UK HOOPS MEETS LOUISVILLE IN 48TH "BATTLE OF THE BLUEGRASS"

No. 12/10 Kentucky looks to continue its winning streak and remain undefeated when it meets No. 10/11 Louisville in the 48th "Battle of the Bluegrass." This is UK's best start to a season since the 2009-10 season when the Cats began 11-0.

The Wildcats' defensive pressure has once again been their bread and butter as they lead the nation in turnover margin (+17.6). The Cats have forced a league-high 250 turnovers for an average of 35.7 forced turnovers per game. Leading the charge is Louisville native A'dia Mathies. Mathies, who already ranks in the top 10 on UK's all-time steals list, averages a Southeastern Conference-high 4.4 steals per game to go along with her team-best 15.4 points per game. She has netted double-figure points in all seven games this season, including a season-high 20 points twice. Freshman Bria Goss has also been a key contributor as she averages 10.9 points and 5.7 rebounds a game. Senior Keyla Snowden and sophomore Kastine Evans add 10.7 ppg, respectively, while sophomore Samantha Drake is the team's leading rebounder with 8.6 rebounds per game.

Louisville travels to Lexington after a 105-62 win over Murray State on Tuesday. The Cardinals are led by senior forward Monique Reid, who is averaging 17.0 points per game. On the glass, sophomore center Cierra Warren and freshman forward Sara Hammond average 6.3 and 5.6 rebounds per game, respectively.

QUICK NOTES

- Kentucky is in its 38th season of varsity women's basketball.
- The Wildcats are one of two teams in the Southeastern Conference still undefeated.
- Sunday is the seventh of nine consecutive home games for the Cats, the most in program history.
- UK is 29-18 all-time vs. Louisville, including a 19-4 advantage when the game is played in Lexington.
- The home team has won in each of the last three years in this rivalry.
- This marks the first time Kentucky and Louisville will meet as two of the nation's top 15 teams.
- Sunday marks the beginning of a tough stretch of games for the Wildcats. In addition to the Louisville game, UK will meet No. 7 Duke on Thursday in Rupp Arena and travel to face No. 3 Notre Dame in Purcel Pavillion at the Joyce Center on Dec. 18.
- UK ranks in the top five of four national statistical categories. The Cats lead the nation in turnover margin (+17.6), rank second in steals per game (18.0), fourth in scoring margin (+36.4) and fifth in offense (87.0).
- Junior A'dia Mathies leads the SEC and ranks ninth nationally in steals per game (4.4).
- The Wildcats have forced double-digit turnovers in 89 consecutive games and at least 30 turnovers six of seven games this season.



- The Cats have won 27 consecutive nonconference games at home, dating back to the 2008-09 season.
- Matthew Mitchell is in his fifth season as the head coach of the Wildcats. He ranks third on UK's all-time wins list with 93.
- The Cats own a 346-140 (71.1) mark in Memorial Coliseum, including a 56-12 (82.3) record under Coach Matthew Mitchell. The Cats are 36-2 at home over the last three seasons.
- The Wildcats have forced double-digit turnovers in 88 consecutive games. The Wildcats are 63-25 during that span, including 30-1 when forcing 25-plus miscues. UK has forced at least 30 turnovers five of six games this season.
- UK has scored over 70 points in all seven games this season, including six with 80 or more. The Cats are 31-1 under Mitchell when scoring 80 or more points.
- UK has won the rebounding battle in all seven games, including five by more than 10.
- Kentucky held Jacksonville State to just 25 points, tying the school record for fewest points in a game by an opponent set by the Lexington Merchants on Dec. 3, 1974, the Cats' first season of varsity women's basketball.
- UK's 75-point win over Jacksonville State was the second-largest margin of victory in school history.
- The Wildcats return 10 letter winners, including four starters from last year's team that finished second in the SEC with a school-record-tying 11 league wins and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament.
- UK has advanced to back-to-back NCAA Tournaments for the first time since the 1981-82 and 1982-83 seasons.
- UK was picked to finish second in the SEC by the league coaches and third behind Tennessee and Georgia by the media.
- Junior guard A'dia Mathies was named to the preseason All-SEC First Team. She was also named a second team All-American by The Sporting News.
- Senior point guard Amber Smith returns for her final season of eligibility after missing all of last season due to a torn ACL in her left knee.
- Two Wildcats, Amber Smith and Keyla Snowden, have already graduated and are working on second bachelor's degrees. Smith, who has a bachelor's degree in integrated communications systems, is working on a second degree in family studies. Snowden graduated with a degree in communications and is working on a second degree in media arts and studies.

