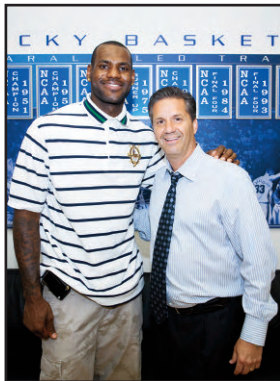

## From the Notebook...

### Social Networking

UK head coach John Calipari has wasted no time embracing his social responsibilities as basketball coach. Within a few weeks of taking the job, Calipari joined the popular networking tool Twitter and through July had over 500,000 followers. He has also created his own Facebook page, as well as launching his own website, CoachCal.com.



### West Coast Cats

While most of their teammates spent the summer taking summer classes or playing pick-up games in Lexington, Patrick Patterson and Daniel Orton spent their time in California for two months training for the upcoming season.

The two big men enlisted in a camp designed to improve basketball skills, while at the same time increasing their strength and stamina.

### Meeks Shines in Summer Camp

It was a fantastic off season for former UK All-American Jodie Meeks. Meeks decided to forego his senior season at Kentucky and was drafted in the second round by the Milwaukee Bucks.

The Norcross, Ga. native proceeded to show off his shooting touch and scoring prowess, as he led the Bucks in scoring and ranked 12th overall in the NBA Summer League averaging 19.0 ppg. The former Wildcat sharpshooter torched the opposition from behind the three point line, shooting 53 percent (8-15), while shooting 56 percent overall (39-70).

### The King Visits Camelot

The King finally visited Camelot. College basketball's greatest tradition and basketball's most visible star came together Friday afternoon at Kentucky's campus. LeBron James, the 2009 NBA MVP, flew into Lexington to tour UK's basketball facilities.

King James and Kentucky have long been

viewed as two of the most iconic figures and programs in basketball for some time, but Friday was the first time the two had come together. Even though James never attended UK or college for that matter - he was the No. 1 pick in the 2003 NBA Draft - UK head coach John Calipari and James have had a budding friendship recently.

When Calipari heard James was interested in touring UK's basketball facilities on his way to an event in Mississippi, Calipari and his staff set up a mock recruiting visit.

### UK and Team USA

The UK basketball program has always had strong ties with the United States Basketball program. Joining the likes of the 1948 Olympic Gold medalist Wildcats, and the most recent gold medal winning Wildcat, Tayshaun Prince, is Darius Miller.

The 6-7 sophomore was selected to the U19 US national team

who helped lead to the U19 World Championship.

Miller led the team with 12 blocked shots in nine games, while averaging 5.0 ppg and 3.1 rpg.

Also representing the US during the offseason were newcomers DeMarcus Cousins and John Wall. Both played for the 2009 USA Nike Hoop Summit Team that went up against the World Select Team, suffering a 97-89 loss. Wall finished the game with 13 points, 11 assists and five steals, while Cousins tallied four points and five rebounds.

### No. 1 Ranked Recruiting Class

According to several recruiting experts, the Wildcats and Coach Calipari reeled in the top ranked recruiting class in the country. Both Rivals.com and Scout.com both list the Wildcats at the top of their lists after

Darius Miller helped lead Team USA to a gold medal in the U19 World Championships.

UK signed five players in the top 50. The outstanding recruiting class led guru Jerry Meyer to exclaim, "(John) Calipari plus Kentucky is an incredibly synergistic explosion. They are going to be in on any recruit in the country. The sum of those two parts is bigger than the parts themselves and it's happened much quicker than originally expected. It's happened so quickly it's immediately shaken up the whole recruiting scene."

### Wildcats Earn APR Award

The University of Kentucky men's basketball team received a public recognition award for its Academic Progress Rate score.

UK receives the award for placing in the top 10 percent of the nation's Division I men's basketball APR scores. The APR marks are a four-year composite, covering the 2004-05, 2005-06, 2006-07 and 2007-08 school years, that measures academic eligibility and retention of student-athletes.

UK was the only men's basketball team in the Southeastern Conference to receive a public recognition award.





