A LOOK BACK AT LAST SEASON

The Baysox finished the 2023 season with a 67-70 overall record. Bowie surged in the second half of the campaign, going 36-32, but ultimately missed out on the second-half title in the Southwest division by 4.5 games to the Richmond Flying Squirrels. The Baysox finished fourth in the Eastern League in team average (.242) and home runs (148). Last season was the third-consecutive campaign that the No. 1 prospect in baseball (per MLB Pipeline) took the field for the Baysox, as IF Jackson Holliday made his Double-A debut with Bowie in July. IF Coby Mayo also took home Eastern League MVP honors, as the Baysox slugger mashed an Eastern League-best 30 doubles in just 78 games, in addition to 49 extra-base hits - third-most in the league.

WE'RE TALKING ABOUT THE FIGHTINS

The Reading Fightin Phils enter 2024 off the back of a 59-77 season in 2023 - ultimately missing the Eastern League postseason. The Double-A Affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies, Reading is once again managed by Al Pedrique, who returns for his second season at the helm. The R-Phils' roster currently includes four of the Phillies' top 30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - OF Gabriel Rincones Jr. (No. 10 PHI), OF/1B Carlos De La Cruz (No. 13 PHI), C Caleb Ricketts (No. 21 PHI), IF Robert Moore (No. 26 PHI).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Southpaw Matt Osterberg gets the Opening Night nod for Reading. Osterberg saw 30.1 innings of action at Double-A last season, walking just six and striking out 30 after pitching to a 3.61 ERA through 92.1 innings at High-A Jersey Shore. Osterberg was a Phillies' Organizational All-Star in 2023, and capped off his season with Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honors following seven, two-hit, shutout frames against Binghamton on 9/14. Osterberg did make one appearance with Reading in 2022, but spent the entire rest of the season at High-A Clearwater. The Coleman, Wisconsin native is a 2021 15th round pick of the Phillies out of St. Cloud State University in

MEET THE SQUAD

The 2024 Baysox roster is headlined by a healthy returning cast. OFs Jud Fabian, John Rhodes, Donta' Williams; IF Billy Cook, Anthony Servideo and pitchers Carlos Tavera, Alex Pham, Houston Roth, Keagan Gillies, Brandon Young and Kade Strowd have all spent at least half a season in Bowie, while OF Dylan Beavers, IF TT Bowens and Collin Burns, C Connor Pavolony and Silas Ardoin and pitchers Trace Bright, Kyle Brnovich, Dylan Heid, Zach Peek and Ryan Long have all seen significant time with the Baysox. Newcomers to the squad include C Samuel Basallo, RHP Kyle Virbitsky, and IF Frederick Bencosme. Basallo (No. 2), Beavers (No. 7), RHP Seth Johnson (No. 10), Fabian (No. 12), Bright (No. 16), Rhodes (No. 23), Pham (No. 24), Bencosme (No. 27), and Cook (No. 30) rank in the Orioles' Top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline.

OPENING DAY HISTORY

The Baysox have had a bumpy stretch in recent openers. Bowie did enjoy a dominant 8-0 win on the road against the Hartford Yard Goats on last season's Opening Day. However, the Baysox have dropped five of their last eight Opening Day contests, dating back to 2014. More specifically, Bowie has come up on the short end in six of its last eight home openers, dating back to 2015, including a 7-4 loss to Akron in 2023.

20/20 VISION

Last season saw IF/OF Billy Cook (24 HR, 30 SB) become just the second player to achieve a 20 home run/20 stolen base season exclusively with the Baysox in the franchise's history (DJ Stewart - 2017). OF Jud Fabian (24 HR, 31 SB) also completed a 20/20 campaign in 2023 with his numbers between Bowie and High-A Aberdeen. Cook and Fabian notched just the second and third 20/20 seasons in the Orioles' minor league system since Stewart's feat in 2017, with the only other such season in that window coming from former Baysox OF Zach Watson in 2019.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF Dylan Beavers ended last season on a tear with the Baysox. After hitting .337 with a .443 OBP in August, winning Orioles Minor Leaguer of the Month for his debut month at the Double-A level, Beavers finished strong. His .321 average ranked second-highest in the Eastern League through the final two months of the 2023 season (min 130 PA), while his .417 OBP led the way. The 2022 first round pick out of Cal enters 2024 as the No. 7 prospect in the Orioles' system, per MLB Pipeline

BASALLO BLASTS

Orioles No. 2 prospect and No. 17 overall prospect (MLB Pipeline) Samuel Basallo is coming off a monster season. At just 19 years old, the phenom catcher finished fifth amongst Orioles minor leaguers in batting average (.313), and on-base percentage (.402), and second in slugging (.551) and OPS (.953) across three levels. Basallo took home MVP honors in the Single-A Carolina League last season, after hitting .299 with 12 home runs in 83 games.

2023: Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. .163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

2022: Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-toback rough outings, soon finding himself on the injured list for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season. Allowed one run in 2.1 innings of postseason action for Aberdeen.

2021: Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

Personal: Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing seventh in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yamouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebby joins the Baysox staff as the Fun damentals Coach in 2024. Sebby was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles' organization in 2022. Sebby played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

BILLY FACTEAU

Development Coach

A familiar face in Bowie, Facteau rejoins the Baysox staff in 2024. Facteau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022. Prior to his first stint with Bowie, Facteau first served in the Orioles' organization as a technology intern.
