the LA Sports and Entertainment Council, The Rose Bowl Institute, the LA Sports Council, an active executive in the LA Chapter of WISE (Women in Sports and Events), and is part of two SPACs focused on sports and gaming/ entertainment. She is also part of the DraftKings' All-Star Network as an Advisor to Drive by DraftKinas. Uhrman's accolades include being named a member of Adweek's 2021 and 2020 Most Powerful Women In Sports, one of the 100 Most Creative People in Business by Fast Company, and to the Creative 50 list by Advertising Age.



### ALEXIS OHANIAN LEADING FOUNDING INVESTOR

Alexis Ohanian, ACFC's leading founding investor, was born in Brooklyn, N.Y. and grew up in the suburbs of Baltimore, M.D. He wrote the national bestselling book, Without Their Permission, and has been a vocal advocate for the open internet, STEM education and paid family leave. Out of college, Ohanian co-founded Reddit, one of the largest websites in the U.S., which was funded by Y Combinator in 2005 and sold to Conde Nast in 2006. He returned as executive chairman in 2014 to help lead the turnaround of the now independent company that today is valued at over \$10B. In 2016, he left Reddit to run the venture capital firm he co-founded, Initialized Capital, and built it to \$100B in market value through early investments in companies like Coinbase, Opendoor, Instacart, Patreon, and Ro. In 2020, Ohanian resigned from the Reddit board in protest and left his role at Initialized Capital to found Seven Seven Six, a new firm built like a technology company that deploys venture capital.



KARA NORTMAN FOUNDING INVESTOR

Kara is a Managing Partner at Upfront Ventures, the largest venture capital firm based in Los Angeles. Her notable investments include Parachute Home, Time by Ping, Endgame, Writer, Open Raven, Britive, and Fleetsmith (acquired by Apple in 2020). Over 50% of her portfolio is led by women CEOs. Kara is also a founding member of All Raise, a VC-led group dedicated to increased diversity in funders and founders, and is a founder of LA's women's soccer team, Angel City Football Club. Before Upfront, Kara co-founded the children's e-commerce company Moonfrye and also spent seven years at IAC where she co-headed the M&A group and acted as the Senior Vice President and General Manager of Urbanspoon and Citysearch. During her tenure at IAC, she led the initial investment in Tinder. Earlier in her career, she also spent time at Morgan Stanley, Microsoft, and Battery Ventures. She received her AB in Politics from Princeton University and her MBA from Stanford University. Nortman resides in Los Angeles with her husband and three daughters.