# John Calipari

**A**fter bringing the University of Massachusetts basketball program to national prominence in the '90s and resurrecting the Memphis basketball program in the 2000s, John Calipari became the 22nd coach in UK history, and the seventh in the last 79 years.

In 1996, Calipari moved from UMass to the NBA after leading the Minutemen to the Final Four. For his efforts, Calipari was named Naismith National Coach of the Year.

Calipari led the Tigers to the 2008 NCAA title game, and Memphis' 38 wins in 2007-08 made him the winningest coach for a single season in NCAA history. As a result, Calipari was named Naismith National Coach of the Year for a second time in his career. He is only the second coach to receive the honor multiple times since the award's inception in 1987. Duke's Mike Krzyzewski is the other to do so.

Calipari, the 2009 *Sports Illustrated* National Coach of the Year, led the Tigers to nine-straight 20-win campaigns and nine-consecutive postseason appearances, the only Memphis coach to do that. He posted 252 wins — 28 wins per season — as the Tigers' head coach, making him the winningest coach in school history.

Calipari's success began in his first season at Memphis, but it was the last four years that placed him in the NCAA and school record books. The Tigers' 147 wins the last four seasons made Calipari the winningest coach in a four-year span in NCAA Division I history. His 104 victories in the last three seasons are the second-most in NCAA Division I history over a three-year span.

He directed the Tigers to the top of both national polls in 2007-08, becoming the fifth coach in NCAA Division I history to take two different schools to the No. 1 ranking. Calipari led UMass to No. 1 in 1996. He joined Roy Williams, Ralph Miller, Frank McGuire and Eddie Sutton in that elite club.

The last four seasons, Calipari directed the Tigers to four-straight 30-win campaigns and is the first coach in NCAA Division I history to record four-straight 30-win ledgers.

With his success at Memphis, Calipari's overall record soared to 445-140 for an impressive 76.1 winning percentage. His 445 wins are the second-most in NCAA Division I history in the first 17 years, Roy Williams being the other.

Calipari's 76.1 winning percentage is the third-highest among active NCAA Division I coaches with 10 years experience at college basketball's Division I level, trailing only Roy Williams and Mark Few. On the NCAA Division I list for winning percentage for all coaches (minimum 10 years), Calipari is in 14th place and ahead of Krzyzewski, Jim Boeheim, Bob Huggins and Lute Olson.

With his four 30-win seasons at Memphis, Calipari now has six for his career, which is the fourth-most for a head coach in NCAA Division I history. For his career (16 years), Calipari has 15 20-win seasons and nine 25-win campaigns.

Much like he did at UMass, when his players graduated at nearly 80 percent, Calipari did the same at Memphis. Fifteen of the last 18 seniors that came through the Tiger program have earned their bachelor's degrees and the three seniors this season are on schedule to graduate in the spring of 2009.

Calipari compiled a 193-71 record (.731) during his eight-year career at Massachusetts, including a 108-44 mark (.684) in Atlantic 10 play. In addition to five-straight NCAA Tournaments, UMass also made two appearances in the NIT, advancing to the NIT final four in 1991. The

1990-91 season was the first of six-straight seasons in which the Minutemen won at least 20 games.

Calipari's personal 20-win streak has reached the 15-season mark as all of his Memphis clubs won 20-plus games. In his final season at UMass, Calipari was named the 1996 Naismith National Coach of the Year and *The Sporting News* National Coach of the Year. He was also named the Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year for the third time in four years, as well as *Basketball Times* East Region Coach of the Year.

During the Minutemen's 35-2 season in 1995-96, UMass posted wins over Kentucky, Maryland, Wake Forest, Georgia Tech, Syracuse, Virginia Tech and Louisville. UMass ended the regular season ranked No. 1 in the nation in the final regular season poll after being the top-ranked team for nine weeks earlier in the year. The Minutemen also won their first 26 games of the season, setting a school record for most consecutive wins.

In addition to his National Coach of the Year honors in 1996, Calipari was a Naismith Coach of the Year finalist in 1994 and 1995. He was the USBWA District I Coach of the Year in 1993.

