OFF THE TOP

- Sophomore forward Ira Lee shot .626 from the floor in Pac-12 play this season. That's the highest mark by an Arizona player with at least 75 attempts since Joseph Blair shot .630 in 1993-94.
- Lee finished the season by going 22 of 25 from the field in his final six games of the season. Lee was perfect from the field in three of those games, including going 5 of 5 from the floor in the final game of the season against USC. Lee hit his final eight shots of the season, as he went 3 of 3 from the floor in the regular season finale against Arizona State. The sophomore entered Pac-12 play averaging 4.5 points per game and finished the season averaging 6.6
- Arizona averaged 13,744 fans in 17 home games this season, leading the Pac-12 in attendance for a 35th straight season.
- Freshman Brandon Williams, who averaged 11.3 points per game in 25 contests, was selected as All-Pac-12 All-Freshman honorable mention. Williams missed six conference games with a knee injury, but averaged a team-best 11.7 points per game in conference play.
- In 18 Pac-12 games this season, Arizona's bench outscored the opposition by 115 points. The bench scored at least 20 points in 16 games this season.
- Redshirt junior center Chase Jeter shot .574 from the floor this season, which was the sixth-best mark in the Pac-12 Conference. Jeter connected on 128 of 223 total field goal attempts on the season.
- Junior guard Dylan Smith shot .405 from 3-point range in Pac-12 games, which ranked 12th in the conference and tops on the team.
- The Wildcats finished the year with a +2.5 turnover margin.

BENCH PRODUCTION UP

It hasn't just been the starters producing for Arizona this season. The Wildcats have gotten a lift all year from their bench. Arizona's bench has outscored or tied its opponent in 14 of the past 20 games. Last month, Arizona's bench outscored Cal's and Stanford's 54-10 in the two games at McKale Center. Arizona outscored Cal 31-7 on the Thursday contest, before outscoring the Cardinal's second unit, 23-3. That strong play continued Thursday at Oregon State when Arizona's bench outscored Oregon State's 29-9. Arizona's bench then scored 20 points Saturday in a loss to Oregon and tied ASU's bench 15-15 in Saturday's regular season finale. The second unit has been led lately by Alex Barcello, Ira Lee and Devonaire Doutrive. Brandon Williams has also given the bench a list the past four games. The Wildcats' bench has outscored the opponent in 19 of 31 games this season, and have tied three more times, meaning Arizona's bench has only been outscored nine times this season. The bench has combined for 20 or more points in 10 of the last 17 games. Of Arizona's primary rotation players, only Barcello and Doutrive have come off the bench in every game this season. Lee has come off the bench in 26 of his 30 games, and is averaging 17.6 minutes per game on the year.

LEE IMPROVING GAME BY GAME

Arizona has seen a rise in production from sophomore forward Ira Lee in Pac-12 play. Lee is averaging 7.8 points per game, 4.4 rebounds a contest and had 17 blocks in the 18 games. The 6-foot-7-inch power forward is 57 of 91 from the floor. Over his last five games, Lee is 17 of 20 from the field. Lee had 10 points late last month against Oregon State. He had eight of his 10 points in the second half. Prior to that, Lee established a new career high with 16 points in 20 minutes against Stanford. He was 6 of 7 from the floor and 4 of 4 from the free throw line. In the weekend sweep of Cal and Stanford, Lee was 9 of 10 from the floor and averaged 11 points per game. Lee has scored five or points in 17 of his last 21 games. Prior to that, Lee had scored more than five points just four times in the previous 10 games. On the season, Lee has 126 rebounds. In 27 total games last season, he had just 62. He's already surpassed his totals in points and blocks as well as free throws made and attempted. Lee shot .626 from the floor in 18 conference games this year. That marks ranks third in the league in conference games only. Lee has played 20 or more minutes in eight of his last 12 games. Prior, Lee had played 20 or more minutes twice in his first 18 games of the season. In Arizona's most recent road game against Oregon, Lee played a career-high 33 minutes and made his third start of the season. Saturday against Arizona State, Lee scored seven points and grabbed three rebounds in 19 minutes.

MORE ON LEE'S EFFICIENCY

Sophomore Ira Lee showed amazing efficiency from the floor during the Pac-12 schedule for the Wildcats this season. Lee played in all 18 conference games and shot .626 from the floor, connecting on 57 of 91 shots. His .626 mark is the best by an Arizona player with at least 75 attempts since Joseph Blair in 1993-94 when he shot .630. Lee hasn't missed more than two shots in a game since Feb. 7 versus Washington.

