### NOTING THE WILDCATS

- Junior point guard **James Akinjo** was named Second Team NABC All-District as well as First Team All Pac-12 following the season. He was the first Arizona player since T.J. McConnell in 2015 to lead the Pac-12 in assists (117).
- It marked the 11th time in 12 seasons under Sean Miller that Arizona has had a representative on the all-conference first team.
- Freshman forward **Azuolas Tubelis** was named Honorable Mention All Pac-12 after averaging 13.7 points and 7.8 rebounds per game in conference play. Tubelis was also named to the Pac-12 All-Freshman team.
- Redshirt sophomore **Jordan Brown** garnered the Pac-12 Sixth Man of the Year award, the first Arizona player to receive that award. He averaged 8.8 points, 4.7 rebounds and shot 51.5% from the field. He ranked ninth in the Pac-12 in FG% and 13th in blocked shots.
- Freshman guard Benedict Mathurin joined Tubelis on the Pac-12 All-Freshman Team after averaging 10.8 points and 4.7 rebounds in Pac-12 games. His 86.8% from the free throw line ranked fourth in the conference.
- The victory over #17 USC also gave Arizona its only win of the season against a ranked opponent and its first road win against a ranked foe since Feb. 15, 2018 at Arizona St.
- Arizona finished the regular season ranked third in the country in free throws made (453) and second in free throws attempted (623) and 20th in assists (403).
- In Pac-12 play, Arizona was 1st in assists (309) and scoring (74.9) and third in 3FG% (37.7).
- The Wildcats were only been out-rebounded twice this season - both games against Oregon. For the season, UA averaged a +7.1 advantage on the boards.
- Tubelis had two game-winning baskets on the year - knocking down a baseline jumper with five seconds left against Washington on Feb. 27 and recording the winning tip-in as the buzzer sounded at Arizona State on Jan. 21. He's the only freshman in the country to have two games of 16 points, 15 rebounds against major conference teams (USC, WASH).
- Junior guard **James Akinjo** picked up first team All Pac-12 accolades after leading the conference in assists in conference play (5.85) and was tied for 20th nationally in total assists (133) this season. The Oakland native was also 4th in assist/turnover ratio (2.39) in league games.

- Freshman wing **Benedict Mathurin** averaged 10.8 points and 4.7 rebounds in conference play. He ranked sixth in 3FG% (41.8%) and fifth in FT% (86.8%). He tallied 10 points and a career-high 13 rebounds against Washington, his 2nd DD. He was named to the Pac-12 All-Freshman team following the season.
- Grad transfer guard **Terrell Brown Jr.**, had 90 assists to just 23 turnovers this season, the second-best ratio in the country (3.91).
- Sophomore **Christian Koloko** scored a career-high 11 points vs. Washington and had career-high 10 rebounds at Oregon State. He finished the year with a team-high 35 blocked shots.
- Since becoming eligible on Feb. 4, freshman **Kerr Kriisa** averaged 5.5 points and 2.4 assists and shot 36.8% from the 3-point line in eight games.
- Redshirt sophomore **Jordan Brown** led Arizona with three double-doubles this year and ranked seventh in the Pac-12 in FG% (56.0%) for the entire season. For the year, he averaged 9.4 points and 5.2 rebounds and was second on the team with 23 blocked shots. The Roseville, Calif. native scored double figures eight times this season and earned Pac-12 Sixth Man of the Year honors.
- Freshman wing **Dalen Terry** was in the starting lineup for 14 games and is averging 4.6 points, 3.2 rebounds and 1.5 assists for the year. He dropped a season-high 13 points at ASU and had a season-high 8 rebounds against Oregon State. In the win at USC, he connected on a pair of key 3-pointers in the second half on his way to 8 points. Followed up the USC game with 8 more points off the bench in the win over WSU.
- Redshirt junior guard **Jemarl Baker Jr.** suffered a broken bone in his wrist against UCLA on Jan. 9 and missed the remainder of the 2020-21 season. He was averaging 12.0 points and had made a team-high 24 3-point field goals.
- Arizona is 119-16 (.881) in the last 135 games at the McKale Center.
- Head coach Sean Miller won at least 10 Pac-12 games in 11 of his 12 seasons in Tucson
- Arizona finished the 2019-20 season with a 21-11 overall record, giving head coach Sean Miller 13 seasons with 20+ wins out of the 17 seasons he has been a head coach.

## OWNING THE GLASS

In 26 games of the 2020-21 season, Arizona was out-rebounded just twice - in both meetings with Oregon. Still, for the year, the Wildcats averaged a +7.1 rebounding margin, which led the Pac-12 and ranked 18th nationally. In the dominating 80-53 win against Washington on Dec. 31, Arizona posted a 58-30 rebounding advantage. The 58 rebounds are the most since grabbing 58 against Houston on Dec. 17, 2006. The Wildcats have out-rebounded an opponent by 10+ rebounds in a game seven times, including three times by more 20 or more. In the win at USC, Arizona out-rebounded the Trojans by 7 despite the Trojans averaging a +7.5 rebound margin this season.

