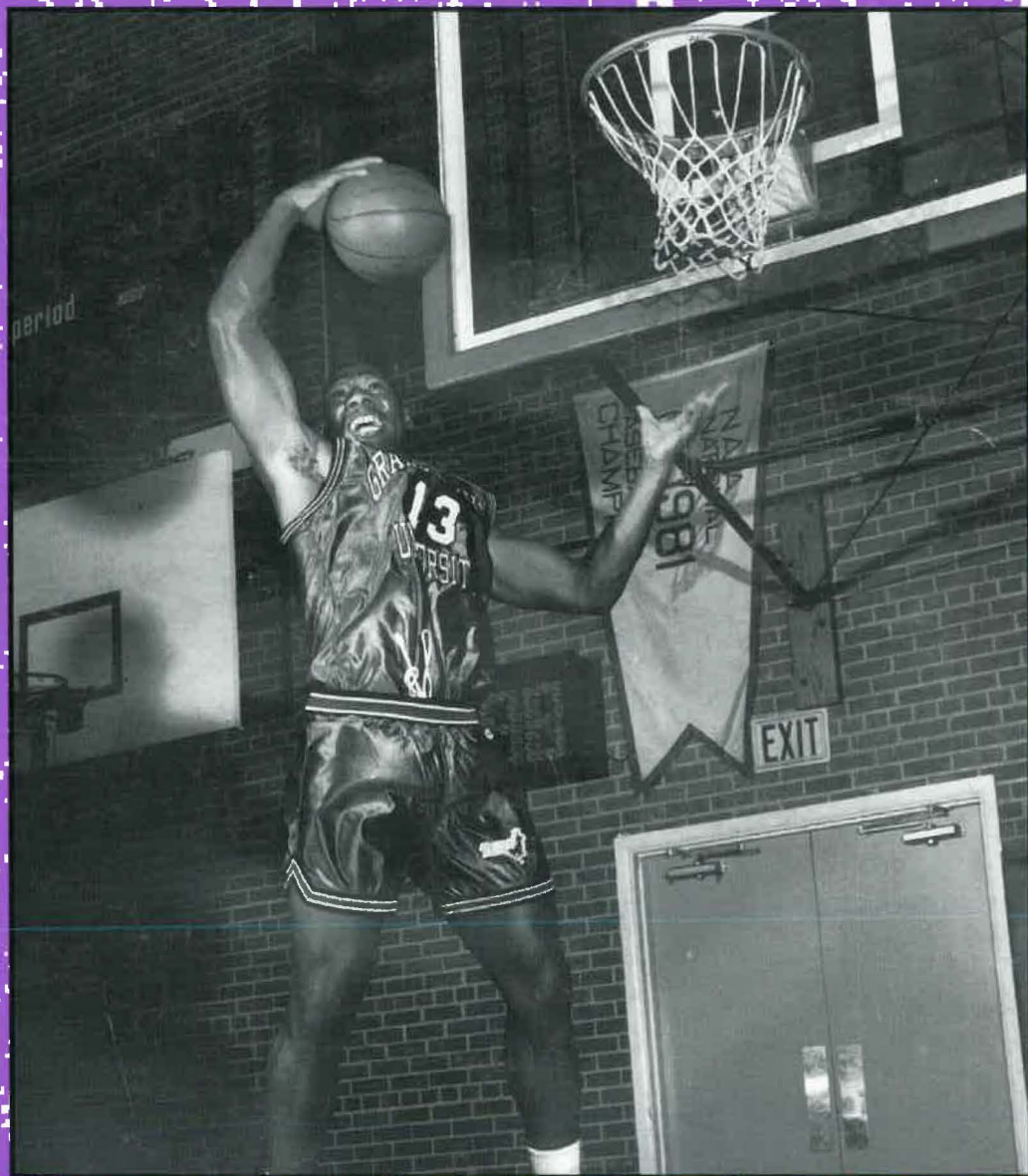

Requests should be made at least 24 hours in advance of matches.

**Press Row:** Courtside seating designated for working press members is limited to those members who make prior arrangement with GCU Sports Information Office. Local media and visiting broadcast media receive first priority. Other media requests will be granted on a first come, first serve basis. Radio broadcast crews must be limited to a crew of two.

**Services:** The Grand Canyon Sports Information office provides game program and cumulative statistics prior to tip-off. Statistical summaries are provided at half-time and accompanied by a full NCAA box score after the game. Media outside the greater Phoenix are may arrange to receive box scores and game summary to be transmitted via facsimile.

## Season Outlook

The Grand Canyon University Men's Basketball squad is looking forward to top last season's finish of 21-7 record, Great Northwest Conference Champions with their 7-3 record, and placing third in the West Region Play-offs.

"We are expected to do well and we are ready to take on all challenges," Head Coach Leighton McCrary said. "We really need to take the steps and go beyond where we've been."

