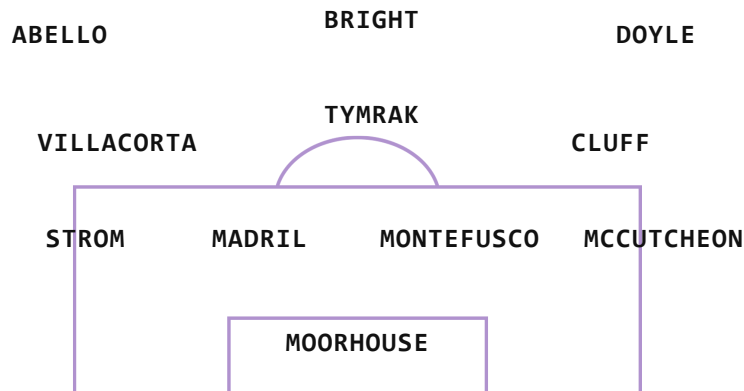

MATCH STORYLINES

DOYLE'S DA BOMB

PRIDE FORWARD JULIE DOYLE RECORDED A BRACE SCORING TWO GOALS IN THE FIRST 16 MINUTES OF THE FIRST HALF IN THE CLUB'S MOST RECENT 3-0 WIN OVER THE WASHINGTON SPIRIT, A PERFORMANCE THAT WOULD EARN HER WEEK 14 NWSL PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS. THE BRACE WAS DOYLE'S FIRST PROFESSIONAL BRACE WITH BOTH GOALS COMING WITHIN EIGHT MINUTES OF ONE ANOTHER. THE TWO GOALS ARE THE FIRST SCORED THIS SEASON FOR DOYLE AND COUNTED AS HER THIRD AND FOURTH SCORED IN HER NWSL CAREER ACROSS ALL COMPETITIONS AFTER SCORING IN BACK-TO-BACK GAMES LAST YEAR FOR THE PRIDE.

BYE BYE BYE

WITH THE 3-0 WIN OVER THE SPIRIT, THE PRIDE COMPLETED THE NWSL REGULAR SEASON SWEEP OF THE WASHINGTON-BASED SIDE FOLLOWING A 2-1 VICTORY BACK AT THE FRIENDLY CONFINES OF EXPLORIA STADIUM. THE PRIDE HAVE ONE MORE GAME SCHEDULED AGAINST THE SPIRIT IN THE UGK CHALLENGE CUP ON AUGUST 4, AT EXPLORIA STADIUM. THE LOSS ALSO COUNTED AS THE FIRST LOSS THE SPIRIT HAVE TAKEN AT HOME OF AUDI FIELD SO FAR THIS SEASON. THE PRIDE WERE ALSO THE FIRST TEAM TO DEFEAT THE SAN DIEGO WAVE AT THEIR HOME STADIUM EARLIER THIS SEASON WITH A 3-1 WIN BACK ON APRIL 29.

THE TURN OF THE CENTURY

DEFENDER HALEY MCCUTCHEON MADE THE START IN THE MATCH, MARKING HER 100TH CAREER NWSL REGULAR SEASON APPEARANCE. MCCUTCHEON WAS ACQUIRED BY THE PRIDE VIA TRADE WITH THE HOUSTON DASH BACK IN AUGUST OF LAST SEASON. SHE ORIGINALLY ENTERED THE LEAGUE AFTER SHE WAS SELECTED AS THE NO. 7 PICK IN THE 2018 NWSL DRAFT BY THE DASH. SINCE JOINING ORLANDO, SHE HAS MADE 20 REGULAR SEASON APPEARANCES WHILE DONNING THE PRIDE KIT.

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

GOALKEEPER ANNA MOORHOUSE ONLY NEEDED TO MAKE TWO SAVES ON HER WAY TO HER THIRD CLEAN SHEET OF THE SEASON. MOORHOUSE IS CURRENTLY SECOND IN THE NWSL WITH 54 SAVES IN 12 APPEARANCES ACROSS ALL COMPETITIONS. MOORHOUSE LAST CLEAN SHEET CAME IN A 0-0 DRAW AGAINST NJ/NY GOTHAM FC ON MAY 14 AT RED BULL ARENA.

