2...Nick Calathes is one of just two men in UF history to record a double-double, joining former Gator great Corey Brewer, after the freshman posted a triple-double in the second round of the NIT against Creighton

11...Florida reached the postseason for the 11th straight year - nine NCAA Tournaments and two NIT Tournaments in that stretch

20...UF won 20 games for the 10th straight year, the fifth longest streak in the nation and the longest streak in the Southeastern Conference

24... Florida posted 24 wins, tied for the sixth-best total in school history

221... Nick Calathes set a UF record with 221 assists, averaging a UF-record 6.1 assists per game, a total that also led the SEC

236...UF has won an SEC-best 236 games this decade, a total that ranks third in the nation

- ✓ The University of Florida finished the season with a 24-12 mark, 8-8 in SEC play and advanced to the Final Four of the MasterCard Postseason NIT for just the third time in school history
- ✓ Florida's 24 wins tied the sixth-highest total in school history, as the Gators recorded 20+ wins for the 10th year in a row, the fifth longest active streak in the nation and the longest in the SEC
- ✓ The Gators reached postseason play for the 11th consecutive year - nine NCAA Tournaments and two NITs - the second longest streak in the SEC
- ✓ UF's 236 wins this decade are the most of any SEC school, and tied for the third highest total in the nation
- ✓ Florida led the SEC in field goal percentage for the third consecutive year, connecting on 48.8 percent of its shots from the floor...Florida hit better than 50 percent in 18 of 24 wins on the year and was 18-2 when hitting over 50 percent from the floor
- ✓ Despite its young backcourt, and the loss of three NBA draft picks up front, the Gators led the SEC in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.39) and in rebounding defense (31.8 per game)
- ✓ The Gators went 15-1 when hitting 40.0 percent or better from three-point range
- ✓ The Gators used the same starting lineup in 35 of 36 games
- ✓ Nick Calathes was the SEC Newcomer of the Year, the co-SEC Freshman of the Year and a Second Team All-SEC selection
- ✓ Calathes broke the UF record for assists (221) and assists per game (an SEC-leading 6.1) and the UF freshman records for points (552), free throws made (144) and free throws attempted (199)
- ✓ Marreese Speights led UF with 8.1 rebounds, 49 blocked shots and 10 double-doubles (including five in the final 10 games of the year)...Speights led UF in rebounding 21 times and scored in double-figures 31 times
- ✓ Jai Lucas and Chandler Parsons earned SEC All-Freshman honors

Gators reach nit semifinals

The University of Florida finished the season 24-12, participating in the NIT for the first time in 10 years and the eighth time overall...Florida reached the semifinals for the third time, as they reached the semis in both 1986 and 1992 prior to this year.

UF posts sixth-highest win total in school history

UF finished the 2007-08 season with 24 wins, matching the 2000-01 and 2004-05 squads for the sixth-highest total in UF history...UF reached 20 wins for the 10th straight year:

Florida is one of only five schools to have reached 20 wins every year since the 1998-99 season.

Almost entire starting five averaged in double-figures in SEC play

Led by 16.9 points and 6.4 assists per game from Nick Calathes, four of five Gator starters averaged in double-figures scoring in SEC play...Marreese Speights averaged 14.2 points, Walter Hodge 11.2, Dan Werner 11.1 and Jai Lucas was a shade under double figures at 8.8 per game.

Nick Calathes breaks UF assist mark

With 221 assists, Nick Calathes broke Ronnie Montgomery's 20-year-old UF single-season mark of 190 assists...He entered the SEC Tournament two shy of the record and dished out four assists on the night...He led the SEC in assists per game, averaging 6.1, surpassing the 5.9 per game of Vernon Delancey in 1982-83...Against Creighton he became the first UF man to reach 200 assists in one season.

Last time out

April 1, UMass 78, Florida 66, NIT Semifinals, New York, N.Y.

Despite 16 points and a career-high 18 rebounds from Marreese Speights, UF couldn't overcome a second-half showing from UMass, that saw the Minutemen outscore the Gators, 51-30, en route to a 78-66 win...Florida jumped out to a 36-27 halftime lead and led by the same margin with 15:53 remaining, before UMass went on a 14-3 run and took control of the game for good...Dan Werner had his third double-double of the season with points and 10 rebounds, while Nick Calathes had 12 points, but struggled from the floor, hitting just 5-of-19 shots...UF dominated the glass, out-rebounding UMass, 50-41, including 20 offensive boards...Florida finished the year with 24 wins, the sixth-best total in school history.

