## PAC-12 MEN'S BASKETBALL SENDS THREE TEAMS TO SWEET SIXTEEN

### Arizona Reaches Elite Eight, Achieved No. 1 Ranking Eight Consecutive Weeks

### Arizona's Johnson, UCLA's Anderson Collect All-America Honors

- The ARIZONA Wildcats captured their 13th Pac-12 regular season title, and first since the 2011 season, while the UCLA Bruins won their fourth Pac-12 Tournament title as they defeated Arizona in the championship game, 75-71.
- A league-record eight teams posted 20-wins during the 2013-14 campaign. The highly-competitive Pac-12 season rewarded the league with a record-tying six teams (ARIZONA, ARIZONA STATE, COLORADO, OREGON, STANFORD, UCLA) selected to participate in NCAA Tournament. Arizona obtained a coveted No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament. It was the first time a Pac-12 team earned one of the four No. 1 seeds since UCLA in 2008, and the sixth time the Wildcats were the Tournament's No. 1 seed. The Pac-12 showed it was worthy of the six selections as it compiled a 8-6 record in the NCAA Tournament with Arizona, Stanford and UCLA each reaching the Sweet Sixteen, with the Wildcats advancing to the Elite Eight before dropping a one-point overtime decision to Wisconsin. The eight wins in the NCAA Tournament were the most by the league since it posted an identical 8-6 mark in 2008.
- Arizona's **Nick Johnson** and **Aaron Gordon**, and UCLA's **Kyle Anderson** picked up several All-America honors as Johnson earned consensus honors after being selected first team All-America by USBWA, NABC and The Sporting News, as well as the Wooden Award All-America team.
- New look in 2014-15 for two Pac-12 teams as **Ernie Kent** will take over the reigns at WASHINGTON STATE and CALIFORNIA will have a new successor to replace **Mike Montgomery**, who retired after 32 years as a college head coach. Montgomery compiled a 677-316 record in 32 seasons (eight at Montana, 18 at Stanford, and six at California). His 282 wins in league play were third only to Hall-of-Famers Arizona's Lute Olson (327) and UCLA's John Wooden (305). On April 15, California hired **Cuonzo Martin** to replace Montgomery. Meanwhile, Kent returns to the coaching ranks for the first time since he was at Oregon from 1998-2010. Kent's career record stands at 325-254 in 19 seasons as a head coach.

**Sweet Sixteen Appearances:** A Pac-12 team has reached the Sweet Sixteen in nine of the last 10 NCAA Tournaments, and 24 of the last 27 NCAA Tournaments. Since 1975 when the NCAA Tournament expanded the field to 32 teams, Arizona and UCLA have each appeared in 17 Sweet Sixteens, while Stanford has appeared in five.

## PAC-12 TOURNAMENT RECAP

### UCLA Bruins Capture Pac-12 Tournament Crown

LAS VEGAS – On paper, Saturday's Pac-12 Tournament championship game between tournament No. 1 seed Arizona and No. 2 UCLA looked like a relatively even matchup. But no scouting could predict just how close the Bruins' 75-71 win over the Wildcats would play out.

The two squads combined for only 15 turnovers in a game that provided great drama from the opening tip. It was decided by a mere few missed Arizona opportunities and clutch plays by UCLA -- the kinds of plays that scouting reports cannot foresee.

"Everybody always focuses on the last play or last plays," Arizona coach Sean Miller said. "There were 150 in the game that could have tilted it in either person's favor.

"It was a war from start to finish."

UCLA took an early lead, weathered a strong Arizona middle 20 minutes, and kicked all the way through the finish line – forward Travis Wear running half the length of the court and diving on the court for a loose ball in the last two minutes represented the intensity of the game as a whole.

The scoreboard read 68-all with 3:40 left in the game, and it remained there for the next three minutes as two fatigued teams clawed at one another on the defensive end.

It was UCLA that benefitted the most despite Arizona coming in as the known defensive power. Armed with four timeouts in the final four minutes, UCLA coach Steve Alford asked his team to play one one-minute battle at a time.

"We'll break it up into maybe four one-minute games, but let's go as hard as we can," he said. "We'll give you Sunday, Monday off, but let's get after it here in these last four minutes."

The Bruins took three UA turnovers in the final three minutes and after the final Arizona miscue finally made the Wildcats pay. Out of a timeout with 43 seconds left, Jordan Adams hit a difficult three-point shot above the left side of the arc, and Arizona couldn't convert on three consecutive three-point looks to force overtime. UCLA hit its free throws down the stretch to make it a two-possession game.

"It's our money play," Alford said of the drawn-up look for Adams. "It's a 2-for-1 situation. I don't like giving the other team, a team like that, the last shot."

Adams finished with 19 points, but teammate Anderson was at the forefront of the Bruins' success. He scored 21, grabbed 15 rebounds, and dolled out five assists.

"I got news for whoever draws them in the NCAA Tournament," Miller said. "Kyle Anderson and Jordan Adams – good luck."

Arizona's free throw troubles bit them and it struggled to score with the game in the balance. The Wildcats' only score in the final five minutes came on a late three-pointer by Nick Johnson, which cut a five-point deficit to two with less than a second remaining.

