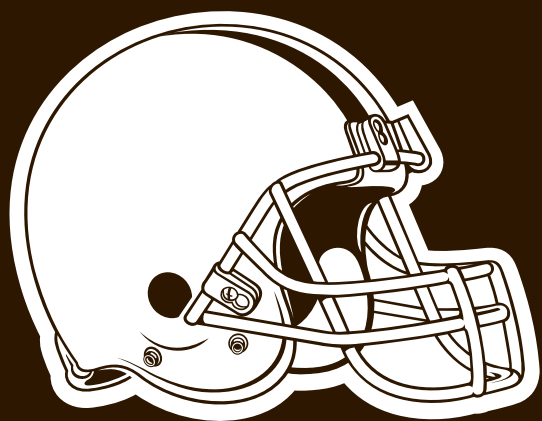



## NOTABLE STORYLINES

- The Browns dropped their season opener, 33-17, to Dallas. DE Myles Garrett, DE Za'Darius Smith and DT Dalvin Tomlinson each recorded sacks, while CB Denzel Ward recorded three passes defended. WR Jerry Jeudy recorded his first touchdown as a Brown after hauling in a 6-yard touchdown and RB Jerome Ford also reached the end zone.

- The Browns finished the 2023 season with an 11-6 record and a trip to the postseason. The 11 regular season wins tied for the second-most in team history, trailing only the 1986 team's 12. Head coach Kevin Stefanski (2020 and 2023) joined Pro Football Hall of Famer Paul Brown (1951 and 1953) as the only coaches in team history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins.

- In 2023, the Browns claimed several on-field awards, including Kevin Stefanski winning NFL Coach of the Year, DE Myles Garrett was named the Defensive Player of the Year, QB Joe Flacco won NFL Comeback Player of the Year and Defensive Coordinator Jim Schwartz was named NFL Assistant Coach of the Year. The Browns also had seven players (G Joel Bitonio, WR Amari Cooper, Garrett, TE David Njoku, LB Jeremiah Owusu-Koramoah, G Wyatt Teller and CB Denzel Ward) selected to the Pro Bowl, the team's most since 1988.

- Last season, the Browns led the NFL in several categories including total defense (270.2 yards per game), passing defense (164.7 yards per game), third down percentage (67-of-230 for 29.1 percent) and first downs allowed (253). The team's 270.2 net yards allowed per game were the fewest allowed in the NFL since the 2014 Seahawks (267.1) and the fewest allowed by a Browns team since 1957. The Browns set a franchise record for sacks in a season with 48. Cleveland also led the league by forcing 112 punts, the third-most forced by an NFL team since 1970.

- DE Myles Garrett was named to the A.P. All-Pro Team for the fifth time in his career and third time as a first-team honoree. He led the Browns and finished tied for seventh in the NFL with 14 sacks. His 14 sacks tied for third-most by a Brown in a season. Garrett is the only NFL player to record at least 14 sacks in each of the past three seasons (2021-23) and the only player to record at least 10 sacks in each of the past six seasons (2018-23). Garrett is the Browns all-time sack leader with 88.5.

- TE David Njoku led the team with 81 receptions last season, the fifth-most by a Browns tight end in a season and tied for the eighth-most by any Browns player. He also led the team with a career-high six receiving touchdowns, the most by a Browns tight end since Gary Barnidge recorded nine in 2015. Among all NFL tight ends last season Njoku ranked tied for second with six receiving touchdowns, tied for fifth with 81 receptions and sixth with 882 receiving yards.

- In 2023, WR Amari Cooper led the Browns with 1,250 receiving yards, the third-most by a Brown in a season. In addition to his 1,160 receiving yards in 2022 last season, Cooper became the first Browns player to record back-to-back 1,000-yard receiving seasons.

- K Dustin Hopkins converted 33 of 36 field goals last season, including four game-winners. His 33 made field goals were the most by a Brown in a season and his eight 50-plus yards field goals were also a team record. He finished second to Jim Brown (126 in 1965) for the most points scored by a Brown in a season with 123. Hopkins set an NFL record with at least one 50-plus yard field goal in five consecutive games. He inked a three-year contract extension in July.

- CB Martin Emerson Jr. led the team with four interceptions and tied for the team lead with 14 passes defended. He ranks tied for fifth in the NFL with 29 passes defended since 2022.

- LB Jeremiah Owusu-Koramoah led the Browns with 98 tackles, while adding 3.5 sacks, six passes defended and one forced fumble. He finished fourth in the NFL with 20 tackles-for-a-loss during the regular season and added four more during the club's postseason game at Houston. Owusu-Koramoah inked a three-year extension with the club in August.

