2019-20 AT A GLANCE

- The college basketball season was cut short due to the coronavirus with the cancellation of the SEC and NCAA Tournaments on March 12, hours before the Gators were set to take on Georgia in Nashville.
- Florida finished the season with 2 ranked wins, defeating #18 Xavier in the Charleston Classic final and #4 Auburn in a 22-point rout.
- The Gators posted 2 of the largest comebacks in team history, rallying from 21 down to defeat Alabama in double overtime to open the SEC schedule and adding a 22-point comeback vs. Georgia that matched the largest rally in program history.
- Keyontae Johnson earned 1st-team All-SEC honors, while Kerry Blackshear Jr. earned 2nd-team recognition and Scottie Lewis garnered SEC All-Freshman honors.
- UF led the SEC in 3-point percentage (.376) and field goal percentage (.470) during conference play. Noah Locke's .481 3-point percentage in SEC action also led the league.
- Through Mike White's first 5 seasons as the Gators' head coach, Florida's 54 conference wins trail only Kentucky over that time span.
- Florida played the toughest non-conference slate of any SEC team for the 4th time in 5 years under Mike White, according to KenPom (3rd in 2017-18). No power conference team has more neutral-site wins than UF's 4.
- Keyontae Johnson's 25-point, 11-rebound, 5-assist night in the win vs. LSU was UF's first 25/10/5 stat line since 2009 (Nick Calathes vs. Arkansas) and only the 3rd since 1996 (Matt Walsh, 2002 vs. Miami).
- The Gators put together a 22-point comeback win vs. Georgia, tied for the largest in school history (1993 at South Carolina). Florida trailed 52-30 before reeling off a 39-7 run. UF had another rally in the road contest vs. Georgia, falling behind 19-6 before outscoring UGA 62-35 from that point on.
- In the win vs. #4 Auburn, Omar Payne made all 9 field goal attempts on his way to 19 points and 11 rebounds. He became the 2nd SEC player in the 2000s to post 9+ makes without a miss in a conference game, joining Andrew Nembhard, who went 9-for-9 at Alabama last season.
- The Gators earned their 100th win under Mike White on Jan. 15 vs. Ole Miss, White's alma mater. White made it to 100 wins in the 2nd-fewest games of any coach in UF history (158), just 4 games behind the pace set by future Hall of Famer Billy Donovan (154). He is the 5th coach in UF history to reach 100 wins.
- In Florida's remarkable 21-point comeback win vs. Alabama, Kerry Blackshear Jr. (24p/16r), Scottie Lewis (15p/10r) and Keyontae Johnson (10p/12r) became the first trio of Gators to post double-doubles in the same game since Corey Brewer, Joakim Noah and Al Horford did so on Dec. 18, 2005, vs. Jacksonville.
- Florida earned a dominant 83-51 win vs. Providence in Brooklyn, led by Keyontae Johnson's double-double with 19 points and 10 rebounds.
- The Gators' first ranked win of the season came vs. #18 Xavier in the Charleston Classic championship game. Keyontae Johnson scored 15 vs. the Musketeers and earned Charleston Classic MVP and SEC Player of the Week honors, averaging 16.3 points and 8.0 rebounds at the event.

The Gators finished 1st in the SEC in field goal percentage (.470) and 3-point field goal percentage (.376) in conference play. Noah Locke also led the SEC in 3-point field goal percentage (.481), hitting at the highest clip with 50+ makes since John Jenkins (Vanderbilt) in 2011-12.

No SEC team played more than UF's 14 Quad 1 games, and KenPom rated Florida's schedule the toughest in the SEC for the 4th time in 5 seasons under Mike White. Florida played the #23 strongest non-conference schedule in the nation, per KenPom, the only SEC team to play a top-50 non-conference slate and 1 of 3 in the top 100 (Alabama 59, Tennessee 79).

The Gators, who had the 7th-youngest team out of all 353 Division I teams, projected to be the youngest team competing in the 2020 NCAA Tournament (based on Joe Lunardi's final field).

