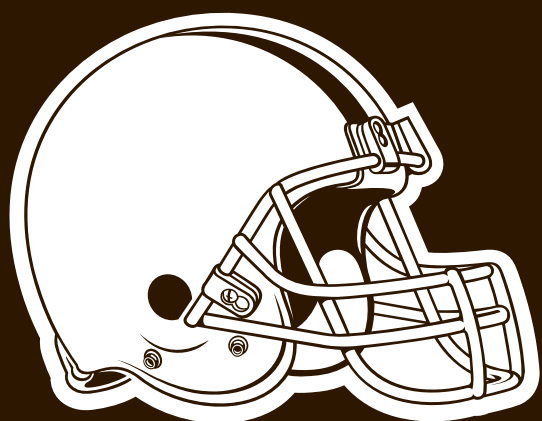



- CB Denzel Ward recorded two passes defended last week at Washington. He is leading the NFL with nine passes defended on the season. Since 2018, only Dallas CB Trevon Diggs (10 in 2021) has recorded more passes defended in the first five games of a season. Ward's nine passes defended are tied with CB Buster Skrine (nine in 2013) for the most by a Brown in the first five weeks of a season. Since entering the league as a first-round pick in 2018, Ward is second in the NFL with 85 passes defended, trailing only James Bradberry's 92.

- DE Myles Garrett is leading the Browns with four sacks this season. He is also tied for second in the NFL with two forced fumbles. Garrett is the only NFL player to record at least 14 sacks in each of the past three seasons (2021-23) and the only player to record at least 10 sacks in each of the past six seasons (2018-23). Garrett is the Browns all-time sack leader with 92.5.

- Last week LB Jeremiah Owusu-Koramoah recorded five tackles, one interception, one sack and one forced fumble. He joined San Francisco LB Fred Warner (9/15/24) as the only players this season to record a game with at least one sack, one interception and a forced fumble. Owusu-Koramoah is leading the team this season with 39 tackles. He inked a three-year extension with the club in August.

- P Corey Bojorquez is leading the NFL with eight punts inside the 10-yard line and is tied for the league lead with 14 inside the 20-yard line. Last week, he booted three punts inside the 10 and four inside the 20.

- K Dustin Hopkins is 7-for-8 on field goal attempts this season, including four from 50-plus yards. Since joining the Browns via trade prior to the start of last season, his 12 field goals from 50-plus yards are the second-most all-time by a Brown. He inked a three-year contract extension in July.

### WHAT TO LOOK FOR THIS WEEK

#### WR AMARI COOPER

- Aims for fifth game in a row with at least four catches.
- 13 receptions from 700 club.
- Cooper is 63 receiving yards away from passing Keyshawn Johnson for the fourth most by a top-five pick in their first 10 years.

#### DE MYLES GARRETT

- One and half-sacks this week can tie DeMarcus Ware (94) for the third most sacks by a player in their first 106 games.

#### TE DAVID NJOKU

- Eight receptions away from 300 in career...Five receptions away from tying Eric Metcalf for the eighth most receptions by a Brown and second since the team returned to Cleveland in 1999.

#### LB JEREMIAH OWUSU-KORAMOAH

- Aims for fifth game in a row with a tackle for loss.

#### CB DENZEL WARD

- A pass breakup gives him at least one in every game this season.
- Looks to have a pass breakup in 11 out of last 12 games on the road.
- Needs one pass breakup to tie for second most (Corey Fuller) by a Brown in their first six games...Two ties Buster Skrine (11) for the most in that category.

## BROWNS GIVE BACK

The Browns have a unified and focused philanthropic mission with “Browns Give Back” that extends throughout Northeast Ohio. Led by Dee and Jimmy Haslam, Whitney and JW Johnson, COO David Jenkins, EVP/GM Andrew Berry and Head Coach Kevin Stefanski, the entire Browns organization - coaches, players and front office members - are dedicated to creating meaningful impact in the communities in which we live and work by investing their time and resources under the Browns Give Back platform.

The target of these endeavors devotes to three focus areas: **EDUCATION, YOUTH FOOTBALL** and **SOCIAL JUSTICE**.

### PLAY LIKE A GIRL!

Bridgestone, the Cleveland Browns and nonprofit organization Play Like a Girl!® welcomed local high school girls flag football teams for a Field Day.

High school players ran flag football drills with Browns QB Dorian Thompson-Robinson and took part in a panel discussion featuring female leaders from the three organizers. Since 2021, the Browns have worked with Northeast Ohio Flag Football to elevate girls flag football to promote equality in high school sports. Over the past four seasons, the number of Northeast Ohio high schools with teams has grown from two to 51. The Browns are focused on pushing girls high school flag football to become a sanctioned varsity sport under the Ohio High School Athletic Association.