MO MONEY, NO PROBLEMS

THIS WEEK, THE PRIDE ANNOUNCED TWO SIGNINGS IN BRAZILIAN NATIONAL TEAM DEFENDER RAFAELLE SOUZA AND ARGENTINE FORWARD MARIANA LARROQUETTE. BOTH PLAYERS JOIN THE PRIDE ON CONTRACTS THROUGH THE 2025 SEASON AND RETURN TO THE NWSL AFTER HAVING PREVIOUSLY PLAYED IN THE LEAGUE. SOUZA SPENT THE LAST TWO SEASONS AT ARSENAL TOTALING 35 APPEARANCES AND FOUR GOALS, PLAYING PRIMARILY CENTER BACK, AND WAS JUST RECENTLY NAMED TO BRAZIL'S 2023 FIFA WOMEN'S WORLD CUP ROSTER. LARROQUETTE COMES TO ORLANDO FROM MEXICO'S CLUB LEÓN AND WILL ALSO BE PARTICIPATING IN THE WORLD CUP WITH HER HOME COUNTRY OF ARGENTINA. THE TWO PLAYERS WILL JOIN THE TEAM AFTER THEIR RESPECTIVE RUNS IN THE TOURNAMENT.

BE KIND, REWIND

FRIDAY NIGHT AT EXPLORIA STADIUM AND THE PRIDE WILL BE TURNING BACK TO THE CLOCK TO CELEBRATE DECADES NIGHT, PRESENTED BY WALT DISNEY WORLD. FANS ARE ENCOURAGED TO DRESS UP FROM THEIR FAVORITE DECADE FROM THE 70S, 80S, 90S OR 2000S. THE MANE STREET PLAZA WILL HAVE A PLETHORA OF ACTIVITIES FOR FANS BEFORE THE MATCH AND THEN THEY CAN HEAD IN THE STADIUM AND ENJOY KARAOKE ON THE CONCOURSE WITH THROWBACK HITS, COSTUME PRIZES AND MUCH MORE. THE FIRST 2000 FANS AT THE MATCH WILL ALSO RECEIVE THUNDERSTICKS, COURTESY OF DISNEY.

SUMMARY:

THE ORLANDO PRIDE HANDED THE WASHINGTON SPIRIT THEIR FIRST HOME LOSS OF THE 2023 REGULAR SEASON ON SATURDAY, TAKING A 3-0 VICTORY. FORWARD JULIE DOYLE LED THE WAY FOR THE PRIDE, RECORDING HER FIRST PROFESSIONAL BRACE JUST 16 MINUTES INTO THE MATCH. WHAT THEY'RE SAYING

HEAD COACH SEB HINES

ON HOW THE TEAM KEEPS THE MOMENTUM FROM SATURDAY

YOU JUST GOT TO STAY HUNGRY. AND YEAH, WE'RE STARTING TO RUN OUT OF GAMES, EVERY GAME MATTERS. EVERY GAME IS A FINAL RIGHT NOW. SO IT'S IMPORTANT THAT WE CREATE THAT MOMENTUM THAT WE SHOWED. PREVIOUSLY WE WENT ON A GOOD RUN, WE NEED TO GO ON A GOOD RUN AGAIN. LIKE I SAY, YOU HAVE TO LEAVE EVERYTHING ON THE FIELD AND FOR US TO GET THAT WIN AGAINST WASHINGTON, YOU COULD SEE THE WORK AND THE COMMITMENT THAT THE PLAYERS PUT IN IT AND THEY WERE REWARDED FOR IT WITH A 3-1 WIN.

ON WHAT THE REIGN PRESENT WITH PERSONNEL MISSING

THEY'RE STILL A GOOD TEAM, THEY HAVE A LOT OF DEPTH IN POSITIONS. THEY ARE MISSING THEIR INTERNATIONALS BUT THEY ALSO HAVE SOME REALLY GOOD PLAYERS THAT CAN FILL THE SPOTS UP. SO WE HAVE TO BE MINDFUL OF THAT. WE CAN'T TAKE THEM FOR GRANTED. BUT ALSO, IT'S AN OPPORTUNITY TO FOCUS ON OURSELVES AND AGAIN, BUILD UP MOMENTUM, MAKE IT A DIFFICULT ENVIRONMENT TO PLAY IN EXPLORIA STADIUM. WE' HAVE OUR FANS BEHIND US AS WELL. AND IF WE DO THAT, THEN WE'VE SET OURSELVES UP FOR SUCCESS.

ON THE MAJORITY OF THE TEAM REMAINING INTACT DESPITE THE WORLD CUP

OBVIOUSLY, ADRI[ANA] AND MARTA ARE LEAVING TO GO TO A WORLD CUP IS AMAZING FOR THEM. BUT THE PLAYERS WHO HAVE COME IN, THE LIKES OF ERIKA [TYMRAC], JULIE [DOYLE], ALLY [WATT], MESSIAH [BRIGHT], THEY EVOLVE, PLAY GOOD MINUTES THIS SEASON. SO IT'S NOT LIKE THEY'RE NOT MATCH READY, THEY'VE BEEN MATCH READY SINCE THE START OF THIS SEASON. AND THAT IS IMPORTANT FOR US BECAUSE WE CAN RELY ON THEM. SO YEAH, IT'S IMPORTANT TO KEEP THE CORE GROUP TOGETHER AND, AGAIN, IT'S A GOOD OPPORTUNITY FOR US TO KEEP THAT MOMENTUM AFTER A GOOD WIN ON SATURDAY AGAINST SPIRIT.