## BROWNS GIVE BACK

The Browns have a unified and focused philanthropic mission with “Browns Give Back” that extends throughout Northeast Ohio. Led by Dee and Jimmy Haslam, Whitney and JW Johnson, COO David Jenkins, EVP/GM Andrew Berry and Head Coach Kevin Stefanski, the entire Browns organization - coaches, players and front office members - are dedicated to creating meaningful impact in the communities in which we live and work by investing their time and resources under the Browns Give Back platform.

The target of these endeavors devotes to three focus areas: **EDUCATION**, **YOUTH FOOTBALL** and **SOCIAL JUSTICE**.

### SANCTION GIRLS HS FLAG FOOTBALL IN OHIO

Since 2021, the Browns have worked with Northeast Ohio Flag Football to elevate girls flag football to promote equality in high school sports. Over the past four seasons, the number of Northeast Ohio high schools with teams has grown from two to 51. The Browns are focused on pushing girls high school flag football to become a sanctioned varsity sport under the Ohio High School Athletic Association.



The Stay in the Game! Attendance Network works to campaign, connect and convene with experts and supporters to dramatically improve attendance for Ohio students. The Network was launched in 2019 by the Cleveland Browns Foundation, Ohio Department of Education and Workforce and Harvard's Proving Ground, and is now managed by Battelle. For the 2024-25 school year, the Network will partner with **100+ school districts** to positively impact the lives of **400k+ students**.

### BACK-TO-SCHOOL!

Browns G Joel Bitonio hosted his annual back-to-school bash at Brook Park Elementary School on September 3, providing an entire 3rd-grade class (160 students) with backpacks and school supplies to start the year. Students also participated in football games and activity stations during the event.





THE HEAD COACHES

BROWNS HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI



Head Coach Kevin Stefanski became the 18th full-time head coach in franchise history on January 13, 2020. In Stefanski's five years, the Browns are 37-31 (.544), the highest winning percentage for the club over a five-year stretch since 1986-89. The two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year led the Browns to two postseason appearances and two 11-win season becoming the second coach in club history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins (Paul Brown, 1951 and 1953). In his first season, he led the club to their first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years, earning him his first AP Coach of the Year. Prior to Cleveland, Stefanski spent 14 seasons with the Minnesota Vikings in various roles. Stefanski joined the Vikings in 2006 as an assistant to the head coach, assistant quarterbacks coach (2009-13), tight ends (2014-15) and lone season (2016) coaching running backs. From 2017-18, he coached the quarterbacks and added the role of interim offensive coordinator for the final three games in 2018 before being named the team's offensive coordinator in 2019. Stefanski played defensive back at University of Pennsylvania.

JAGUARS HEAD COACH DOUG PEDERSON



Doug Pederson was appointed the ninth head coach of the Jaguars franchise on Feb. 4, 2022. He began his NFL coaching career with the Eagles serving as an Offensive Quality Control Assistant from 2009-10 before being promoted to QBs coach (2011-12). Pederson spent time as part of the Chiefs from 2013-15 (OC) before returning to the Eagles as their Head Coach from 2016-20. During his tenure with Philadelphia, he led them to a 60-53-1 record in five years, winning Super Bowl LII in 2017. Pederson played football at the University of Louisiana-Monroe (1987-90). He signed as an undrafted free agent by the Miami Dolphins in 1991. He spent time as a Quarterback in Miami (1991, 1992-94, 1995), Carolina (1995), Green Bay (1995-98, 2001-04), Philadelphia (1999) and Cleveland (2000).