Calathes records first triple double

He had been close on many occasions, but Nick Calathes finally recorded his first triple-double in the Gators' win over Creighton on March 21, scoring 11 points, grabbing 13 rebounds and dishing out 11 assists...He joins former Gator great Corey Brewer as the only Gators to ever do so.

three-point line crucial to gators' success

UF went 12-of-25 from the three-point line, hitting 48.0 percent in its win at Arizona State...The Gators went 15-1 when hitting 40.0 percent or better., including 43.8 percent against San Diego State and 40.0 percent against Creighton, as the Gators shot the three-ball well during the NIT (prior to going 2-of-12 against UMass)...Florida averaged 8.5 three-pointers per game in its 24 wins and just 5.7 while hitting 25.9 percent in its 12 losses.

calathes rewriting uf freshman record book

Nick Calathes broke the UF freshman records for assists (221), points (552) free throws made (144) and free throws attempted (199) and came up just two steals shy (58) of breaking Brett

Nelson's UF freshman record of 60.

calathes tops elite company in billy donovan tenure

Nick Calathes averaged 15.3 points per game...His total was the highest ever by a UF freshman under Billy Donovan, as only six previous freshmen have averaged in double-figures in Donovan's first 12 years in Gainesville.

gators holding opponents under season scoring average

Only 10 teams out of 36 hit their season average in points per game against the Gators...UF has held seven teams under 55 points, including limiting San Diego State to just 49 points and Creighton to 54 in the first two NIT games.

balance in scoring continues

Over the last two years, few teams if any, were as balanced as the Florida Gators...That trend continued with its newest generation of players...In Billy Donovan's ideal world, he would aim for a wealth of scoring options and a high number of players averaging from 10-15 points per game - he had his starting five averaging between 8.5-15.3 points per game this season.

simplifying the game

Florida dished out 20 assists on 12 occasions, including games of 29, 27 and 26...The Gators hit 48.8 percent from the floor, but have had 17+ assists on 18 occasions and their field goal percentage jumped significantly in nearly all of those games.

Team Notes

- UF went 27-1 when holding opponents under 70 points for the second straight year in 2006-07 and is 72-6 over the last three seasons when holding opponents under 70 points (18-4 this year).
- Florida led at the half in 24 of 36 games, however, did manage to rally from a nine-point halftime deficit against Georgia Southern on Dec. 15...They trailed by 11 points just before half, the biggest rally since coming back from 18 points down against Alabama on Feb. 14, 2007...The Gators rallied from seven points down at the half against Alabama in their SEC opener this year and rallied from as many as 10 down on the night...They rallied from nine points down in the second half at South

Carolina on Jan. 23.

- UF dished out 17.5 assists per game, reaching 20 assists 12 times (including 29 against NC Central, 27 against Florida A&M and 26 against Vanderbilt) and posting 15 or more in 23 of the final 27 games...Florida dished out 22.5 assists per game in its two exhibition wins, getting assists on nearly 60-percent of its baskets (58.4)...The Gators continued the trend in the regular season with assists on 61.1 percent of their baskets, including 23 of 26 against Arizona State and 22 of 28 against Tennessee (March 5).

- The Gators opened this season with five straight home wins before losing to Florida State... The Gators had won a school record 24 straight at home dating back to 2005-06 prior to that loss...After going 17-4 at home this year, the Gators are 51-6 at the O'Dome over the last three years.

Team Offensive Notes

- Florida hit 48.8 percent from the field on the year...The Gators hit 50.0 percent or better in 18 of 24 wins this season.
- UF is 183-25 during the last nine seasons when it gets 15-plus assists in a game (75-54 when it gets less than 15 assists)...The Gators dished out 29 assists against North Carolina Central, the third highest total ever by a Billy Donovan-coached team and the highest total since posting 31 against Montana State on Nov. 25, 2003.
- UF has 31 100-point games under Donovan in 400 games or one every 12.6 games...Donovan has 41 century scoring games in his 455 career games or one every 10.9 games.
- UF has made a three pointer in a school-record 543 consecutive games (dating back to Jan. 11, 1992 vs. Kentucky).