## MULTIPLE WEAPONS

The Arizona offense has been one of the most efficient in the country this season, according to KenPom.com. Making it so efficient is the ability for any number of players to have a big night.

The Wildcats and Notre Dame are the only two teams in the country to have five different players score at least 25 points in a game this season.

**TRACKING THE GOLD JERSEY**

**WHAT CAN 'ZU' DO FOR YOU?**

Freshman forward Azuolas Tubelis earned All Pac-12 Honorable Mention and Pac-12 All-Freshman team accolades after a standout campaign in Tucson. He was named Pac-12 Freshman of the Week on two occasions (Feb. 22, March 1) and logged his second double-double of the season at USC, posting 16 points and 15 rebounds. After putting up 9 points and 9 rebounds against WSU, he went for 16 points and 15 rebounds again against Washington, giving him his second double-double of the season. He's the only freshman in the country to have two 16/15 games against major conference teams this season. In Pac-12 play, those numbers jump up to 13.7 points and 7.8 boards per contest. The left-hander has scored in double figures 16 times including a 31-point effort against USC on Jan. 7 and a 20-point outing against Oregon on Feb. 13. He registered the game-winning tip-in at the buzzer at Arizona State on Jan. 21 and then on Jan. 25 had his first collegiate double-double with 16 points and 12 rebounds against the Sun Devils. He also had the game-winning jumper with 5.2 seconds left to beat Washington on Feb. 27. Azuolas is ONE OF THREE freshmen at a Power Conference school to average 13.0 points and 7.5 rebounds in conference play this year.

**HERE WE GO AKINJO**

Junior guard James Akinjo led the Wildcats in scoring (15.6) and assists (5.4) and earned All Pac-12 distinction following the season. He was also named to second team all-district by the NABC. In Pac-12 play, he tied for first in the conference in assists per game (5.85) and led the league in minutes played per game (35.56). At home against Washington, he posted a career-high 26 points, highlighted by a 5 of 8 effort from the 3-point line, and also handing out seven assists. His eight assists against Cal pushed him over 300 career assists. The 6-foot point guard has scored 20 or more six times this year. At Arizona State, he logged 24 points - including 5 of 9 beyond the arc to tie his career high 3FG made. The Oakland, California native tied his then career high with 25 points and dished out 8 assists against UCLA. He joined the Arizona record book by connecting on 14-of-14 free throws against UTEP, tying the UA single-game record. At Stanford, he assisted on a season-high nine baskets. Akinjo was named Preseason Honorable Mention All-Pac-12 by the conference media members.

**DO THE 'MATH'URIN**

Freshman wing Benedict Mathurin was one of five players named to the Pac-12 All-Freshman team after a solid rookie campaign. He finished the year averaging 10.8 points and 4.8 rebounds while also shooting 41.8% from the 3-point line. In conference play, his 42.1% ranked seventh overall while his 86.8% effort at the free throw line was fourth-best among all Pac-12 players. Mathurin's top scoring output of the season came at Oregon State, when he went 10 of 12 from the field - including 6 of 7 from long range - on his way to 31 points and eight rebounds. Overall, he scored in double figures 15 times and had two double-doubles. His first double-double game in a 24-point, 11-rebound effort at Washington State before registering 10 points and 13 rebounds in a home win over Washington on Feb. 27.

**SEATTLE SIGHTS**

Graduate transfer Terrell Brown Jr. proved to be one of the best players in the country in protecting the basketball, handing out 90 assists to just 23 turnovers this season, a ratio that ranked second in the country. He averaged 7.3 points, 3.5 rebounds and shot a career-best 36.8% from the 3-point line. At home against Washington State, he had 8 assists and just 1 turnover. In the home win over

Arizona State, he scored a team-high 18 points and added four steals. In the Dec. 28 win against Colorado, Brown handed out seven assists and did not have a turnover. Then on the roadtrip to the Washington schools, he was 10-of-19 from the floor and averaged 12.5 points. For his career, he has 381 assists and 178 turnovers. During the 2019-20 season while playing for Seattle University, he averaged 20.7 points, which ranked 20th in all of Division 1. He is also the godson of another famous basketball player out of Seattle - 19-year NBA veteran, NCAA Champion and current UA assistant coach, Jason Terry.

## LOKO FOR KOLOKO

Sophomore center Christian Koloko set new season highs in every statistical category, increasing his scoring from 2.3 points per game to 5.3 points per game. And his rebounding went from 2.4 to 4.8. Koloko led the team lead with 35 blocked shots, easily topping the 25 denials he had as a freshman. Of his 35 blocked shots, 23 of those came in the last 15 games. He was third on the team with and 125 rebounds. The native of Cameroon registered one of his top games as a Wildcat in the home win over Colorado on Dec. 28, finishing with 10 points and eight rebounds. On Feb. 27 against Washington, he tallied a career-high 11 points on 5 of 6 shooting. Last year, he averaged just 8.3 minutes per game last season, but this year he is averaging 17 minutes per game.

