NOTABLES

- Arizona advanced to the Sweet 16 for the 19th time in 34 NCAA Tournament appearances and for the first time since 2017.
- As a No. 1 seed, Arizona is 18-7 all-time and 3-1 vs. the No. 5 seed after a 72-60 loss to Houston in San Antonio
- The 11 3FG made by Arizona against Wright State matched the school record for an NCAA Tournament game.
- UA **leads the nation** in assists/gm (19.8) total assists (714) and total rebounds (1,496).
- The Wildcats led the country with 22 games of 20 or more assists this season.
- The Wildcats had at least one 10-0 run in 29 out of 37 games.
- When scoring 80 or more points this year, Arizona was 28-0.
- Arizona head coach Tommy Lloyd is the **ninth first-time head coach in NCAA history** to win 30 games in year one. The **33 wins** are tied for third-most in program history and one shy of tying Bill Guthridge (UNC) for the most by a first-time head coach in NCAA history.
- As a team, Arizona has shot 50% or better in 43 of 74 halves played this season, and at or above 50% for the game on 22 occasions.
- The 287 made 3-point field goals this season are the second-most in UA history (297).
- Christian Koloko** was the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year and has posted a double-double in each of the last three games. His 100 blocked shots are second-most in a season in UA history and needs 3 more to break the record. He became the **first player in NCAA Tournament history** to post 17p, 13r (t-career high), 6a and 5 blk against Wright State. Was 12 of 13 from the floor for career-high 28 points and 12 rebs vs. TCU.
- Benedict Mathurin** was the Pac-12 Player of the Year and Most Outstanding Player of the Pac-12 Tournament in 2022. He drilled a game-tying 3-pointer with 12 seconds left to force OT against TCU, and went on to finish with 30 points (11-13 FT). It was his third career 30-point game and he's the **sixth Arizona player** to score 30 in an NCAA Tournament game. Mathurin was one of five finalists for the Jerry West Shooting Guard of the Year Award.
- Azuolas Tubelis** was a First Team All Pac-12 honoree and is averaging 14.2 points, 6.2 rebounds and shooting 54.0% from the floor this season. He played just 19 minutes per game over the three NCAA Tournament games, averaging 6.7 p, 4.7r.
- Sophomore **Dalen Terry** registered a career-high 17 points in the loss to Houston in the Sweet Sixteen. A Pac-12 Honorable mention and all-defensive team member, he averaged 12.0 points, 5.2 rebounds and 4.0 assists in the postseason. He had the steal on TCU's final possession in regulation with the game tied.
- Sophomore reserve **Pelle Larsson** came off the bench to score 11 points on 3 of 4 shooting from long range against Wright State. He added three assists and five rebounds. In six postseason games, he averaged 7.8 points, 4.7 rebounds and 2.0 assists.
- Sophomore point guard **Kerr Kriisa** returned to action on March 20 against TCU, coming off the bench to play 27 minutes and had a +/- of +24. He suffered an ankle injury in the closing minute of the game on March 10 against Stanford. He led the Pac-12 in assists (155) and fourth in assist/turnover ratio (2.15). He had the 10th triple-double in program history with 21 points (7-9 3FG), 10 rebounds, 10 assists. His 80 made 3FG this season rank as the eighth-most in a season in Arizona history.
- Sixth-year grad transfer **Justin Kier** was one of eight active players in Division I to have 1,500 career points, 700 rebounds and 300 assists. He moved into the starting lineup for Senior Day and then filled in while Kriisa missed three games with an ankle injury. He scored 13 points - 6 of 6 free throws - in the Pac-12 Tournament semifinal win over Colorado. He had eight points and six assists in the win over Wright State.
- Redshirt Sophomore **Oumar Ballo** made history in the Pac-12 Tournament Championship game, recording a tournament record and new career-high six blocked shots. His 44 blocked shots while coming off the bench lead the country in blocks by players that have not started a game. For the season, he shot 62.2% from the floor. The native of Mali has also improved his free throw percentage from 55.2% last year to 70.1% this year.