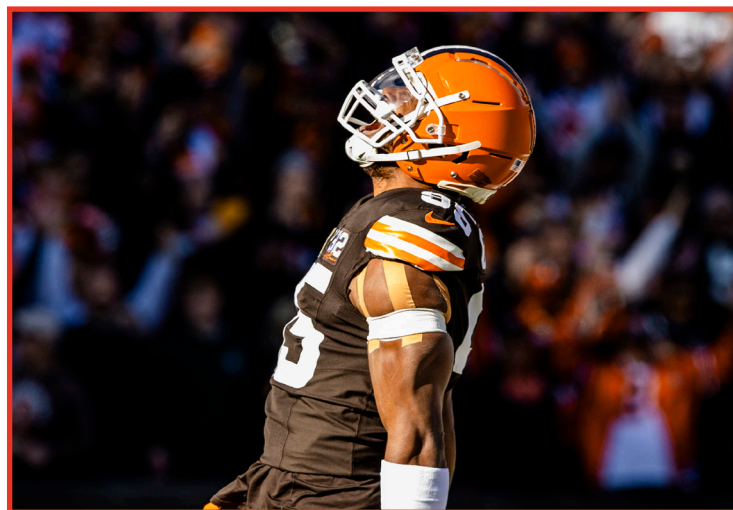

# HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI

## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- In his four seasons as head coach the Browns are 37-31 (.544), the highest-winning percentage for the team over a four-year stretch since 1986-89. Stefanski has led the team to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons. He joined Pro Football Hall of Famer Paul Brown (1951 and 1953) as the only coaches in team history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins.
- Stefanski became the 16th coach to win the Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year award multiple times since its inception in 1957. Stefanski won the honors in 2020 and 2023 and joined Forrest Gregg (1976) as the only Browns coaches to win the award.
- During the Browns 77-year history, the team has surpassed 6,000 scrimmage yards in a single season just seven times, but have reached the mark in all four seasons under Stefanski. Since 2020, the Browns are third in the NFL with an average of 139.6 rushing yards per game.
- Stefanski has recorded a 24-11 (.685) record at Huntington Bank Field, while not recording a losing record at home in any season. The Browns finished 8-1 at home in 2023, a team record for wins at home.
- In his first season with the Browns, Stefanski led the team to its first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years. He notched the most wins (11) by a first-year Browns head coach since Paul Brown had 12 in the team's inaugural season in 1946. Stefanski's 11 regular season wins were the most by a first-year head coach in 2020 and marked just the 11th time since 1970 a first-year coach has won 11 or more games. Stefanski was named the NFL Coach of the Year.

### **BUBBA VENTRONE | ASSISTANT HEAD COACH/SPECIAL TEAMS COORDINATOR**

Ventrone brings 19 years of coaching and playing experience in the NFL with experience in two Super Bowls. The Pittsburgh, Pa. native joined the Browns ahead of the 2023 season and aided a special teams unit that set several franchise records including 33 made field goals and a 49.4-yard punt average and three blocked field goals. Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Ventrone spent five seasons with the Indianapolis Colts guiding the unit to a top-10 finish in his last three seasons. As an assistant special teams coach with the New England Patriots from 2015-17, he was a member of the Super Bowl LI winning team.



### **JIM SCHWARTZ | DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR**

Schwartz is in his 16th season as an NFL defensive coordinator and his second with the Cleveland Browns. In his first season with the Browns, Schwartz won NFL Assistant Coach of the Year after coaching the defense to several NFL-leading categories including total defense (270.2 yards per game), passing defense (164.7 yards per game), third down percentage (67-of-230 for 29.1 percent) and first downs allowed (253). Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Schwartz was a defensive coordinator with the Philadelphia Eagles (2016-20), winning Super Bowl LII, Buffalo Bills (2014) and Tennessee Titans (2001-08). The Baltimore, Md. native served as the head coach of the Detroit Lions from 2009-13, coaching the team to a 10-6 season in 2011 and a playoff berth for the first time since 1999.



### **KEN DORSEY | OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR**

After playing quarterback for the Browns from 2006-08, Dorsey rejoined the Browns with 17 years of NFL coaching and playing experience. Prior to joining the Browns, Dorsey spent five seasons with the Bills in several capacities on offense, coaching QB Josh Allen to several NFL records including becoming the first QB in NFL history with at least 4,000 passing yards, 30 passing touchdowns and eight rushing touchdowns. As the quarterbacks coach for the Carolina Panthers from 2013-17, Dorsey aided QB Cam Newton to be named 2015 NFL MVP. As a player, Dorsey was selected by the San Francisco 49ers in the seventh round of the 2003 NFL Draft after leading Miami (Fla.) to a 38-2 record and a national championship in 2001. He spent the 2003-05 seasons in San Francisco and 2006-08 with the Browns, where he started 13 games.



### **CHAD O'SHEA | PASS GAME COORDINATOR/WIDE RECEIVERS**

O'Shea joined the Browns in 2020 and is in his 21st NFL season, winning 12 division titles, five conference championships and three Super Bowls (XLIX, LI and LIII). The Browns' offense saw Amari Cooper post back-to-back 1,000-yard seasons in 2022, the first Brown to do so. In his first season, O'Shea aided the offense to 408 points, the second most in franchise history. Previously, the Houston, Texas native spent the 2019 season as the offensive coordinator for the Miami Dolphins and 2019-18 as the New England Patriots wide receivers coach.
