TONIGHT'S GAME: The Modesto Nuts (Mariners) continue a six-game set with the Fresno Grizzlies (Rockies). The Nuts have won 13 of their last 14 games since they ended a five-game losing streak. The Nuts had their ten-game winning streak snapped on Tuesday. The last time the Nuts had a ten-game winning streak snapped, they went 9-21 in their next 30 games falling from their best record of the year (34-22) to their worst record of the year (43-43). Today, the Nuts are 12-games over .500 to match their best record of the season.

KEEP IT IN THE YARD: *Brett Rodriguez* snapped a long homerless drought for the Nuts on Wednesday. Modesto had gone seven games and 87 hits between home runs before the go-ahead two-run homer that he hit in the third inning on Wednesday. Prior to that homer drought, the Nuts averaged one home run per 11 hits. The *B. Rodriguez* home run is still the only Nuts' home run since Tuesday, August 17th. That's one home run in nine games. Of the last 111 hits recorded by the Nuts, only one has left the yard.

STREAKING: The Nuts second ten-game winning streak was snapped on 8/24. The Nuts had also won ten in a row from June 26th to July 7th this year before the Ports snapped their streak on July 8th. The Nuts' ten-game winning streaks are the second longest streak in Nuts' history dating back to 2005 when they transitioned to the Nuts from the Modesto A's. In 2005 they won eleven consecutive games from June 21st to July 6th. Troy Tulowitzki was the starting SS during that stretch. We have not confirmed the longest winning streak in franchise history because we know the Modesto A's had a 13-game winning streak in 1992 and a 13-game winning streak in 1982 when they set a franchise record in wins.

SOULS ROYCE: The Nuts offense leads the league in walks (478 - +49 over RC). In the first four games of this series, the Nuts have taken 33 walks in 36 innings against the Grizzlies.

STREAKING: *Corey Rosier*, who was named Low-A West Player of the Week (8/16-22) is on a eleven-game hitting streak batting .500/.537/.705 (22x44) 13 R 4 2B 1 3B 1 HR 12 RBI 7 BB 7 K. He has seven multi-hit games during that stretch and three consecutive multi-hit games... *James Parker* had his 14-game hitting streak snapped on Sunday. It was the longest streak by a member of the Nuts this year... *Alberto Rodriguez* had his eleven-game hitting streak ended on Thursday night after hitting .367/.426/.633 (18x49) 10 R 5 2B 1 3B 2 HR 12 RBI 5 BB 10 K.

LOW-A WEST SHERIFF: OF *Alberto Rodriguez* has ten outfield assists this year which is twice as many as the next closest outfielder in the league.

PORTS SERIES REVIEW: In game six, it was the second game of a doubleheader. The Nuts won 5-4 in eight innings. *Andy Thomas* won the game for the Nuts with a walk-off sac fly to score *Colin Davis*. *Davis* scored the winning run in all three walk-off wins against Stockton in the series... In game five, it was the first game of a doubleheader. *Jimmy Kingsbury* tossed five shutout innings to earn his first pro win in the Nuts' 10-0 victory... In game four on Saturday night, the Nuts won 10-7 on 15 hits. *Sam Carlson* struck out eight batters. *Noelvi Marte* scored three runs. *Colin Davis* recorded three RBI. *Spencer Packard* and *Cesar Izturis Jr.* recorded three hits... In game three on Friday night, the Nuts won 6-5 in walk-off fashion again. The Nuts came back from a 2-0 deficit and a 5-2 deficit to win their seventh straight game. The only time the Nuts lead was on the final play of the game when *Eric Jones* delivered a walk-off RBI single... In game two on Thursday night, the Nuts won 13-12 in walk-off fashion coming back from a seven-run deficit. *Ty Duvall* was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded in the bottom of the ninth to score *Colin Davis*. The Nuts recorded a season-high seven doubles. The seven-run comeback was the largest comeback by the Nuts this season... The game on Wednesday night was postponed due to poor air quality. It will be made up as part of a doubleheader that starts at 2:05pm on Sunday afternoon... In game one on Tuesday, the Nuts won 11-4 while *Josias De Los Santos* tossed a quality start and both *Corey Rosier* & *Alberto Rodriguez* homered.

NEW RULES: For the 2021 season. Pitchers get two step offs or pickoffs per plate appearance. On the third they must record an out or a balk is ruled... Pitch clock of 15 second without runners on and 17 seconds with runners on. Hitters must be alert to pitcher at the 8 second mark. Pitchers must begin delivery before zero. Penalty is an auto ball to pitcher or auto strike to hitter... There will be playoffs in Low-A West this year. The two best overall records, regardless of division, will meet in a best-of-five series starting on Sept. 21st.

Injury Timeline:

2017 - Pitched in two games and three innings after draft before experiencing elbow pain that would keep him out until 2021.

2018 – After an offseason of rehab, received a platelet rich plasma injection in February. Resumed throwing in early summer '18 before elbow pain returned. Underwent Tommy John Surgery on July 2nd, '18.

2019 - In August, 13 months after TJ surgery, felt elbow pain and he thought he tore his UCL again. It turned out to be an impingement in his elbow but he did not pitch in MiLB that season.

2020 - Healthy and ready to pitch before COVID-19 shutdown. Spent summer throwing with nine other pitchers in the organization at Elon in North Carolina with Sean McGrath. Learned to throw a curveball in that time. Spent time during rehab taking business management classes at Arizona State University. Has a junior standing entering 2021 season.