GATORS FACED A GAUNTLET

- The Gators' 14 Quad 1 games tied for the most in the SEC (UF 5-9; UT 3-11). Florida 5 Quad 1 wins trailed only Kentucky (9) and Auburn (7).
- Florida had 12 games against 2019 NCAA Tournament opponents, including 3 non-conference contests (Florida State, Utah State, Baylor). UF's schedule rated among KenPom's top 20 toughest in each of Mike White's first 4 seasons with the Gators.
- This marked the 4th season in 5 under Mike White that the Gators have played the SEC's hardest non-conference schedule. UF's slate ranked in the top 25, while no other SEC team played a top-50 schedule, just 2 played a top-100 non-conference slate (Alabama, Tennessee), and 4 played a sub-200 schedule (Kentucky, Texas A&M, Ole Miss, Vanderbilt).

NOTABLES

KEEP FIGHTING

- The Gators, who had not posted a 20-point comeback since a record-setting 22-point rally at South Carolina in 1993, did so twice this season. Florida rallied from 21 down to beat Alabama in 2OT in the SEC opener, then matched the UF all-time record with a 22-point comeback vs. Georgia on Feb. 5.
- In both games, Andrew Nembhard was the driving force, scoring a career-best 25 in each contest. Against Alabama, 15 of his 25 came after the 5:00 mark in the 2nd half, and vs. Georgia he had 19 in the 2nd half, including 14 points over the final 7 minutes.
- The Alabama game also saw 3 Gators post a double-double for the 1st time since 2005. Blackshear posted 24 point & 16 rebounds, a number unmatched by a Gator in SEC action over the past 20 years. Scottie Lewis had 15 points and 10 rebounds for his 1st double-double. Keyontae Johnson added 10 point and 12 rebounds despite have 0 points and 1 rebound at halftime.
- Florida added a 13-point road rally in its game at Georgia. The Gators fell behind 19-6 at the first media timeout as Georgia shot 7-for-7 out of the gate, including 4-for-4 from 3-point range. After that point, Florida outscored the Bulldogs, 62-35, including a 23-8 run over the final 7:30.

KEY TO THE GAME

- Keyontae Johnson put together 8 double-doubles this season, including 6 in SEC action.
- During the month of February, Johnson averaged 16.2 points and 8.4 rebounds per game while shooting .560 from the floor and .795 from the free throw line.
- Johnson had a career-high 25 points, along with 11 rebounds and 5 assists in the home win vs. LSU, just the 3rd Gator since 1996 to post a 25/10/5 stat line, joining Nick Calathes (28p/10r/7a, 1/17/09 vs. Arkansas) and Matt Walsh (33p/11r/5a, 12/21/02 vs. Miami).
- In Florida's win vs. Arkansas, Johnson posted 24 points, 10 rebounds and drew 10 fouls that helped pave the way for a 15-for-17 day at the free throw line.

BLACKSHEAR GOES BIG

- Kerry Blackshear also had 8 double-doubles on the year, including 3 straight double-doubles to open the season and 5 in the first 7 games of the year.
- Blackshear turned in a 24-point, 16-rebound performance in Florida's rally from 21 points down to beat Alabama in double overtime. Blackshear and Daniel Gafford are the only 2 SEC players over the past decade to post 24 & 16 in a conference win.

- Sophomore point guard Andrew Nembhard had 4 games with 20+ points in SEC play.
- Nembhard exploded offensively in the SEC opener vs. Alabama, scoring 25 in the comeback 2OT win, with 15 points coming after the 5:00 mark in the 2nd half. He repeated that performance with 25 in the rally vs. Georgia, including 14 over the final 7 minutes.

- He also posted a pair of double-doubles at South Carolina and LSU, the first Gator with multiple points/assists double-doubles in a season since Nick Calathes.

- Noah Locke hit a season-high 6 3-pointers in the home win vs. Vanderbilt and went on a 24-game streak with a made 3-pointer, which tied for the 7th-longest in Florida history.