Team Defensive Notes

- Florida came up with nine steals from six different players against North Dakota State, led by Nick Calathes, Dan Werner and Walter Hodge who had two apiece...The Gators followed each of the next two games with nine steals before coming up with 10 against UNF...Hodge had four more against the Ospreys...The Gators had eight against Jacksonville, six of which came from Calathes...UF had 12 against Charleston Southern with Hodge getting five and Calathes three...Florida came up with eight critical steals in the win over South Carolina, led by four from Werner...Against Georgia, the Gators posted 11, led by a career-high seven from Werner...Florida rediscovered its defense against San Diego State, grabbing nine steals, including three from Hodge, then followed that with a season-high 13 against Creighton, led by five from Calathes ...Calathes led the team with 58 steals, while Hodge had 50 and Werner 41...Calathes came up just two shy of breaking the UF freshman record of 60 by Brett Nelson in 1999-2000.
- The Gators forced 21 turnovers against Tennessee Tech, North Carolina Central and Creighton and 23 against Charleston Southern and came up with 13.5 turnovers per game.
- The Gators held their opponents to just 58.0 points per game in their two exhibition wins, a number that went down to 26.5 points per game in the second half as they wore their oppo-

nents down...They held teams to 67.6 points per game during the regular season (number that reduced 62.1 if you subtract three games against Ole Miss, Arkansas, Tennessee (twice), LSU, South Carolina and UMass) and held seven opponents under 55 points.

- Florida is 201-32 when forcing more turnovers than its opponents under Donovan.

- During the last six years, UF is 201-26 under Billy Donovan when holding opponents to 70 points or less, including 27-1 each of the past two seasons...Florida has held 22 of 35 opponents thus far under 70 points, and is 18-4 this year when holding opponents under 70.

Walter Hodge Notes

- Walter Hodge was a key factor in the Gators' win over North Dakota State, scoring 15 points, including six of the Gators' final eight as the Bison stormed back, while coming up with two steals and three assists (with no turnovers).

- Hodge poured in 14 points and knocked down 4-of-5 threes against Rutgers...He hit a pair of threes during a 17-2 Florida run to close out the first half that turned a 31-31 game into a 48-33 halftime lead...He matched that total against UNF, hitting three more treys and coming up with four steals.

- Hodge matched his then-career high with six assists against Vermont.

- The junior guard was at his best against Charleston Southern, scoring a then-season-high 16 points, dishing out six assists (no turnovers) and posting five steals...Hodge had 12 points and three assists against Temple...Against High Point he dished out a career-high seven assists...In the Gators' SEC opener he had a then-season-high 17 points on 6-of-7 shooting, including 3-of-3 from three-point range...He had four assists and three steals against Auburn...He had 13 points against Auburn and hit a pair of threes...He came up huge against Kentucky, scoring 10 points, but hitting a pair of critical threes, one towards the end of regulation and one in overtime...Hodge had a career-high 19 points against Vanderbilt to go along with three steals...He had a team-high 13 points against Arkansas...Hodge had 14 points and five assists against Georgia...In the Gators' win over South Carolina, he set the tone with 11 first half points, en route to 14 on the night, hitting four three-pointers...He came out on fire against Tennessee on March 5, scoring 15 first half points and 16 overall on the night, hitting 6-of-9 shots and 3-of-4 three-pointers...Hodge had three steals in the Gators' NIT win over San Diego State, then led UF with 15 points in their win over Creighton, also dishing out three assists and no turnovers...Hodge was spectacular in the win at Arizona State, scoring 18 points on 6-of-10 shooting, and dishing out seven assists to just one turnover.

- He hit 48.0 percent from the floor and was second on the team in steals with 50, while his 103 assists were also second on the team.

Dan Werner Notes

- Dan Werner opened the 2007-08 season with a strong showing against North Dakota State, defending well and posting a then-career-high seven rebounds, three on the offensive end... He matched the seven rebounds and came up with two more steals against Tennessee Tech.

- Werner came up huge against Rutgers, posting his first career double-double with 10 points and a then-career-high 10 rebounds...He came close to those numbers again with nine points and eight rebounds against Stetson.

- Werner put the Gators' on his back against Georgia Southern and came up with career highs of 20 points and 14 rebounds while blocking two shots...Seven of his 14 rebounds were on the offensive end, while he also hit UF's only two three-pointers on the night.