LET IT GROW

Sophomore Brandon Randolph is having a strong sophomore season. Randolph has scored in double figures in 23 of 31 games this season and is averaging a team-leading 12.8 points per game. As a freshman last season, Randolph played in 31 games, drawing four starting assignments. He averaged 3.7 points per game, scoring a total of 116 points. He had 26 rebounds last season and has 104 this year. Randolph scored in double figures in each of the first 17 games of the season, becoming the first Arizona guard since Hassan Adams in 2005-06 to reach double figures in the first 17 games of the season. He was the first Wildcat, regardless of position, to score in double figures in the first 17 games since Derrick Williams in 2010-11. Last week against Oregon State, Randolph had one of his finest games of the conference season. Randolph led Arizona with 15 points and was 7 of 8 from the floor. He played 33 minutes, one shy of Justin Coleman's team-leading 34. Here's a closer look at Randolph's production so far as a sophomore versus his time as a freshman.

1,000 AND COUNTING

Senior Justin Coleman notched his 1,000th career point against Oregon State in January. The Birmingham, Alabama native began his career at Alabama before transferring to Samford and eventually Arizona for his senior season. Coleman had 14 points against the Beavers and eight more against USC. He then popped off for 19 points at Arizona State and was 3 of 5 from 3-point range in the game. Coleman, who led Arizona in scoring against Washington and Washington State now has 1,118 points in his four-year career after a 10-point outing against Oregon State, five against Oregon and nine Saturday against Arizona State. As prolific of a scorer as Coleman has been in his career, it's his playmaking that has really taken off late this season. He's averaging more than five assists over his last five games. Against Colorado, Coleman tied his season high with nine assists, and then followed that up with eight helpers in a win over California. For the season, Coleman is 11th in the conference in assists and sixth in conference games only. He's sixth in assist-to-turnover ratio.

WELCOME BACK WILLIAMS

Freshman guard Brandon Williams has returned to Arizona's lineup after missing six games with a knee injury. Williams returned against Stanford and played 18 minutes in Arizona's win. Williams then played 20 minutes Thursday in a two-point win at Oregon State. He again played 20 minutes against Oregon, scoring 12 points on 3 of 6 shooting. He returned against the Cardinal and had four points, three assists and one rebound. Against Oregon State, his production picked up with 10 points, four rebounds, a pair of assists and one steal. He connected on two of three 3-point attempts. Williams was the team's leading scorer in conference games before the injury at 13.0 points per game. He's averaging 11.3 points per game in 25 games played this season. In conference games, Arizona is 7-4 with Williams in the lineup and 1-5 when he's out. With Williams, Arizona averages 71.1 points per game on .422 shooting in conference games. Without him, the Cats average 69.2 points per game on .408 shooting. Williams was named to the All-Pac-12 All-Freshman honorable mention squad. Williams was the only freshman in the league to earn at least three votes from coaches without making the All-Freshman first-team.

LUTHER LEADING THE WAY

Senior Ryan Luther, a graduate transfer from Pittsburgh, has been more aggressive lately, and it is paying off for the 6-foot-10-inch sharpshooter. Over Arizona's last five games, Luther is the team's leading scorer at 9.6 points per game. During that stretch, he has 10 3-pointers, which leads the team by three over his next closest teammate, Justin Coleman. Luther has scored in double figures in five of his last eight games and six of his last 10. Prior to that, Luther hadn't scored in double figures in back-to-back games the entire season. On the season, Luther has his 3-point percentage up to .373. He's shooting .372 from deep in conference games.