- Louisville (7-1), located less than 80 miles west on I-64, travels to Lexington after a home game against Murray State on Tuesday. The Cardinals defeated the Racers, 105-62. Louisville was led by Monique Reid's 18 points, and Shawnta' Dyer and Shoni Schimmel's 14 points.
- The Cardinals are led by senior forward Monique Reid, who is averaging 17.0 points and 4.6 rebounds per game, while shooting 62.3 percent from the field. Louisville is led on the glass by sophomore center Cierra Warren and freshman forward Sara Hammond, who average 6.3 and 5.6 rebounds per game, respectively. Shoni Schimmel is averaging 4.4 assists per game.
- Jeff Walz is in his fifth season leading the Cardinals. Louisville returns nine letter winners from last year's team, including four starters, as well as two other players who had at least 10 starts. Walz has a record of 103-47 at Louisville.

- The intrastate rivals played 16 times prior to UK becoming a varsity sport in 1974. The Wildcats went 11-5 in games spanning from 1912 to 1924.
- The home team has won in each of the last three years in this rivalry.

KENTUCKY VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- Kentucky has played in 243 games against opponents ranked in the AP poll. The Wildcats own a 51-192 record in those games, including a 10-25 mark under Matthew Mitchell.
- Louisville is the first of six possible ranked opponents for the Wildcats this season.
- UK's last win over a ranked team was Nov. 21, 2010 vs. No. 12 Notre Dame in Memorial Coliseum (81-76).
- This marks the second time in the series that both teams have been ranked in the top 25 of the national polls but the first time both teams have been ranked in the top 15. The last time both teams were ranked was in 2006. The 24th-ranked Cats fell to the 19th-ranked Cardinals (83-75) in Louisville.
- The last time UK beat a top-10 was in 2010 vs. No. 4 Nebraska in the NCAA Tournament. UK's last win over a top-10 team in the regular season was in 2006 vs. No. 1 Tennessee.

CATS VS. THE BIG EAST

- UK is 69-31 all-time against teams from UofL's BIG EAST conference. The Cats will also meet BIG EAST member Notre Dame this season (Dec. 18).
- In addition to Louisville, the Cats are 19-6 vs. Cincinnati; 1-2 vs. UConn; 2-0 vs. DePaul, Georgetown, and Syracuse; 1-0 vs. Notre Dame, Pittsburgh, Seton Hall, South Florida, and Villanova; 3-2 vs. Rutgers and 2-1 vs. Marquette, St. John's (N.Y.) and West Virginia. UK has never met Providence.

KENTUCKY/LOUISVILLE CONNECTIONS

- Kentucky has three players from the Commonwealth of Kentucky, including one player (A'dia Mathies) from Louisville (Iroquois High School). Keyla Snowden is from Lexington and attended Lexington Catholic High School, while Samantha Drake is a native of Bardstown, Ky., and attended Nelson County High School.
- Louisville has five players from Kentucky in Tia Gibbs (Louisville Vanderbilt), Monique Reid (Louisville Fern Creek), Shelby Harper (Scottsville Allen County), Antonia Slaughter (Shelbyville Louisville Christian Academy) and Sara Hammond (Vernon Rockcastle County.

UK VS. TEAMS FROM THE BLUEGRASS

UK sports a 119-46 (72.1) all-time record against teams from the Commonwealth of Kentucky, including a 1-0 record this season after defeating Morehead State in the season opener.

2011-12 GAME NOTES

MATHIES NAMED TO NAISMITH WATCH LIST

Junior guard A'dia Mathies has been named to the prestigious 2011-12 Naismith preseason watch list, the Atlanta Tip Off Club announced.

The watch list is compiled by the Atlanta Tipoff Club's Board of Selectors, which based its criteria on player performances from the previous year and expectations for the 2012 college basketball season. The 2012 Naismith Trophy will be awarded at the NCAA Women's Final Four in Denver.