The 'Lopes enter their new season with a pre-season ranking of seventh, given by NCAA Preview magazine this month. "The ranking is a compliment and is encouraging to us - that so many people know about our program," McCrary said.

"It's good recognition for our program and it is something we have worked hard at in our two years in the NCAA."

McCrary feels confident the talent he has returning and the recruits joining the 'Lopes this season should keep GCU in the top 20 amongst NCAA Division II rankings. The 'Lopes placed as high as No. 20 last season and hope their experience and depth will help them move up on the charts. Canyon returns six players to the court, five of them starters, and are bringing in a wide selection of new recruits.

"The new players are good athletes and are trying to get caught on to the system here at Canyon in order to make an impact on the team," McCrary said.

Seniors Chad Briscoe and Darrell Peoples are the team's top returnees,

who both earned All-Conference honors last year and were named as the top players to watch in Division II basketball.

Briscoe averaged 21.0 points per game last season which placed him 30th overall in Division II. He earned conference and region player-of-the-week honors, while both Peoples and Briscoe were selected as the *USA Today* Players-of-the-Week.

Canyon defends their conference title under a new conference name this year as the Great Northwest and Continental Divide Conferences merged earlier this summer to create a men's and women's conference.

The Pacific West Conference competition will be tougher than ever with the new conference tournament to decide the championship. Although

McCrary hopes to stay at the top of their conference, he knows when tournament play rolls around that the championship can belong to anyone.

"When conference play gets tight, I know the returners from last year will know how to override and be successful because of their experience," McCrary said. "We will prevail if we stay poised and confident."

The 'Lopes will also look for their second consecutive NCAA Division II regional bid this year and hope to be the team that represents the West Region at the national play-offs.

"This region is tough because it has a lot of up-and-coming teams," McCrary said. "If we can't be the ones to win regionals, I know the team that does will deserve it because of all the good competition." ■

## The 1992 Grand Canyon University Analysis

**The Strengths:** The experience. McCrary says the experience is strong with this team because of the number of starters returning (5) to the squad this year. He says those players are the ones who made the program successful last year.

**The Concerns:** The expectations. With a pre-season ranking of No. 7 in the NCAA Division-II and competing to beat last year's top finish in the conference, McCrary feels the expectations of the team are high in the community and amongst the team members. Since everyone feels the team is going to be good, he says, the players need to stay focused. "With our tough schedule, the team needs to be focused from day one or it will be a miserable year," McCrary said.

**The Angle:** Grand Canyon has never been pre-seasoned ranked in the top 10 in the nation before placing No. 7 this year. The 'Lopes will also be defending their conference title and are likely to compete past regional play.

**The Coach:** Leighton McCrary, beginning his third season at the helm of the 'Lopes. He has led the team to a 40-18 record in two years and is the third winningest basketball coach at Canyon with a .690 percentage.

**The Returnees:** Briscoe, Peoples, Hayes, Holthaus, and Speckman were all starters last season. Manning is also returning this season after a strong of-the-bench player last year. Jones is returning after taking a year off last season.

**The Newcomers:** Al Norris (G), Elbert Meeks (G), Darius White (G), Andre Barnett (F), Ethan Wildenborg (C), Trent Hudgens (G), Anthony Kyle (F), Chris Eymann (F/C) comprise the recruits for the No. 7 ranked 'Lopes.

**The Tradition:** In its 43rd season, the Grand Canyon University Men's Basketball program has captured eight District titles, three NAIA championship banners, and placed third in their first ever NCAA Division II West Regional play-offs. The program has also sported four All-Americans and had two players named as *USA Today* Players-of-the-Week.



# Coaching Staff



## Leighton McCrary

Leighton McCrary begins his third season as the men's head basketball coach at Grand Canyon. He led the Antelopes to their first NCAA post-season opportunity in 1991-92 after capturing the Great Northwest Conference title with a 21-7 and 7-3 conference record. The 'Lopes finished third at the NCAA Division II West Regional Tournament last March.

McCrary was named the Great Northwest Conference Coach-of-the-Year for taking his squad to the top of the GNC title race last season. In two seasons at the helm of the 'Lopes program, McCrary posts a 40-18 overall record.

McCrary and his squad will be battling for a new crown this season as the Great Northwest Conference merged with the Continental Divide Conference to create a men's and women's conference, the Pacific West Conference. The Pacific West aligns three sports, women's volleyball and basketball and men's basketball. There are six schools competing in both men's and women's basketball and five in volleyball. McCrary returns his starting line-up from 1991-92 and Honorable Mention All-American, Chad Briscoe. He hopes with solid recruiting added to the returning line-up, the 'Lopes will be stronger and able to go beyond the regional tournament this season.

This past summer, in addition to running three one-week basketball camps for children, McCrary was published in The Basketball Bulletin the publication of the National Association of Basketball Coaches of the United States. Former University of St. Louis men's basketball coach, Rich Grawer gave contribution to McCrary's article on 'The Postman: Philosophies and Drills'.

