**NATE OATS**

**Head Coach** 5th Season at UA  
**MARANTHA BAPTIST, 1998** 9th Season Overall

When Nate Oats was formally introduced as head men's basketball coach at The University of Alabama on March 28, 2019, he promised fans would see an entertaining, up-tempo and fast-paced style of play. And that's exactly what he has delivered during his three years in Tuscaloosa.

Oats continues to lead the Crimson Tide men's basketball resurgence to national prominence, having guided his team to 92 wins, highlighted by a pair of SEC Regular Season championships, two SEC Tournament championships and two trips to the Sweet 16. Oats is the only coach in program history to win multiple SEC regular season and tournament championships. He has compiled a record of 92-41 (.692) in his four years at The Capstone. In fact, in his eight years as a head coach, Oats owns an impressive record of 188-84 (.691) and has led his teams to NCAA Tournament appearances six separate times with one of those years being the global pandemic.

During Oats' four years at the helm, the Tide have compiled 49 Southeastern Conference wins, which is tied for the most in the SEC along with Kentucky highlighted by winning the 2023 SEC Regular Season championship at home against Auburn. Against the top teams across the country, Oats and the Crimson Tide have risen to the challenge as Alabama has 15 AP Top 25 wins including defeating the No. 1 team in the country twice during the 2022-23 season, becoming the first team since 1965-66 (Duke) with multiple wins over the AP No. 1 team before

the New Year.

Following the cancelation of the 2020 postseason, Alabama has made consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances in 2021, 2022 and 2023 marking the first time in 19 years the program has achieved the feat dating back to the 2002, 2003 and 2004 events. Furthermore, after earning the No. 2 seed in 2021 and No. 6 seed in 2022, the Tide has garnered a No. 6 seed or better in back-to-back NCAA Tournaments for the first time in 30 years. The last time it occurred came in 1991 (No. 4) and 1992 (No. 5). The 2022-23 version of the Crimson Tide earned the No. 1 overall seed in the NCAA Tournament for the first time in program history.

After agreeing to a contract extension during the 2020-21 season, Oats received a contract extension midway through the 2022-23 season that is set to keep him in charge of the Crimson Tide basketball program through the 2029 season.

"I am honored and humbled to receive a contract extension from The University of Alabama," Oats said. "As I have said many times, my family and I love this community, the city of Tuscaloosa and the University. I am incredibly proud of what we have been able to build during our time at UA which is a direct reflection of the student-athletes, coaches and staff who have all played a big part in our success. I am excited for what's happening in the future of our program and the direction we are heading. I cannot thank President Stuart Bell, Chancellor St. John, The Board of Trustees and Greg Byrne enough for trusting me to lead this program for the long term."

An indicator of Alabama's resurgence can be seen by looking at the last four NBA Drafts. In the 11 NBA Drafts prior to his arrival (2009-19), the Tide had just one men's basketball player selected. Since then (2020-23), a total six UA players have been drafted including having an Alabama player selected in the NBA Draft and lottery selections (top-14 pick) in consecutive years – a first in program history. In 2023, Brandon Miller was selected No. 2 in the NBA Drafted, matching the program record for highest draft pick in program history (Antonio McDyess, 1995) and Noah Clowney was selected by the Brooklyn Nets with the 21st pick. The Miller-Clowney duo became the first Crimson Tide teammates in 28 years to be selected in the first round of the same NBA Draft, dating back to 1995 when McDyess (No. 2 overall to the LA Clippers) and Jason Caffey (No. 20 overall to Chicago Bulls) achieved the feat. The New Orleans Pelicans selected Kira Lewis Jr. No. 13 overall in the 2020 NBA Draft Lottery while Joshua Primo was taken by the San Antonio Spurs at No. 12, making UA one of three schools across the nation to have an NBA Lottery pick during that span.

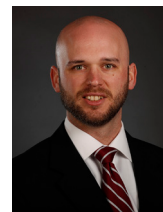
**RYAN PANNONE**
