

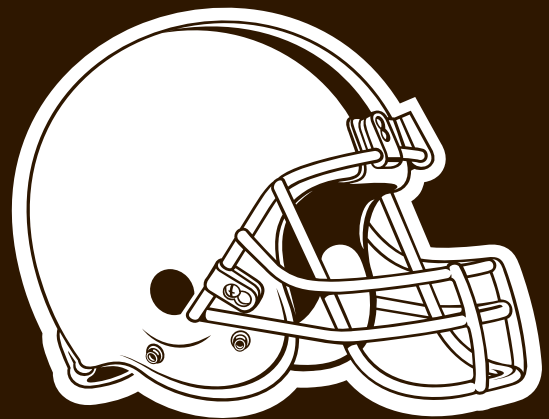



• CB Denzel Ward is leading the NFL with 12 passes defensed this season. He is the only player in the league with at least one pass defensed in every game this year. He is the only NFL player to record at least 10 passes defensed in each of the past seven seasons (2018-24). Ward's 12 passes defensed are the most by a Brown in the first seven weeks of a season. Since entering the league as a first-round pick in 2018, Ward is second in the NFL with 88 passes defensed, trailing only James Bradberry's 92.

• Last week, TE David Njoku tied a career-high with 10 receptions, while adding 76 yards and a touchdown. He became the first NFL player to record at least two receptions from three different passers in the same game since WR Marty Booker in 2003. Njoku (307) passed WR Webster Slaughter (305) for the seventh-most receptions in Browns history. Njoku now trails WR Reggie Rucker (310), WR Kevin Johnson (315) and WR Brian Brennan (315) on the list.

• RB Nick Chubb made his 2024 season debut last week. He recorded his 49th career rushing touchdown. Chubb hadn't appeared in a game since Sept. 18, 2023.

• DE Myles Garrett is leading the Browns with two forced fumbles this season and tied for the team lead with four sacks. Garrett is the only NFL player to record at least 14 sacks in each of the past three seasons (2021-23) and the only player to record at least 10 sacks in each of the past six seasons (2018-23). Garrett is the Browns all-time sack leader with 92.5.

• DE Za'Darius Smith recorded his fourth sack of the season last week. He has at least one sack in every home game this season and has 64 career sacks.

• LB Jeremiah Owusu-Koramoah is leading the Browns with 53 tackles, while adding two sacks, one interception, three passes defensed and one forced fumble. Earlier this season at Washington (10/6), he joined San Francisco LB Fred Warner (9/15) as the only players this season to record a game with at least one sack, one interception and a forced fumble. Owusu-Koramoah inked a three-year extension with the club in August.

• S Rodney McLeod has scored two touchdowns this season. He returned a blocked field goal 50-yards for a touchdown at Philadelphia (10/13). It was the Browns first blocked field goal returned for a touchdown since Leigh Bodden on Nov. 13, 2005. He also returned a fumble 25-yards for a score at Las Vegas (9/29). McLeod and Minnesota LB Andrew Van Ginkel are the only defensive players this season to score two touchdowns.

• P Corey Bojorquez is leading the NFL with nine punts inside the 10-yard line and is toed for second in the league with 18 inside the 20-yard line. His 52.1 punt average ranks third in the league.

• K Dustin Hopkins is 10-for-13 on field goal attempts this season, including four from 50-plus yards. Since joining the Browns via trade prior to the start of last season, his 12 field goals from 50-plus yards are the second-most

WHAT TO LOOK FOR THIS WEEK

RB NICK CHUBB

- Is eight rushing yards away from becoming third on the franchise's all-time rushing yard list.
- One rushing score shy of 50 for his career.

DE MYLES GARRETT

- Aims for a tackle-for-loss in seven of his past eight home games.
- Five and a half sacks from passing Mario Williams (97.5) for sole possession of second-most sacks by a No.1 pick.

TE DAVID NJOKU

- Looks to appear in his 100th regular season game this Sunday.
- Aims for his fifth game in a row versus AFC North with six-or-more catches.

LB JEREMIAH OWUSU-KORAMOAH

- Aims for 16th game in a row (dating back to last season) in a row with 5+ tackles.