Mathies is a 2011-12 preseason All-SEC First Team selection by both the league coaches and media. Last season, she averaged 12.8 points, 4.7 rebounds, 2.6 assists and 2.1 steals per game despite moving to the point guard position in mid-season to help the team. With Mathies as the floor general, the Wildcats advance to their second straight NCAA Tournament, UK's first back-to-back appearances in the "Big Dance" in 28 years.

Mathies currently leads UK in scoring with 15.4 points per game and has scored in double digits in all seven games this season. She leads the SEC and ranks ninth nationally in steals per game (4.4).

Mathies is one of five players on the list from the Southeastern Conference. Joining her on the list are LaSondra Barrett (LSU), Glory Johnson (Tennessee), Meighan Simmons (Tennessee) and Shekinna Stricklen (Tennessee).

In late February, the Atlanta Tipoff Club's Board of Selectors will compile a mid-season team of the top 30 players in the nation. Then in March, the Naismith Trophy voting academy will vote to narrow the list to the four finalists.

REMEMBER NOVEMBER

The Wildcats are 94-35 all-time in the month of November, good for a .728 winning percentage. Coach Matthew Mitchell is 29-12 overall, including a 25-5 mark in five seasons at UK. In the last three seasons, UK has been an impressive 18-0 in November.

UK RANKS IN BOTH NATIONAL POLLS

Since the middle of 2009-10, Kentucky has been ranked in both polls 29 consecutive weeks. The Cats moved up to No. 12 in this week's Associated Press poll and are No. 10 in the *USA Today*/ESPN Coaches' poll.

UK has appeared in the AP poll 125 times in the poll's 38-year history. UK's longest streak in the poll is 61 consecutive weeks from week 11 during the 1979-80 season to week 17 of the 1982-83 season.

BASKETBALL STATE OF MIND

Both of Kentucky's basketball teams are ranked in the top 25 of both *The Associated Press* and *USA Today*/ESPN Coaches' poll. The men's team is No. 1 in both polls while the women's team is No. 12 by AP and No. 10 in the coaches' poll.

UK is one of just five schools in the nation to have both its men's and women's teams ranked in the top 15 of the AP poll. The others are: Baylor, UConn, Duke, Louisville, and North Carolina.

TOUGH SCHEDULE

Kentucky's schedule is always tough as it plays in the nation's premier women's basketball league, the Southeastern Conference. Kentucky will play six ranked opponents, including No. 8 Tennessee (twice), No. 15 Georgia and No. 25 Vanderbilt. The Cats will also meet No. 3 Notre Dame, No. 7 Duke and No. 10 Louisville in nonconference play.

CATS' PRESSURE DEFENSE TOUGH TO HANDLE

Once again this season, opponents are finding the Wildcats' signature pressure and full-court defense tough to handle. Last year, UK led the SEC and ranked in the top 10 nationally in steals and turnover margin and the Wildcats look to be on pace to do that again. The Cats currently lead the nation and the SEC in both categories.

DEFENSE CREATES OFFENSE

Kentucky's stellar defensive play continues to create scoring opportunities, and lots of them. UK, which forces 35.7 turnovers per game, averages 40.3 points off those miscues compared to the opponents' 13.1.

Since the beginning of the 2009-10 season when Coach Mitchell implemented UK's pressure, trapping, in-your-face defense, the Cats have forced 20-plus turnovers in 58 of 77 games (75.3 percent). UK is 56-12 overall when forcing more turnovers than the opponent during that span, including an impressive 31-1 when forcing 25-plus miscues.

SPEAKING OF OFFENSE ...

The Cats, who lead the SEC and rank fifth nationally in scoring offense (87.0), have scored at least 80 points in six of seven games this season, including three games with 90-plus points. In five seasons under Coach Matthew Mitchell, the Cats are 31-1 when scoring over 80 points, 10-0 when scoring over 90 points and 4-0 when scoring over 100.

