STELLAR POSTSEASON, NIT TITLE HIGHLIGHT PAC-12 MEN'S BASKETBALL

PAC-12 ROLLS THROUGH THE POSTSEASON. . . The Pac-12 posted a 17-8 (.680) record in postseason play. That equals the most wins ever in postseason play for the Pac-12. The league also produced 17 wins (17-8, .680) during the 1996-97 season in which Arizona won the national title. No other conference won more games during the 2011-12 postseason.

STANFORD CAPTURES NIT CROWN. . . The STANFORD Cardinal put together an impressive postseason run that resulted in the Pac-12's sixth ever NIT title. Sophomore G **Aaron Bright**, the NIT's Most Outstanding Player, led the Cardinal to a dominating 75-51 victory over Minnesota in the NIT championship game at Madison Square Garden. In five NIT games, Bright shot 25-of-39 (.641) from the field, including 12-of-18 (.667) from three-point range, and 22-of-25 (.880) from the free throw line to average 16.8 points/4.2 assists. It was the second NIT title for the Cardinal, as they won the 1991 NIT crown as well. . . With WASHINGTON's run to the NIT semifinal, the Pac-12 tallied a 10-3 record in NIT play, the most wins ever by the Conference in the nation's oldest postseason tournament.

WASHINGTON STATE REACHES CBI CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES. . . WASHINGTON STATE narrowly missed out on becoming the third Pac-12 team in four years to capture a postseason title in the College Basketball Invitational (Oregon State in 2009; Oregon in 2011). Despite playing the three-game championship series without junior F **Brock Motum**, the Pac-12's Most Improved Player and the league's leading scorer (18.0 ppg), the Cougars fell just short to Pittsburgh, two games to one.

COLORADO WINS PAC-12 TOURNAMENT TITLE.

. . In its debut season in the Pac-12, COLORADO became the first league team to win four tournament games to capture the Conference's postseason crown. Senior G **Carlton Brown**, the Pac-12 Tournament Most Outstanding Player, led the way by averaging 15.8 points and 4.8 rebounds. The Buffaloes earned the league's automatic NCAA Tournament bid and knocked off No. 23 UNLV in second round action. It was the first NCAA Tournament win for the Buffaloes since 1997.

Pac-12 Tournament Recap: Colorado became the first team to win four straight tournament games to capture the Pac-12 Tournament hardware. . . . Colorado's **André Roberson** set a Tournament record with 41 rebounds. He also became CU's single-season record holder during the Utah game, passing Pac-12 Hall of Honor inductee Burdette Haldorson (1954-55, 346). Roberson has 377 rebounds this season. . . STANFORD's **Chasson Randle** set a Pac-12 Tournament single-game record for the most points scored by a freshman with 30 in its win over Arizona State.

PAC-12 NOTES

ARIZONA - The NIT appearance was the program's 27th postseason appearance in the last 28 years. . . At 12-6 in league play, Arizona has posted a winning record in Pac-12 play in 26 of the last 28 seasons. . . Arizona was one of the top long-range shooting teams in the Pac-12, connecting on 37.8 percent (258-of-683) of its attempts from behind the arc and led the league with a per game average of 7.4 made treys per game. Defensively, the Wildcats topped the league and was third in the nation in defending the three-pointer, allowing the opposition to shoot just 28.5 percent (170-of-596). . . Senior G **Kyle Fogg** led Arizona in scoring with a 13.5 ppg average. Additionally, he now holds the UA record for career games played with 139.

ARIZONA STATE - Junior G **Trent Lockett** has earned first-team Pac-12 All-Academic honors for the second-time in his career. . . Sophomore C **Jordan Bachynski** made great strides during the year. He averaged just 2.8 points/2.5 rebounds through the first 18 games, but finished with 10.0 points/6.0 rebounds the last 13 games. . . Freshman F **Jonathan Gilling** was another slow starter, averaging just 1.9 points in 8.8 minutes of action and shooting 35.7 percent from three-point range through the first nine games, but finished with 9.0 points in 30.0 minutes per game and shot 41.7 percent over the final 22 games. . . Of the 338 D-I schools, ASU was one of just nine without a senior on the roster. The others: Albany, Binghamton, UC Irvine, Illinois St., St. John's, St. Joseph's, Savannah St. and Toledo.

