



#### JAY ARNOTE Head Basketball Coach

Second year head coach Jay Arnote has an impressive record as a player and coach. Arnote, 33, is a Phoenix native and played under Ned Wulk at Arizona State University. He was responsible for starting the basketball program at Thunderbird High School in Phoenix. While at Thunderbird, Jay was named Division coach of the year.

Jay's first year record at Grand Canyon was 17-11 which is included in his overall coaching record of 67-25.

Grand Canyon College Basketball brings into the '82-'83 season an overall record of 483 wins against 298 losses with national championships in 1975 and 1978 under Ben Lindsey. Head Coach Jay Arnote in his second year looks to continue this winning tradition.

Coming off a 17-11 record in '81-'82, which included wins over NCAA teams California State Dominguez Hills (54-22) and the University of California at Riverside (72-70), the 'lopes work towards another successful season.


The 'Lopes face an even tougher schedule in '82-'83 playing NCAA schools such as the University of New Mexico, Northern Arizona University, California State Domingues Hills, along with NAIA schools Mesa State, Southern Utah State and Western New Mexico who last year defeated Canyon in the District 7 playoffs 48 to 45.

A strong nucleus of seven players return: Starters Jim Pyers (Guard, 6'0'', 160 lbs.) last year's leading scorer with a 11.57 points per game; and Anthony McKinney (Forward, 6'7", 200 lbs.) averaging 8.32 points and 3.3 rebounds per game. These two will give the 'Lopes maturity and experience. Guard Carter Pittman (6'3", 195 lbbs.) and Guard/Forward Carl Powell (6'41/2", 180 lbs.) look to have good years and will add experience and fine ability. Forward Mike Boatwright (6'8", 200 lbs.) will be a valuable asset and will be counted on heavily being one of the top returnees. Centers Toby Harrison (6'5", 218 lbs.) and Ray Jackson (6'9", 240 lbs.) return and will add strength and durability in the middle.

New players Ray Fearen (6'6", 185 lobs., Forward) is a fine athlete and will see much playing time and Guard/Forward Randy Mead (6'4", 190 lbs.) will add size and strength to his position. Center/Forward Brian Gillis (6'8", 200 lbs.) and Guard Elliot Jones (6'3", 176 lbs.) both played for strong junior college teams at Mesa Junior College under Tom Bennette. Forward Bob Kulovitz (6'8", 200 lbs.) also played MCC for Tom Bennett and then attended the University of San Diego before transferring to Grand Canyon. Guards Larry Craig (5'11", 173 lbs.), Billy Carter (6'3", 175 lbs.) and Forward Cornell Staples (6'5", 205 lbs.) are also junior college tranfers and round-out the '82-'83 squad.






BILLY CARTER Guard 6'3'' Junior




CORNELL STAPLES Forward 6'5'' Junior


