2017-18 QUICK HITS

- · Alabama returns four starters and seven letterwinners from last season's 19-15 team that reached the National Invitation Tournament. The Crimson Tide will return 74 percent of its total scoring output, 58 percent of its rebounding and 77 percent of its assist totals from a year ago. In addition, head coach Avery Johnson's returning letterwinners started 69 percent of last year's games and accounted for 68 percent of the total minutes played, 74 percent of its field goals made, 75 percent of its made threes and 73 percent of the total made free throws.
- Alabama welcomes back its top four scorers and seven of the top eight scorers from last season's squad. Leading the list of returnees is SEC All-Freshman honoree Braxton Key, who led the team in scoring (12.0 ppg) and minutes (29.9 mpg), while ranking second in rebounding (5.7 rpg) and assists (2.5 apg). He is joined by Dazon Ingram, who was the only player to start all 34 contests a year ago and topped the team in assists (3.3 apg), steals (0.9 spg) and three-pont field goal percentage (.429), while also ranking second in scoring (10.6 ppg). Together, Key (407 points) and Ingram (360 points) became the programs top scoring freshmen duo in program history, combining to score a total of 767 points.
- Junior Donta Hall returns after stellar sophomore season in which he led Alabama in dunks (36), field goal percentate (.658) and blocked shots (1.4 bpg). He also established career-best numbers when he averaged 6.0 points and 5.5 rebounds per game to go along with his 20 starts. Meanwhile, the Tide's lone four-year senior on the 2017-18 squad is guard/forward Riley Norris. Last season, Norris averaged 9.0 points and 3.8 rebounds a game, while topping Alabama in threes made at 47.
- · In addition to the returning letterwinners, Alabama welcomes five freshmen who collectively made up the nation's sixthranked recruiting class according to Rivals.com - the highest-rated class in program history. According to the site, four of the Tide's five newcomers were considered top-100 players and included a pair of five star signees in Collin Sexton (Ranked No. 7) and John Petty (Ranked No. 25), two four star signees in Herb Jones (Ranked No. 86) and Alex Reese (Ranked No. 95), along with three star prospect Galin Smith.
- · Sophomore Daniel Giddens will be eligible after sitting out the 2016-17 season as an NCAA transfer. Giddens, who played his freshman season at Ohio State, was one of the top-rated centers coming out of high school. After playing his final prep season at Oak Hill Academy, Giddens was a consensus top-50 player and top-10 center nationally. In his lone season at Ohio State, the 6-11, 240-pound forward/center saw action in 33 contests, while making seven starts, and averaged 3.8 points, 3.6 rebounds and 1.5 blocks in 18.2 minutes per game.
- · Alabama finished the 2016-17 season with a final record of 19-15 overall and 10-8 in Southeastern Conference play. The Crimson Tide reached the National Invitation Tournament for the second straight time under head coach Avery Johnson and for the 15th time in program history.
- · Alabama's fifth-place finish in the SEC was a five-spot improvement from ending league play in 10th-place last season. The five spot jump in the standings was second only to Florida's six-spot improvement from last season. It was the Tide's best finish in the SEC since closing the 2012-13 season in fourth overall.

- · Alabama played in the NIT for the 15th time in school history and the fifth time in the last seven years with the 2017 at-large selection. The Tide owns a 24-18 (.571) alltime record in the event.
- A pair of freshmen led the Tide offensively throughout the 2016-17 campaign. Forward Braxton Key averaged team highs of 12.0 points per game and 29.8 minutes a contest, while also ranking second in assists (2.5) and rebounds (5.7). Guard Dazon Ingram, who ranked second in scoring (10.6 ppg), led the Tide in assists (3.3 apg), steals (0.9 spg) and 3-point shooting (.429). Six of Alabama's top seven scorers were underclassmen.
- Key was selected to the 2017 Southeastern Conference All-Freshman team. In doing so, he became the first Crimson Tide freshman since 2014 to earn the honor (Shannon Hale).
- Alabama finished the year as one of the top defenses in the nation. The Crimson Tide led the SEC and ranked 28th in the nation in scoring defense (64.5 ppg). Alabama was also third in the SEC and 25th in the nation in field goal percentage defense (.405) and was sixth in the league in three-point field goal percentage defense (.333).
- · Alabama, which was outrebounded just seven times over

its 34 games on the year, led the SEC and ranked 31st in the nation in rebounding margin (+5.6) by season's end. The Tide also ranked 46th nationally in offensive rebounds per game (12.29) and was 27th in the nation in total rebounds per game (39.0).