### CRUCIAL CATCH

On Tuesday, October 1st, Browns RB Nyheim Hines and G Michael Dunn visited the Joseph S. & Jeannette M. Silber Hope Lodge in Cleveland to meet patients and their families and kick off Crucial Catch month. Players helped serve food from Cleveland Huddle restaurants, Beckham's B&M Bar-B-Que with desserts from Sweet Fix Bakery, and played a series of games with the guests.

Since 1995, the Silber Hope Lodge has provided a free home away from home for cancer patients and their caregivers. The facility offers 24/7 staffing services and 43 guest rooms located near Cleveland-based cancer treatment facilities.



The Stay in the Game! Attendance Network works to campaign, connect and convene with experts and supporters to dramatically improve attendance for Ohio students. The Network was launched in 2019 by the Cleveland Browns Foundation, Ohio Department of Education and Workforce and Harvard's Proving Ground, and is now managed by Battelle. For the 2024-25 school year, the Network has partnered with **100+ school districts** to positively impact the lives of **400k+ students**.

### GARFIELD HEIGHTS HIGH SCHOOL FIELD DEDICATION

The Cleveland Browns, QB Jameis Winston and Garfield Heights City Schools hosted a field dedication ceremony for the new ForeverLawn high-quality synthetic turf field in association with Ohio Cat at Garfield Heights High School.

The new field marks the 15th field surface provided to Ohio schools and communities by the Browns, courtesy of the Haslam and Johnson families as well as Browns Give Back, since the team's long-term field initiative launched eight years ago in May 2016. Garfield Heights City School District has been a partner of the Stay in the Game! Attendance Network since 2021 and is committed to improving school attendance.



THE HEAD COACHES

BROWNS HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI



Head Coach Kevin Stefanski became the 18th full-time head coach in franchise history on January 13, 2020. The two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year led the Browns to two postseason appearances and two 11-win season becoming the second coach in club history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins (Paul Brown, 1951 and 1953). In his first season, he led the club to their first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years, earning him his first AP Coach of the Year. Prior to Cleveland, Stefanski spent 14 seasons with the Minnesota Vikings in various roles. Stefanski joined the Vikings in 2006 as an assistant to the head coach, assistant quarterbacks coach (2009-13), tight ends (2014-15) and lone season (2016) coaching running backs. From 2017-18, he coached the quarterbacks and added the role of interim offensive coordinator for the final three games in 2018 before being named the team's offensive coordinator in 2019. Stefanski played defensive back at University of Pennsylvania.

EAGLES HEAD COACH NICK SIRIANNI



Nick Sirianni was appointed the 24th head coach of the Eagles franchise on Jan. 24, 2024. He began his NFL coaching career with the Chiefs serving as Offensive Quality Control coach in 2009 and 2011, Asst. QBs coach in 2010 and WRs coach in 2012. Sirianni spent time as part of the Chargers organization in 2013 (Offensive Quality Control coach), 2014-15 (QB's coach), 2016-17 (WRs coach) and Colts organization from 2018-20 (OC). During his time in Philadelphia, Sirianni has led the Eagles to a postseason berth in his first three seasons with the organization, including a Super Bowl LVII appearance in 2022. Sirianni played football at Mount Union (2000-03) where they won three Division III national championships from 2000-02.