CATS' FORMULA FOR SUCCESS

The Wildcats' formula for success is comprised of two things: turnovers forced and rebounding margin. For an undersized team like Kentucky, winning the turnover margin offsets a deficit in rebounding margin. UK went 9-2 last season when it lost the rebounding margin but won the turnover margin. The only losses came against No. 4 Tennessee on Feb. 7 and No. 14 North Carolina.

BALANCED SCORING

MATHIES BECOMES FOURTH-FASTEST WILD-CAT TO REACH 1,000 CAREER POINTS

Junior A'dia Mathies scored the 1,000th point of her career on a layup with 2:55 remaining vs. Southern Miss to give Kentucky an 80-67 lead.

Mathies became the fourth-fastest player in UK history to reach 1,000 career points, accomplishing the feat in just 74 games.

CATS FORCE A SCHOOL-RECORD 48 TURNOVERS

Tipping off at an unconventional 11 a.m. didn't seem to bother the Wildcats as they bolted out

of the gate and turned up the defensive pressure in its home opener vs. Jacksonville State on Tuesday. The Wildcats forced the Gamecocks into a school-record 48 turnovers on 25 steals, just three shy of the school's steals mark.

Kentucky guard Bria Goss was named the Southeastern Conference's Freshman of the Week on Nov. 21.

Goss, a 5-foot-10 guard, received the honor after averaging 11.0 points, 5.3 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game last week. She scored in double-figures in all three of UK's wins, including a

career-high 12 points against Southern Mississippi. She also grabbed a career-high and team-high eight rebounds vs. the Lady Eagles.

Overall, Goss is UK's second-leading scorer and third-leading rebounder, averaging 10.9 points and 5.7 rebounds per game.

MATHIES SWIPES CAREER-HIGH NINE STEALS

Junior guard A'dia Mathies recorded a near triple-double vs. Nebraska Omaha when she swiped a career-high nine steals to go along with 11 points and seven rebounds.

Mathies' nine steals ties for the second most in a single game in UK history, and is the most since Rita Adams had nine steals against Virginia Commonwealth on Dec. 16, 2001.

Mathies currently leads UK in scoring (15.4), steals (4.4) and field goals made (5.6).

DEFENSE HOLDS JACKSONVILLE STATE TO 25 POINTS

Kentucky held Jacksonville State to just 25 points, tying the school record for fewest points allowed in a game. UK also allowed just 25 points vs. the Lexington Merchants on Dec. 3, 1974, the Cats' first season of varsity women's basketball.

The 75-point margin of victory (100-25) was the second-largest margin of victory in program history.

RECORD-BREAKING SECOND HALF LIFTS WILDCATS OVER MOREHEAD IN SEASON OPENER

It was a tale of two halves in the season opener for Kentucky. A feisty Morehead State team built a 32-31 lead at the half and outrebounded UK 26-19. The Wildcats, looking to win their eighth-straight game over the Lady Eagles, shot just 38.7 percent from the field and needed the 15-minute intermission to regroup.

Trailing 36-34 with 17:25 to play, Kentucky went on a 9-0 run to take the lead 43-36. From there, the Wildcats held Morehead State without a field goal for 4:44 and exploded on a 36-10 run to take a decisive 70-46 lead. Kentucky scored 65 second-half points en route to a 96-30 win.

More second-half highlights:

- The Wildcats shot an impressive 62.2 percent from the field.
- Kentucky held Morehead State to just eight field goals on 26.7 percent shooting.
- Kentucky outrebounded Morehead State 30-12 in the second half.
- Kentucky's 65 second-half points were the most in school history.

CATS FORCE 40 TURNOVERS IN WIN OVER COKER COLLEGE IN EXHIBITION PLAY

Kentucky won its lone exhibition in preparation for the 2011-12 season, racing past Division II foe Coker College by a score of 86-44 in Memorial Coliseum on Nov. 6.

Coach Matthew Mitchell and the Wildcats relied on their signature pressure defense to hold the visiting Cobras to 26.9-percent shooting from the field. UK also forced 40 turnovers, tallying 15 steals and scoring 45 points off Coker miscues. On three separate occasions, the Kentucky defense held the visitors scoreless for at least five consecutive minutes.

UK benefited from a balanced offensive effort, with all 11 Wildcats who played scoring at least two points. Freshman Bria Goss led the Wildcats with 17 points, with Samantha Drake (11), A'dia Mathies (10), Maegan Conwright (10) and Brittany Henderson (10) joining Goss in double figures.