- Alabama boasted a record of 16-3 when holding teams to 62 points or fewer this season. However, the Tide fell to 3-12 when allowing opponents to score more than 62 points in a contest.
- · Eleven of Alabama's 15 losses on the season were decided by nine points or fewer, including each of its last seven defeats. Furthermore, six of those 11 defeats came down to five points or less.

BY THE NUMBERS

Alabama led the SEC and ranked 31st in the nation in rebounding margin, outrebounding the competition by an average of 5.6 rebounds per game (39.0-33.4). It is the highest rebounding margin for a Crimson Tide team since the 1989-90 season when UA owned a +5.7 advantage on the boards (38.0-32.3).

According to the NCAA, the Crimson Tide ranked second in the nation in "Largest Increase for Average Attendance from Previous Year," improving 2,934 fans per game from 10,176 in 2014-15 to 13,110 in 2015-16.

Number of AP top-25 teams Alabama has beaten in Avery Johnson's tenure (5-7). Last season, the Tide was one of 15 teams nationally that defeated four AP top-25 teams - the first time since 2001-02 that UA recorded at least four wins against top-25 competition.

The Crimson Tide had six wins in games that were decided by less than 10 points this year, going 6-10 in 16 such contests this past season. Last year, Alabama had 13 wins in those games, with seven of those coming down to the game's final possession. The Tide finished last season with a record of 13-8 in games decided by 10 or fewer points and 5-2 in one-possession games.

Total number of sellouts in Alabama head coach Avery Johnson's two seasons, including four consecutive games this year (Mississippi State on Jan. 28, Auburn on Feb. 4, Kentucky on Feb. 11 and LSU on Feb. 18). Alabama recorded five sellouts a year ago, which was the most games sold out in a single season at Alabama since selling out six during the 2006-07 campaign.

Avery Johnson's 18 wins last season tied him for the most wins by a first year head coach at The University of Alabama. Wimp Sanderson won 18 games during his first year in 1980-81.



Avery Johnson, who finished his second season with the Crimson Tide, was introduced as Alabama's 20th head men's basketball coach on April 6, 2015. Johnson, who led the San Antonio Spurs to the 1999 NBA title and was named the 2006 NBA Coach of the Year, came to the Capstone after a successful coaching career in the NBA.

Johnson's first year at Alabama turned many heads in the college basketball world as it didn't take long for fans and student-athletes alike to heed his motto "Buckle Up" in reference to the excitement he expects his tenure will offer. During the 2015-16 season, his inaugural as a collegiate head coach, Johnson gave a glimpse of just that. The Crimson Tide finished with an 18-15 record and earned an at-large selection to the 2016 National Invitation Tournament – Alabama's fifth postseason trip in the last seven years.

The fan support was tremendous throughout the year. Helped by reseating the student section to create a better in-game atmosphere, Alabama averaged a school record 13,110 fans per game - a number that ranked 22nd-best in the nation. Furthermore, the Tide also sold out five home games, which was the most sellouts in a single year since the 2006-07

On the court, Alabama knocked off four teams that were ranked in the Associated Press' Top 25 during the 2015-16 campaign which led the SEC. It marked the first time since 2001-02 that an Alabama team recorded four AP Top 25 victories in the regular season.

Johnson owned an NBA coaching record of 254-186 (.577) after spending four seasons with the Dallas Mavericks (2004-08) and two-plus seasons with the Brooklyn Nets (2010-13).

During his time in Dallas, Johnson led the Mavericks to the postseason in each of his three-plus seasons as head coach. He led the Mavericks to a record of 194-70 (.735) and set the record for reaching the 50-win plateau (62 games) and the 150-win plateau (191 games) the fastest.

- Alabama will begin its 105th season of basketball in 2017-18. The Tide's first season of basketball came in 1912-13. There was not a season in 1943-44 due to World War II.
- The Tide has an all-time record of 1,636-1,014-1 (.615), which includes a 775-596 (.565) record in SEC play. The program's first year of play 1912-13.
- Alabama ranks second in the SEC in league victories and all-time winning percentage.
- UA has made 34 NCAA (19) or NIT (15) appearances and has won seven SEC regular-season titles and six SEC Tournament championships.