CALIFORNIA - The Golden Bears earned their 17th invitation to the NCAA Tournament. . . Led by Pac-12 Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year senior G **Jorge Gutierrez**, the Bears amassed 24 victories, matching their total from 2009-10 (24-11). No team has had more than 24 wins since the 1960 squad that reached the NCAA championship game compiled a 28-2 mark. . . Sophomore G **Allen Crabbe**, a first-team All-Pac-12 choice, paced Cal with 15.2 ppg, while Gutierrez contributed 13.0 ppg. Sophomore G **Justin Cobbs** (12.6 ppg) and senior F **Harper Kamp** (11.6 ppg) also averaged in double figures for the Bears.

COLORADO - First NCAA Tournament appearance since 2003, 11th overall, and just the third appearance since 1969. . . First time in school history that the Buffaloes have put together back-to-back 20-win seasons. . . Colorado has 24 wins for just the second time (24 in 2010-11). . . Senior F **Austin Dufault** is the 19th player in school history to score 1,000 points/500 rebounds for a career (1,076 points/529 rebounds). Dufault played in a school-record 135 games during his career. . . Sophomore F **André Roberson** topped the Pac-12 in rebounding at 11.1 per game (3rd in the nation). His margin of +3.4 rebounds over Arizona's Solomon Hill (7.7 rpg) is the widest since 1982 when California's Mark McNamara (12.6 rpg) had a +4.0 margin over Stanford's John Revelli (8.6 rpg). Roberson led the Pac-12 with 20 double-doubles.

OREGON - Made its 10th appearance in the postseason National Invitation Tournament. . . It's the second straight year for UO to tally 20+ wins. It marks just the third time in school history UO has produced consecutive seasons of 20+ wins. The 24 wins are the most since the 2007 squad posted 29 wins on the way to an Elite Eight appearance at the NCAA Tournament. . . Junior F **E.J. Singler** became the 13th player at UO to amass over 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds (1,095 points and 537 rebounds). Singler finished second in the nation in FT% (90.9%). . . Senior G **Devoe Joseph** averaged a team-high 16.9 points per outing. The Ducks were 20-7 with him in the lineup. Joseph scored in double-figures in 19 straight games, and 26 of the 27 games he played this season.

OREGON STATE - The Beavers made their third trip to the CBI. . . Oregon State has 20 wins for the 25th time in school history and the first time since the 1989-90 season. . . Junior G **Jared Cunningham**, an All-Pac-12 First Team selection, joins former OSU great Gary Payton as the only OSU player to twice earn Pac-12 All-Tournament Team honors. He moved into 13th on Oregon State's career scoring list with 1,271 points. His 645 points this season were second most points scored by a junior school history (trailed Mel Counts, 661). He is also second on the Beavers' career steals list (219). . . Junior F **Joe Burton** is the only Pac-12 player to finish in the top-15 in the conference in rebounding (11th, 5.9 rpg), assists (15th, 2.8 apg) and steals (10th, 1.3 spg). . . Sophomore G **Ahmad Starks** nailed 79 three-pointers this season, the second most in a season behind Payton's 82 (1988-89). . . Freshman F **Eric Moreland** (1.9 bpg) led the Pac-12 with a school-record 69 blocked shots.

STANFORD - Reached the postseason for the 23rd time, the sixth time in the NIT. The Cardinal now have captured two NIT crowns (1991, 2012). . . Stanford's 26 wins are the most since a 28-8 finish during the 2007-08 campaign, when the Cardinal reached the NCAA Sweet 16. . . Senior F **Josh Owens** reached the 1,000-point plateau for his career (1,044 points), and became the 21st player to reach 1,000 points and 500 rebounds (564 rebounds). . . The Cardinal posted a school-record 17 wins at Maples Pavilion this season. . . Freshman G **Chasson Randle** scored 512 points (13.8 ppg). It's the second most points scored by a Cardinal freshman, trailing only Todd Lichti's 516 points (1986). In addition, he connected on a Stanford freshman record 85 three-pointers, which ranks third all-time on the school's single-season list.

