MUSSELMAN AT A GLANCE

- Eric Musselman was named Arkansas' 13th head men's basketball coach on April 7, 2019. He has over 30 years of coaching experience, including his seven as a collegiate head coach and 14 as a professional head coach.
- In his first seven years as a collegiate head coach, Musselman has won at least 20 games each season (24, 28, 29, 29, 20, 25 and 28), advanced to all six postseasons played (including five straight NCAA tournaments) and reached three NCAA Sweet 16's, including an Elite 8 appearances with the Hogs in 2021 and '22. Prior to entering the collegiate head coaching ranks, Musselman was a head coach for seven professional teams, including two seasons with the Golden State Warriors (2002-04) and one with the Sacramento Kings (2006-07). He won over 550 games as a professional head coach with a combined pro winning percentage of .626 (553-330).
- Musselman played collegiately at the University of San Diego and helped the Toreros to NCAA Tournament berths in 1984 and 1987. He was recipient of the program's Bugelli Leadership Award as a senior.
- Musselman is married to Danyelle Sargent Musselman, who has worked at ESPN, Fox Sports and the NFL Network as a broadcaster. Musselman has two sons, Michael and Matthew, and the couple has a daughter, Mariah.
- Musselman's father Bill was also an NBA head coach and they were the first father-son combination to become head coaches in the NBA.

MUSSELMAN DID YOU KNOWS

- Named General Manager of CBA's Rapid City Thrillers at age of 22. The next year, became head coach of the Thrillers at he age of 23, the youngest coach in CBA history.
- From 1990-1997, had 26 players called up to the NBA, the highest number in the league during that span.
- Is the only person in CBA history to coach in five league All-Star Games (1990, 1992, 1993, 1994, 1997)
- The first coach in professional basketball history to win 100 games by the age of 28.
- At the age of 37, named head coach of the Golden State Warriors and was the youngest head coach ever hired by an NBA team at the time.
- He and his father, Bill, were first father-son combination to both become head coaches in NBA history.
- In 2003, was runner-up to Gregg Popovich for NBA Coach of the Year Award voting (231 points, including 26 first-place votes).
- Is the CBA's third all-time winningest coach (270-122 in seven seasons) and the most successful coach (54-3 in two seasons) in the history of the United States Basketball League.
- Led CBA in scoring (116.7 ppg) in 192-93 and was 2nd in NBA in scoring (102.4 ppg) in 2002-03.
- Only needed 130 games to win his 100th game as a collegiate head coach. He was the 27th-fastest coach in NCAA history to reach 100 wins but was the ninth-fastest since 1970.
- In his first season at Arkansas, the Razorbacks led the NCAA in 3-point field goal percentage defense while Arkansas led the NCAA in both free throws made and attempted in 2022.

Much Too Early Top 25

- After back-to-back Elite 8 appearances and having the #2 recruiting class in the country coupled with the return of Jaylin Williams – Arkansas was picked by several publications at #1 in the "much too early top 25" lists for 2022-23.
- However, Williams performed well at the NBA combine and decided to enter the NBA Draft. With that, the Razorbacks dropped, but are still considered a favorite to contend for the national championship this season. **NOTE: PRE was immediately after the season ranking prior to Williams decision and POST was after he declared for the NBA Draft.**

Williams Drafted by OKC

- As mentioned above, Jaylin Williams entered the NBA Draft after his sophomore season and was rewarded by being the 34th overall pick in the 2022 Draft as the Oklahoma City Thunder selected him early in the second round.
- Williams became the 41st Razorback to be selected in the NBA Draft and is the 16th-highest picked player in school history.
- This marks the fourth-straight year a Razorback has been taken in the NBA Draft, joining fellow Arkansas natives Daniel Gafford, Isaiah Joe and Moses Moody. Joe, Moody and Williams played for Musselman, and Joe and Williams were high school teammates at Fort Smith Northside.
- Williams was part of Arkansas head coach Eric Musselman's inaugural and highly-touted recruiting class. The consensus top-five group also featured Moody, Arkansas' first one-and-done and eventual lottery pick by 2022 NBA Champion Golden State Warriors.
- This marks the fourth straight year Coach Musselman has had a player drafted including Cody Martin (at Nevada) and Jalen Harris (Nevada), Joe, Moody and Williams.

Racking Up the Frequent Flier Miles

- Arkansas will get plenty of frequent flier miles this season.

RAZORBACKS IN EUROPE

- Arkansas will get an early start to the 2022-23 season as the Razorbacks will play a total of four games on an 11-day trip to Spain and Italy from August 6-16.
- Current trip itinerary includes:
 - Depart Aug. 6, arrive in Valencia, Spain on Aug. 7.
 - GAME 1** - Aug. 9 in Valencia

- Bus to Madrid, Spain on Aug. 10
- GAME 2** - Aug. 11 in Madrid
- GAME 3** - Aug. 12 in Madrid
- Fly to Milan, Italy on Aug. 13
- GAME 4** - Aug. 14 in Lake Como, Italy
- Return to Fayetteville on Aug. 16.
- Per NCAA rules regarding a foreign tour, Arkansas will hold 10 days of practices prior on campus prior to departing for Europe.
- The last time the men's program played in Europe was 2016 when the Razorbacks traveled to Spain (Madrid, Albacete and Barcelona). Before that, Arkansas played in Italy prior to the 2012-13 season.

