PAC-10 CAPS 2010-11 CAMPAIGN WITH SUCCESSFUL POSTSEASON:

The ARIZONA Wildcats reached the Elite Eight where they bowed out of the NCAA Tournament to eventual national champion Connecticut just one three-pointer short of reaching the Final Four, the WASHINGTON STATE Cougars reached the semifinals of the NIT, and the OREGON Ducks captured the CBI crown to give the Pac-10 its second title in three seasons of the CBI Tournament. . . . Oregon's **Joevan Catron** earned CBI Tournament Most Outstanding Player honors, while All-America honors rolled in for Arizona's **Derrick Williams**, who was a consensus Second Team All-America selection. He earned second team honors by the USBWA, NABC and the Associated Press, as well as collecting John R. Wooden All-America honors. . . . Five Pac-10 teams won 20 or more games for the fourth time in five seasons. . . . The road was a tough place to play in league action as the home team held a 58-32 (.644) advantage. It was the most wins compiled by the home teams since 1999 (62-28). . . . The road looks to be a little tougher in 2011-12 as the Conference expands to include two more stops on the league schedule with the addition of Colorado and Utah. The tentative 2011-12 Pac-12 league schedule is on page 7.

AROUND THE PAC-10

AROUND THE LEAGUE: The Pac-10 had a total of 17 seniors on rosters around the league, with 11 having been on their current squads for their entire college careers. . . . Three Pac-10 squads were seniorless in 2010-11 - Stanford, UCLA and Washington State. . . . Just two seniors were among the top 16 in the league in scoring, Washington's **Matthew Bryan-Amaning** (15.3 ppg) and Oregon's **Joevan Catron** (15.3 ppg). . . . Only one senior, Bryan-Amaning, was named to the 10-member All-Pac-10 First Team.

POSTSEASON SUCCESS: All 10 Pac-10 institutions have participated in the postseason over the last three seasons and have compiled a record of 31-20 (.608). . . . ARIZONA's run to the Elite Eight this season provided the Pac-10 with a team in the Sweet Sixteen in 22 of the last 24 seasons, with a total of 40 teams advancing past the second round. . . . OREGON's best-of-three series win over Creighton provided the Pac-10 with its second CBI title in three years as OREGON STATE captured the inaugural CBI title in 2009. . . . WASHINGTON STATE reached the semifinals of the NIT, the first time a Pac-10 team has played in the semifinals of college basketball's first postseason tournament since Oregon in 2004.

ARIZONA: The Wildcats captured their 12th Pac-10 title, and first since 2005. . . . The Wildcats made their 27th NCAA Tournament appearance overall and the program has a 45-25 (.643) record in NCAA Tournament action. Arizona reached the Sweet Sixteen for the 13th time in school history, and the Elite Eight for the fourth time in the last 11 seasons and seventh time overall. . . . Sophomore F **Derrick Williams** became the seventh Arizona player to earn Pac-10 Player of the Year, and first since 1999, joining Sean Elliott (1988, 1989), Chris Mills (1993), Damon Stoudamire (1995), Mike Bibby (1998), and Jason Terry (1999). He was one of ten finalists for the Oscar Robertson Player of the Year Award and one of 20 finalists for the John R. Wooden Award. . . . The Cats were a perfect 17-0 at home this season. . . . The 30 victories are the most for the program since the 1998 squad posted a 30-5 record.

ARIZONA STATE: The senior trio of **Ty Abbott**, **Rihards Kuksiks** and **Jamelle McMillan** produced 80 wins, the most by any seniors in ASU history. The Sun Devils were 21-13 (2007-08), 25-10 (2008-09), and 22-11 (2009-10) in their first three seasons. Prior to their arrival, ASU won 37 games in the previous four seasons. The 80 wins is the best by any four-year player, as Gary Jackson (1973-76) was with the program for 79 wins. . . . Sophomore G **Trent Lockett**, who earned second-team All-Pac-10 honors, averaged 13.4 points after averaging 6.7 in his freshman season. The +6.7 increase is the best from first year to second year by a Sun Devil since Jeremy Veal went from 7.4 in 1994-95 to 18.9 in 1995-96 (+11.5). . . . With its injuries and illnesses, ASU used 11 starting lineups, 11 players made a start in 2010-11, and the only player to see action in all 31 games was freshman F **Kyle Cain**. The 11 lineups were the most by the Sun Devils since 2003-04 team started 13 and tied for third-most in past 18 season.

CALIFORNIA: Freshman G **Allen Crabbe** averaged 19.8 points over the final six games, while hitting 19-of-40 (.475) from three-point range. In Pac-10 play, Crabbe led the league in three-point accuracy having connected on 37-of-77 (.481) from beyond the arc. Crabbe becomes the seventh California player to earn Pac-10 Freshman of the Year, and first since 2004, joining Dave Butler (1983), Leonard Taylor (1985), Jason Kidd (1993), Tremaine Fowlkes (1995) Shareef Abdur-Rahim (1996), and Leon Powe (2004). . . . In looking at the 2011-12 season, the Bears lose only one senior from their NIT squad, forward **Markhuri Sanders-Frison** (10.9 ppg/7.4 rpg).