"THREE" MANIA

UK has hit a 3-pointer in 264 consecutive games, dating back to the 2003-04 season. The Cats' last game without a trey was against San Francisco on Nov. 29, 2003 (0-2).

THE MAGIC "80"

The Wildcats hold a remarkable 277-19 (.935) record since 1974 when scoring 80 points or more. The last loss came against Minnesota (11/23/07) when the Cats fell 92-80 in the Rainbow Wahine Classic.

UK is 31-1 (.968) under Coach Mitchell when scoring 80 points or more.

In the last three seasons, UK is 26-0 when it exceeded the 80-point mark.

KENTUCKY PICKED SECOND BY LEAGUE COACH-ES, THIRD BY MEDIA; MATHIES NAMED ALL-SEC

Kentucky was picked to finish second in the Southeastern Conference by the league coaches and third by the media this season. Junior A'dia Mathies was a All-SEC first team selection, by both the media and league coaches.

The Wildcats finished 25-9 overall last year, 11-5 in SEC play, and advanced to back-to-back NCAA Tournaments for the first time since the 1981-82 and 1982-83 seasons. Despite losing one of the most talented players in UK Hoops' history in Victoria Dunlap, Kentucky enters the 2011-12 season with high expectations. The Wildcats, led by head coach Matthew Mitchell, who is entering his fifth year at UK, return 10 letter winners, including four starters from last year.

Along with Mathies, senior point guard Amber Smith returns to the hardwood after sitting out the 2010-11 season with a knee injury. One of the nation's top recruiting classes, Kentucky will welcome three freshmen in Bria Goss (Indianapolis, Ind.), Azia Bishop (Toledo, Ohio) and Bra'Shey Ali (Plainfield, N.J.). Also joining the Wildcats will be sophomore forward Samarie Walker (West Carrollton, Ohio), who will be eligible following the 2011 fall semester after transferring from Connecticut in December of 2010.

CATS RANKED NO. 18 IN PRESEASON AP POLL; 15TH IN USA TODAY/ESPN COACHES' POLL

For the first time in school history, Kentucky is ranked in back-to-back preseason Associated Press and USA TODAY/ESPN coaches' polls. The Wildcats were picked to start the 2011-12 season at No. 18 by the AP and No. 15 by the 31-member Board of Coaches.

Last season, UK was picked No. 9 in the preseason by AP and No. 10 in the coaches' poll.

UK HOOPS RANKS IN TOP 25 OF PRESEASON MAGAZINES; MATHIES NAMED PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN

After its second-straight appearance in the NCAA Tournament, Kentucky again earned top-25 preseason rankings by Sporting News Magazine and Athlon Sports Magazine.

The Wildcats, who are coming off a 25-9 record, including a school-record-tying 11 Southeastern Conference victories, are ranked No. 18 by Sporting News and No. 23 by Athlon Sports. Kentucky has advanced to back-to-back NCAA Tournaments for the first time since the 1981-82 and 1982-83 seasons.

One of the main reasons for UK's success has been junior guard A'dia Mathies. The 5-foot-9 guard, who was named a second-team preseason All-America choice by Sporting News, is UK's top returning scorer and third-leading rebounder from 2010-11, with an average of 12.8 points and 4.7 rebounds per game. After moving to the point guard position out of necessity midway through last season, she also led the team in assists (89) and ranked second in steals (71). Mathies, a second-team All-SEC choice and SEC All-Defensive team member in 2010, was named a first-team All-SEC selection by the media in 2011.

CATS TO BE TELEVISED 15 TIMES DURING THE REGULAR SEASON

Kentucky will be televised 15 times during the regular season.

The conference package selected nine of 29 regular-season games for national or regional TV, including four games on the ESPN family of networks. Two matchups will be Big Monday games on ESPN2 (at Tennessee on Feb. 13 and home vs. Vanderbilt on Feb. 20) while ESPNU will televise UK's rematch against Notre Dame in South Bend, Ind., on Dec. 18 and UK's conference road game at Mississippi State on Feb. 26. The ESPN2 game against Tennessee will be the first-ever women's basketball game in 3D.

