Mike White moved into #3 on Florida's all-time wins list, trailing only Billy Donovan and Norm Sloan. White's six NCAA Tournament wins rank second in Gators history.

+10.7

Tre Mann increased his scoring average by 10.7 points per game vs. his freshman campaign, up to 16.0. It surpassed Joakim Noah's 10.6-point scoring leap in his sophomore year (2005-06) for the largest by a Gator over the past 25 seasons.

2nd

Florida ranks second in the SEC over the past six seasons in conference wins, top-25 wins, NCAA Tournament wins and road SEC wins. The Gators' four true road wins over top-25 teams, including this season's win at 11th-ranked West Virginia is tied for most by an SEC team.

2020-21 AT A GLANCE

- Florida found itself in elite company among teams with at least one win in every NCAA Tournament since 2017, joining only Florida State, Gonzaga, Kansas, Michigan and Villanova. Of the 11 teams trying to keep that streak going this year, two did not make the field (Duke, Kentucky) and three lost their first game (Michigan State, North Carolina, Purdue).
- A duo of All-SEC performers led the Gators, with Tre Mann (coaches first team, AP second team) and Colin Castleton (coaches second team) taking home honors this season. Mann increased his scoring average +10.7 points per game this season vs. his freshman campaign, matching Joakim Noah for the largest single-season jump by a Gator over the past 25 years (2005-06).
- Mann was on fire down the stretch, averaging 20.9 points over his last seven games, including a career-best 30 vs. Tennessee in the SEC Tournament. His four-game streak of 20+ points matched the longest by a Gator over the past 25 years (Matt Walsh, Nick Calathes).
- Mann's 19 points and 13 rebounds at Auburn marked his first career double-double. He followed that with 21 points and eight rebounds at UK, scoring 11 of Florida's last 20 points to help secure the victory. Those performances garnered SEC Player of Week honors for Mann, who became the only Gator over the past 50 years to lead the team in points and rebounds in back-to-back wins with both games on the road.
- Castleton's 2.22 blocked shots per game marked a top-five performance in Florida history and trails only Dwayne Schintzius, who holds the top three single-season marks, and Joakim Noah. He had a six game stretch with 28 blocked shots (4.7 average), including an eight-block performance against Ole Miss that was the most by a Gator since Dwayne Davis' record-setting nine blocks vs. New Orleans (12/27/89).
- Castleton became the sixth player over the past 25 years to post in an NCAA Tournament game at least 19 points, 14 rebounds, three blocked shots and two assists, joining Zion Williamson, JaJuan Johnson, Kevin Love, Nick Collison (three times) and Tim Duncan.
- The Gators lead the SEC in free throw percentage (.753, 44th NCAA), field goal percentage (.471, 41st NCAA) and 3-point field goal percentage (.356, 87th NCAA). Florida was the last team to lead the SEC in all three shooting percentage categories at the end of the season (2005-06).
- UF earned the SEC's best win of the SEC/Big 12 Challenge, knocking off 11th-ranked West Virginia, 85-80, in Morgantown behind 21 points and five blocked shots from Colin Castleton and Noah Locke's 19 points.
- Florida's 75-49 rout of #6 Tennessee was UF's fifth top-10 win under White, the third by 20+ points, and came despite the absence of Scottie Lewis and Castleton.
- In Florida's comeback win vs. Ole Miss, the Gators held Ole Miss without a field goal for the final 6:28 as part of a 20-2 finish. Castleton finished with 21 points, 10 rebounds and eight blocked shots, the first SEC player to achieve a 20/10/8 stat line in conference action since Ole Miss' Ansu Sesay vs. Mississippi St. in 1997.
- Castleton had a breakout week in the start of SEC play and earned co-SEC Player of the Week honors, scoring 23 against Vanderbilt and 21 vs. LSU. Castleton's offense was efficient in Nashville, going 11-for-13 from the field with five dunks. Against LSU, he scored the Gators' first 15 points of the second half over a six-minute span and totaled 19 of his 21 points after the break.

