

Asumnu Recently

A player who continues to improve with each game as he becomes more comfortable playing in the SEC ... Earned a starting assignment in Tennessee's quarterfinal game against Auburn in the SEC Tournament (3/14/03) ... Contributed 17 positive minutes off the bench at Kentucky, during which he shot 100 percent from the field and scored six points (2/26/03) ... Sparked the Vols to victory against South Carolina (1/29/03) ... Broke a 42-42 tie with South Carolina by scoring six straight points, giving the Vols a lead they would not relinquish en route to the victory ... Had one of his best games at 19th-ranked Georgia (1/22/03) with six points in 14 minutes ... Was the hero in the Vols' road win over Ole Miss when he grabbed a huge offensive rebound and put-back the winning shot with 2.6 seconds remaining in the game (1/11/03) ... Against Kentucky in the first SEC game of his career, saw 13 minutes of action and scored two points to break a drought of three games without a field goal (1/8/03) ... Posted an eight point, four rebound, two assist performance at Texas A&M while making his first collegiate appearance in his home state of Texas (12/4/02) ... Broke out of a shooting slump for an 11 point, four rebound, two assist performance against VMI (11/25/02) ... Earned his first career start in the season opener against Gardner-Webb (11/22/02) ... Gained a starting assignment in Tennessee's exhibition game against BC Cesis of Latvia ... Had 12 points and six rebounds against the Latvians.

Noting Asumnu

Wears No. 3 jersey because it symbolizes the three Bible verses (Psalms 23, Matthew 6:33 and James 4:6) he reads before every game and every day ... Has recorded a 40-inch vertical jump ... Rated as one of the top-10 fifth-year prep school players in the nation coming out of Hargrave Military Academy ... Led Hargrave to a 25-3 record while averaging 10 points per game.

Crump Recently

After averaging 4.7 points in his first three SEC games, he has averaged 12.2 points in the last ten conference games ... Recorded his second consecutive double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds against Auburn in the quarterfinals of the SEC Tournament (3/14/03) ... Against Vanderbilt, recorded his first career double-double against an SEC team, scoring 18 points and tearing down 11 rebounds in the winning effort (3/8/03) ... Scored 16 points and energized his team at key points in the Vols' win over No. 23 Mississippi State (3/5/03) ... Established a new career-high with 19 points on eight for 10 shooting while helping to lead the Vols to an upset win over No. 4 Florida (2/15/03) ... Tied a career-high with 16 points in a strong effort in the Vols' upset win over Georgia (2/8/03) ... Had a strong outing against South Carolina, grabbing nine rebounds and scoring 13 points, a season-high against SEC competition (1/29/03) ... Broke out of a three-game SEC slump with a strong 11-point performance against Vanderbilt in which he snatched a career-high five steals (1/18/03) ... Tied his career-high with 16 points in just 25 minutes against UT Martin (12/30/02) ... Enjoyed one of his best performances for the Vols against Texas A&M, notching career-highs with 11 rebounds, four assists, three blocks, 35 minutes played and sinking all of his career-high eight free throw attempts (12/4/02) ... Pulled down nine rebounds against VMI (11/25/02) ... Narrowly missed career marks in points and rebounds in the season opener against Gardner-Webb (11/22/02) with a 15 points, 7 rebounds effort ... Averaged 18.5 points and 7.0 rebounds in Tennessee's two exhibition games ... Had a 24 points, 10 rebound performance against BC Cesis of Latvia that included going 7-of-8 from the field and 10-for-12 from the free throw line.

Attended the Pete Newell Big Man Camp in Hawaii during August 2002 ... Joined former teammate Vincent Yarbrough at the camp ... Former Vols who have attended the camp since its inception in 1977 include Dale Ellis, Steve Hamer, Bernard King (as an NBA player), Doug Roth and Yarbrough ... Recorded the best bench press on the team with a lift of 365 pounds ... Arrived on campus during the fall of 2000 weighing 204 pounds ... Has since added more than 30 pounds to his frame ... Wears the No. 4 jersey because he is a fan of the Sacramento Kings star Chris Webber ... In a movie of his life he would choose Martin Lawrence to play him.