Fox Sports Net picked up two games in Lexington on Jan. 8 vs. Mississippi State and Jan. 12 vs. Tennessee, CSS selected UK at Florida on

Jan. 1 and a home game against Alabama on Jan. 29. The Cats' matchup with the Gators in Lexington on Jan. 22 will be broadcast on the SEC Network.

The UK IMG Sports Network, UK's local network that serves eight over-the-air stations and Fox Sports Net South on cable, will broadcast five games (Mississippi Valley State, Louisville, Duke, Arkansas-Pine Bluff and Arkansas, while Cox Sports Television will air the Wildcats' game at LSU.

The majority of games not televised nationally will be available as a part of ESPN Full Court, the pay subscription college basketball out-of-market service, and on ESPN3.com.

NEWCOMERS SET TO MAKE AN IMPACT

Three highly touted freshmen and a Connecticut transfer look to make an immediate impact for the Wildcats this season.

Freshmen guards Bria Goss and Bra'Shey Ali along with rookie forward/center Azia Bishop will don the Blue and White for the first time on Friday.

Kentucky has started a freshman in 108-of-140 games during the Matthew Mitchell era, including 75 consecutive.

Sophomore transfer Samarie Walker will be eligible for action following the 2011 fall semester.

UK WELCOMES TWO TRANSFERS TO UK

UK welcomes two transfer this season in DeNesha Stallworth and Samarie Walker.

Stallworth, a 6-foot-3 forward/center from Richmond, Calif., transferred to UK during the summer of 2011, after playing two seasons for the California Golden Bears under Coach Joanne Boyle. Stallworth led the team in scoring as a sophomore last season, averaging 13.3 points per game while grabbing 6.4 rebounds a game. She was named an All-Pac-10 media selection in helping lead her squad to the Women's National Invitational Tournament for the second straight season.

Stallworth, who must sit out the 2011-12 season due to NCAA transfer rules, will have two seasons of eligibility remaining.

Walker, a 6-1 forward/center and native of West Carrollton, Ohio, transferred to Kentucky last December after playing in 17 games for UConn as a freshman. She averaged 6.2 points and 5.8 rebounds in 18.8 minutes per game. She hit 58.7 (44-of-75) percent from the field and posted double digits in five games, including a career-high 15 points vs. St. John's. She grabbed double-figure rebounds twice, pulling down 11 vs. South Florida and a career-high 13 boards vs. Marquette.

She will have three years of eligibility remaining.

CATS IN THE CLOSE ONES

The Cats are 38-27 (.584) overall in "close games" (games decided by 10 points or less) in five seasons under Coach Mitchell.

Last season, UK defeated No. 12 Notre Dame by five points (81-76), Ole Miss by six, Middle Tennessee by nine (81-72), Florida by one (59-58), Vanderbilt by 10 (78-68) in Lexington and nine (80-71) in Nashville. UK defeated LSU twice (49-47 and 60-58) and Arkansas (55-54), all on last-second shots. UK had one overtime game last season, defeating Hampton 66-62 in the first round of the NCAA Tournament. The other 12 wins were by 12-plus points.

The close losses came at No. 3 Duke (54-48), vs. Georgia (61-59), vs. No. 4 Tennessee (73-67) and at South Carolina (66-61).

UK BOASTS FOUR MCDONALD'S ALL-AMERICANS

Kentucky's roster boasts a school-record four McDonald's All-Americans on its roster this season in junior DeNesha Stallworth (Richmond, Calif., sophomores Jennifer O'Neill (Bronx, N.Y.) and Samarie Walker (West Carrollton, Ohio) and incoming freshman Bria Goss (Indianapolis, Ind.).

It marks the most McDonald's All-Americans on the roster in school history.

UK HOOPS RETURNS TO RUPP ARENA

For the first time in three years, the Wildcats will play a game in Rupp Arena, the home of UK's nationally-renowned men's basketball program.

UK will play host to Duke in the downtown venue on Thursday, Dec. 8. It will mark the Blue Devils' first trip to Lexington, Ky.

The Wildcats are 20-12 all-time in Rupp Arena (since 1977), including a 1-4 record under Matthew Mitchell.