STYLE POINTS

- Under Mike White, the Gators have 16 wins of 20+ points vs. power conference opponents, with nine coming in neutral or road games.
- The Gators have multiple 20-point wins against ACC, Big 12, Big Ten and Pac-12 foes, claiming six of those eight victories outside of Gainesville. Eight 20-point wins have been vs. SEC competition, and three of those were against AP top-10 teams.

MANN ON A MISSION

- Tre Mann's week at Auburn and Kentucky was a rare one, as he became the only Gator dating back to 1970 to lead the team outright in points and rebounds in back-to-back wins with both games on the road. The performances earned Mann SEC Player of the Week honors.
- Mann's 19-point, 13-rebound effort in the win vs. Auburn marked just the second such performance by a Florida guard since 1996 (Donovan/White years), joining Nick Calathes, who posted 20 points and 13 rebounds vs. Georgia on Jan. 28, 2009.
- Mann's scoring average this season is higher than his season high of 13 points during his freshman season. Tre Mann had five double-figure scoring games his entire freshman season, a mark he matched in the sixth game of the 2020-21 season.
- Mann is among a select group of Gators who have boosted their scoring average by seven or more points from one season to the next over the past 26 seasons.

CASTLETON A STOPPER AT THE RIM

- Colin Castleton put up a monster performance in the Gators' comeback win vs. Ole Miss, totaling 21 points, 10 rebounds and eight blocks. He's the first SEC player to post a 20/10/8 stat line in conference action since Ole Miss' Ansu Sesay did so vs. Mississippi State in 1997, and he's one of just two major conference players to do so in a league game over the past decade.
- Castleton is the seventh major conference player over the past 20 seasons to go for 20/10/8. He is the only one, however, to do so while also dishing three assists. The last player with 20 points, 10 rebounds, eight blocks and three assists in a major conference league game was Tim Duncan, who had 22, 10, nine and six vs. Florida State on Jan. 25, 1997.

- Castleton is also the first Gator in the Donovan/White era (1996-present) to score 20+ points in three of his first five SEC games in a Florida uniform. He is the fifth to do it over the first five games in any season, joining Erving Walker (2009-10, sophomore), Taurean Green (2005-06, sophomore), Anthony Roberson (2004-05, junior) and Brett Nelson (2001-02, junior).
- The Deland, Fla., native became the SEC's first player to block six or more shots in consecutive games since LSU's Jordan Mickey in Jan. 2015. Castleton, Mickey, Nerlens Noel and Anthony Davis are the only SEC players over the past decade to do so vs. SEC opponents.

- Tre Mann had 19 points and five steals in the season opener vs. Army, and Scottie Lewis had 16 points and five steals in the Feb. 23 win at Auburn. Mann and Lewis become the first UF teammates since Nick Calathes and Walter Hodge to post 15-point, five-steal games in the same season.

MEDIA COVERAGE

CREDENTIALS: Requests for credentials will be taken online and reviewed by Florida communications. All requests for the 2020-21 season will be on a game-by-game basis, and a health screening questionnaire must be completed as part of the process.

To access the credential request form, please visit www.sportssystem.com/floridahoops. Once you have submitted your credential request, you will receive an automated email from the Communications Department acknowledging your request was received and is being reviewed. Once a decision is made on your request, you will receive an email with further information.

CREDENTIAL PICK-UP: All media admittance will be via a will-call list at the loading dock entrance below Gate 3 for the 2020-21 season.

INTERNET CREDENTIALS: Only official websites of each participating institution, along with networks holding contractual broadcast rights to a game and websites affiliated with a national publication or news outlet, will be issued credentials.

PLAYER/STAFF INTERVIEWS: All interview requests for players or coaching staff should be coordinated through Denver Parler at least 24 hours in advance. Interviews will be arranged before or after practice according to class and meeting schedules during the preseason and once the season begins, players will typically be available at least once a week plus game days. Please contact Parler for player availability during the season.

The Communications Office will not give out home or cell phone numbers for any players, and players may not be contacted directly by phone, text, email or social media. Members of the media are not permitted in team areas. Team locker room, training room and strength complex are considered private work areas. These areas, as well as players' housing (on-campus and off-campus), are off-limits to media representatives.

