DOLPHINS-CHIEFS GAME MOVED TO FRIDAY NIGHT DUE TO APPROACHING HURRICANE

To accommodate the South Florida community in preparing to deal with the approach of Hurricane Wilma, the Miami Dolphins' home game against the Kansas City Chiefs has been rescheduled for this **Friday, October 21 at 7:00 p.m. ET** at Dolphins Stadium, the NFL has announced in conjunction with both teams and local authorities. The game originally was scheduled to be played this Sunday, October 23, at 1:00 p.m. ET.

Moving the game to this Friday night will enable emergency personnel and others in the South Florida community to focus on preparing for the approach of Hurricane Wilma.

CBS will televise the game live to the Miami and Kansas City primary and secondary markets, which are WFOR/Miami, WPEC/West Palm and WINK/Ft. Myers in the Dolphins' area, and KCTV/Kansas City and WIBW/Topeka in the Chiefs' territory.

For customers of Sirius Satellite Radio, the game will be available live on Friday at 7:00 p.m. ET on Channel 121 for the Chiefs' radio broadcast and Channel 131 for the Dolphins' broadcast.

On NFL.com, fans can follow the stat tracker (NFL.com/scores) live, or listen to the local radio broadcast of the game via the Field Pass subscription service (NFL.com/fieldpass). (Field Pass is available on a seven-day free trial basis for first-time subscribers.)

A delayed-telecast of the Dolphins-Chiefs game will be shown nationally on NFL Network on Sunday night, October 23 at a time to be determined.