JETER HAVING STRONG DEBUT SEASON AT ARIZONA

Chase Jeter arrived at Arizona prior to the 2017-18 season after transferring from Duke, but had to sit out the season per NCAA rules. In his first 29 games as a Wildcat, Jeter has been a presence in the paint and a threat down low. Jeter is averaging 11.1 points per game and 6.6 rebounds a contest with five double-doubles. Jeter missed two games with a back injury and played just four minutes against Oregon State after suffering the injury. Jeter is shooting .589 from the floor, having connected on 126 of 214 shot attempts. He's fifth in the Pac-12 in field goal percentage. He entered Pac-12 play with a percentage of 65.7, which is the best by any Arizona player in pre-conference play since Jordan Hill also shot 65.7 percent on 99 attempts in 2007. Jeter has scored in double figures in 19 of the 29 games he has played in. Jeter posted his fifth double-double of the season against Oregon with 12 points and 10 rebounds. Prior to that, he was coming off a career night in Arizona's win

over California. Jeter had a career-high 23 points and added nine rebounds in 27 minutes. He was 8 for 11 from the floor and 7 of 8 from the free throw line. On the Bay Area trip, Jeter was 9 for 10 from the free throw line in the two wins and scored in double figures in both games. Jeter returned from injury against Arizona State and played 31 minutes off the bench. He had seven points and eight rebounds. In Arizona's second game against Cal, Jeter had perhaps his best game since returning from injury. He had 13 points on 6 of 8 shooting and added seven rebounds in 23 minutes. He then backed that up with 14 points and four rebounds in 21 minutes against Stanford before fouling out. Jeter was 7 of 10 from the free throw line. The 14 points were the most since he had his 23-point game against Cal in early January. Jeter had six points and six rebounds Thursday against Oregon State. He was limited to just six minutes in Saturday's game at Oregon with a knee bruise. Jeter had 11 points in 28 minutes Saturday against Arizona State.

TAKING CHARGE

Not only has Chase Jeter been productive scoring and rebounding, he's also been Arizona's top charge-getter this season. A play Coach Sean Miller values as much as any in basketball, Jeter has taken 27 charges in 29 games this season. Jeter took four charges in the finale in Maui against Auburn. Jeter had taken at least one charge in every game this season, until the Montana game. He also has at least two charges six times this season. Against Utah, Jeter drew two charges. He drew three against Arizona State on Saturday in the regular season finale. As a team, Arizona has taken 66 charges in 31 total games this season. Dylan Smith is also in double figures in charges with 14 on the season. He's second on the team to Jeter. Smith has taken a charge in three of Arizona's last five games. Against Stanford, sophomore Brandon Randolph took three charges, and then followed that up with another one against Oregon State.

SMITH'S STRONG SECOND SEASON

The pride of Mobile, Alabama, redshirt junior Dylan Smith is playing some of the best basketball of his career after a slow start to the season. In 13 non-conference games, Smith shot 29 percent from 3-point range, hitting 13 of 45 attempts. He averaged 5.1 points per game and shot 30 percent from the floor all total in 20.6 minutes per game. In 18 conference games, it's been a different story. Smith has greatly improved from deep. He connected on 32 of 79 attempts for a .405 percentage. He is averaging 26.7 minutes per game. Smith has had to play several different positions for the Wildcats with limited personnel at times. Smith started at the power forward position against USC, and often sees time at the small forward spot and shooting guard. Smith is 19 of 23 from the free throw line in Pac-12 games after going 13 for 21 in non-conference play. He has connected on 17 of his last 19 attempts. Smith missed a free throw against Stanford, marking his first miss since Jan. 17 against Oregon. Smith's 32 3-pointers in conference games are tied for most on the team. Smith has also hit at least one 3-pointer in 13 of his last 15 games. Smith has played more than 30 minutes in five of the past eight games. Prior, Smith had surpassed the 30-minute mark just once in the team's first 23 games of the season. Smith has also started nine straight games for Arizona.

Sean Miller led Team USA to a gold medal to the 2015 FIBA U-19 World Championships as head coach with a roster that included Arizona Wildcat Allonzo Trier. This came one summer after he helped guide the U.S. U-18 National Team to a gold medal at the FIBA Americas Championship as an assistant coach. The pair of gold medals he has earned as a coach are team with a third that he won one as a player at the 1991 World University Games in England.

MILLER AMONG NATION'S ELITE AT ADVANCING IN NCAA TOURNAMENT

Head coach Sean Miller has directed Arizona to its 18th Sweet 16 appearance in 2017, marking the program's fourth Sweet 16 appearance in the last five seasons. He led Xavier to Sweet 16 appearances in 2008 and 2009, giving him seven for his career. Since 2008, Miller is one of five coaches nationally to lead a team to seven Sweet 16 berths. He also has a 15-2 (.882) career record in the NCAA Tournament against lower-seeded teams.