A GLANCE OF WHAT'S RETURNING

- This year's trip to Canada is a much anticipated one, as the 2017-18 Alabama squad will be on display for the first time.
- In addition to returning four starters and seven letterwinners from last season's 19-15 team that reached the National Invitation Tournament, the Crimson Tide will return approximately 73 percent of its total scoring output, 58 percent of its rebounding and 77 percent of its assist totals from a year ago.

SCOUTING ALABAMA'S 2016-17 SEASON

- Alabama ended the year with a 19-15 overall record and finished fifth in the SEC with a 10-8 league record. It was the best league finish for the Tide since placing fourth in the standings during the 2012-13 campaign.
- In the postseason, Alabama reached the SEC Tournament semifinals for the
 first time since 2013 and won two games in the same tournament for the first
 time since 2002. Alabama earned an at-large invitational to the 2017 National
 Invitation Tournament. UA, which reached its fifth NIT appearance in the last
 seven years and 15th overall, was the No. 3 seed, but fell to sixth-seeded Richmond
 in the opening round to end the season.
- As a team, Alabama outscored the competition by 3.8 points per game (68.5-64.7), which is the highest scoring advantage since 2012-13. Moreover, the Tide ranked as one of the top rebounding teams in the nation, outrebounding opponents by 5.6 rebounds per game (39.0-33.4). It was the best rebounding advantage by an Alabama team since 2000-01 when it owned a +7.2 (42.2-35.0) edge on the boards.
- Nationally, the Crimson Tide ranked among the top 50 teams in the nation in a number of categories. Alabama ended the season ranked 25th in field goal percentage defense (.405), 27th in rebounding offense (39.0), 28th in scoring defense (64.7), 31st in rebounding margin (+5.6) and 46th in offensive rebounds per game (12.3).
- The Tide boasted a balanced offensive attack as eight guys averaged between 5.0
 and 12.0 points per game. The Tide's top two scorers were both freshmen, while
 six of the top seven were underclassmen.
- True freshman Braxton Key, who was named to the SEC All-Freshman team, led
 the Tide in scoring (12.0 ppg), double-figure scoring games (20), 20-plus point
 scoring games (3) and minutes (29.8 mpg). Key ranked second in assists (2.5 apg),
 rebounding (5.7 rpg) and three-point field goal percentage (.337).
- Redshirt freshman Dazon Ingram, who was the only player to start all 34 games on the year, led the team in assists (3.3 apg), three-point field goal percentage (.429) and steals (0.9 spg), while ranking second in scoring (10.6 ppg) and double figure scoring games (18).
- Sophomore center Donta Hall topped the team in field goal percentage (.658) and in blocked shots (48), while he ranked third in rebounds (5.5 rpg). Junior Riley Norris ranked as the team's leader in threes made (47) and attempted (141) and was third in scoring (9.0 ppg). Graduate senior Bola Olaniyan was the Tide's top rebounder (6.4 rpg) and averaged a team-leading 2.7 offensive boards per game. In SEC games only, Olaniyan led the league in offensive rebounds a game (3.6) and was fourth in the league in rebounding (7.8 rpg).

TIDE HAD BEST SEC TOURNAMENT SHOWING SINCE 2002

- Alabama had a successful SEC Tournament showing in which the Tide, which entered as the No. 5 seed, captured a pair of victories on its way to the first semifinal appearance in the event since 2013.
- Alabama opened the event with a 75-55 victory over 12th-seeded Mississippi State on March 9, followed by a 64-53 win against No. 4 seed South Carolina on March 10. The Tide dropped a hard-fought 79-74 decision against top-seeded Kentucky on March 11.
- It was Alabama's first time winning two games in the same tournament since achieving the feat in 2002.

KEY NAMED TO SEC ALL-FRESHMAN TEAM

- Alabama forward Braxton Key was selected to the 2017 Southeastern Conference All-Freshman team, becoming the first Crimson Tide men's basketball studentathlete to earn a spot on the team since Shannon Hale achieved the feat in 2013-14.
- Key, a Charlotte, N.C. native, was the Tide's top offensive threat, as he led the team
 in scoring (12.0 ppg) and minutes (29.8 mpg), while ranking second in rebounds
 (5.7 rpg) and assists (2.5 apg).