McCrary, 40, is originally from Chicago, but he spent his playing and coaching career in Arkansas. He graduated from Philander Smith College in Little Rock in 1974, where he finished in the top 25 percent of his class with a physical education degree and lettered four years in basketball. In 1982, he added a Master's degree in adaptive physical education from the University of Arkansas-Little Rock to his list of accomplishments.

He came to GCU in 1990 after spending six seasons as the top assistant at Arkansas State University. While at Arkansas State, McCrary helped guide the Indians to three 20 win seasons and three trips to the National Invitational Tournament. Their best showing at the NIT came in 1987-88 when they advanced to the quarterfinals. Arkansas State put together a 109-75 (.592) record during coach McCrary's six year stay and never produced a losing season.

An active participant in AAU basketball for seven years, McCrary assisted with the U.S. Junior National Olympic Men's Team in the summer of 1983. The selected team spent two weeks touring the Soviet Union and was made up of future college All-America team members Tommy Amaker (Duke), Bruce Dalrymple (Georgia Tech), Ricky Blanton (Louisiana State), and Kenny Smith (North Carolina).

McCrary began his coaching career at East Side High School in Menifee, Arkansas where he established a 68-24 record over three years. His last stint at the high school level came at Parkview High School in Little Rock, where he was a basketball assistant for five seasons (109-46), before accepting the position at Arkansas State.

McCrary and his wife Jacquelin have two children, Jami Lyn and Briana. McCrary also has a son Leighton Jr. and a daughter Shawnee from a previous marriage.

### Leighton McCrary

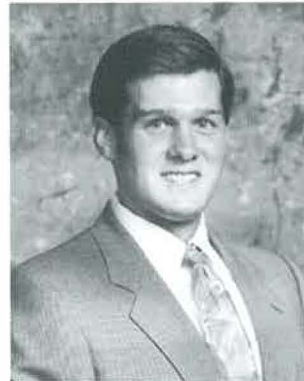

Grand Canyon University men's basketball team earned the third seed in the NCAA Division II west regionals to be held this weekend at California State University, Bakersfield. The announcement came from Alfred J. Mathews, Jr. of the NCAA Division II Men's Basketball committee in a nationwide press conference held this afternoon.

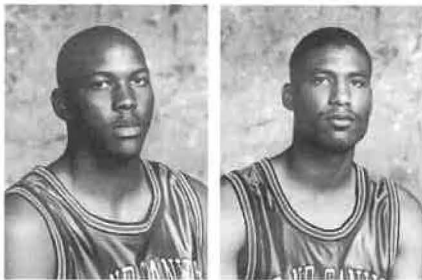
The 'Lopes (20-6), who clinched the Great Northwest Conference championship a week ago, received one of two at-large bids in the west regional and will play number nine nationally-ranked University of California, Riverside this Friday, March 13 at Bakersfield. Riverside enters the tournament seeded second in the West. Riverside is making their fifth consecutive appearance in the tournament while Grand Canyon makes their first showing in NCAA post-season action.

The NCAA Division II tournament begins with a field of 32 teams that compete for the eight regional championships. The "Elite Eight" advance to the three-day national tournament hosted by Springfield College of Massachusetts held March 26, 27 and 28th. The championship game will be broadcast live on CBS at 2 p.m. eastern time on March 28th. The tournament is single elimination.

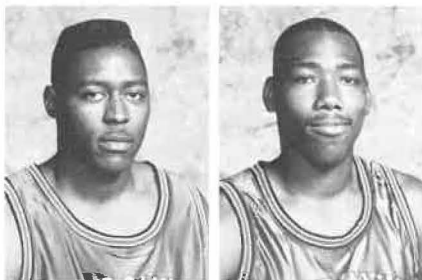

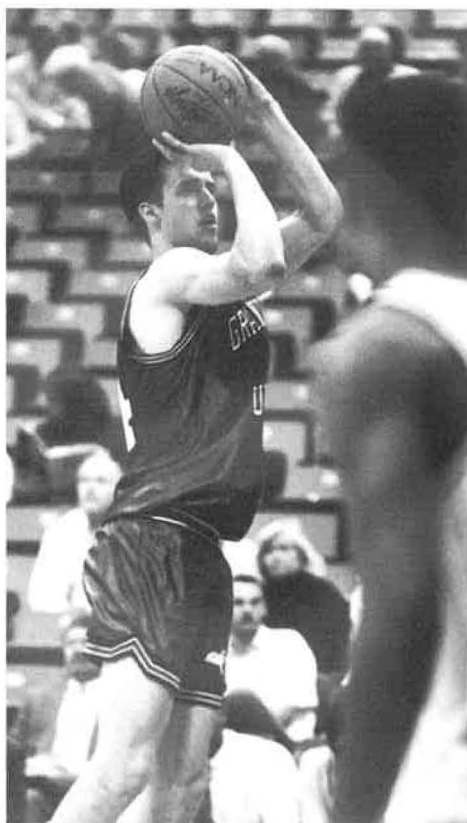