- Werner came up with 11 points and five rebounds off the bench against Auburn after suffering a mid-foot sprain (right)...He just missed another double-double at Ole Miss with 16 points and nine rebounds...Five of his rebounds were offensive...He had four steals at South Carolina and hit a three-pointer with 2:54 remaining the gave the Gators a four-point lead...Werner posted big numbers against Vanderbilt, scoring 14 points and grabbing nine rebounds, but also had six assists (no turnovers), a block and a steal in the Gators' 22-point win...He had 18 points and seven rebounds against Tennessee, hitting 6-of-11 shots from the floor...Werner had great showing against Georgia, with 10 points, six rebounds and a career-high seven steals...The seven steals tied an O'Connell Center record and were one shy of matching the school record...He followed that with 13 points and nine rebounds against LSU...Werner had 15 points and three assists against South Carolina, hitting a trio of three-pointers...He had 13 points and eight rebounds in the rematch with Georgia and hit three more three-pointers in victory...Werner was a major factor in the Gators having a chance to upset No. 4 Tennessee, scoring 16 points, including 4-of-6 shooting from three-point range...He also had five assists...Werner had a solid night against San Diego State, scoring nine points, grabbing five boards, picking up two steals and blocking two shots...Werner had 10 points and six boards at Arizona State...He had his third double-double of the year against UMass with 11 points and 10 rebounds.

- Werner averaged 11.1 points and 5.9 rebounds in league play.

- Werner finished third on the team in steals with 41, second in rebounding at 6.4 per game and had seven or more rebounds in 20 of the Gators' 36 games this season...A gifted passer, he also had 89 assists on the year, third on the team.

Marreese Speights Notes

- Marreese Speights flirted with a double-double against North Dakota State in the season opener, scoring 10 points and added eight rebounds, including three offensive...Speights followed that with a game-high 16 points and two blocks against Tennessee Tech.

- Speights was dominant, however, in the Gators' win over North

Carolina Central, scoring 19 points, grabbing nine rebounds and blocking two shots...He was 9-of-10 from the floor...He followed that with his first double-double of the year with 18 points and 12 boards on 9-of-15 shooting against Rutgers.

- Speights was once again overpowering against UNF, scoring 20 points on 7-of-10 shooting, while grabbing 12 more rebounds (six offensive)...He had 15 points, six rebounds and a career-high four blocked shots against Stetson and then had a solid homecoming in the Gators' win over Vermont in Tampa, scoring 15 points, pulling down seven rebounds and blocking two more shots...He put up solid numbers again against Jacksonville, with 16 points, seven rebounds and three blocked shots and then came up with his third double-double of the year against FAMU with 10 points and 10 rebounds...He had 14 points on 6-of-7 shooting against Charleston Southern and 12 points and seven rebounds against Ohio State.

- Speights earned MVP honors at the Orange Bowl Classic, scoring 20 points, while hitting 7-of-10 shots from the floor, but just as significantly, taking two charges...He followed that with a career night against High Point, scoring 24 points, and grabbing 15 rebounds...Speights came up with 14 points and eight rebounds against Auburn...He took his game to another level against Kentucky, scoring 20 points (8-of-12 from the floor), grabbing eight rebounds and blocking four shots...He followed that with a 22-point, 13-rebound showing at South Carolina, hitting 10-of-13 shots from the floor...Against Vanderbilt, he had 12 points, eight rebounds and two blocks...He had 12 against Arkansas as well...Speights was tremendous against Tennessee, totalling 23 points, nine rebounds and three blocked shots...He hit 8-of-12 shots from the floor and was 7-of-8 from the line in a career-high 33 minutes...He had 11 points and eight rebounds against LSU and followed with an 11-point game at Vanderbilt. ...Speights had his sixth double-double of the season and the eighth of his career against South Carolina, with 10 points and 10 rebounds...He added his ninth career double-double a game later against Georgia with 15 points and 10 boards...He had his third straight and 10th of his career against Mississippi State with 20 points and 10 rebounds.

- Speights a perfect 8-of-8 from the floor with 21 points and seven assists against Tennessee on March 5 and followed that with 20 points and eight boards at Kentucky...He had 18 points and six rebounds in the NIT opener against San Diego State... He had his ninth double-double of the season at Arizona State with 14 points and 10 rebounds...He had 16 points and a career-high 18 boards against UMass in the NIT semifinals and finished the year with 10 double-doubles.

- He averaged 14.5 points, 8.1 rebounds and hit 62.4 percent from the floor on the year. and did so in only 24.3 minutes per game...Speights led the team with 49 blocked shots, 26 of which came in SEC play.

- Speights was a member of the Naismith Award's 50-man Pre-season Watch List, as well as a Second Team Preseason All-SEC selection by the league coaches.