UK HOOPS SEASON TICKETS TOP 3,500

UK Hoops fans have scooped up over 3,500 season tickets for the eighth consecutive season. The Wildcats have ranked in the top-25 nationally and in the Southeastern Conference's top four in average attendance eight straight seasons, including averaging a school record 6,364 fans per game overall last year.

A combined 95,615 people passed through the turnstiles in 2009-10, breaking the school's previous single-season attendance total of 90,663 set during the 2004-05 campaign.

KENTUCKY ALL-TIME

The Cats are 634-464 (.577) in 38 years of varsity women's basketball.

KENTUCKY IN OVERTIME

Kentucky is 22-23 all-time in overtime games. Coach Matthew Mitchell is 5-3 all-time in overtime games, 3-2 at UK (see page 133 of the UK Hoops media guide for more info).

The Cats' only overtime game last season came in the first round of the NCAA Tournament vs. Hampton. UK won 66-62.

HITTING THE CENTURY MARK

UK is an impressive 36-0 when scoring 100 points or more, including a 4-0 mark under Coach Matthew Mitchell.

CATS SIGN ONE OF NATION'S TOP RECRUITS

One of the nation's top recruits Janee Thompson, a 5-foot-7 point guard from Whitney Young High School in Chicago has signed a national letter of intent with the Kentucky women's basketball team.

Thompson is rated as the No. 6 point guard in the class of 2012 by ESPN's HoopGurlz, and the No. 35 player overall.

After returning to action last January from a torn ACL, Thompson averaged 7.4 points and 2.3 assists in the final 14 games for the Whitney Young Dolphins. She is a quick point guard who should fit into Mitchell's up-tempo style of game very well. She has great ball-handling skills and is known as a lock down defender, as well.

Thompson was named an Honorable Mention All-American by Sporting News along with earning Most Valuable Player honors at the 2011 Fila Deep South Classic and All-Tournament team honors at the 2011 Nike Battle in the Boro.

Thompson chose Kentucky over Auburn,

Miami (Fla.), Northwestern, South Carolina and Virginia Tech, among others.

With Thompson signing and the addition of California transfer DeNesha Stallworth (Richmond, Calif.), UK Hoops has the nation's No. 14 recruiting class, according to the All-Star Girl's Report. It marks Mitchell's third consecutive top-15 recruiting class.

Kentucky head coach Matthew Mitchell's teams are known for using three "winning tools" for success: honesty, hard work and discipline. So it's no surprise that in just four seasons at the helm, he used those winning tools to build a program that has quickly ascended back into the national spotlight.

Under his leadership, the Wildcats have advanced to four consecutive postseason tournaments, including back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances for the first time in 28 years. UK has also finished second in the Southeastern Conference race, advanced to the SEC Tournament championship game and charted over 20 wins in consecutive seasons, including a school-record 28 victories in 2009-10.

In the last two seasons alone, the Wildcats have defeated 10 nationally-ranked opponents, ranked in the top 25 of the national polls, garnered top 25 rankings in average attendance and recorded a remarkable 30-2 record in Memorial Coliseum.

Eight different players have received All-SEC accolades, including Victoria Dunlap who was named UK's first SEC Player of the Year and first SEC Defensive Player of the Year. She also was just the second player in school history to be named to the prestigious WBCA/State Farm All-America team. In the classroom, seven Wildcats have been SEC Academic Honor Roll members over 12 times and all 10 players in their final season of eligibility received their degree.

Mitchell's success on the hardwood has already moved him up to No. 4 in all-time wins at Kentucky with 86. His winning percentage of 63.7 percent (86-49) ranks third.

Last season, Mitchell once again led the Wildcats to an outstanding season with a 25-9 overall record and a school-record tying 11 wins (11-5) in the SEC. UK took a second-place finish in the league standings for the second consecutive year and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament as the No. 4 seed.

Year Three proved to be the best year yet as Mitchell was named SEC Coach of the Year for his remarkable job in turning around a team that went 16-16 overall, 5-9 in conference play last season to a 28-8 overall record in 2009-10. The Cats' 28 overall wins, including 11 SEC wins were school records and UK finished second in the league despite being picked to finish 11th in the preseason polls.
