

NOTABLE STORYLINES

- Last week, S Rodney McLeod led the team with eight tackles and returned a blocked field goal 50-yards for a touchdown. It was the Browns first blocked field goal returned for a touchdown since Leigh Bodden on Nov. 13, 2005. In addition to a 25-yard fumble return for a score at Las Vegas (9/29), McLeod and Minnesota LB Andrew Van Ginkel are the only defensive players this season to score two touchdowns.
- CB Denzel Ward recorded one pass defensed last week at Philadelphia. He is tied for the NFL lead with 10 passes defensed on the season. Ward's 10 passes defensed are tied for the second-most by a Brown in the first six weeks of a season. Since entering the league as a first-round pick in 2018, Ward is second in the NFL with 86 passes defensed, trailing only James Bradberry's 92.
- G Joel Bitonio appeared in and started his 150th career games last week. The six-time Pro Bowler ranks 15th on the Browns career games played list. His 150 career starts trails only Hall of Famer Joe Thomas' 167 for the most since the Browns returned in 1999.
- TE David Njoku recorded five receptions last week to pass Eric Metcalf for eighth place on the Browns career receptions list. Njoku has 297 career receptions. He trails only WR Kevin Johnson (315) for the most by a Brown since the team's return in 1999.
- DE Myles Garrett is leading the Browns with four sacks this season. He is also tied for third in the NFL with two forced fumbles. Garrett is the only NFL player to record at least 14 sacks in each of the past three seasons (2021-23) and the only player to record at least 10 sacks in each of the past six seasons (2018-23). Garrett is the Browns all-time sack leader with 92.5.
- Last week, LB Jeremiah Owusu-Koramoah recorded seven tackles, one sack and one pass defensed. He has two sacks this season and has recorded at least one sack in consecutive games for the first time in his career. He is leading the team this year with 46 tackles. Earlier this season at Washington (10/6), he joined San Francisco LB Fred Warner (9/15) as the only players this season to record a game with at least one sack, one interception and a forced fumble. Owusu-Koramoah inked a three-year extension with the club in August.
- P Corey Bojorquez is leading the NFL with eight punts inside the 10-yard line and is fourth in the league lead with 15 inside the 20-yard line. His 52.4 punt average ranks third in the league.
- K Dustin Hopkins is 10-for-12 on field goal attempts this season, including four from 50-plus yards. Since joining the Browns via trade prior to the start of last season, his 12 field goals from 50-plus yards are the second-most all-time by a Brown. He inked a three-year contract extension in July.
- The Rock & Roll Hall of Fame and Cleveland Browns celebrate the accomplishments of the 2024 Rock & Roll Hall of Fame Inductees for a special first-ever Cleveland Browns Rock & Roll Hall of Fame Game at Huntington Bank Field.

• Three receptions away from 300 in career.

CB DENZEL WARD

- Aims for seven consecutive games with a pass breakup for the first time in career.
- A pass breakup gives him at least one in every game this season.
- Needs one pass breakup (11) to tie for first by a Brown in their first seven games of a season...He recorded 11 in 2020 and Buster Skrine had 11 in 2013.
- Needs two interceptions to extend accomplishment as the only player in NFL with at least 10 pass deflections and two interceptions in first seven seasons.
- Six pass breakups ties Jalen Ramsey for third-most by a top-five pick in first seven seasons.

Led by Dee and Jimmy Haslam, Whitney and JW Johnson, COO David Jenkins, EVP/GM Andrew Berry and Head Coach Kevin Stefanski, the entire Browns organization - coaches, players and front office members - are dedicated to creating meaningful impact in the communities in which we live and work by investing their time and resources under the Browns Give Back platform.

The target of these endeavors devotes to three focus areas: EDUCATION, YOUTH FOOTBALL and SOCIAL JUSTICE.

PLAY LIKE A GIRL!

Bridgestone, the Cleveland Browns and nonprofit organization Play Like a Girl!® welcomed local high school girls flag football teams for a Field Day.

High school players ran flag football drills with Browns QB Dorian

Thompson-Robinson and took part in a panel discussion featuring female leaders from the three organizers. Since 2021, the Browns have worked with Northeast Ohio Flag Football to elevate girls flag football to promote equality in high school sports. Over the past four seasons, the number of Northeast Ohio high schools with teams has grown from two to 51. The Browns are focused on pushing girls high school flag football to become a sanctioned varsity sport under the Ohio High School Athletic Association.





CRUCIAL CATCH

On Tuesday, October 1st, Browns RB Nyheim Hines and G Michael Dunn visited the Joseph S. & Jeannette M. Silber Hope Lodge in Cleveland to meet patients and their families and kick off Crucial Catch month. Players helped serve food from Cleveland Huddle restaurants, Beckham's B&M Bar-B-Que and Sweet Fix Bakery, and played a series of games with the guests.

Since 1995, the Silber Hope Lodge has provided a free home away from home for cancer patients and their caregivers. The facility offers 24/7 staffing services and 43 guest rooms located near Cleveland-based cancer treatment facilities.



The Stay in the Game! Attendance Network works to campaign, connect and convene with experts and supporters to dramatically improve attendance for Ohio students. The Network was launched in 2019 by the Cleveland Browns Foundation, Ohio Department of Education and Workforce and Harvard's Proving Ground, and is now managed by Battelle. For the 2024-25 school year, the Network has partnered with **100+ school districts** to positively impact the lives of **400k+ students**.

GARFIELD HEIGHTS HIGH SCHOOL FIELD DEDICATION

The Cleveland Browns, QB Jameis Winston and Garfield Heights City Schools hosted a field dedication ceremony for the new ForeverLawn high-quality synthetic turf field in association with Ohio Cat at Garfield Heights High School.

