LAST NIGHT'S RECAP

The Baysox dropped the series opener to the Hartford Yard Goats by a score of 5-4 from Dunkin' Park on Tuesday night. Hartford never trailed from the end of the third inning onward and scored a pair of runs each in the third and sixth innings to win its home opener. Connecticut native TT Bowens and Billy Cook drove in the only runs of the game as both collected two RBI each on the night. It was the first RBI of the season for Bowens and the first multi-RBI game for Cook of the season. However, Bowie grounded into a season-high three double plays, including in the sixth and eighth innings, to thwart a couple potential rallies in the game. RHP Brandon Young earned the start for the Baysox. The 25-year-old went 4.1 innings, allowed three runs on five hits and struck out seven, receiving a no decision. Young's seven K are the most by a Bowie starter so far this season.

A GLANCE AT THE GOATS

The Hartford Yard Goats are coming off a 57-76 campaign in 2023, finishing last overall in the Northeast division. The Baysox took two of three from the Yard Goats at Dunkin' Park to open last season in the only meeting between the two teams. The Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies, Hartford is led by first-year skipper Bobby Meacham. The Yard Goats roster includes four of the Rockies' top-six prospects, per MLB Pipeline - 2B Adael Amador (No. 1 COL), OF Yanquiel Fernandez (No. 3 COL), IF/OF Sterlin Thompson (No. 5 COL), and OF Zac Veen (No. 6 COL).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Andrew Quezada gets the ball on Wednesday for Hartford. Quezada spent all of last season with Double-A Hartford and finished with the fourth-most innings pitched (106.0) and tied for the fifth-most starts (20) in the Rockies' system. A 7th round pick by the Rockies in 2018 out of Cal State Fullerton, the Southern Calif. native enters his third stint with the Yard Goats.

FAMILIAR FACES

The Baysox have a couple individuals returning close to home this week. Both IF TT Bowens and first-year manager Roberto Mercado are Connecticut natives. Before joining the Orioles' organization in 2022, Mercado coached for 17 seasons at New Britain High School and led them to three conference championships, while also serving as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He currently resides in the offseason with his family in the Dunkin' Park area. Bowens is a New London native and played four years collegiately at Central Connecticut State, winning a pair of conference championships, before signing with the Orioles as an undrafted free agent, following the shortened 2020 draft.

WAY OF THE K

Baysox pitching is pacing the Eastern League in strikeouts through the first few games of the season, with 49 of them through four games, which is tied with New Hampshire for the most in the circut. The bullpen has shined in particular, accumulating 23 of the 37 strikeouts. Baysox relievers also sport the second lowest bullpen ERA (1.86 - 4 ER in 19.1 IP). Baysox relievers are holding opponents to just a .141 opposing average.

FEEL THE BURNS

Collin Burns enjoyed a career-night on Saturday, driving in a career-high seven RBI and was a double away from the cycle. He hit the first Baysox homer of 2024 with a three-run homer in the second inning, tripled in a run in the fourth and singled in a pair in the sixth. His home run was also his first at Double-A. The 6th round pick in the 2021 Draft by the Orioles is back healthy after playing just 9 games with Bowie last year.

EAVE IT TO BEAVERS.

OF Dylan Beavers ended last season on a tear with the Baysox. After hitting .337 with a .443 OBP in August, winning Orioles Minor Leaguer of the Month for his debut month at the Double-A level, Beavers finished strong. His .321 average ranked second-highest in the Eastern League through the final two months of the 2023 season (min 130 PA), while his .417 OBP led the way. The 2022 first round pick out of Cal enters 2024 as the No. 7 prospect in the Orioles' system, per MLB

BASALLO BLASTS

Orioles No. 2 prospect and No. 17 overall prospect (MLB Pipeline) Samuel Basallo is coming off a monster season. At just 19 years old, the phenom catcher finished fifth amongst Orioles minor leaguers in batting average (.313), and on-base percentage (.402), and second in slugging (.551) and OPS (.953) across three levels, Basallo took home MVP honors in the Single-A Carolina League last season, after hitting .299 with 12 home runs in 83 games.

No. 10 Orioles prospect via MLB Pipeline

Enters season fully healthy for first time since '22 after rehabbing from TJ surgery in '23 Traded from TB to BAL on 8/1/22 in three-team deal that sent Trey Mancini to HOU Arsenal: Fastball (94-96), Curveball (75-79), Slider (Mid-High 80s), Changeup (86-89)

2023: Placed on 60-day injured list to begin season by Triple-A Norfolk. Sent on rehab assignment to FCL Orioles on August 19. Made one start before being sent to Single-A Delmarva on August 22. Made one start with Shorebirds, then assigned to High-A Aberdeen on August 29. Made two starts with IronBirds. Struck out five in three shutout innings on Sept. 6 vs Greenville. Assigned to Double-A Bowie on Sept. 13. Struck out four in three innings, allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits and two walks in lone start of season against Harrisburg.

2022: Started season in High-A Bowling Green. Made seven starts and struck out 41 batters over 27 innings to an ERA of 3.00. Placed on injured list in late May with right forearm inflammation before discovering that he suffered a torn UCL and needed Tommy John surgery. Traded from TB to BAL in a three team deal on August 1 that sent Trey Mancini to Houston.

2021: Entered first full season in minors with Single-A Charleston. Made 23 appearances (16 starts), pitched 93.2 innings and struck out 115 batters, good for fourth in the TB system. Posted an ERA of just 2.88 and allowed 33 walks.

2019: Debuted professionally with TB rookie ball affiliates in Princeton and GCL Rays.

College/Personal: Drafted by the Rays out of Campbell with the 40th overall selection in the 2019 Draft. At the time, was the highest-drafted player in Campbell history. A former two-way player at Louisburg (N.C) junior college as a shortstop before committing to pitching full time at Campbell.

The "Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake" are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión TM" or "Fun Cup TM" During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet activation Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yamouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach
