PAC-12 TIPOFF

FOUR TO 23 WINS: With COLORADO's NIT second-round victory, the Pac-12 now has four teams to reach the 23-win plateau for the sixth consecutive season and seventh time since expanding to 12 teams eight season ago in 2011-12.

► Prior to expansion, the league had four teams reach 23 wins only twice (2000-01, 2006-07).

► The league-high for 23-win teams came in 2011-12 with six.

► Should Colorado advance to the NIT Championship game, the Pac-12 would have three 25-win teams for just the eighth time in Conference history.

SIDELINE REPORT: Pac-12 sidelines will have a different look in 2019-20 as three head coach positions are currently vacant across the league - CALIFORNIA, UCLA and WASHINGTON STATE.

► It marks the first time since 2014-15 that the Conference will have three new head coaches.

► Two Pac-12 coaches recently signed contract extensions in OREGON's Dana Altman (through 2025-26) and WASHINGTON's Mike Hopkins (through 2024-25).

1, 2, 3 in 4: OREGON became only the second team in Pac-12 Tournament history to win four games in four days on its way to the Conference tournament title, joining Colorado in 2012.

► The Ducks are the first program to knock off the tournament's top three seeds - No. 1 seed Washington (68-48), No. 2 seed Arizona State (79-75 OT), No. 3 seed Utah (66-54) - en route to the Conference's tourney title and automatic bid.

Two Pac-12 teams remain alive in the 2019 postseason:

► OREGON: The No. 12 seed in NCAA Tournament South Regional advanced to the Sweet 16 for the third time in the last four seasons, fourth time under coach Dana Altman (2013, 2016, 2017, 2019) and ninth time in program history. The Ducks are seeking their seventh Elite 8 appearance, third Final Four (1939, 2017) trip and second NCAA Championship (1939).

► COLORADO: The No. 4 seed making its 11th all-time NIT appearance advanced to the round of 8 for the third time in program history (1991, 2011, 2019). The Buffaloes are seeking their fifth-ever NIT trip to Madison Square Garden (1938, 1940, 1991, 2011) and second NIT title (1940).

The Pac-12 has advanced a team to the Sweet 16 in six of the past seven seasons. The ACC, Big 12, Big Ten and SEC are the only leagues to have a Sweet 16 team each of the last seven seasons.

► Should Oregon advance to the Elite 8, it would mark the fifth time in the last six seasons the Pac-12 advanced a team to the Regional Final. Only the ACC could match that total.

Four Pac-12 postseason teams have combined for a 6-2 record (.750) through two rounds of tourney play.

► Among the 11 leagues with multiple NCAA Tournament participants, the Pac-12 is second in terms of combined (NCAA, NIT, CBI) postseason win percentage trailing only the ACC (13-3, .813).

OREGON is tied with Auburn for the nation's longest active win streak at 10 consecutive games after the Ducks halted what was the longest stretch in the country by ending UC Irvine's 17-game win streak.

► Oregon is allowing just 54.2 points, 34.9% FG and 23.0% 3FG during its 10-game win streak, lowering its season scoring defense from 65.5 to a league-leading and NCAA 12th-best 62.5 in the process.

331

WASHINGTON's **Matisse Thybulle**, among four finalists for Naismith Trophy Defensive Player of the Year, concluded his career with 331 steals, the most in Pac-12 history and 17th-most in NCAA Division I history.

► Thybulle recorded 126 steals this season, the most in a season in Conference history and 10th-most in a season in NCAA Division I history.

► Thybulle is the only D-I player in the top 50 nationally in both steals (1st, 3.50) and blocks (19th, 2.28).

► Since 1992-93, Thybulle is the only NCAA Division I player with multiple 100-steal/40-block seasons and the only player with 120+ steals and 80+ blocks in a season and 300+ steals and 150+ blocks in a career.

PAC-12 IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

The Pac-12 Conference has won 16 NCAA basketball titles, second-most of any conference behind only the ACC (17) . . . Oregon's Tall Firs won the first NCAA Championship in 1939. Stanford claimed the national title in 1942, followed by Utah in 1944 and California in 1959 . . . UCLA established a basketball dynasty that included 10 titles in 12 seasons and a winning streak of seven consecutive NCAA crowns . . . In 1997, Arizona became the sixth different Pac-12 institution to capture the NCAA basketball title.

PAC-12 IN THE POSTSEASON NIT

The Pac-12 has had considerable success in the National Invitation Tournament (NIT), as five current members have captured the NIT crown - Colorado (1940), Utah (1947), UCLA (1985), Stanford (1991, 2012, 2015) and California (1999). Colorado also finished second in 1938, as did Utah in 1974 and 2018. Meanwhile third-place finishes were turned in by Oregon in 1975 and 2004, Colorado in 1991 and 2011, Utah in 1992, Washington in 2012 and Washington State in 2011. The league now stands at 109-89 (.551) in America's original postseason tourney. The records of all Pac-12 members in the NIT:

Sparked by do-everything point guard **Payton Pritchard**, Oregon shut down Washington 68-48 on March 16 to become the second team to win four games in four days at the Pac-12 Tournament.