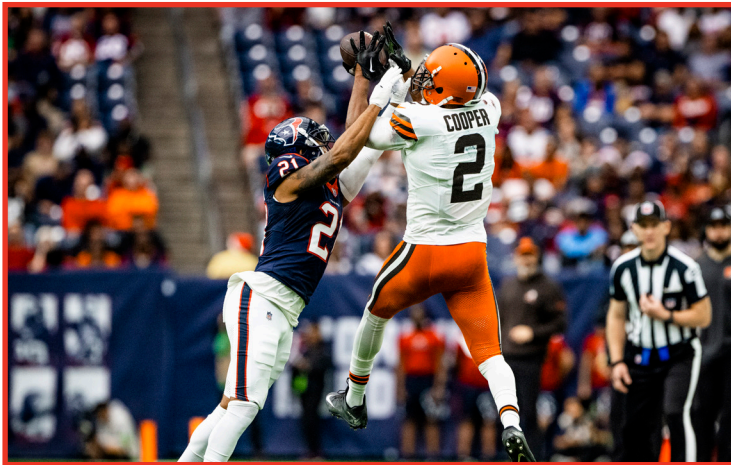

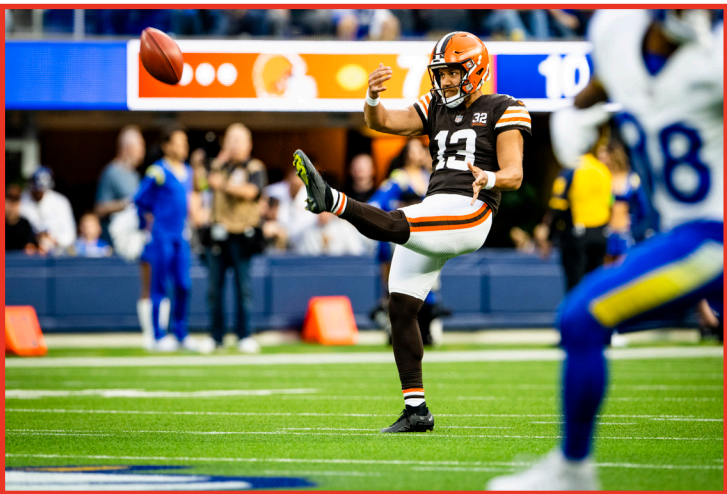

# HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI

## CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Stefanski has led the team to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons. He joined Pro Football Hall of Famer Paul Brown (1951 and 1953) as the only coaches in team history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins.
- Stefanski became the 16th coach to win the Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year award multiple times since its inception in 1957. Stefanski won the honors in 2020 and 2023 and joined Forrest Gregg (1976) as the only Browns coaches to win the award.
- During the Browns 77-year history, the team has surpassed 6,000 scrimmage yards in a single season just seven times, but have reached the mark in all four seasons under Stefanski. Since 2020, the Browns are third in the NFL with an average of 139.6 rushing yards per game.
- Stefanski has recorded a 24-12 (.666) record at Huntington Bank Field, while not recording a losing record at home in any season. The Browns finished 8-1 at home in 2023, a team record for wins at home.
- In his first season with the Browns, Stefanski led the team to its first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years. He notched the most wins (11) by a first-year Browns head coach since Paul Brown had 12 in the team's inaugural season in 1946. Stefanski's 11 regular season wins were the most by a first-year head coach in 2020 and marked just the 11th time since 1970 a first-year coach has won 11 or more games. Stefanski was named the NFL Coach of the Year.

### **BUBBA VENTRONE | ASSISTANT HEAD COACH/SPECIAL TEAMS COORDINATOR**

Ventrone brings 19 years of coaching and playing experience in the NFL with experience in two Super Bowls. The Pittsburgh, Pa. native joined the Browns ahead of the 2023 season and aided a special teams unit that set several franchise records including 33 made field goals and a 49.4-yard punt average and three blocked field goals. Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Ventrone spent five seasons with the Indianapolis Colts guiding the unit to a top-10 finish in his last three seasons. As an assistant special teams coach with the New England Patriots from 2015-17, he was a member of the Super Bowl LI winning team.



### **JIM SCHWARTZ | DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR**

Schwartz is in his 16th season as an NFL defensive coordinator and his second with the Cleveland Browns. In his first season with the Browns, Schwartz won NFL Assistant Coach of the Year after coaching the defense to several NFL-leading categories including total defense (270.2 yards per game), passing defense (164.7 yards per game), third down percentage (67-of-230 for 29.1 percent) and first downs allowed (253). Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Schwartz was a defensive coordinator with the Philadelphia Eagles (2016-20), winning Super Bowl LII, Buffalo Bills (2014) and Tennessee Titans (2001-08). The Baltimore, Md. native served as the head coach of the Detroit Lions from 2009-13, coaching the team to a 10-6 season in 2011 and a playoff berth for the first time since 1999.



### **KEN DORSEY | OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR**

After playing quarterback for the Browns from 2006-08, Dorsey rejoined the Browns with 17 years of NFL coaching and playing experience. Prior to joining the Browns, Dorsey spent five seasons with the Bills in several capacities on offense, coaching QB Josh Allen to several NFL records including becoming the first QB in NFL history with at least 4,000 passing yards, 30 passing touchdowns and eight rushing touchdowns. As the quarterbacks coach for the Carolina Panthers from 2013-17, Dorsey aided QB Cam Newton to be named 2015 NFL MVP. As a player, Dorsey was selected by the San Francisco 49ers in the seventh round of the 2003 NFL Draft after leading Miami (Fla.) to a 38-2 record and a national championship in 2001. He spent the 2003-05 seasons in San Francisco and 2006-08 with the Browns, where he started 13 games.



### **CHAD O'SHEA | PASS GAME COORDINATOR/WIDE RECEIVERS**

O'Shea joined the Browns in 2020 and is in his 21st NFL season, winning 12 division titles, five conference championships and three Super Bowls (XLIX, LI and LIII). The Browns' offense saw Amari Cooper post back-to-back 1,000-yard seasons in 2022, the first Brown to do so. In his first season, O'Shea aided the offense to 408 points, the second most in franchise history. Previously, the Houston, Texas native spent the 2019 season as the offensive coordinator for the Miami Dolphins and 2019-18 as the New England Patriots wide receivers coach.