- Florida started 3 different freshmen this season: Scottie Lewis, Tre Mann and Omar Payne. The Gators have started 3 different freshmen in 4 of 5 seasons under Mike White.
- Lewis and Mann started together in the Gators' win vs. Towson. The Gators have started multiple freshmen in a game at least once in each of the past 3 seasons.

- With an NCAA Tournament bid in 2019 and another tournament victory, the Gators are one of 10 teams to win an NCAA game each of the past three seasons. White's five NCAA Tournament wins also ranks second in Florida history, surpassing Lon Kruger's four and trails only Billy Donovan's 35.
- In 2016-17, White was named SEC Coach of the Year, his third conference coach of the year honor, and was a semifinalist for the Naismith Men's College Coach of the Year.
- His 43 SEC wins through his first four seasons at UF rank second among active SEC coaches at the same period in their tenures.
- White earned his 100th win at Florida on Jan. 14, 2020, defeating his alma mater Ole Miss, 71-55. He's the 5th Florida coach to reach the milestone and did so in the 2nd-fewest games in program history.

MEDIA COVERAGE

CREDENTIALS: Requests for credentials will be taken online and reviewed by Denver Parler. To access the credential request form, please visit www.sportssystems.com/florida. Once you have submitted your credential request, you will receive an automated email from the Communications Department acknowledging your request was received and is being reviewed. Once a decision on your request is made, you will receive an email with further information. Requests must be made by the day prior to a game (noon for afternoon games or 4:30 p.m. for evening games).

CREDENTIAL PICK-UP: Credentials will be mailed up until 10 days prior to the event or held at the Press Will Call window at Gate One of the O'Connell Center, which opens for pick-up 90 minutes prior to each game. Credentials can be overnighted at the expense of the media organization within 10 days of the event (by request).

PARKING: A limited number of parking spaces exist and can be requested online with your credential application. Please note that if you request to pick up your credentials at Press Will Call, we will be unable to provide a parking pass as you will have to park before visiting Press Will Call. Free parking is available in the deck next to the O'Connell Center and is generally still available 75-90 minutes before the game.

MEDIA ROOM/INTERVIEW AREA: Located between Gates 1 & 4 in the Orange & Blue room near the loading dock, the media room includes work space, necessary electrical outlets, a television and wireless internet. A pre-game meal, snacks and soft drinks are also available in the media room. The pre-game meal begins 1:15 before tip. Post-game coach and player press conferences are also conducted in this area.

FLORIDA LOCKER ROOM: The Gator locker room is closed to the media with the exception of the SEC and NCAA Tournaments. Coach White and selected players will be available to the media following games in the media room/interview area. At Florida home games, players are available first while Coach White will follow with a post-game press conference in the Orange & Blue Room. If the visiting team chooses to utilize the media room, they will do so either directly before or after Florida players. Coach White will typically go last.

VISITOR LOCKER ROOM: Interview policies and procedures will be determined by visiting Sports Information Directors and coaches. Those procedures will be announced on game days.

GENERAL GAME DAY MEDIA SERVICES: Game program/scorecard, game notes, play-by-play, complete halftime and final statistics, coaches' & player quote sheets and post-game notes are all regular services on game days.

- Earned his first career double-double with 21 points and 10 assists in the win at South Carolina, then added another with 15 points and 10 dimes at LSU. He joins Tremont Waters (LSU) and Tyler Ulis (Kentucky) as the only players over the past 5 seasons to have multiple points/assists double-doubles in SEC play.
- Has been the driving force behind 2 of the largest comebacks in Florida history, scoring 25 points each in a 21-point rally vs. Alabama and a 22-point comeback vs. Georgia. The UGA rally matched the largest on record in UF history.
- Against Alabama, Nembhard scored 15 of his 25 points in the final 5 minutes of regulation and the overtime periods. In the Georgia game, 14 of his 25 came in the final 7 minutes of the game.
- Posted 13 assists vs. Long Beach State, the most by a Gator since Nick Calathes and only the 4th Gator to hit that mark in a game since 1996.
