OREGON LEADS PAC-10 WITH SUCCESSFUL POSTSEASON RUN Ducks Reach Elite Eight After Capturing First Pac-10 Title Since 1945

The Pac-10 Conference sent a record six teams into the NCAA Tournament where OREGON, ARIZONA and UCLA advanced to the Sweet 16. It's the second consecutive year in which the Pac-10 advanced three or more teams to the Sweet 16. In fact, seven appearances in the Sweet 16 the last two seasons is more than any other conference. . . Oregon's appearance in the Elite Eight capped a banner season for the Ducks. Oregon captured the Pac-10 championship, its first since sharing the title in 1945, and produced the third most wins in school history with 26 victories this season. The Ducks also captured the Pac-10 football title this past season, marking the 16th time in Conference history that one school has won league championships (or co-championships) in football and men's basketball. . . Arizona reached the Sweet 16 for the fifth time in seven years, and its current streak of 18 consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament leads the nation. . . UCLA reached the Sweet 16 for the fifth time in six years, making coach Steve Lavin one of two coaches to guide his team to the Sweet 16 in five of the last six Tournaments. . . One of the most competitive Conference races in Pac-10 history came down to the last weekend in order to determine the league champion. It was the first time in league history that six teams posted 11 or more league wins in Conference play. . . Individual accolades were awarded to several individuals as All-America honors were achieved by USC's **Sam Clancy** (Pac-10 Player of the Year), STANFORD's **Casey Jacobsen**, OREGON's **Frederick Jones**, and ARIZONA's **Jason Gardner** and **Luke Walton**.

PAC-10 NOTES

- The Pac-10 sent six teams to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in league history. The previous best of five occurred in 1995, 1997 and 2001. Each of those years the Pac-10 had a team appear in the Final Four with UCLA winning the title in 1995 and Arizona in 1997.
- The Pac-10 has responded with considerable success when five or more Pac-10 teams participate in the NCAA Tournament. In four NCAA Tournaments where the Pac-10 has sent at least five teams, the league has produced a record of 44-19 (.698). In three of those four seasons, a Pac-10 team has reached the championship game.
- Over the last eight years of NCAA Tournament play, the Pac-10 has posted a 63-35 record (.643). During the last eight Tournaments, eight Pac-10 member institutions have reached the Sweet 16 a combined 19 times.
- Over the last six NCAA Tournaments, only the Big Ten (61) and ACC (53) has won more games than the Pac-10 (51). In terms of winning percentage, the Pac-10 ranks second among the conferences that have placed three or more teams in each of the last six NCAA Tournaments:

TEAM NOTES

ARIZONA - Arizona won its fourth Pac-10 Tournament title in five tries. . . Sixteen of Arizona's 31 regular season opponents (52 percent) were nationally ranked at the time of the game, and the Cats were 10-6 in those contests. . . Arizona has been ranked in 253 consecutive AP polls released during the regular season only. . . Coach **Lute Olson** has led UA to 15 consecutive 20-win seasons and has 24 overall in his career, making him one of only seven head coaches in NCAA history to record 24 or more 20-win seasons. . . Guard **Jason Gardner** will enter his senior year with 1,512 career points - 10th on the all-time UA scoring list. Gardner has 106 three-pointers this season, placing him fourth on the Pac-10 single-season list. . . Arizona set a school record for average attendance this season, averaging 14,544 fans per game, which broke last season's record of 14,533.

ARIZONA STATE - All-Pac-10 center **Chad Prewitt** closed out his ASU career with 1,177 points, ranking 18th on the school's career list. Prewitt led the Sun Devils in scoring in 14 of the last 20 games. . . This season ASU topped Arizona and UCLA in the same season for the first time since 1985-86. . . ASU's six-game stretch to finish the regular season was the first time in school history it played six straight ranked teams. In fact, excluding their NIT game, the Sun Devils finished the season by playing 11 of its final 13 games against NCAA Tournament teams.

CALIFORNIA - The Bears posted a 17-1 record at Haas Pavilion this year. It's the second-highest victory total in Berkeley. Cal is 34-4 in its last 38 games on Pete Newell Court. . . The Bears posted their fourth 20-win season in six years under coach **Ben Braun** and made their 12th NCAA Tournament appearance all-time. . . Junior forward **Joe Shipp** became the 31st player in school history to top 1,000 career points, finishing the year at 1,034 career points. . . The Bears had the stingiest defense, allowing a league-low .418 shooting percentage. Their 66.6 points allowed per game ranked second in the league.

