OF Kennie Taylor was sent to Tacoma (AAA) for a fill-in spot with INF Liam Sabino joining the Nuts from the ACL (Rk)... 1B Dariel Gomez was promoted to Everett ( $\mathrm{A}+$ ) on Friday. UTL Eric Jones joins Modesto from the ACL-Mariners (Rk). He was recently signed out of Independent Baseball where he was playing with the Gateway Grizzlies. Jones played collegiately at Davidson College where he went undrafted in 2019 despite hitting . 351 AVVG as a senior.

GIANTS SERIES NOTES: After suffering four consecutive blowout losses, the Nuts lost two late leads in their last two game of the Giants series. On Saturday, Patrick Bailey launched a go-ahead two-run homer in the eighth inning. On Sunday, Jairo Pomares lifted a go-ahead two-run homer in the ninth inning with two outs.

HOT JULY: Robert Perez Jr. is the only member of the Nuts batting over .300 in July while leading the team in hits, bases, home runs and RBI. Overall, he has posted a line of . 346 (18x52) . 426 OBP . 673 SLG 4 HR 15 RBI 4 BB 14 K.

WEIGHT PEN: The Nuts bullpen has done some heavy lifting in the month of July. Of the 145 innings thrown by Nuts' pitchers this month, 100 innings have been thrown by relievers and only 45 of them have been thrown by the five pitchers who are considered full-time starters.

NEW RULES: For the 2021 season. Pitchers get two step offs or pickoffs per plate appearance. On the third they must record an out or a balk is ruled... Pitch clock of 15 second without runners on and 17 seconds with runners on. Hitters must be alert to pitcher at the 8 second mark. Pitchers must begin delivery before zero. Penalty is an auto ball to pitcher or auto strike to hitter.

PLAYOFFS: It was announced last week that there will be playoffs in Low-A West this year. The two best overall records, regardless of division, will meet in a best-of-five series starting on Sept. $21^{\text {st }}$. The Nuts are currently nine games back of a playoff spot.

STREAKING: The Nuts' ten-game winning streak is the second longest streak in Nuts' history dating back to 2005 when they transitioned to the Nuts from the Modesto A's. In 2005 they won eleven consecutive games from June $21^{\text {st }}$ to July $6^{\text {th }}$. Troy Tulowitzki was the starting SS during that stretch. We have not confirmed the longest winning streak in franchise history be we know the Modesto A's recorded a 13-game winning streak in 1982 when they set a franchise record in wins. The excerpt from The Sporting News on September 6th, 1982 read "Helped by a 13-game winning streak, Modesto (California) shattered the club's all-time record for most wins in a season on August 21 when the A's defeated Redwood for victory No. 89. The old record of 88 was set in 1954 and tied in 1966 by a team that included Reggie Jackson, Rollie Fingers, Joe Rudi, Dave Duncan, Skip Lockwood and Tony LaRussa." The 1982 team would win 94 games, a mark later broken in 1994 (96 wins), set the single-season attendance record and win the California League Championship over the Visalia Oaks. It was their sixth California League Championship. Modesto has nine total championships in their history with the most recent coming in 2017, their first year as a Mariners affiliate. The longest winning streak in the history of the California League is 26 games done in 1947 from June 4 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ to July $1^{\text {st }}$ by the Stockton Ports.