Jonathan Mitchell I Notes

- Jonathan Mitchell broke out against Stetson, totalling a then-career-high 10 points on 4-of-7 shooting...Mitchell knocked down 2-of-4 three-point attempts and nearly matched his season total of points (11) in his 22 minutes against the Hatters.. He also grabbed four rebounds and blocked two shots...He followed that with a career-high seven rebounds against Vermont.

- Mitchell came up with a then-season-high six points against North Carolina Central, knocking down 3-of-5 shots from the floor in 16 minutes...He followed that with five points and three rebounds against Rutgers...Mitchell looked solid against Ohio State, scoring five points and knocking down both attempts from the floor, one of which was a three-pointer.

- Mitchell lifted the Gators in their win over Temple, scoring a career-high 15 points on 6-of-6 shooting...He continued his solid play with a 12-point showing against High Point, the second-highest offensive output of his career, hitting 5-of-6 shots, with the only miss being a three-point heave as the shot clock expired...He also added four points and four assists...In the three games before the start of league play, Mitchell knocked down 13-of-14 shots...He hit 4-of-5 shots against Ole Miss and had nine points in 18 minutes...Mitchell had five points and four rebounds in 15 minutes against Vanderbilt...He had five points against LSU, knocking down 2-of-3 shots and his only three-point attempt...Mitchell scored eight points and came up with three steals against Creighton in the second round of the NIT, hitting 4-of-7 shots from the floor.

- Adam Allen broke out offensively against Tennessee Tech, scoring 15 points and knocking down 3-of-6 three-pointers... He added nine points against UNF on 3-of-5 shooting from beyond the arc...He was one of UF's bright spots against Florida State, going for eight points, hitting 3-of-6 shots from the floor and knocking down a pair of three-pointers.

- He was on fire against Florida A&M, coming up with a career-high 19 points on 7-of-10 shooting, including 4-of-6 shooting from three-point range...Had one of his better games in league play against LSU, scoring six points and going 2-of-2 from the floor, both three-pointers...Allen came up huge in the Gators' home win against South Carolina, scoring nine points and hitting 3-of-3 from beyond the arc.

- Allen finished 32-of-76 from three-point range on the year (42.1 percent)...He definitely found his stroke at the O'Connell Center and is 29-of-54 (53.7 percent) from three-point range in home games, while just 3-of-22 away from the O'Dome.

- Allen made a successful debut for the Gators against Flagler, coming up with 10 points and knocking down a pair of three-pointers against Flagler...He was perfect from the floor against Lynn, going 5-for-5 and 3-for-3 from three-point range for 13 points.

- Allen averaged 11.5 points, hit 72.7 percent from the floor and 62.5 percent from three-point range in exhibition play.

nick calathes notes

- Nick Calathes delivered big-time against North Dakota State in his UF regular season debut, scoring 21 points, the most by a Gator freshman on opening night in five years...He followed with 15 points and eight assists against Tennessee Tech.

- He nearly had his first regular season double-double against North Carolina Central, scoring 16 points and dishing out eight assists...He came up with 14 points and six assists against UNF.

- Calathes matched his then-career high with 21 points in the Gators' win over Vermont in Tampa...He got to the line 11 times, hitting eight free throws...He followed that with a memorable night against Jacksonville, scoring a career-high 24 points, dishing out nine assists and coming up with a then-career-high six steals...Against FAMU two nights later he came up with 20 points, nine assists and eight rebounds, once again flirting with a triple-double.

- For his back-to-back showings against Jacksonville and FAMU, Calathes was named SEC Freshman of the Week and Dick Vitale's Diaper Dandy of the Week on ESPN.com after averaging 22.0 points, 9.0 assists, 5.5 rebounds and 3.0 steals per game.

- Against Georgia Southern, Calathes came up with 15 points and a career-high 11 rebounds...He was 11-of-11 from the line, including 4-of-4 in the final :35 as he helped UF turn a 49-48 deficit into a 52-49 win...He had 18 points, nine rebounds, five assists and three steals against Charleston Southern, hitting 6-of-12 shots and 3-of-4 three-pointers...He came up with 14 points, dished out eight assists and had seven rebounds against Temple in the Orange Bowl Classic.

- Calathes was spectacular in his first taste of SEC action against Alabama, scoring a team-high 21 points, dishing out nine assists and grabbing seven rebounds...He scored 17 of his 21 points after the break, as the Gators rallied from a seven-point halftime deficit...He knocked down 3-of-5 shots from beyond the arc...He came up with 16 points and five assists vs. Auburn and was named SEC Freshman of the Week afterwards for his performances against Alabama and Auburn...He had 16 points against Ole Miss and dished out five assists.