- The Wildcats went 24 of 25 from the free throw line vs. Colorado, tying the school record for FT% in the Pac-12 Tournament (2004).
- With 52 points in the paint against TCU, it was the 25th game this year with 40+ paint points - the most by any Pac-12 team in the last 15 seasons.
- Arizona finished the season 17-0 at home, marking the 13th time they have gone undefeated in the 49-year history of the McKale Center. Overall, UA has won 19 straight at home, the **longest active streak** in the Pac-12 and the third-longest in Division I.
- With the win at USC in the final true road game of the season, Arizona collected 9 road wins this season, the most since 9 in 2016-17.
- Arizona's 91-71 win over then 25-4 USC made history, becoming the first Division I team to beat a 25-win team on the road by 20+ since March 7, 1981.
- Arizona won three straight Pac-12 road games by at least 25 points this season, becoming the **first Pac-12 team to ever** do that dating back to 1978-79 when UA joined the Pac-10.
- Arizona had 20+ assists in its first five Pac-12 games, the first Pac-12 school to do that in the last 15 seasons (h/t ESPN Stats & Info).
- Arizona trailed by 13 points at Illinois and came back to win the game, marking the largest deficit overcome to win a game since trailing by 13 at UNLV in 2017 and coming back to win the game. Arizona also posted another comeback from an 11-point deficit against California Baptist to get the win. The Wildcats have trailed by double figures and come back to win **five times this season**.
- The 29-point margin of victory over NAU in head coach **Tommy Lloyd's** debut marked the second-largest in a Arizona head coach debut. The largest was a 66-4 win in J.F. "Pop" McKale's debut in 1914-15.
- Koloko was the first Arizona player in the last 25 years to have at least 10 blocked shots through the teams' first two games. The last Pac-12 player to do it was Malik Dime (WASH) at the start of the 2016-17 season.
- Koloko is the first Arizona player to post a game of 10+ points, 10+ rebounds and 5+ blocked shots since Jordan Hill on Dec. 10, 2008. USC's Evan Mobley did it four times last season and was the only Pac-12 player to do so.
- Head coach **Tommy Lloyd** is the **first Division I head coach** to ever do each of the following in his first five games coached: 1) win all five, 2) win by an average of 30 points/game, 3) beat an AP Top 5 team (*credit: ESPN Stats & Info*)
- School record for most assists in a season (726)
- Led the country in total assists and assists per game (19.6)
- School record for most blocked shots in a season (210)
- School record for most 3FG shot attempts in a season (815)
- The 33 wins are tied for the third-most in a season in UA history
- Arizona's 726 assists rank 21st in NCAA history for a single-season
- The 726 assists are the most in a season by any school since UCLA in 2016-17 (771)
- Christian Koloko tied the school record for blocked shots in a season (102)
- Benedict Mathurin's 655 points scored are the 10th-most in a season in UA history and ranked 24th in the country this season
- Scored the 4th-most points in a season in UA history (3,107)
- Made the 3rd-most shots in a season in UA history (1,117)
- Shot the 2nd-most shots in a season in UA history (2,269)
- Made the 2nd-most 3FG shots in a season in UA history (287)
- Grabbed the 3rd-most rebounds in a season in UA history (1,531)
- Had the 8th-best rebound margin in a season in UA history (+7.6)
- Benedict Mathurin's 83 made 3FG are the 8th-most in a season in UA history
- Kerr Kriisa's 80 made 3FG are the 9th-most in a season in UA history

DYNAMIC DUO

Benedict Mathurin (30) and Christian Koloko (28) combined for 58 points in the overtime win against TCU in the Second Round of the NCAA Tournament - more than four other TEAMS scored in tournament games that day.

In addition to 58 points, they totaled 20 rebounds, 3 blocks and 3 steals, become the first teammates to do that in an NCAA Tournament game since David Robinson and Vernon Butler in 1986.

LLOYD SUPERLATIVES

The last time a first-time head coach like Tommy Lloyd won Pac-12 coach of the year was Tony Bennett at WSU in 2007. It's the fifth time overall it's happened in the Pac-12.

Lloyd has set a new Pac-12 record for conference wins in his first season in the conference. He needs to get to 30 wins to match John Warren (ORE; 1944-45) for most overall wins in the first year.

Tommy Lloyd and UCLA's Gary Cunningham (1977-78) are the only two first-time head coaches in the Pac-12 to win 25 of their first 27 games. Both Lloyd and Cunningham would lose their 28th game.

Tommy Lloyd is the only first-year Pac-12 head coach to ever start 15-1 or better through his first 16 games in the conference.

Lloyd is also a candidate for the Naismith National Coach of the Year award. He was named ESPN College GameDay Coach of the Year.

Lloyd joins Bill Guthridge (UNC in 1998) and Bill Hodges (Indiana State in 1979) as the only head coaches to earn a No. 1 seed in their first season as head coach.

RECORD SETTING GPA

In the Fall 2021 semester, the men's basketball team posted a team GPA of 3.04, which is the best team GPA for a semester in the history of the program. 11 players had a 3.0 or better, including 4 with a 4.0.

KOLOKO KLIMBING

Junior center Christian Koloko continues to rise up the blocked shot lists at Arizona for a season and a career. His 100 blocked shots are the second-most blocked shots in a single season in UA history (102 - Loren Woods). His 160 career blocked shots are fifth in program history, trailing Ed Stokes 167 blocks in fourth place.

30 WINS IN YEAR ONE

Head coach Tommy Lloyd became the ninth head coach to reach 30 victories in his first season as a head coach with a win over Colorado in the Pac-12 Tournament. The full list is below...

TALL ORDER

According to KenPom.com's "height" metric, Arizona players average 79.4 inches (6-foot 7-inches) among those players that play at least 10% of the team's minutes this season. That height ranks as the second-tallest in the country and the Pac-12 makes up three of the top four in the country with Stanford (79.2) third and USC (79.1) in fourth.

INSIDE THE ARC

Arizona is among the nation's best at playing inside the arc this season. The Cats are shooting 57.1% on 2-point field goals, the fifth-best percentage in the country. Arizona also holds opponents to 41.8% inside the arc, which is second in the country. The national average on 2-point field goals is 49.7%.