Arizona opened the game with a starting lineup change. Rondae Hollis-Jefferson was in and Gabe York was out, and the Wildcats' offense struggled to get looks without many shooters on the court. UCLA led 14-3 early and forced three early turnovers, but Arizona's Elliott Pitts and Gabe York opened things up off the bench, hitting 4-for-6 from deep to allow for more space for Aaron Gordon and Kaleb Tarczewski to operate inside.

By halftime, the Bruins' lead was down to 43-40, but their offense was smoking by hitting 58 percent of its shots. That cooled to 43 percent for the game as Arizona held their opponents to just 26 percent shooting in the second half, but it wasn't enough.

The Wildcats tied the game at 46 on a dunk by Tarczewski, and the rest of the second half was a back-and-forth affair. The two squads had seven ties and 10 lead changes, most of which came in the final 20 minutes.

Nick Johnson led the Wildcats with 22 points and Gordon added 11 points, eight rebounds and eight assists. Both teams await their NCAA tournament fate on Sunday, and both see the Pac-12 Championship as a valuable lesson.

"To be able to score 75 on this team, we've actually done it twice this year," Alford said. "And I think Arizona's the best defensive team we've played all year. But we haven't beaten them. Beating them gives these guys the momentum, the confidence of knowing not only can we play with anybody, we can beat anybody."

## PAC-12 MEN'S BASKETBALL RECAP

**ARIZONA:** The Wildcats won their 13th conference title... It's the fifth 30-win season in UA history, while the 33 wins are the second most in school history (1988, 35-3). It's the 35th 20-win season, 25th in the last 27 seasons... Made their 31st NCAA Tournament appearance... 'Cats hauled in several league honors with junior G **Nick Johnson** (16.3 ppg) claiming Pac-12 Player of the Year, freshman F **Aaron Gordon** (12.4 ppg/8.0 rpg) Pac-12 Freshman of the Year, and **Sean Miller** Pac-12 Coach of the Year... Arizona ranked among the top ten nationally in scoring defense (6th - 58.6 ppg), rebound margin (9th - +7.1), defensive field goal percentage (4th - .380), scoring margin (5th - +14.3)... 'Cats were ranked in the AP top five each week since Nov. 18, including an eight-week stretch at No. 1... ARIZONA was perfect at home this season, posting a 18-0 mark. The Wildcats have won 21 straight in McKale Center.

**ARIZONA STATE:** Won at least 20 games in five of the last seven seasons under head coach **Herb Sendek**. In the 25 years prior to his arrival in Tempe, ASU had three 20-win seasons (1990, 1995, 2003). Senior C **Jordan Bachynski**, the Pac-12 Defensive Player of the Year, bettered the Pac-12 single-season record for blocked shots he set a year ago with 133 rejections (NCAA-leading 4.03 bpg). His career total of 314 blocked shots is a Pac-12 career record... All-Pac-12 sophomore G **Jahii Carson's** two-year scoring total stands at 1,261 points. Only two Sun Devils reached 1,000 points quicker than sophomore G Jahii Carson who did it in his 55th game (Ike Diogu - 50th game; James Harden - 52nd game)

**CALIFORNIA:** Cal posted its fifth 20-win season in the last six seasons, the 22nd 20-win season for coach **Mike Montgomery** in his 31-year career. On March 31, Montgomery announced his retirement. In 32 seasons as a collegiate head coach, he captured 677 career victories and exits the game as the 25th-winningest head men's basketball coach with at least 10 years of experience at the Division I level in NCAA history. He ranks third on the Pac-12's all-time conference victories list behind Arizona's Lute Olson and UCLA's John Wooden with 282 league wins. Montgomery enjoyed 31 winning seasons in his 32 years as a collegiate head coach... All-Pac-12 senior G **Justin Cobbs** (15.7 ppg) tallied 531 assists in 102 career games. He finished his three-year Cal career second on the school's all-time assist list. Cobbs is one of just three Golden Bears in school history to record at least 1,400 career points (1,469) and 500 career assists (531)... Senior F **Richard Solomon** (10.2 rpg) was the first Cal player to lead the league in rebounding since Leon Powe (10.1 rpg) in 2006.

**COLORADO:** At 23-12, the Buffs posted their fourth straight 20-win campaign under coach **Tad Boyle**. There have only been eight 20-win seasons in CU history, and Boyle owns four. The 92 victories over his four seasons are the most wins in any four-year span in CU history... CU earned its record third straight NCAA Tournament berth... The Buffs opened the season at 14-3 and were ranked 15th before junior G **Spencer Dinwiddie** suffered a season-ending knee injury. CU went 9-9 without Dinwiddie... Dinwiddie (1,115) and junior G **Askia Booker** (1,208) both reached the 1,000-point plateau for their career during the 2013-14 season.