OREGON: Junior G **Malcolm Armstead** broke his own single-season school record with 89 steals this season, which ranks sixth on the Pac-10 single-season list. He posted 65 thefts last year. . . . Senior F **Joevan Catron** pushed his career scoring total to 1,167 points, becoming the 30th player in school history to eclipse the 1,000 point mark. Catron posted three double-doubles in six CBI games, and averaged 20.7 points and 9.0 rebounds to earn CBI Most Outstanding Player. . . . Sophomore G/F **E.J. Singler** finished the season scoring double digit figures in nine straight games, averaging 15.1 points in that stretch, while shooting 45-of-87 (.517) from the field and 17-of-35 (.486) from three-point range.

OREGON STATE: Sophomore G **Jared Cunningham** grabbed a Beaver sophomore record 85 steals this season. That total ranks fourth on the school's single-season list, and most by a Beaver since Gary Payton tallied 91 thefts in 1988-89. The 85 steals are tied for seventh most on the Pac-10's single-season top 10 list. . . . Cunningham is the second OSU player ever to be named to the Pac-10 All-Tournament team, joining Payton (1988 and 1989). Cunningham averaged 23.5 points and 4.0 steals in a pair of games. His six steals vs. Arizona were one shy of the Tournament record (7 by ASU's James Harden vs. USC, 2008).

STANFORD: Over the last 11 games, junior G **Jeremy Green** averaged 21.4 points. During that stretch of games, he connected on 39-of-79 (.494) from three-point range. . . . Green tallied a career-high seven three-pointers in the Pac-10 Tournament opening-round loss to Oregon State and moved into second place on Stanford's all-time three-point field goals list with 228, surpassing Casey Jacobsen's career mark of 222. Dion Cross holds the school record at 241. . . . After posting 21 assists (2.6 apg) through the first eight games of league play, junior G **Jarrett Mann** averaged 6.1 assists over the final 12 games of the season.

UCLA: The Bruins made their 44th NCAA Tournament appearance and have posted a record of 100-37 (.730), with 11 national titles. . . . Sophomore **F Reeves Nelson** averaged 15.8 points and 10.5 rebounds over the final six games. He posted 10 or more rebounds in five of the last seven games. . . With Nelson, junior G **Malcolm Lee** and sophomore F **Tyler Honeycutt** all earning Pac-10 All-Conference honors, the Bruins placed three on the First Team for the first time since 1997 (Toby Bailey, Jelani McCoy, Charles O'Bannon). . . . Freshman C **Joshua Smith** averaged 15.0 points in two NCAA Tournament games, while shooting 12-of-18 (.667) from the field. Smith led all Pac-10 freshmen in rebounding (6.3 rpg) and field goal percentage (.555).

USC: The Trojans made their 16th appearance in the NCAA Tournament, and have posted a record of 12-18 (.400). . . USC's defense allowed a league-low 62.7 points and had a defense field goal percentage of 40.9 percent. . . . Junior F **Nikola Vucevic** posted 10 double-doubles over the last 11 games, averaging 18.5 points/11.0 rebounds. He led the Pac-10 with 22 double-doubles this season, and has 32 for his career. Vucevic has declared for the NBA draft. . . . Freshman G **Maurice Jones** set a USC freshman single-season mark with 69 steals (third most overall by a USC player in a single-season). . . . Vucevic (10.3 rebounds per game) and senior F **Alex Stepheson** (9.2 rebounds per game) become the first pair of Pac-10 teammates to finish 1-2 in the league in rebounding.

WASHINGTON: The Huskies captured back-to-back Pac-10 Tournament titles, joining Arizona (1988-90 and 2002) as the only teams to win back-to-back titles. . . . The Huskies made their 16th appearance, and have posted a record of 18-17 (.514). . . . Senior F **Matthew Bryan-Amaning** was honored as the Pac-10's Most Improved Player. Over his four seasons at Washington, his averages increased each year from 4.2 ppg/3.2 rpg as a freshman, to 6.0 ppg/4.0 rpg as a sophomore, to 8.8 ppg/5.9 rpg as a junior, and 15.3 ppg/8.0 rpg as an All-Pac-10 selection this year. . . . In three seasons, junior G **Isaiah Thomas** has scored 1,721 points, which ranks fifth all-time on the Husky career list. . . . Freshman G **Terrence Ross** earned Pac-10 All-Tournament honors after averaging 15.3 points, while shooting 19-of-36 (.528) from the field.

WASHINGTON STATE: In WSU's fifth appearance in the NIT, the Cougars reached the semifinals in Madison Square Garden. . . . With his Pac-10 Tournament single-game 43-point outburst, Junior G **Klay Thompson** became WSU's single-season scoring leader. His single-game effort was two points shy of matching Brian Quinnett's 45 points vs. Loyola Marymount (Dec. 5, 1986). . . . After adding 63 points in three NIT games, Thompson finished the year with 727 points (Pac-10 leading 22.0 ppg). He passed Isaac Fontaine who had 657 points in 1997. . . . Thompson's 1,756 career points ranks third all-time in the WSU record book. . . . WSU reached 20 wins for the third time in five seasons.
