TONIGHT'S GAME: The Modesto Nuts (Mariners) continue a six-game set with the Fresno Grizzlies (Rockies). The Nuts have won 13 of their last 14 games since they ended a five-game losing streak. The Nuts had their ten-game winning streak snapped on Tuesday. The last time the Nuts had a ten-game winning streak snapped, they went 9-21 in their next 30 games falling from their best record of the year (34-22) to their worst record of the year (43-43). That's one home run in nine games. Of the last 111 hits recorded by the Nuts, only one has left the yard.

STREAKING: The Nuts second ten-game winning streak was snapped on $8 / 24$.