## JEMARL CAN SCORE THE BALL

Redshirt junior guard Jemarl Baker Jr. (pronounced "Jamal") was named Pac-12 Player of the Week on Dec. 14, becoming the first Wildcat since Dusan Ristic in 2018 to receive the honor. His 2020-21 season was cut short on Jan. 9 against UCLA when he broke a bone in his wrist and will be forced to miss the remainder of the season. He had a career night on Dec. 7 against Northern Arizona, scoring 33 points on 12-of-16 from the field and 7-of-9 from the 3-point line to surpass his previous career-best of 17 points. They are the most points scored by a Sean Miller player in his 17 seasons as a Division I head coach (Xavier and Arizona). Baker made his first 7 triples in a row against NAU and later in the season, he went 7-of-10 from long range in the second half at Stanford, and finished 8-of-13 for the game on his way to 29 points. In the 12 games he played, he averaged 12.0 points and 2.8 rebounds.

In 16 seasons as a Division I head coach, Sean Miller has yet to suffer through a losing season, making him one of just six current Division I head coaches with at least 10 years of experience who can make that claim. He is the only Pac-12 head coach on the list.

**A HISTORY OF GOLD MEDALS WITH TEAM USA AS A PLAYER AND A COACH**

Sean Miller led Team USA to a gold medal to the 2015 FIBA U-19 World Championships as head coach with a roster that included Arizona Wildcat Allonzo Trier. This came one summer after he helped guide the U.S. U-18 National Team to a gold medal at the FIBA Americas Championship as an assistant coach. The pair of gold medals he has earned as a coach are team with a third that he won one as a player at the 1991 World University Games in England.

**400 CAREER WINS**

On Feb. 6, 2020, Arizona defeated USC to give Miller 400 wins as a collegiate head coach in just 542 games, tying him with Eddie Sutton for 22nd on the NCAA list of fewest games to reach 400 wins.

**WINNING PEDIGREE**

In his 16 seasons as a head coach, Sean Miller has led his team to the NCAA postseason 11 times, not including the shortened 2019-20 season. In those trips to March Madness, Miller's teams have advanced to the Sweet 16 on seven occasions and four Elite Eights. Arizona is averaging 25.9 wins per seasons under Miller's guidance, best in program history for a coach with at least four years at the school. The Wildcats have reached the 20-win mark in nine of Miller's 11 seasons at the helm, including four 30-win campaigns. The Arizona Basketball program has recorded 30 or more wins in seven different seasons with four of those coming with Miller at the helm. Overall, Miller has been a part of 17 NCAA Tournament teams as a player, assistant coach and head coach.

**LEADER OF THE PAC**

Through 12 seasons leading the Wildcats, Miller accumulated eight conference titles - five regular season and three tournament - and a Pac-12 winning percentage that ranks third in conference history behind only John Wooden and Lute Olson. His eight titles are as many as all other active Pac-12 men's basketball coaches combined.

## REMEMBERING LUTE OLSON

Former Arizona head coach Lute Olson, who guided the Wildcats to the NCAA Championship in 1997 and was inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame in 2008, passed away on Aug. 27, 2020. He was 85 years old.

To honor the great legacy that Olson left on the University of Arizona and the Southern Arizona community as a whole, the Wildcats will be wearing a patch on their uniforms (pictured).

In his 24 seasons as the head coach at Arizona, he compiled a 589-187 record. He helped UA to four NCAA Final Four appearances and 15 Pac-10 regular season and tournament titles.

Including stops at Long Beach State and the University of Iowa before his arrival in Tucson, Olson's career coaching record stands at 781-279, good for a 781 career wins rank 14th in NCAA history.

He also established himself as one of the best coaches in Pac-10 history, securing 327 conference wins, which is still the most of any coach in conference history. Olson's Pac-10 conference winning percentage of .764 is second only to former UCLA great John Wooden, among coaches who coached in the Pac-10 for more than three seasons.

Under Olson, Arizona appeared in the Associated Press Top 25 poll 341 times out of a possible 431 polls, or 81.2% of the time. That is the fourth-best percentage in the country in that span. The Wildcats were ranked No. 1 in the country for 29 weeks and in the top 5 nationally for 111 weeks.

Player development was a key part of Olson's programs at Arizona, and that led to an array of student-athletes that would go on to star in the NBA. He coached 31 players who went on to play in the NBA, with 12 of those selected in the first round of the NBA Draft.

The court inside McKale Memorial Center was named in Olson's honor in 2000 and officially became "Lute and Bobbi Olson Court" in 2001 to honor his wife of 47 years after she passed away.

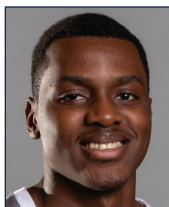