ON PLAYERS TAKING THEIR OPPORTUNITIES

I SAID IT FROM THE START, WINNING'S HARD IN THIS LEAGUE, NO ONE GIVES YOU ANYTHING. AND WE KIND OF FELL OFF THAT A LITTLE BIT IN THE LAST COUPLE OF GAMES, BEEN QUITE PASSIVE. BUT THE INTENT FROM KICKOFF WAS THERE AGAINST SPIRIT AND THAT WAS MORE LIKE OURSELVES. THE WAY THAT WE PRESSED, THE WAY THAT WE GOT THE BALL AND TOOK DEFENDERS ON, WE GOT GOOD CROSSES INTO THE BOX, WE GOT PLAYERS IN THE BOX, HAVING THAT HUNGER TO TRY AND SCORE. THAT'S THE STANDARD THAT NEEDS TO BE SET FOR EVERY GAME AND THE PLAYERS KNOW THAT, THEY KNOW WHAT IT TAKES TO WIN A GAME OF FOOTBALL. THEY'RE SO WILLING TO PUT THE WORK AND ALL THE CREDIT GOES TO THEM BECAUSE AT THE END OF THE DAY IT'S THEM WHO HAVE TO RUN, COMPETE, BATTLE, FIGHT AND TRY AND WIN A GAME OF FOOTBALL AND THEY'RE FULLY BOUGHT INTO THAT AND IT'S GREAT TO SEE.

DEFENDER CELIA

ON HOW THE TEAM FEELS AFTER THE WIN IN WASHINGTON

HONESTLY, VERY EXCITED. IT FEELS GOOD TO GET THREE POINTS AWAY FROM HOME BUT WE'RE STILL VERY HUNGRY. WE HAVE A LOT OF GAMES AND WE HAVE ANOTHER GAME NOW, SO WE'RE PRETTY FOCUSED ON THAT.

ON THE THREATS THAT THE REIGN PRESENT

I THINK THEY'RE A POSSESSION-BASED TEAM, AND I THINK THAT IF WE ACTUALLY PRESS THEM AND PUT THEM UNDER TROUBLE AND BRING THE HEAT TO THEM, WE'RE DEFINITELY GOING TO HAVE AN ADVANTAGE, ESPECIALLY AT HOME.

ON HOW HER FAMILIARITY WITH THE REIGN WILL HELP

FOR SURE, EXPERIENCE AND KNOWING THE TEAM IS SOMETHING THAT WE HAVE AGAINST THEM. ALLY [WATT] IS ALSO ANOTHER PLAYER. SO WE DEFINITELY KNOW THEIR STYLE AND WE PRETTY MUCH HAVE A SET PLAN ON HOW WE'RE GOING TO TACKLE THEM AND HOW WE'RE GOING TO COME TO THIS GAME. BUT I AM VERY CONFIDENT IN HOW THE TEAM IS FEELING, THE THINGS THAT WE'VE BEEN WORKING ON LATELY, AND I REALLY HOPE THAT WE'RE GOING TO GET A POSITIVE RESULT.

ON HOW THE WIN VS. WASHINGTON HELPS CONFIDENCE

YEAH, A LOT. OBVIOUSLY, A WIN FEELS GOOD FOR EVERYONE BUT IF I HAVE TO HIGHLIGHT SOMETHING ABOUT THAT GAME, IT'S JUST THE SPIRIT THAT WE HAD. THE SPIRIT THAT WE HAD ABOUT RECOVERING THE BALL AND HOW, WHEN WE WOULD LIKE LOSE POSSESSION, EVERYONE WAS IN IMMEDIATE TRANSITION AND WANTING TO RECOVER WITHIN SECONDS. AND I THINK THAT REALLY PAID OFF IN THAT GAME AND WE'RE BRINGING THAT TO THIS NEXT GAME. IT'S SOMETHING THAT WE'VE BEEN WORKING ON, SOMETHING THAT WE ARE BUILDING ON, AND IT'S ONLY GOING TO GET BETTER.

