NOTABLE STORYLINES

- Last week, the Browns fell 21-15 to the New York Giants. WR Amari Cooper led the Browns with seven receptions for 86 yards and two touchdowns. He recorded a 24-yard touchdown catch on the Browns first offensive play.
- CB Denzel Ward recorded two passes defensed against the Giants and is leading the Browns with six passes defensed this season. His total is tied for second in the NFL this season and tied for the second most by a Brown through the first three weeks of a season. Since entering the league as a first-round pick in 2018, Ward is second in the NFL with 82 passes defensed, trailing only James Bradberry's 92.
- DE Myles Garrett has recorded two sacks this season, both strip-sacks. He is second in the NFL with two forced fumbles. Garrett is the only NFL player to record at least 14 sacks in each of the past three seasons (2021-23) and the only player to record at least 10 sacks in each of the past six seasons (2018-23). Garrett is the Browns all-time sack leader with 90.5.
- WR Amari Cooper recorded his 10th career game with at least two receiving touchdowns. He has 62 career touchdowns. Last season, Cooper became the first Browns player to record back-to-back 1,000-yard receiving seasons.
- LB Jeremiah Owusu-Koramoah is leading the Browns with 25 tackles this season. Last year, he led the team with 98 tackles, while adding 3.5 sacks, six passes defensed and one forced fumble. He finished fourth in the NFL with 20 tackles-for-a-loss during the regular season and added four more during the club's postseason game at Houston. Owusu-Koramoah inked a three-year extension with the club in August.
- P Corey Bojorquez is leading the NFL with 881 punt yards this season. Last week, he landed five punts inside the 20-yard line to increase his season total to nine, which is tied for second in the league this season.
- K Dustin Hopkins is 4-for-5 on field goal attempts this season, including two from 50-plus yards. Since joining the Browns via trade prior to the start of last season, his 10 field goals from 50-plus yards are the second-most all-time by a Brown. Last season, Hopkins' 33 made field goals were the most by a Brown in a season and his eight 50-plus yards field goals were also a team record. He finished second to Jim Brown (126 in 1965) for the most points scored by a Brown in a season with 123. He inked a three-year contract extension in July.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR THIS WEEK

TEAM

- The team looks for their second road win of the season and looks for two consecutive road wins for the first time since Weeks 12-13 of the 2020 season.
- The team can improve to 11-6 under Stefanski in the month of September.
- The defense needs five sacks to tie for the third most by a Browns team in the first four games of a season.

WR AMARI COOPER

- Can log back-to-back multiple receiving TD games for first time in career and can be the first Brown to do so since Braylon Edwards in 2007.
- 158 receiving yards away from passing Keyshawn Johnson for the fourth most by a top-five pick in their first 10 years.
- Three receiving TDs ties A.J. Green for third by a top-five pick in their first 10 years.

DE MYLES GARRETT

• One and a half sacks this week can tie DeMarcus Ware (92) with the third most sacks by a player in their first 103 games.

LS CHARLEY HUGHLETT

· Looks to appear in his 151st regular season game, 14th most by a Brown.

TE DAVID NJOKU

- Nine receptions away from 300 in career.
- Six receptions away from tying Eric Metcalf for the eighth most receptions by a Brown and second since the team returned to Cleveland in 1999.

LB JEREMIAH OWUSU-KORAMOAH

· Aims for 12th consecutive game with six or more tackles, dating back to last season.

CB DENZEL WARD

- · Aims for four consecutive games with a pass breakup for the first time since 2022.
- Aims for his third game this season with multiple pass breakups for the third season in a row.

OB DESHAUN WATSON

• One game with over 250 passing yards and 40 rushing yards matches Randall Cunningham (13) for the fourth-most games in NFL history.

BROWNS GIVE BACK

The Browns have a unified and focused philanthropic mission with "Browns Give Back" that extends throughoout Northeast Ohio. Led by Dee and Jimmy Haslam, Whitney and JW Johnson, COO David Jenkins, EVP/GM Andrew Berry and Head Coach Kevin Stefanski, the entire Browns organization - coaches, players and front office members - are dedicated to creating meaningful impact in the communities in which we live and work by investing their time and resources under the Browns Give Back platform.

