LAST TIME OUT

The Pelicans posted their seventh shutout victory of the season with a 6-0 blanking of the Down East Wood Ducks on Thursday night. For the first time in his professional career, **1B Brian Kalmer** hit a home run in the top of the seventh. **CF Brett Bateman** also collected three hits, all singles. **RHP Yovanny Cabrera** picked up the win with 2.2 shutout innings out of the bullpen with three strikeouts. **RHP Luis Rujano** lasted 4.1 innings with a career-high six strikeouts in his start.

FIRST HALF CHAMPS

After starting the season 17-19, the Pelicans won 21 of their next 27 games and took home the Carolina League South First-Half title for a second consecutive season to clinch a playoff berth. During the stretch that began on May 20, the Pelicans tallied two winning streaks of six games or more, with a sweep against the Fayetteville Woodpeckers from May 23-28 and seven consecutive victories across the series against the Salem Red Sox and Augusta GreenJackets. The Pelicans are the defending Carolina League South division first-half champions, posting a 47-19 record through 66 games in the 2022 season. Come September, the Pelicans will make their 13th postseason appearance in franchise history after falling in the divisional round last season.

PELICANS POWER

The Pelicans have hit 73 home runs as a team, hit by 18 different players. **OF/1B Felix Stevens** holds the team lead at 13, with **OF Andy Garriola** and **OF Parker Chavers** being the active leaders with 10 as Stevens was promoted to High-A South Bend on June 20. Despite the high power numbers, the Birds have only hit 20 home runs in 47 games at Pelicans Ballpark, with 53 homers hit on the road. During a road trip in Augusta from July 4-9, where they hit 10 home runs as a team, the most in the Carolina League.

TOP BIRDS

Currently, the Pelicans roster features five of the Cubs top 30 prospects by MLB Pipeline. **LHP Jackson Ferris** leads the charge after being added to the roster on May 1 and comes in as the Cubs' No. 8 prospect. Ferris was a second-round draft pick in 2022 out of IMG Academy in Florida. **INF Cristian Hernandez** comes in at No. 9 after being signed by the Cubs as an international free agent in 2021. Hernandez hit .261 through 44 games in the Arizona Complex League last season. **INF Jefferson Rojas** cracked the top-30 list in the middle of the season, coming in at No. 15. Rojas is just 18 years old and signed

as an international free agent in 2022. The infielder played just one game in the Arizona Complex League before reaching Single-A. Another name on the list is Cubs' No. 21 prospect **INF Pedro Ramirez**. A 19-year-old on the Pelicans roster, Ramirez came to Myrtle Beach at the end of 2022 and played 10 games with a .268 average and just six strikeouts through 41 at-bats. **LHP Drew Gray** arrived to the Pelicans in mid-June and ranks as the No. 28 in the Cubs' system. Gray was a third round draft pick in 2021 and sat out the entirety of 2022 with Tommy John surgery. 2022 Cubs' second-round pick **RHP Cade Horton** was ranked as the organization's No. 4 prospect before being promoted to High-A South Bend on May 9. Horton struck out 21 batters in 14.1 innings as a Pelican with a 1.26 ERA through four starts.

BUDDY IS BACK

A familiar face will be leading the Pelicans in 2023 as **Buddy Bailey** returns to manage the club for his sixth year in Myrtle Beach. Bailey previously led the Pelicans from 2016-18 and 2021-22, and will be coaching his 17th season in the Cubs organization. During his Pelicans tenure, Bailey has recorded 409 wins, the most in franchise history. He has also guided the Birds to four half-season Southern Division Championship titles, one Southern Division Championship title, and the Carolina League Championship in 2016. In 2017, Bailey became just the 11th minor league manager to reach the 2,000-win plateau- he currently sits with 2,336. Bailey moved past Johnny Lipon for fourth place on the MiLB all-time wins list with a 6-5 walk-off win over Charleston on August 10, 2021 for his 2,186th victory. Bailey is the winningest active manager in MiLB, as 2023 will be his 35th season as a minor league manager.

PELICAN POINTS

The Pelicans clinched a playoff spot by beating the Fredericksburg Nationals 8-2 on Sunday, June 18 to take home the Carolina League South First-Half title.

The Pelicans lead the Carolina league with 809 hits, averaging 8.3 hits per game.

For the only time this season, the Pelicans travel to Kinston, N.C. for a six-game series with the Down East Wood Ducks. In their last visit, the Birds dropped four of six from August 16-21 during the 2022 season. The Pelicans have been consistently playing the Wood Ducks since their establishment in 2017.