- Key was even better in SEC play, ranking 17th in league games only with 14.0 points per game and 14th with 6.1 rebounds per contest.
- Earlier in the season, Key was named the league's freshman of the week on Jan. 30, after leading the Crimson Tide to wins at Georgia (1/25) and vs. Mississippi State (1/28). In those games, he averaged 22.5 points and 9.0 rebounds, while shooting 11-of-24 (45.8 percent) from the floor, 4-of-8 (50.0 percent) from three and 19-of-27 (70.8 percent) from the charity stripe.
- Key became the 16th player in Alabama program history to be named to the All-SEC Freshman Team.

COLLINS EARNS SPOT ON SEC COMMUNITY SERVICE TEAM

- Graduate senior Corban Collins was named to the Southeastern Conference's Men's Basketball Community Service team, the league office announced on March 2. The annual award handed out from the league office recognizes the accomplishments of student-athletes beyond the field of competition.
- Collins made an impact in his short time in the Tuscaloosa community. During
 his limited spare time, the High Point, N.C., native volunteered to help locally at
 food shelters, spending time to help the less fortunate. He became a regular with
 local elementary schools, where he has read to the children and talked about the
 importance of education. Just recently, Collins spent time at a local hospital visiting
 with cancer patients.
- In addition to his volunteer work in the community, Collins was named one of 14 members of the SEC Men's and Women's Basketball Leadership Council, which provides student-athletes with additional opportunities to engage with campus leaders and Conference office staff. Collins was also nominated for the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Good Works Team for his community outreach efforts and is a member of the Alabama Student-Athlete Advisory Committee (SAAC).
- Collins, who received a master's degree in sports management, played in 32 contests for the Tide on the year, making 14 starts. He ended the year second on the team in three-pointers made (45) and in three-point field goal percentage (.349), while finishing fourth in scoring (7.0 ppg).

ALABAMA'S TOP FRESHMEN DUOS

- Dazon Ingram and Braxton Key proved to be the best freshmen scoring duo in program history.
- Key led the Tide with 407 points on the season, while Ingram had 360 points scored. Those numbers ranked sixth and 13th, respectively among single-season freshman scoring records at UA.
- Combined, the duo accounted for 767 points, which leads all freshman scoring combinations on the same team in program lore.

 3.6 offensive rebounds per game and ranked fourth in the conference with 7.8
 rebounds a contest.
- According to KenPom.com, Olaniyan finished the season with an offensive rebounding percentage at 18.9 percent. That number would have led the country, ranking nearly two percent higher than the nation's leader (17.6 percent by Sidy Djitte of Clemson). However, to qualify for the statistic, one has to play at least 40 percent of his team's minutes and Olaniyan finished the year at 38.5 percent (played 538 of a possible 1,380 total minutes on the year).
- Olaniyan finished with nine double-figure rebounding games for the season, five of which came over the Tide's final 11 contests. He had 30 such games in his career, 22 of which came over his final two seasons (13 at Southern Illinois in 2015-16).

2016-17 PRESEASON TEAM NOTES

REBOUNDING FROM WORST TO FIRST

- Alabama went from the one of the worst rebounding teams in the nation one of the tops in the league during the 2016-17 campaign. The Tide was outrebounded by its opponents in just seven of its 34 games on the year, which included only three times in its 18 SEC contests.
- Last season, the Tide ended the year ranked 13th in the SEC and 293rd in the nation in rebound margin at -3.6 (34.6-38.2). However, it was quite the opposite this season as Alabama led the conference and ranked 31st in the nation in rebounding margin at +5.6 (39.0-33.4).
- Those numbers were even better against SEC competition. In its 18 league games, Alabama ranked among the top two teams in the conference in nearly every rebounding category, including rebounding average (1st, 40.4), offensive rebounds (1st, 13.2), rebounding margin (2nd, +5.9) and rebounds allowed (3rd, 34.4).
- The Tide boasted three games of 50 or more rebounds (53 vs. Stetson, 50 vs. Vanderbilt and 62 at South Carolina) this season. The Tide's 62 boards in the quadruple overtime win at then-No. 16 South Carolina were the most in a game since Dec. 7, 2002 when Alabama pulled down 62 boards against St. Bonaventure.
- The last time the Tide collected 50 or more rebounds in a game three times in the same season came during the 2007-08 campaign when Alabama pulled down 61 vs. Troy (11/9/07), 50 at Mercer (11/13/07) and 52 vs. George Washington (12/29/07).