DOES EXPERIENCE MATTER?

According to KenPom.com, Arizona's roster averaged 0.63 years of experience, which ranks 355th out of 358 teams in NCAA Division 1. The average for rosters across the country is 1.89 years.

MORE ON 45-POINT VICTORIES

Here's a historical look at how many teams have been able to accomplish that in the month of December in any season against Division I teams (since 1980):

Florida did it 4 times during the 2006-07 season. N.C. State did it 3 times during the 2018-19 season. Arizona has done it 3 times so far this season.

NOTING THE WIN OVER #4 MICHIGAN

A few of the notes following the Wildcats win over #4 Michigan on Nov. 21 in Las Vegas:

- First win over a top 5 team since Dec. 30, 2017 vs. #3 Arizona State
- The 18-point margin of victory was UA's largest vs. a Top 5 team since beating #3 Michigan State by 19 on March 31, 2001.
- The Arizona defense held Michigan to 1 of 14 shooting from the 3-point line
- It's head coach Tommy Lloyd's first win over a ranked team as a head coach
- Arizona improves to 9-1 all-time at T-Mobile Arena in Las Vegas

Tommy Lloyd was named head coach at the University of Arizona on April 14, 2021 after serving as an assistant coach at Gonzaga the last 20 seasons, where he developed 19 All-Americans and 15 conference players of the year and contributed to five straight 30-win seasons and two appearances in the national championship game.

Lloyd's contract is for five seasons starting with the 2021-22 season.

Lloyd, 46, served as an administrative assistant at Gonzaga for Few during the 2000-01 season before being promoted to assistant coach prior to the 2001-02 season. In his 20 seasons in Spokane, the Zags posted a record of 578-109 (.841) and reached the NCAA Tournament every year, going as far as the title game twice, the Elite Eight twice and the Sweet 16 four times. Gonzaga was also ranked No. 1 in the country for the first time in program history in 2012-13 and then again ascended to the top spot in 2016-17, 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21.

During his tenure, Lloyd and the Zags won 19 West Coast Conference regular season titles and 15 WCC Tournament championships with the help of 87 all-WCC honorees, including nine newcomers of the year and six defenders of the year.

Coach Lloyd was instrumental in the Zags signing and developing NBA players, including two-time NBA All-Star Domantas Sabonis, Rui Hachimura, Kelly Olynyk, Zach Collins, Adam Morrison, Brandon Clarke, Kyle Wiltjer, Austin Daye, Robert Sacre, Ronny Turiaf, Jeremy Pargo and Elias Harris.

Lloyd has used his knowledge of the European game to help Gonzaga players earn professional contracts overseas while also helping to cultivate recruiting relationships that have led to the signing of international players such as Martynas Arlauskas (Lithuania), Joel Ayayi (France), Oumar Ballo (Mali) and Pavel Zakharov (Russia). Also included among his former players are Japanese National Team member Hachimura; Polish National Team member Przemek Karnowski; Lithuanian National Team member Sabonis (the son of Naismith Hall of Famer Arvydas Sabonis); Canadians Kevin Pangos, Olynyk and Sacre; Germans Harris and Mathis Mönninghoff; JP Baptista of Brazil; Frenchmen Turiaf, Killian Tillie and Mathis Keita; Filip Petrusev of Serbia; Guy Landry Edi of the Ivory Coast; and Addullahi Kuso of Nigeria.

The Zags have had one of the most potent offenses in the nation over the last 20 years, joining North Carolina and Duke as the only three schools in the country to average more than 80 points per game. Gonzaga also led the country in overall field goal percentage (49.6%) and three-point field goal percentage (37.9%) in that span.

A 1993 graduate of Kelso High School in Washington, Lloyd went on to attend Walla Walla Community College for two seasons and was an All-Northwest Athletic Association of Community Colleges All-East Region selection in 1995. Following his graduation from WWCC, he finished his career at Whitman College, earning his degree in biology and a secondary teaching credential. He played professionally in Brisbane, Australia in 1997 and Dusseldorf, Germany in 1999.

Lloyd and his wife, Channele, have three children - Liam, Sofia and Maria. Liam plays basketball at Grand Canyon University.

SEASON NOTES

- Arizona's 25-point win at Oregon State on Dec. 5, 2021 in Lloyd's first-ever Pac-12 Conference game was one for the record books. It's the second-largest margin of victory in a Pac-12 coach's first-ever road game as head coach. And it's tied for the largest margin of victory in a Pac-12 coach's first-ever conference game as head coach.

- Lloyd is the first Pac-12 coach to win his first 10 games at a school since Johnny Dawkins (STAN) in 2008-09 and the first Arizona coach to do it since Pop McKale in 1915.

- Set Pac-12 record for conference wins in his first season and needs 30 overall wins to match Pac-12 record

- Became first Pac-12 team to ever win three straight conference road games by 25+ points

- Only two first-time head coaches had a better record at a major college school through 25 games than Tommy Lloyd's 23-2 mark - Bill Guthridge (UNC: 24-1) and Jamie Dixon (PITT: 23-2).