RAZORBACKS IN HAWAII

- Fresh of back-to-back NCAA Elite 8 appearances, Arkansas was selected to play in the 2022 Maui Jim Maui Invitational.
- The Razorbacks will join Arizona, Cincinnati, Creighton, Louisville, Ohio State, San Diego State and Texas Tech at the event. The 39th edition of the Maui Invitational is set for Nov. 21-23, 2022, at the historic Lahaina Civic Center on the island of Maui.
- This will be the fourth time Arkansas has played in the Maui Invitational. The Razorbacks' previous appearances came in the 1991-92, 2005-06 and 2013-14 seasons.

Razorbacks Draw Baylor Big 12/SEC Challenge

- In a rematch of the 2021 NCAA Elite 8 meeting, Arkansas will face Baylor as part of the 2023 SEC/Big 12 Challenge. The contest will be played on Jan. 28, 2023, in Waco, Texas.
- Overall, the 10th annual SEC/Big 12 Challenge will feature 10 games played on the same day (Saturday, Jan. 28, 2023) in a matchup of two premier college basketball conferences. ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU will once again televise the Challenge.
- Arkansas will play in its ninth consecutive Challenge. The Razorbacks are 4-4 in such games.
- Arkansas helped the SEC win last year's Challenge, 6-4, with a 77-68 home victory over West Virginia. It was the second year in a row the SEC won the Challenge. The SEC has lost the Challenge just one time in the last six years.

RAZORBACKS AND BEARS

- The Arkansas and Baylor rivalry dates back to the Razorbacks' first season of basketball (1924-24) when both schools were members of the Southwest Conference. The teams have met on 144 previous occasions, making the Bears fourth (tied) among Arkansas' most common opponents behind Texas A&M (161), Texas (155) and SMU (155) while being tied with Rice (144). Arkansas owns a 96-48 advantage in the series, including a 37-32 mark in games played in Waco. However, the teams have only played three times since 1990-91 after Arkansas left the SWC for the SEC and all three were on neutral courts - Jan. 5, 2008, in Dallas; Dec. 20, 2009, in North Little Rock; and Mar. 29, 2021, in Indianapolis.

- The Arkansas and Oklahoma series includes 29 games dating back to the 1938-39 season. Arkansas

owns a 16-13 advantage in the series, including a 5-1 record when the teams play on a neutral court. The teams have only met in Tulsa once.

- Anthony Black was a key part of the Team USA gold-medal winning FIBA Americas U18 Championships in Tijuana (Mexico).

- This season will be just the second time since the Razorbacks joined the SEC (1991-92) that the Arkansas and **Kentucky** will meet twice during the same regular season. The only other time came in 2013-14 when Arkansas swept Kentucky with a pair of overtime victories. First, Arkansas beat #13 Kentucky in Fayetteville (Jan. 14, 2014). Then, the Razorbacks handed the 17th-ranked Wildcats a 71-67 setback in Rupp Arena (Feb. 27, 2014).
- Arkansas and **Missouri** will be playing a home-and-home series in each of the now 11 years since the Tigers joined the SEC (2012-13).
- Arkansas and **LSU** have met for a home-and-home series in all but two seasons since the Razorbacks joined the SEC (1991-92). The Razorbacks and Tigers only met once in 2013 (at Baton Rouge) and just once in 2015 (in Fayetteville).

- Arkansas and **Tennessee** will only play once in 2022-23, marking the fifth time over nine years the schools will have a single-game series. Four of those five have one thing in common ... being played in Thompson-Boling Arena (2023, 2021, 2019 and 2017). Since 2013-14, Arkansas will be playing in Knoxville for the ninth time as compared to five meetings being played in Fayetteville and two at the SEC Tournament.
- On the other end of a scheduling quirk, Arkansas will play at **Vanderbilt** for just the fourth time since 2014-15. 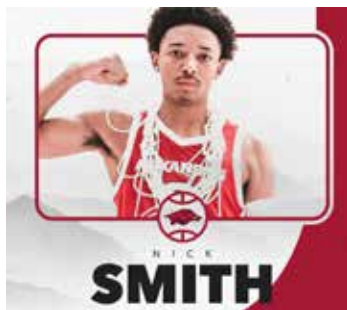

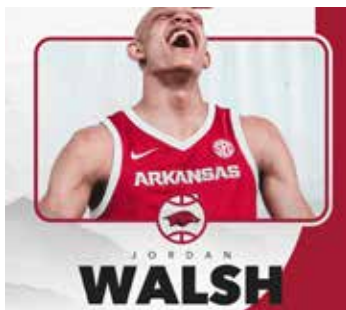