"In my 39 years in coaching, I've never seen a team grow up that much that fast," Oregon coach **Dana Altman** said.

Sparked by a lineup change that ignited a late four-game win streak to close the regular season, Oregon set tournament records for largest margin (+69), most points (297), field goals (107), steals (36) and blocks (23), and was clearly the best team on the floor all four days in Sin City.

"Game in game out, we just came prepared," said Pritchard, named tournament MOP after finishing with 20 points, seven assists, six rebounds and four steals in the title game. "Fatigue never hit us."

PAC-12 MOMENTUM

Pac-12 men's basketball has experienced some of its most competitive campaigns over the past several years:

- 2018-19:
 - The Pac-12 boasted some of the best incoming talent in Division I basketball, including eight top 40 recruiting classes featuring 10 freshmen rated as Top 50 recruits and 19 Top 100 newcomers, both second-best nationally.
- 2017-18:
 - The Pac-12 had seven programs reach the 20-win plateau in 2017-18, equaling the most in league history.
 - The Pac-12 sent a Conference-record tying eight teams to the postseason (three NCAA, five NIT) for the fourth time in the past six seasons.
 - The Pac-12 had a Conference-record nine teams finish in the RPI top 100, the second time in the past three seasons the league accomplished the feat.
 - The Pac-12 produced a consensus All-American (Arizona's Deandre Ayton) for the fifth consecutive season, a feat matched only by the ACC. Ayton went on to become the league's second straight No. 1 overall NBA Draft selection.
- 2016-17:
 - Oregon reached the NCAA Final Four, the first Pac-12 school to advance to national semifinals since 2008.
 - Pac-12 posted a 10-4 record in NCAA Tournament play, its most tourney wins since 2007 and the third-most of any league (ACC & SEC - 11).
 - A Pac-12 program advanced to the Elite Eight for the fourth straight year.
 - A national-best three teams (Arizona, Oregon, UCLA) finished in the top 10 of the Associated Press and ESPN/USA Today Coaches polls.
 - Four Associated Press All-Americans, the most of any conference in the country and tied for most in league history (1975).
 - League record and national-best 14 selections in the NBA Draft, including Nos. 1 & 2 overall picks in Markelle Fultz and Lonzo Ball. Fultz was the league's first No. 1 pick since Bill Walton in 1974.
- 2015-16:
 - A league-record seven teams earned NCAA Tournament bids.
 - Four teams ranked in the final Associated Press Top 25 poll, the most for the league since 2007.
 - Nine teams finished season in top 100 of NCAA RPI, the most in Conference history.

► Seven former Pac-12 men's basketball standouts were selected in the 2018 NBA Draft, including the No. 1 overall selection in ARIZONA's Deandre Ayton. It marked the first time in Conference history the league has had the No. 1 pick in the NBA Draft in back-to-back years.

Ayton was the No. 1 overall selection by the Phoenix Suns, joining WASHINGTON's Markelle Fultz in 2018 and UCLA's Bill Walton in 1974 and Lew Alcindor (Kareem Abdul-Jabbar) in 1969 as top picks from Conference members. UTAH's Andrew Bogut (2005) and Bill McGill (1962) were No. 1 picks prior to the Utes joining the Pac-12.

► The seven selections coupled with the 14 picks from last year's Draft matched the league's two-year record total of 21 set in 2008-09.

► Over the past six Drafts, the Pac-12 has amassed 49 picks overall and 26 first-round selections, totals which rank second nationally behind the 15-team ACC (62, 36).



► Pac-12 members were well represented by alumni and former players during the 2018 NBA Playoffs with 37 players (2nd only to ACC's 42) on 13 playoff teams and representing 11-of-12 league programs.

► The 2018 NBA Eastern and Western Conference Finals series between Cleveland and Boston, and Golden State and Houston, featured 12 former Pac-12 standouts, the most of any league.

► For the third straight year, the Pac-12 also led the way in the NBA Finals between the Cleveland Cavaliers and champion Golden State Warriors.

STRUCTURE-SEEDING & TIE-BREAKING PROCEDURES

Seeding: The seedings and pairings shall be determined upon completion of regular season play on Saturday, March 9. The won-lost percentage record of the teams in regular season Conference play will determine tournament seedings. The team with the best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #1, the next best won-lost percentage in Conference play will be seeded #2, and so forth through all the seeds.

Tie-Breakers: Tie breaking procedures for determining all tournament seeding will be:

1. Two-team tie

a. Results of head-to-head competition during the regular season.
b. Each team's record (won-lost percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (won-lost percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

c. Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
d. Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.

2. Multiple-team tie

a. Results (won-lost percentage) of collective head-to-head competition during the regular season among the tied teams.
b. If more than two teams are still tied, each of the tied team's record (won-lost percentage) vs. the team occupying the highest position in the final regular season standings, and then continuing down through the standings, eliminating teams with inferior records, until one team gains an advantage.

When arriving at another group of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record (won-lost percentage) against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to that group's own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against individual tied teams.

If at any point the multiple-team tie is reduced to two teams, the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

c. Won-lost percentage against all Division I opponents.
d. Coin toss conducted by the Commissioner or designee.