TIDE'S TRENDS

- There were a few noticeable trends when it comes to the 2016-17 Alabama men's basketball team.
- One of the biggest trends on the year was the amount of points the Tide's defense allowed. Alabama owned a record of 16-3 when holding the opposition to 62 or fewer points in a game. However, UA went 3-12 when it allowed more than 62 points to an opponent.
- Below is a breakdown of a few other key factors to look into during a game.
 Alabama is:
- 16-3 when holding the opposition to 62 or fewer points in a game
- 3-12 when allowing opponents to score more than 62 points in a game
- 13-2 when holding opponents to 40 percent or less shooting
- 15-2 when shooting the same or better than the opposition
- 16-2 when attempting more free throws than an opponent
- 3-13 when attempting the same or less free throws than an opponent
- 12-2 when committing fewer turnovers than an opponent
- 12-3 when scoring more than 70 points in a game
- 14-3 when leading at the half
- 5-12 when tied or trailing at the half
- 6-11 in games by 10 points or less

NOTES FROM THE QUADRUPLE OVERTIME THRILLER

- Alabama and South Carolina played an epic quadruple overtime contest on Feb. 7, that many feel was the game of the year – not only in the SEC but in all of college basketball this season.
- The Crimson Tide escaped Columbia, S.C., with a 90-86 victory in its only overtime game of the season. Below are some other notes surrounding that contest:
 - It was the first four overtime game in Division I college basketball this year. The last time it happened in college basketball came when UConn defeated Cincinnati, 104-97, in the American Athletic Conference quarterfinal match-up on March 11, 2016.
 - It was just the second quadruple overtime game in Alabama program history. The only game in which it took four extra periods to decide the outcome came on Feb. 12, 1972 vs. LSU. The Tide, which defeated the Tigers 103-99 in that contest, improved to 2-0 in such games.
 - With the victory, Alabama captured its first true road win over a top-25 team since taking a 77-73 victory over then-No. 4 Mississippi State on Feb. 21, 2004 in Starkville, Miss.
 - The contest featured 10 ties and 11 lead changes throughout. All but one lead change occurred at the end of regulation and in the four overtimes.
 - Avery Johnson Jr. led Alabama with a career-high 23 points in the winning effort. Over the previous five contests, he had a combined 22 points.

- South Carolina's Sindarius Thornwell finished with 44 points and 21 boards on the night. He was only the third collegiate Division I player to record a 40/20 game in the last 20 years (Oklahoma's Blake Griffin and Cleveland State's Norris Cole).

LEADING THE SEC

- Alabama tied for tops in the SEC when it came to Graduation Success Rate (GSR) among men's basketball schools in the league.
- Alabama, along with Georgia, were the only men's basketball programs in the SEC that boasted a perfect 100 percent in the 2015-16 GSR results.
- The GSR factors students who entered school from 2006-09 and graduated within six years of their start date.

COLLINS NOMINATED FOR NABC GOOD WORKS TEAM

- Alabama graduate transfer Corban Collins was named a nominee for the 2017 National Association of Basketball Coaches' (NABC) Allstate Good Works Team. The esteemed award honors an outstanding group of student-athletes who represent the sport's finest in the areas of community service and leadership among their peers.
- Collins, who is in his first season at Alabama, was a member of the Southeastern Conference Men's Basketball Leadership Council. The Leadership Council consists of one male and one female representative from each school in the SEC and provides student-athletes with additional opportunities to engage with campus leaders and conference office staff.
- In addition, Collins made an impact in his short time in the Tuscaloosa community.
 During his limited spare time, the High Point, N.C., native volunteered to help locally at food shelters, and also visited elementary schools, where he read to the children and talked about the importance of education.
- Collins is a two-time nominee for the prestigious award. Last year while at
 Morehead State, he was actively involved in the community. In 2015, Collins spent
 a portion of his summer in New Zealand with Athletes in Action, a Christian
 organization known for using sports as a platform to help people answer questions
 of faith.


