30-WIN TRIO: OREGON's program-record 33 victories were tied for the fourth-most in a season in Conference history, while ARIZONA and UCLA also recorded win totals in the top 10 in league annals.

WEST COAST AP-PRECIATION:

Four Pac-12 standouts were named to one of the three AP All-America Teams, which were the most selections of any conference in the country and tied for the most-ever by the Conference along with four AP All-Americans in 1975.

Ball is the first Conference player to earn AP First Team All-America accolades since James Harden in 2009. Additionally, Ball (1st Team) and Brooks (2nd) are the first pair of Consensus All-Americans from the Conference since Brandon Roy (WASH) and Leon Powe (CAL) in 2006.

2016-17 #PAC12HOOPS HIGHLIGHTS

1 OREGON's trip to the Final Four gave the Conference its first entry since 2008 and marked the first time in NCAA Tournament history that two teams from the Pacific Time Zone, along with Gonzaga, participated in the national semifinals.

3 Three Pac-12 teams finished the season ranked in the top 10 of the Associated Press and USA Today/ESPN Coaches polls in #9/3 OREGON, #4/7 ARIZONA and #8/9 UCLA.

>> For the first time since the start of the USA Today Coaches postseason poll in 1994, three Conference teams concluded the season in the top 10.

>> The league placed three teams in the AP top 10 for seven weeks in 2016-17, equaling the longest stretch in league history: 1997-98 (12/23/97 - 2/3/98); 2016-17 (1/23/17, 2/6/17 - 3/13/17).

3x30 For the first time in the Conference's 101-season history, three teams reached at least 30 overall victories.

4x25 >> USC set a program record with 26 wins to give the Conference four 25-win teams in a single season for just the second time in its 101-season history (2006-07).

4 Four consecutive years the Pac-12 has advanced a team to the Elite Eight - the only conference in the country to accomplish the feat (2014 & 2015 - ARIZONA; 2016 & 2017 - OREGON).

>> The Pac-12 also had multiple Sweet 16 participants for the fourth time in the last five years.

10-4 The Pac-12 posted a 10-4 record (.714) during the 2017 NCAA Tournament, the second-best win percentage (WCC - .750) and third-most victories of any conference (ACC & SEC - 11).

>> The 10 tournament victories were the most for the league since 2007 and tied for fourth-most ever in Conference history (13 - 2001, 1997; 11 - 1998; 10 - 2017, 2007).

PAC-12 TIPOFF

A KIDD NAMED BALL: UCLA's **Lonzo Ball** was named the USBWA Wayman Tisdale National Freshman of the Year. He's the third Conference player to receive the organization's honor along with CALIFORNIA's **Jason Kidd** in 1993 and ARIZONA's **Jason Gardner** in 2000.

YOUTH MOVEMENT: Seven of the 16 Pac-12 Player of the Week awards went to freshmen, tying the most in a season since the award was created in 1983, matching the seven rookie selections from a 2007-08 campaign that featured the likes of future NBA lottery picks **Jerryd Bayless**, **James Harden**, **Kevin Love** and **O.J. Mayo**.

DRAWING A CROWD: This season's 108-game Pac-12 regular-season late drew an average of 8,737 fans per game, besting the previous Pac-12 mark of 8,380 set during 2015-16.

MUST-SEE MATCHUPS: The 2016-17 Pac-12 season featured eight clashes between ranked teams, the most in the league since 2007-08 including the seventh meeting of top-5 teams (#5 UCLA at #4 Arizona) in Conference history.

RECORD WATCH

OREGON set a new single-season league record with 248 blocked shots, shattering the previous mark of 225 set by WASHINGTON last season.

UCLA recorded the highest team assist average (21.4 apg) in the Conference since assists became an official NCAA statistic in 1983-84. UCLA's 771 total assists are the most recorded in league history.

UCLA (354) set a new Conference single-season three-pointers made mark, while ARIZONA STATE (328) and OREGON (327) joined the Bruins in becoming only the fourth, fifth and sixth teams in league history to reach 300 threes in a season.

UCLA's 1,210 made field goals eclipsed the previous record of 1,161 set by the Bruins' 1968 team.

With 274 assists, UCLA's **Lonzo Ball** shattered the Pac-12 freshman single-season assists mark and ranks second on the all-time single-season list.

With a new Conference freshman-record 23.2 points per game, WASHINGTON's **Markelle Fultz** became the first freshman to lead the league in scoring since CALIFORNIA's **Shareef Abdur-Rahim** in 1995-96. Fultz is only the third freshman to pace the league in scoring along with **Abdur-Rahim** and **Cliff Robinson** (USC, 1977-78).

UCLA's **Bryce Alford** entered the Pac-12 career top 10 in three-point field goals as his 329 triples are third-most all-time. Alford's 1,922 career points rank 24th in Conference history.

UCLA's **Bryce Alford** (116 3FG) and ARIZONA STATE's **Torian Graham** (108 3FG) cracked the Conference's single-season top 10 in made threes, finishing in second and seventh places, respectively.

OREGON junior **Jordan Bell** (235 blocks) moved into fifth on the Pac-12's career blocked shots list, while COLORADO senior **Wesley Gordon** (204 blocks) climbed to eighth.

WASHINGTON STATE's **Josh Hawkinson** became only the 13th member of the Pac-12 1,000-rebound club, climbing to 12th with 1,015 caroms.

2017 PAC-12 TOURNAMENT



Allonzo Trier was named Most Outstanding Player in helping No. 7 Arizona outlast No. 5 Oregon 83-80 on Saturday, March 11 in the Pac-12 Tournament championship game. It marked the first Conference title game between two AP top 10 opponents.

The Wildcats and Trier - who missed three of Arizona's four losses due to a 19-game suspension - got their payback by avenging their only two regular-season league losses to UCLA and Oregon en route to a sixth tourney title and second in the last three seasons.

In the event's first year in Las Vegas' new T-Mobile Arena, the tournament set records for highest-attended quarter-final session (18,153, Session 4), highest-ever single-session attendance (19,224, Session 5), and total all-session attendance (86,910).

PAC-12 IN THE POSTSEASON NIT

The Pac-12 has had considerable success in the National Invitation Tournament (NIT), as five current members have captured the NIT crown - Colorado (1940), Utah (1947), UCLA (1985), Stanford (1991, 2012, 2015) and California (1999). Colorado also finished second in 1991, as did Utah in 1974. Meanwhile third-place finishes were turned in by Oregon in 1975 and 2004, Colorado in 1955 and 2011, Utah in 1992, and Washington State in 2011.