ON THE OPPORTUNITY FOR PLAYERS TO STEP UP DOING THE WORLD CUP

IT'S VERY IMPORTANT BUT IT'S ALSO AN OPPORTUNITY. EVERY SINGLE TEAM IS MISSING SOME NATIONAL TEAM PLAYERS AND IT'S AN OPPORTUNITY FOR VETERANS TO MAYBE THE LEAD, BUT ALSO FOR YOUNGER PLAYERS TO STEP UP. AND I THINK WE ARE IN A GOOD POSITION, AND I THINK WE ARE READY TO TAKE ON THESE NEXT FEW MONTHS. WE OBVIOUSLY WISH THEM THE BEST OF LUCK AND WE HOPE TO HAVE THEM GONE FOR AS LONG AS THEY CAN AND HOPEFULLY MAKE IT TO THE FINAL AND BRING THAT TROPHY BACK. BUT AS OF RIGHT NOW, I THINK WE'RE IN GOOD SHAPE. I THINK WE HAVE YOUNG TALENT THAT HAS BEEN ON THE LINE, CHARGING, NOT HESITANT FOR ONE SECOND, AND I DO THINK THAT WE HAVE THE EXPERIENCE IN OUR ROSTER TO GO ABOUT THESE GAMES, NOT JUST THE ONE.

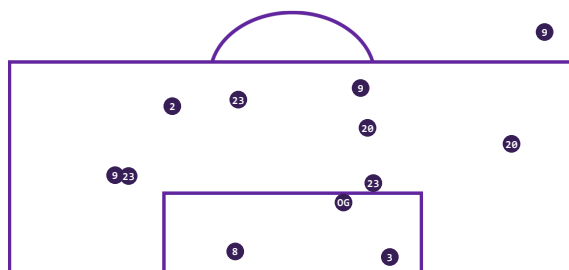

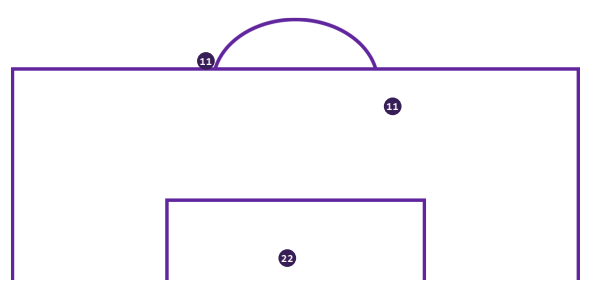

CARTER IS A FORMER PROFESSIONAL PLAYER, BUSINESS EXECUTIVE, COACH, LICENSED ATTORNEY, AND VETERAN OF THE U.S. MARINE CORPS. THE ORLANDO PRIDE ANNOUNCED THE PROMOTION OF SEB HINES TO HEAD COACH ON NOV. 11, 2022.

PRIOR TO THAT, HINES SERVED 15 GAMES AS THE INTERIM HEAD COACH DURING THE 2022 CAMPAIGN, AFTER SPENDING EIGHT YEARS COMBINED AS A MEMBER OF THE ORLANDO PRIDE AND ORLANDO CITY SC FAMILY.

A FORMER DEFENDER IN THE ENGLISH PREMIER LEAGUE, HINES WAS NAMED THE CLUB'S INTERIM HEAD COACH ON JUNE 7, 2022. DURING THAT TIME, THE PRIDE WENT ON A SEVEN-GAME UNBEATEN RUN FROM JULY 3 TO AUG. 20, AND SAW INCREASES IN THE TEAM'S AVERAGES ON SHOTS, SHOT ON TARGET AND PASSING ACCURACY, AS WELL AS THREE TOTAL CLEAN SHEETS.

A NATIVE OF WETHERBY, ENGLAND, THE DEFENDER FIRST CAME TO ORLANDO IN 2015, PLAYING THREE SEASONS WITH ORLANDO CITY SC IN MAJOR LEAGUE SOCCER. FOLLOWING HIS RETIREMENT, HINES BEGAN SHADOWING FORMER PRIDE HEAD COACH TOM SERMANNI IN 2018 AND CONTINUED AS A VOLUNTEER ASSISTANT OVER THE NEXT TWO SEASONS, ULTIMATELY HIRED AS A FULL-TIME ASSISTANT UNDER MARC SKINNER IN 2020.

FOLLOWING HIS STINT WITH DERBY COUNTY, HE THEN HELPED WEST BROMWICH ALBION GAIN PROMOTION TO THE PREMIER LEAGUE WHERE HE PLAYED FOR THEM UNTIL TRANSFERRING TO DONCASTER ROVERS FC.

BARNES TRANSITIONED TO MAJOR LEAGUE SOCCER IN THE UNITED STATES IN 2012 AFTER SIGNING WITH THE HOUSTON DYNAMO. HE PLAYED FOR A FEW DIFFERENT MLS TEAMS BEFORE BEING TRADED TO ORLANDO CITY IN 2017. HE WOULD GO ON AND APPEAR IN 34 GAMES FOR THE LIONS DURING THE 2017 SEASON NETTING THREE GOALS AND TALLYING TWO ASSISTS.