The target of these endeavors devotes to three focus areas: EDUCATION, YOUTH FOOTBALL and SOCIAL JUSTICE.

SANCTION GIRLS HS FLAG FOOTBALL IN OHIO

Since 2021, the Browns have worked with Northeast Ohio Flag Football to elevate girls flag football to promote equality in high school sports. Over the past four seasons, the number of Northeast Ohio high schools with teams has grown from two to 51. The Browns are focused on pushing girls high school flag football to become a sanctioned varsity sport under the Ohio High School Athletic Association.





TASTE OF THE BROWNS

The Cleveland Browns and Greater Cleveland Food Bank, along with co-chairs Joel Bitonio and Hanford Dixon, teamed up to host the 26th Annual Taste of the Browns on September 16. Guests sampled food and drinks from over 25 of Cleveland's best restaurants all to support efforts to provide nutritious food and meals at no cost to the Cleveland community.



The Stay in the Game! Attendance Network works to campaign, connect and convene with experts and supporters to dramatically improve attendance for Ohio students. The Network was launched in 2019 by the Cleveland Browns Foundation, Ohio Department of Education and Workforce and Harvard's Proving Ground, and is now managed by Battelle. For the 2024-25 school year, the Network has partnered with **100+ school districts** to positively impact the lives of **400k+ students**.

GYM CLASS TAKEOVERS

Browns WR Cedric Tillman hosted a Gym Class Takeover presented by Meijer at Shoreview Elementary School on September 17 as a celebration for students having a strong commitment to school attendance. The takeover offered hands-on instruction, including football skills stations, contests, and non-contact games in a high-energy environment for the top students with good or improved school attendance.

Meijer, the presenting partner for the Gym Class Takeover, donated \$2,500 to the Euclid City School District in support of increased attendance, a SITG!

Attendance Network school district.

The Browns Flag-In Schools is in its second year and has expanded to 161 elementary schools across Northeast and Central Ohio. The program works in tandem with the Stay in the Game! Attendance Network by providing school-based activities to further engage students and increase school attendance.



THE HEAD COACHES

BROWNS HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI



Head Coach Kevin Stefanski became the 18th full-time head coach in franchise history on January 13, 2020. The two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year led the Browns to two postseason appearances and two 11-win season becoming the second coach in club history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins (Paul Brown, 1951)

and 1953). In his first season, he led the club to their first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years, earning him his first AP Coach of the Year. Prior to Cleveland, Stefanski spent 14 seasons with the Minnesota Vikings in various roles. Stefanski joined the Vikings in 2006 as an assistant to the head coach, assistant quarterbacks coach (2009-13), tight ends (2014-15) and lone season (2016) coaching running backs. From 2017-18, he coached the quarterbacks and added the role of interim offensive coordinator for the final three games in 2018 before being named the team's offensive coordinator in 2019. Stefanski played defensive back at University of Pennsylvania

RAIDERS HEAD COACH ANTONIO PIERCE



Antonio Pierce was appointed the 23rd head coach of the Raiders organization on Jan. 19, 2024. He began his NFL coaching career with the Raiders serving as linebackers coach from 2022-23. Pierce was announced the interim head coach for the Raiders on Oct. 31, 2023 after week 8 of the regular season and in the nine games he stepped in for, he led them to a

5-4 record to finish out the season. Before joining the NFL, Pierce spent time with Arizona State University from 2018-19 (LBs coach), 2020 (Associate HC/Co-DC), and 2021 (Associate HC/DC). Pierce played football at Mt. San Antonio College (1997-98) and Arizona (1999-2000) before signing as an undrafted free agent by Washington. He spent time as a linebacker with Washington (2001-04) and the Giants (2005-09) where he was named to the Pro Bowl in 2006 and helped the Giants to a Super Bowl XLII championship in 2008.



HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Stefanski has led the team to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons. He joined Pro Football Hall of Famer Paul Brown (1951 and 1953) as the only coaches in team history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins.
- Stefanski became the 16th coach to win the Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year award multiple times since its inception in 1957. Stefanski won the honors in 2020 and 2023 and joined Forrest Gregg (1976) as the only Browns coaches to win the award.
- During the Browns 77-year history, the team has surpassed 6,000 scrimmage yards in a single season just seven times, but have reached the mark in all four seasons under Stefanski. Since 2020, the Browns are third in the NFL with an average of 139.6 rushing yards per game.
- Stefanski has recorded a 24-12 (.666) record at Huntington Bank Field, while not recording a losing record at home in any season. The Browns finished 8-1 at home in 2023, a team record for wins at home.
- In his first season with the Browns, Stefanski led the team to its first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years. He notched the most wins (11) by a first-year Browns head coach since Paul Brown had 12 in the team's inaugural season in 1946. Stefanski's 11 regular season wins were the most by a first-year head coach in 2020 and marked just the 11th time since 1970 a first-year coach has won 11 or more games. Stefanski was named the NFL Coach of the Year.

BUBBA VENTRONE | ASSISTANT HEAD COACH/SPECIAL TEAMS COORDINATOR

Ventrone brings 19 years of coaching and playing experience in the NFL with experience in two Super Bowls. The Pittsburgh, Pa. native joined the Browns ahead of the 2023 season and aided a special teams unit that set several franchise records including 33 made field goals and a 49.4-yard punt average and three blocked field goals. Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Ventrone spent five seasons with the Indianapolis Colts guiding the unit to a top-10 finish in his last three seasons. As an assistant special teams coach with the New England Patriots from 2015-17, he was a member of the Super Bowl LI winning team.



JIM SCHWARTZ | DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Schwartz is in his 16th season as an NFL defensive coordinator and his second with the Cleveland Browns. In his first season with the Browns, Schwartz won NFL Assistant Coach of the Year after coaching the defense to several NFL-leading categories including total defense (270.2 yards per game), passing defense (164.7 yards per game), third down percentage (67-of-230 for 29.1 percent) and first downs allowed (253). Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Schwartz was a defensive coordinator with the Philadelphia Eagles (2016-20), winning Super Bowl LII, Buffalo Bills (2014) and Tennessee Titans (2001-08). The Baltimore, Md. native served as the head coach of the Detroit Lions from 2009-13, coaching the team to a 10-6 season in 2011 and a playoff berth for the first time since 1999.



KEN DORSEY | OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR

After playing quarterback for the Browns from 2006-08, Dorsey rejoined the Browns with 17 years of NFL coaching and playing experience. Prior to joining the Browns, Dorsey spent five seasons with the Bills in several capacities on offense, coaching QB Josh Allen to several NFL records including becoming the first QB in NFL history with at least 4,000 passing yards, 30 passing touchdowns and eight rushing touchdowns. As the quarterbacks coach for the Carolina Panthers from 2013-17, Dorsey aided QB Cam Newton to be named 2015 NFL MVP. As a player, Dorsey was selected by the San Francisco 49ers in the seventh round of the 2003 NFL Draft after leading Miami (Fla.) to a 38-2 record and a national championship in 2001. He spent the 2003-05 seasons in San Francisco and 2006-08 with the Browns, where he started 13 games.



CHAD O'SHEA | PASS GAME COORDINATOR/WIDE RECEIVERS

O'Shea joined the Browns in 2020 and is in his 21st NFL season, winning 12 division titles, five conference championships and three Super Bowls (XLIX, LI and LIII). The Browns' offense saw Amari Cooper post back-to-back 1,000-yard seasons in 2022, the first Brown to do so. In his first season, O'Shea aided the offense to 408 points, the second most in franchise history. Previously, the Houston, Texas native spent the 2019 season as the offensive coordinator for the Miami Dolphins and 2019-18 as the New England Patriots wide receivers coach.