**OREGON:** Posted its fourth consecutive 20-win season, which has been done just once in UO history (1936-39). Oregon's 97 victories in the past four seasons breaks the program record for most wins in a four-year span. Oregon won 94 games between 1935-1939. Duck senior G **Johnathan Loyd** finished his career having appeared in more games (144) than any other player in Oregon history. Loyd moved from the locker room at Matt Knight Arena to one adjacent to Autzen Stadium as he will work out with the Oregon football team this spring... Junior G **Joseph Young** (18.9 ppg) scored 645 points during the 2013-14 season, the most by a Duck since Luke Jackson (656 points) in 2003-04.

**OREGON STATE:** With an 8-10 Pac-12 record, the Beavers equaled their best league finish since 1993 (the 2005 and 2009 teams also finished 8-10)... Senior guard **Roberto Nelson** led the league in scoring (20.7 ppg). He's the first Beaver to do so since Gary Payton in 1990 (25.7 ppg). Nelson finished his career with 1,745 points, good for fourth on the school's all-time list... Senior F **Devon Collier** finished his career with 1,489 career points, good for seventh on OSU's all-time list... Junior F **Eric Moreland** set an OSU career mark with 184 blocked shots. Moreland pulled down 205 rebounds in just 20 games (10.3 rpg). He's the third OSU player in history to average double figure rebounds in multiple seasons.

**STANFORD:** It's the 17th NCAA Tournament appearance for the Cardinal. The Cardinal reached the Sweet Sixteen for the fifth time, and first since the 2008 Tournament... Redshirt junior G **Anthony Brown** picked up Pac-12 Most Improved Player honors in a vote of the league coaches. Brown, who had a career average of 6.6 ppg entering the season, is third on the team averaging 12.3 ppg. He leads the team, and is third in the Pac-12, shooting .453 from three-point range. . . Senior F **Josh Huestis** earned Pac-12 All-Defensive Team accolades for the third consecutive season and is now Stanford's all-time leading shot-blocker (190)... Senior F **Dwight Powell** (853 rebounds) and Huestis (834 rebounds) stand seventh and eighth on Stanford's career rebounding list... Huestis (1,019 points), Powell (1,465 points) and junior G **Chasson Randle** (1,652) are the first trio of Cardinal to each record 1,000 points during their career in the same season.

**UCLA:** The Bruins earned their fourth Pac-12 Tournament crown... The Bruins made their 46th NCAA Tournament appearance... It's the seventh 20-win season over the last nine years, 48th overall... All-Pac-12 sophomore G **Kyle Anderson** averaged closer to a triple-double than any other player in the nation, with 14.6 ppg, while logging 8.8 rebounds and 6.5 assists per game. He led all Pac-12 players with 16 double-doubles and is the only player in the conference to rank in the top five in rebounds (8.8), assists (6.6) and steals (1.8). . . All-Pac-12 sophomore G **Jordan Adams** led the Bruins in scoring with 17.4 ppg. In two seasons, Adams has amassed 1,131 career points. His 95 steals (2.6 spg) this season are third on the Pac-12 single-season list and are the most by a Pac-12 player since California's Jason Kidd (110 in 1993).

**USC:** Despite posting a 2-16 league mark for first-year coach Andy Enfield, the Trojans received promising play from freshmen G **Julian Jacobs**, G **Roschon Prince**, and forward **Nikola Jovanovic**. The trio combined for 581 points (18.2 ppg) and 354 rebounds (11.1 rpg). In addition, Jacobs averaged 3.6 assists and 1.1 steals... Junior G **Byron Wesley** (17.8 ppg/6.4 rpg) led the Trojans in both scoring and rebounding. His 17.8 ppg average was the highest by a Trojan since O.J. Mayo averaged 20.7 ppg in 2008.

**UTAH:** The Utes were a 20-game winner for the first time since 2009... Utah collected 222 steals on the season - the fourth best single-season total in school history. All-Pac-12 junior G **Delon Wright** posted 82 steals in 2013-14, which were two shy of matching the school record of 84 set by Andre Miller in 1999... The versatile Wright was the only Pac-12 player to rank among the top 12 in points (15.15 ppg/10th), rebounds (6.8 rpg/12th), field goal percentage (.561/3rd), assists (5.3 apg/4th) and steals (2.5 spg/2nd)... The Utes were 18-2 at home in 2013-14.

**WASHINGTON:** Senior G **C.J. Wilcox** closed out his career with 1,880 points, second on the school's career list. His 301 career three-pointers is a school record and sixth all-time in the Pac-12... Freshman G **Nigel Williams-Goss** led the league in double-figure scoring efforts by a freshman during conference play with 14. He finished the season as the top scoring frosh (13.4 ppg) and set the UW freshman assist record with 140, 10 ahead of Tony Wroten who held the record with 130.

**WASHINGTON STATE:** Junior G **DaVonté Lacy** (19.4 ppg/4.2 rpg) led the Cougars in scoring and would have been second among all Pac-12 scorers, but was one game shy of meeting the minimum of playing in 75 percent of his team's games. Lacy three-point shooting... Senior F **D.J. Shelton** (10.1 ppg/9.6 rpg) posted the best rebound average by a Cougar since Carlos Daniel pulled down a league-leading 10.1 rpg in 1998. Shelton tallied 10 double-doubles over the final 14 games.