OREGON - The Ducks captured their first Pac-10 crown since a tie for the 1945 title. It's the first outright title since the 1939 season when they went on to win the NCAA's first postseason championship. . . At 26-9, it's the ninth 20-win season in school history. The 26 victories are the most since the 1945 season (30). . . It's 16-0 home record equaled the school record set by the 1937-38 squad. . . **Frederick Jones** capped off his career ranked fifth on UO's career scoring list with 1,644 points. He ranks in the top five in five different career categories at Oregon - scoring, assists (365/3rd), blocks (74/t3rd), steals (147/t2nd) and three-pointers (149/5th). . . For the first time in school history, three players have each scored at least 500 points in a season. Jones leads the way with 650 points, followed by sophomores **Luke Jackson** (583) and **Luke Ridnour** (542). . . The Ducks set a Pac-10 record for three-pointers in a season with 304, passing the previous mark of 279 (Arizona in 1994). . . Oregon also eclipsed the league record for free throw percentage, shooting .769 (662-of-861) to outdistanced the mark of .760 (Washington State in 1992).

OREGON STATE - The Beavers will begin the 2002-03 season with a new head coach TBA to replace Ritchie McKay. . . The Beavers held the opposition to a scoring average below 70 points for the fifth consecutive season - currently, the longest streak in the Pac-10. . . Junior forward **Philip Ricci** led the Beavers in scoring at 16.2 ppg and rebounds at 7.1 rpg - both figures rank 10th in the Pac-10. Ricci posted double digit scoring totals in 27 of 28 games played this season.

STANFORD - The Cardinal posted its eighth consecutive 20-win season. . . Guard **Casey Jacobsen** ranks third on the school's career scoring list with 1,723 points. he's the first Stanford player to lead the Pac-10 in scoring (21.9 ppg) since 1983-84 when Keith Jones averaged 20.0 ppg. . . Center **Curtis Borchardt** lead the league in rebounding (11.4 rpg). he's only the seventh Pac-10 player to average double digit rebounds in the last 19 seasons. . . It's the first time in Pac-10 history that two different players from the same school led the league in scoring and rebounding.

UCLA - The Bruins are making their NCAA-record 38th NCAA Tournament appearance and have compiled a record of 85-30 (.739) in the NCAA Tournament. . . The Bruins have posted their 14th consecutive 20-win season. . . UCLA has reached the Sweet 16 in five of the last six NCAA Tournaments. . . Junior forward **Jason Kapono**'s 87 three-pointers is a UCLA single-season mark. With 1,608 career points, Kapono ranks 15th on the UCLA all-time scoring list. . . Senior center **Dan Gadzuric** pulled down 896 rebounds during his career, placing him 8th on UCLA's all-time list, 26th on the Pac-10's all-time list. . . With 1,066 points, senior forward **Matt Barnes** became the 43rd Bruin to top 1,000 career points.

USC - The Trojans made their 12th NCAA Tournament appearance. . . Center **Sam Clancy**, the Pac-10 Player of the Year, closes out a stellar career finishing third on the school's career scoring list with 1,657 points and second on USC's career list with 839 rebounds. . . Guard **Brandon Granville**, USC's career leader in games played with 124, owns the school record and is fifth all-time in the Pac-10 record books with 779 career assists.

WASHINGTON - The **Lorenzo Romar** era begins in Seattle. The former St. Louis coach was named the 18th head coach of Washington basketball on Wednesday, April 3. Romar played two seasons at Washington under Marv Harshman from 1978-80. . . Sophomore forward **Doug Wrenn**, the Pac-10 Newcomer of the Year, became the 16th different Husky to record 500 or more points in a season as he topped out at 546 points this year.

WASHINGTON STATE - The Cougars closed out the season on a winning note for the first time since the 1992-93 season and for just the third time in the last 22 years. . . **Mike Bush** closed out his career with 1,061 points - 20th on the WSU all-time scoring list. . . Guard **Marcus Moore** finished with 53 steals this season and has 93 thefts for his career. Both numbers rank 10th on the respective WSU lists.