PRESS CONFERENCES: All media opportunities and press conferences will take place via Zoom until further notice.

- The first player with at least 22 points, seven rebounds and six assists in an SEC Tournament game since Texas A&M's Alex Caruso in 2014, turning in that stat line vs. Vanderbilt.

- Earned SEC Player of the Week after wins at Auburn and Kentucky, as he became the only Gator dating back to 1970 to lead the team outright in points and rebounds in back-to-back wins with both games on the road.
- Had a monster performance in the win at Auburn with 19 points and 13 rebounds, his first career double-double. He's one of three Gators over the past 10 seasons to put up a 19/13 game, along with Kerry Blackshear and Dorian Finney-Smith, who each did so twice. He and Nick Calathes are the only Florida guards with a 19/13 game dating back to 1996 (Donovan/White years).
- Posted 21 points in the win at Kentucky, including 14 in the second half. Mann scored 11 of the Gators' final 20 points and hit the game-sealing free throws with 10 seconds remaining.
- Went for a career-high 24 points at Georgia, helping the Gators to a 92-84, the most points by Florida at Georgia in regulation since 1994.
- Scored 17 points in the win vs. Ole Miss, including 12 in the second half, and hit all eight of his free throws in the game.
- Opened the season with a then-career-best 19-point, five-steal outing vs. Army. He became the first Gator with at least 19 points and five steals in a game since Michael Frazier (2/3/15 at Vanderbilt).
- Grew another inch to 6-foot-5 and added 18 pounds of muscle over the offseason.

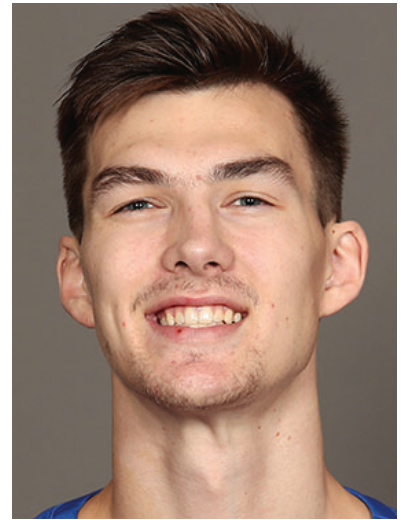

- Two-time SEC Player of the Week, the seventh Gator in program history to earn the honor multiple times in a season and just the second frontcourt player to do so, along with Joakim Noah.
- Led Florida to a win at #11 West Virginia with 21 points, seven rebounds and five blocked shots, shooting 9-for-9 from the free throw line. Scored 15 in the second half while helping limit Derek Culver to seven points on 1-for-5 shooting after the break.
- Had a breakout performance in the win at Vanderbilt with 23 points on 11-for-13 shooting, including five dunks. It marked the best field goal percentage performance on the road in SEC league play (10+ makes) in five seasons (Damian Jones, Vanderbilt, .923, 2/23/16 at Florida). His 17

second-half points alone topped his previous career best of 14, set at Michigan (vs. Houston Baptist).

- Followed that up with a 21-point game vs. LSU, including 19 in the second half. Castleton scored the Gators' first 15 points after halftime over a six-minute span.
- Posted 21 points, 10 rebounds and eight blocked shots in the win vs. Ole Miss, including 14 second-half points. He is one of two major conference players (Mo Bamba) to post a 20/10/8 stat line in league action over the past decade.
- Followed up his eight-block outing vs. Ole Miss with six swats at Mississippi State, becoming the first SEC player with six-plus blocks in back-to-back games since LSU's Jordan Mickey on Jan. 14 and 17, 2015.
- Fought off double-teams all game to post 14 points and a career-best four assists in the win at Kentucky.
- He is the only Gator during the Donovan/White era (1996-present) to post 20+ points in three of his first five career SEC games. He is the fifth player to do so over the first five SEC games of any season throughout their career, joining Erving Walker, Taurean Green, Anthony Roberson and Brett Nelson.
