### LAST TIME OUT

In the final game of the series in Columbia, the Pelicans suffered a 16-3 loss to the Fireflies on Sunday evening as the two teams split the six-game series. The 16 runs allowed were the most this season by the Pelicans. **LHP Marino Santy** allowed eight runs with four being earned in his start that lasted just shy of two innings to take the loss. **DH Brian Kalmer** hit a two-run home run in the top of the sixth and **RF Rafael Morel** hit a solo homer in the top of the eighth for the Birds' only three runs.

### FIRST HALF CHAMPS

After starting the season 17-19, the Pelicans won 21 of their next 27 games and took home the Carolina League South First-Half title for a second consecutive season to clinch a playoff berth. During the stretch that began on May 20, the Pelicans tallied two winning streaks of six games or more, with a sweep against the Fayetteville Woodpeckers from May 23-28 and seven consecutive victories across the series against the Salem Red Sox and Augusta GreenJackets. The Pelicans are the defending Carolina League South division first-half champions, posting a 47-19 record through 66 games in the 2022 season. Come September, the Pelicans will make their 13th postseason appearance in franchise history after falling in the divisional round last season.

### PELICANS POWER

The Pelicans have hit 86 home runs as a team to lead the Carolina League, hit by 19 different players. **OF/1B Felix Stevens** held the team lead at 13, with **LF Andy Garriola** being the active leader with 12 as Stevens was promoted to High-A South Bend on June 20. Despite the high power numbers, the Birds have only hit 26 home runs in 53 games at Pelicans Ballpark, with 60 homers hit on the road. Myrtle Beach has launched eight grand slams this season, the most in a single season in franchise history.

### TOP BIRDS

Currently, the Pelicans roster features four of the Cubs top 30 prospects by MLB Pipeline. **LHP Jackson Ferris** leads the charge after being added to the roster on May 1 and comes in as the Cubs' No. 8 prospect. Ferris was a second-round draft pick in 2022 out of IMG Academy in Florida. **INF Jefferson Rojas** cracked the top-30 list in the middle of the season and now comes in at No. 11. Rojas is just 18 years old and signed as an international free agent in 2022. The infielder played just one game in the Arizona Complex League before reaching Single-A. **LHP Drew Gray** arrived to the Pelicans in mid-June and ranks as the No. 15 in the Cubs' system. Gray was a third round

draft pick in 2021 and sat out the entirety of 2022 with Tommy John surgery. **INF Cristian Hernandez** ranks as the No. 20 Cubs' prospect after being signed by the Cubs as an international free agent in 2021. Hernandez hit .261 through 44 games in the Arizona Complex League last season. 2022 Cubs' second-round pick **RHP Cade Horton** was ranked as the organization's No. 4 prospect before being promoted to High-A South Bend on May 9. Horton struck out 21 batters in 14.1 innings as a Pelican with a 1.26 ERA through four starts. Other names that appear on the list that spent time in Myrtle Beach in 2023 are No. 7 **C Moises Ballesteros**, No. 12 **RHP Michael Arias**, and No. 29 **RHP Brody McCullough**.

### BUDDY IS BACK

A familiar face will be leading the Pelicans in 2023 as **Buddy Bailey** returns to manage the club for his sixth year in Myrtle Beach. Bailey previously led the Pelicans from 2016-18 and 2021-22, and will be coaching his 17th season in the Cubs organization. During his Pelicans tenure, Bailey has recorded 418 wins, the most in franchise history. He has also guided the Birds to four half-season Southern Division Championship titles, one Southern Division Championship title, and the Carolina League Championship in 2016. In 2017, Bailey became just the 11th minor league manager to reach the 2,000-win plateau- he currently sits with 2,345. Bailey moved past Johnny Lipon for fourth place on the MiLB all-time wins list with a 6-5 walk-off win over Charleston on August 10, 2021 for his 2,186th victory. Bailey is the winningest active manager in MiLB, as 2023 will be his 35th season as a minor league manager.

### PELICAN POINTS

The Pelicans clinched a playoff spot by beating the Fredericksburg Nationals 8-2 on Sunday, June 18 to take home the Carolina League South First-Half title.

The Pelicans lead the Carolina league with 935 hits, averaging 8.3 hits per game.

For the first time ever, the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers will make their way to Pelicans Ballpark from August 23-27. In the last two seasons, the Pelicans have traveled to Kannapolis, losing three of five games from June 20-25 this year and taking four of six games from June 21-26 last season. Previously known as the "Intimidators", Kannapolis played in the Class A South Atlantic League from 1995-2020.