UCLA - Despite not playing a game on campus this season, the Bruins still managed to post a 14-4 "home" record. UCLA returns to campus next season in a renovated Pauley Pavilion. . . The Bruins were among the league leaders in scoring defense (62.5 ppg/3rd), blocked shots (4.6 bpg/1st) and steals (7.9 spg/2nd). . . Sophomore twin forwards **David Wear** (6.3 rpg/8th) and **Travis Wear** (5.9 rpg/10th) ranked among the league's top 10 in rebounds. . . In the last 20 games, Travis averaged 12.4 points while David averaged 11.3 points per game. Combined, they were 181-for-337 (.537) from the field and 89-for-113 (.788) from the charity stripe in the last 20 games.

USC - The Trojans led the Pac-12 in scoring defense for the third straight season as they allowed just 59.7 points per game, which ranked 17th in the nation. . . With a roster depleted by injuries, no Pac-12 sophomore or freshman logged more minutes than sophomore G **Maurice Jones** (38.2 minutes per game/1st) and freshman G **Byron Wesley** (34.6 minutes per game/4th). . . Jones was among the league leaders in steals (1.8 spg/4th). His 125 career thefts ranks ninth on the school's all-time list.

UTAH - Junior F **Jason Washburn** led the Utes in scoring (11.4 ppg/27th in the Pac-12), rebounds (6.2 rpg/9th in the Pac-12), field goal percentage (.552/7th in the Pac-12) and blocked shots (1.4 bpg/4th in the Pac-12). . . Washburn tied a Pac-12 Tournament single-game record with five blocked shots vs. Colorado. Washburn moved into a tie for eighth place on the single-season blocks list at Utah with 43, equaling Larry Cain (1992-93) and Nate Althoff (1998-99).

WASHINGTON - Washington made its first appearance in the NIT since 1997 and its sixth overall trip to the postseason tournament. . . **Tony Wroten**, the Pac-12 Freshman of the Year, and Detlef Schrempf (1985) are the only Huskies with 500 points, 150 rebounds and 100 assists in a season. . . Wroten holds three freshman school season records - points (559 points), assists (130) and steals (66). . . UW is the only Pac-12 team that has three players ranked among the conference's top-10 in scoring. **Terrence Ross** 4th (16.4), **Tony Wroten** is 5th in scoring (16.0), and **C.J. Wilcox** 7th (14.2). . . Pac-12 Coach of the Year **Lorenzo Romar** joins Cal's Mike Montgomery and UCLA's Ben Howland with 100 conference victories each. The last time three or more coaches had 100 league wins at the same time was 1964 - OSU's Slat's Gill (276), UCLA's John Wooden (171) and USC's Forrest Twogood (121). . . The Huskies finished with an 18-2 record in home games at Alaska Airlines Arena.

WASHINGTON STATE - The 12th postseason appearance and fifth in the last six years for the Cougars. . . This was the first CBI appearance for the Cougars. . . Junior F **Brock Motum** led the Pac-12 in scoring with 18.0 points per game and had a team-best 6.4 rebounds an outing. Following Klay Thompson's league-best 21.6 points per game a year ago, it marks the second time a WSU player has led the league in scoring in back-to-back years. Huntley Gordon accomplished the feat in 1931 (10.7 ppg) and 1932 (8.4 ppg). . . Motum is the only Pac-12 player ranked in the top-15 in scoring (18.0 ppg/1st), rebounds (6.4 rpg/7th) and field goal percentage (.554/6th). . . Senior G **Marcus Capers** set the WSU school record for games played. He now has played in 132 games. . . Junior G **Reggie Moore** led the Pac-12 in assists (5.2 apg), the first WSU player to lead that category in conference history. . . Moore set the WSU single season record books with 193 assists.