- Calathes elevated the Gators against Kentucky, scoring 13 of his game-high 24 points in overtime...He dished out eight assists and had eight rebounds and went 10-of-10 from the line in overtime...He guided Florida to a win at South Carolina with 21 points and four assists...A triple-double was again within reach against Vanderbilt, as Calathes scored 15 points, dished out a career-high 10 assists and had seven rebounds...He was tremendous in defeat at Tennessee, scoring 15 points, grabbing nine rebounds and dishing out eight assists...Against LSU he had 16 points, seven rebounds and five assists, while hitting 3-of-6 shots from beyond the arc...Calathes scored 13 of his team-high 17 points after the break in the Gators' home win over South Carolina, while adding seven assists...He had 22 points and seven rebounds in the Gators' second win over Georgia...He followed that with 18 points and seven rebounds against Mississippi State.

- Calathes rose to the occasion against Tennessee on March 5, matching his career-high with 24 points while dishing out nine assists...He had 16 points and six assists at Kentucky...He had 16 points, five rebounds and five assists against San Diego State in the NIT opener...He hit 7-of-11 shots overall and was 2-of-3 from three-point range.

- He recorded just the second triple-double in UF history on March 21 against Creighton, scoring 11 points, grabbing 13 rebounds and dishing out 11 assists...He followed that with 11 points and nine assists (just one turnover) at Arizona State.

- He was selected to the NABC's District 6 First Team, was named SEC co-Freshman of the Year and Second Team All-SEC...He was named SEC Newcomer of the Year by the AP.

For those who have followed Billy Donovan's career it should come as no surprise that he has made Florida basketball a winner.

Under Donovan, Florida has set a school record with 11 straight post-season appearances, including nine NCAA Tournament bids in those 11 years. UF made the school's first-ever appearance in the National Championship game in 2000 before winning back to back National titles in 2006 and 2007. Donovan is already the winningest NCAA Tournament coach in UF history and his 22 NCAA Tournament wins more than triple the total of seven in school history before his arrival. He guided the Gators to three Final Fours and two in a row in 2006 and 2007, a first in Gator history.

After the school had just one Southeastern Conference Championship in 77 seasons prior to his arrival, Donovan has tallied three SEC titles (2000, 2001 and 2007). Florida and Kentucky are the only two SEC schools to capture consecutive league crowns in the past 31 years. He led the Gators to their first SEC Tournament title in 2005 and then again in 2006 and in 2007.

Florida's 236 wins during the past nine years is the best such stretch in school history and the third highest total in the nation in that time. After only being ranked in the national polls 42 times prior to Donovan's arrival, UF had been ranked a school-record 94 consecutive weeks in the Associated Press poll and 99 weeks by the ESPN/USA Today poll before falling out on Feb. 16, 2004. The Gators started the 2005-06 season unranked, before entering at No. 14 in the AP Poll and No. 15 in the coaches' poll on Nov. 20. After starting unranked, the Gators finished the year No. 1, a place they opened and finished the 2006-07. The Gators' once again started the 2007-08 season unranked before joining both polls on Nov. 19, the third edition of both polls (the Gators fell out a week later). They returned to both polls on Jan. 28 (fell out of AP on Feb. 4, Coaches on Feb. 11).

His winning percentage at UF (.713) is the best among all Gator coaches who spent more than one season at UF and he reached the 100 and 200 victory marks at UF quicker than any coach in school history, needing just 154 games to reach the century plateau and 292 games to reach 200 wins. Donovan became the school's all-time leader in wins on Dec. 20, 2006 and stands at 285. He won his 300th career game on Nov. 17, 2007 vs. Rutgers.

Donovan's teams have knocked off 44 ranked opponents during his tenure. UF has won 38 of its last 60 meetings with ranked teams.

Donovan's squads have led the SEC in a statistical category 43 times, including 34 offensive categories. Nineteen of his players have captured All-League honors and 10 of his freshmen have been recognized. Seven of Donovan's players have been first round draft picks in the NBA Draft, after the school boasted only two before his arrival. In the 2007 NBA Draft, Florida became the first school to ever have three players drafted in the Top 10, as Al Horford went third, Corey Brewer seventh and Joakim Noah ninth. He has inked 11 McDonald's All-Americans after UF had just three prior to his arrival. The fans are taking notice, attendance is up over 5,000 since Donovan's arrival.