The new field marks the 15th field surface provided to Ohio schools and communities by the Browns, courtesy of the Haslam and Johnson families as well as Browns Give Back, since the team's long-term field initiative launched eight years ago in May 2016. Garfield Heights City School District has been a partner of the Stay in the Game! Attendance Network since 2021 and is committed to improving school attendance.

THE HEAD COACHES

BROWNS HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI



Head Coach Kevin Stefanski became the 18th full-time head coach in franchise history on January 13, 2020. The two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year led the Browns to two postseason appearances and two 11-win season becoming the second coach in club history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins (Paul Brown, 1951)

and 1953). In his first season, he led the club to their first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years, earning him his first AP Coach of the Year. Prior to Cleveland, Stefanski spent 14 seasons with the Minnesota Vikings in various roles. Stefanski joined the Vikings in 2006 as an assistant to the head coach, assistant quarterbacks coach (2009-13), tight ends (2014-15) and lone season (2016) coaching running backs. From 2017-18, he coached the quarterbacks and added the role of interim offensive coordinator for the final three games in 2018 before being named the team's offensive coordinator in 2019. Stefanski played defensive back at University of Pennsylvania.

BENGALS HEAD COACH ZAC TAYLOR



Zac Taylor was appointed the 10th head coach of the Bengals franchise on Feb. 4, 2019. He began his NFL coaching career with the Dolphins serving as QBs coach and OC from 2012-15. A one-season stint as OC and QBs coach for the University of Cincinnati in 2016 before returning to the NFL in 2017, Taylor spent time as part of the Rams organization in 2017

(asst. WRs) and 2018 (QBs coach). Taylor played football at Wake Forest (2002-03), Butler Community College (2004) and Nebraska (2005-06).





HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Stefanski has led the team to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons. He joined Pro Football Hall of Famer Paul Brown (1951 and 1953) as the only coaches in team history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins.
- Stefanski became the 16th coach to win the Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year award multiple times since its inception in 1957. Stefanski won the honors in 2020 and 2023 and joined Forrest Gregg (1976) as the only Browns coaches to win the award.
- During the Browns 77-year history, the team has surpassed 6,000 scrimmage yards in a single season just seven times, but have reached the mark in all four seasons under Stefanski. Since 2020, the Browns are third in the NFL with an average of 139.6 rushing yards per game.
- Stefanski has recorded a 24-12 (.666) record at Huntington Bank Field, while not recording a losing record at home in any season. The Browns finished 8-1 at home in 2023, a team record for wins at home.
- In his first season with the Browns, Stefanski led the team to its first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years. He notched the most wins (11) by a first-year Browns head coach since Paul Brown had 12 in the team's inaugural season in 1946. Stefanski's 11 regular season wins were the most by a first-year head coach in 2020 and marked just the 11th time since 1970 a first-year coach has won 11 or more games. Stefanski was named the NFL Coach of the Year.

BUBBA VENTRONE | ASSISTANT HEAD COACH/SPECIAL TEAMS COORDINATOR

Ventrone brings 19 years of coaching and playing experience in the NFL with experience in two Super Bowls. The Pittsburgh, Pa. native joined the Browns ahead of the 2023 season and aided a special teams unit that set several franchise records including 33 made field goals and a 49.4-yard punt average and three blocked field goals. Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Ventrone spent five seasons with the Indianapolis Colts guiding the unit to a top-10 finish in his last three seasons. As an assistant special teams coach with the New England Patriots from 2015-17, he was a member of the Super Bowl LI winning team.



JIM SCHWARTZ | DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Schwartz is in his 16th season as an NFL defensive coordinator and his second with the Cleveland Browns. In his first season with the Browns, Schwartz won NFL Assistant Coach of the Year after coaching the defense to several NFL-leading categories including total defense (270.2 yards per game), passing defense (164.7 yards per game), third down percentage (67-of-230 for 29.1 percent) and first downs allowed (253). Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Schwartz was a defensive coordinator with the Philadelphia Eagles (2016-20), winning Super Bowl LII, Buffalo Bills (2014) and Tennessee Titans (2001-08). The Baltimore, Md. native served as the head coach of the Detroit Lions from 2009-13, coaching the team to a 10-6 season in 2011 and a playoff berth for the first time since 1999.



KEN DORSEY | OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR

After playing quarterback for the Browns from 2006-08, Dorsey rejoined the Browns with 17 years of NFL coaching and playing experience. Prior to joining the Browns, Dorsey spent five seasons with the Bills in several capacities on offense, coaching QB Josh Allen to several NFL records including becoming the first QB in NFL history with at least 4,000 passing yards, 30 passing touchdowns and eight rushing touchdowns. As the quarterbacks coach for the Carolina Panthers from 2013-17, Dorsey aided QB Cam Newton to be named 2015 NFL MVP. As a player, Dorsey was selected by the San Francisco 49ers in the seventh round of the 2003 NFL Draft after leading Miami (Fla.) to a 38-2 record and a national championship in 2001. He spent the 2003-05 seasons in San Francisco and 2006-08 with the Browns, where he started 13 games.



CHAD O'SHEA | PASS GAME COORDINATOR/WIDE RECEIVERS

O'Shea joined the Browns in 2020 and is in his 21st NFL season, winning 12 division titles, five conference championships and three Super Bowls (XLIX, LI and LIII). The Browns' offense saw Amari Cooper post back-to-back 1,000-yard seasons in 2022, the first Brown to do so. In his first season, O'Shea aided the offense to 408 points, the second most in franchise history. Previously, the Houston, Texas native spent the 2019 season as the offensive coordinator for the Miami Dolphins and 2019-18 as the New England Patriots wide receivers coach.