PAC-12 PLAYER OF THE YEAR

GUTIERREZ was instrumental in leading Cal to its third 20-win season in four years and becomes the sixth Golden Bear to earn Pac-12 Player of the Year honors, joining Jason Kidd (1994), Shareef Abdur-Rahim (1996), Ed Gray (1997), Sean Lampley (2001), and Jerome Randle (2010). Gutierrez averaged 12.9 ppg/12th in Pac-12, posted 5.3 rebounds per game, and a team-best 1.2 steals per game/12th in Pac-12. He is the active Pac-12 career leader for assists (408), is second in steals (145) and is third for points (1,189).

PAC-12 FRESHMAN OF THE YEAR

WROTEN becomes the fifth Washington player to earn Pac-12 Freshman of the Year, and first since 2009, joining Chris Welp (1984), Mike Hayward (1988), Mark Pope (1992) and Isaiah Thomas (2009). Wroten was a key piece all season for Pac-12 regular season champion Washington, leading the Huskies in scoring (16.3 ppg/4th in Pac-12) and steals (59 total, 2.0 spg/2nd in Pac-12), and was second in assists (3.7 apg/8th in Pac-12). He posted 10 20-point games this season, tied for most in the Pac-12 with Oregon State's Jared Cunningham. Wroten was the only freshman to be named Player of the Week this season, and the first freshman to earn that honor since USC's O.J. Mayo in February 2008.

PAC-12 DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR

As noted above, GUTIERREZ was key on defense for the Golden Bears this year, who allowed their opponents only 61.2 points per game overall. As a team, Cal is in the league top-three for field goal percentage defense (.408), three-point percentage defense (.324) and rebounding defense (30.5). Gutierrez led the team in steals (36 total, 1.2 spg/12th in Pac-12) and is 9th in the Pac-12 in defensive rebounds with an average of 4.5. He is the second Cal player to earn the honor, with Butch Hays receiving the award in 1984.

PAC-12 MOST IMPROVED PLAYER OF THE YEAR

MOTUM was second in scoring in the Pac-12 (18.1 ppg), was in the league top-10 for field goal percentage (.549) and was one of the top rebounders in the conference (6.5 rpg) this season. Motum's numbers took a monumental leap this year, improving from 2.9 points/.8 rebounds as a freshman and 7.6 points/3.0 rebounds as a sophomore. He had nine 20-point games and had three double-doubles this season.

PAC-12 COACH OF THE YEAR

ROMAR guided Washington to its second Pac-12 title under his watch and the first since 2009, with a 14-4 league mark and 21-9 overall record. Under Romar, the Huskies put together their fourth consecutive 20-win season and the sixth of his tenure at Washington. This is Romar's third Pac-12 Coach of the Year honor, with his first coming in 2005 and his second in 2009. He's the third Washington coach to receive Pac-12 Coach of the Year honors, joining two-time honoree Marv Harshman (1982, 1984) and Bob Bender (1996). Romar has a career record of 309-199 (.608), while his Washington record stands at 216-111 (.661).

THE VOTE: Coach of the Year, All-Conference, All-Freshman, All-Defensive teams and Most Improved Player are voted on by the coaches. Coaches are not permitted to vote for themselves or their own players for the honors.

UCLA TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

LOS ANGELES--The UCLA Bruins are picked to finish first in the 2011-12 Pac-12 Conference men's basketball race, according to a poll of media members who cover Pac-12 men's basketball.

UCLA, led by junior All-Conference forward Reeves Nelson (13.9 ppg/9.1 rpg), tallied 14 first-place votes and narrowly edges out CALIFORNIA and ARIZONA. California, paced by senior All-Conference guard Jorge Gutierrez (14.6 ppg/4.5 apg) and senior forward Harper Kamp (14.2 ppg/5.6 rpg) picked up 13 first-place votes and is tabbed for second. Arizona, the reigning regular-season Conference champion, pulled in the remaining 11 first-place votes and are picked to finish third.

WASHINGTON, the defending Pac-12 Tournament champion, is slotted fourth, followed by OREGON in fifth and STANFORD sixth. The second half of the predicted race starts with USC edging out OREGON STATE for seventh with ARIZONA STATE picked ninth. COLORADO and WASHINGTON STATE are tied for tenth, followed by UTAH.