At 29, when he was named head coach, Calipari began to build a program from the ground up, going 10-18 his first season before posting a 17-14 record his second year (receiving a bid to the NIT).

The Minutemen won their first A-10 championship in 1992 with a 30-5 record, including a 13-3 mark in league play. With a 77-71 overtime win over Syracuse in an East Regional second-round game, UMass made its first NCAA Sweet 16 appearance.

Calipari left UMass in June of 1996 to become Executive Vice President of Basketball Operations and Head Coach of the New Jersey Nets. He led the Nets to a second-place finish in the NBA's Atlantic Division and the playoffs in 1998, ending a five-year postseason drought for the franchise. The Nets' 17-game turnaround from the previous year was the best that season in the NBA.

He became a member of the Philadelphia 76ers coaching staff in 1999, rejoining Philadelphia coach Larry Brown, for whom Calipari was an assistant at Kansas.

Calipari began his coaching career at Kansas as a volunteer assistant under Ted Owens. In 1983, he was hired as the recruiting coordinator at the University of Vermont, but was swayed back to the nation's heartland when Brown was hired as head coach at KU. He spent three seasons at Kansas (1982-85) before another three-year stint as an assistant coach to Paul Evans at Pittsburgh (1985-88).

The 50-year-old lettered two years at North Carolina-Wilmington before transferring to Clarion State. He played point guard at Clarion during the 1981 and 1982 seasons, leading the team in assists and free throw percentage. The Eagles were ranked in the Division II Top 20 both years and participated in the 1981 NCAA Division II Tournament.

Calipari and his wife, Ellen, have two daughters, Erin Sue and Megan Rae, and a 12-year-old son, Bradley Vincent. Erin recently graduated from UMass and is now in her first year of grad school at Wake Forest, while Megan is a sophomore at UK.

## KENTUCKY MEN'S BASKETBALL (22-14, 8-8 SEC) End Season Notes

### WILDCATS END SEASON IN NIT QUARTERFINALS

Kentucky's season came to an end following a 77-67 loss to Notre Dame in the quarterfinals of the NIT.

Jodie Meeks led the Wildcats with 21 points, including 18 in the second half. After going just 1-3 in the first half, Meeks went 4-of-6 from behind the three point line, including scoring 18 points in a nine-minute stretch.

Patrick Patterson was the only other Wildcat in double-digits tallying 18 points, while pulling down seven rebounds. Kevin Galloway tied for team high honors with seven rebounds as well.

The Wildcats finished the season with a 22-14 record, their 53rd 20-win season, however the team did not receive a bid to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1991.

Kentucky did lead the nation in attendance (22,239) for the fourth straight year and the 13th time in the last 14 years.

- Jodie Meeks was named Second Team All-America by the Associated Press, *The Sporting News*, USBWA and NABC.
- Jodie Meeks and Patrick Patterson received All-SEC honors from both the league coaches (Meeks - 1st Team, Patterson - 1st Team) and the Associated Press (Meeks - 1st Team, Patterson - 2nd)
- Jodie Meeks lead the Southeastern Conference and ranked eighth nationally in scoring (23.7 ppg).
- Patrick Patterson lead the SEC and ranked 11th in the nation in FG percentage (60.3) and tied for 28th in rebounding (9.3).
- Patterson was the only player in the SEC to rank in the top five in scoring (4th - 17.9) and rebounding (3rd - 9.4).
- UK ranked third in the country in blocked shots per game (6.6), sixth in free throw percentage (77.3), ninth in FG pct. defense (38.7), 11th in field goal percentage (48.1) and 28th in assists/game (15.8).
- Jodie Meeks (1,246) and Patrick Patterson (1,020) became the 56th and 57th members of Kentucky's prestigious 1,000 point club. Meeks currently ranks 33rd, while Patterson ranks 54th.
- Patterson broke the 1,000-point plateau in just 59 games, the 10th fastest in school history.
- The Wildcats finished with 238 blocked shots, two shy of the school record 240 set in the 1998 season.
- Kentucky shot 77.3 percent (601-777) from the free throw line, barely missing the school record of 77.6 percent (666-858) in 1979. The 601 made free throws was the most since the 1996 team hit 630.