CB DENZEL WARD

- Aims for eight consecutive games with a pass breakup for the first time in career.
- A pass breakup gives him at least one in every game this season.
- Ward is second on the Browns' all-time list of games with multiple pass breakups (25)...Three games away from matching Joe Haden's 28.
- Needs one pass breakup (13) to tie Buster Skrine for most by a Brown in their first eight games of a season.
- Need three pass deflections to have three total seasons at least 15 pass breakups.

The target of these endeavors devotes to three focus areas: **EDUCATION, YOUTH FOOTBALL** and **SOCIAL JUSTICE**.

PLAY LIKE A GIRL!

Bridgestone, the Cleveland Browns and nonprofit organization Play Like a Girl!® welcomed local high school girls flag football teams for a Field Day.

High school players ran flag football drills with Browns QB Dorian Thompson-Robinson and took part in a panel discussion featuring female leaders from the three organizers. Since 2021, the Browns have worked with Northeast Ohio Flag Football to elevate girls flag football to promote equality in high school sports. Over the past four seasons, the number of Northeast Ohio high schools with teams has grown from two to 51. The Browns are focused on pushing girls high school flag football to become a sanctioned varsity sport under the Ohio High School Athletic Association.



CRUCIAL CATCH

As part of Browns Give Back’s continued support of the NFL Crucial Catch campaign, Browns WR Elijah Moore, DT Maurice Hurst II, RB Nyheim Hines and K Dustin Hopkins visited University Hospitals Rainbow Babies & Children’s Hospital patients.



The Stay in the Game! Attendance Network works to campaign, connect and convene with experts and supporters to dramatically improve attendance for Ohio students. The Network was launched in 2019 by the Cleveland Browns Foundation, Ohio Department of Education and Workforce and Harvard’s Proving Ground, and is now managed by Battelle. For the 2024-25 school year, the Network has partnered with **100+ school districts** to positively impact the lives of **400k+ students**.

MEIJER GYM CLASS TAKEOVER

On Tuesday, October 15, the Cleveland Browns and RB Pierre Strong Jr. hosted a Gym Class Takeover presented by Meijer at Stephanie Tubbs Jones School as a celebration for students having a strong commitment to school attendance.

Meijer, the presenting partner for the Gym Class Takeover, donated \$2,500 to the Cleveland Metropolitan School District, a SITG! Attendance Network school district.

THE HEAD COACHES

BROWNS HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI

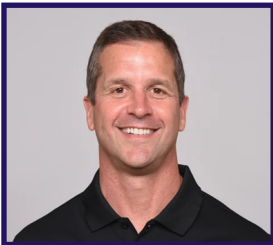


Head Coach Kevin Stefanski became the 18th full-time head coach in franchise history on January 13, 2020. The two-time Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year led the Browns to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons becoming the second coach in club history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins (Paul Brown, 1951 and 1953). In his first season, he led the club to their first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years, earning him his first AP Coach of the Year. Prior to Cleveland, Stefanski spent 14 seasons with the Minnesota Vikings in various roles. Stefanski joined the Vikings in 2006 as an assistant to the head coach, assistant quarterbacks coach (2009-13), tight ends (2014-15) and lone season (2016) coaching running backs. From 2017-18, he coached the quarterbacks and added the role of interim offensive coordinator for the final three games in 2018 before being named the team's offensive coordinator in 2019. Stefanski played defensive back at University of Pennsylvania.

RAVENS HEAD COACH JOHN HARBAUGH



John Harbaugh was appointed the third head coach of the Ravens franchise on Jan. 19, 2008. He began his NFL coaching career with the Eagles serving as ST coordinator and DBs coach from 1998-2007. He also coached at the collegiate level starting with Western Michigan from 1984-87 (RBs/OLBs coach), Pittsburgh in 1987 (TEs), Morehead State in 1988 (STs/DBs coach), Cincinnati from 1989-96 (STs coord.) and Indiana in 1997 (STs/DBs coach). During his tenure in Baltimore, Harbaugh has led the Ravens to ten postseason berths, including a Super Bowl XLVII championship in 2013. He won Coach of the Year in 2019 when he helped Baltimore to a 14-2 record, first in the AFC Conference headlined by unanimous MVP QB, Lamar Jackson. Harbaugh played football at Miami (OH) University (1981-84).

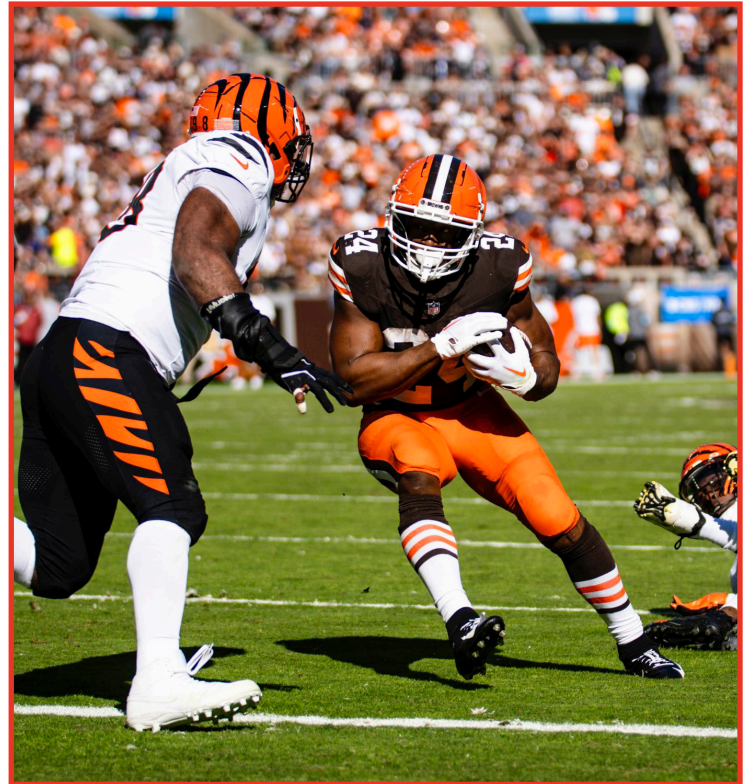

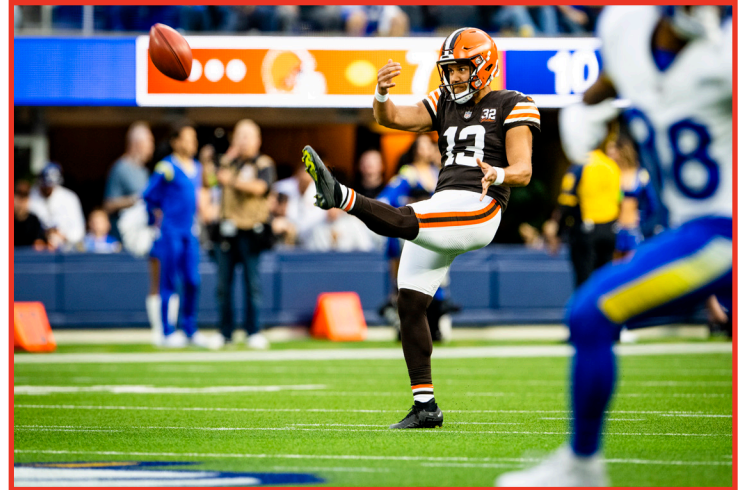

HEAD COACH KEVIN STEFANSKI

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Stefanski has led the team to two postseason appearances and two 11-win seasons. He joined Pro Football Hall of Famer Paul Brown (1951 and 1953) as the only coaches in team history to record multiple seasons with at least 11 regular season wins.
- Stefanski became the 16th coach to win the Associated Press NFL Coach of the Year award multiple times since its inception in 1957. Stefanski won the honors in 2020 and 2023 and joined Forrest Gregg (1976) as the only Browns coaches to win the award.
- During the Browns 77-year history, the team has surpassed 6,000 scrimmage yards in a single season just seven times, but have reached the mark in all four seasons under Stefanski. Since 2020, the Browns are third in the NFL with an average of 139.6 rushing yards per game.
- Stefanski has recorded a 24-12 (.666) record at Huntington Bank Field, while not recording a losing record at home in any season. The Browns finished 8-1 at home in 2023, a team record for wins at home.
- In his first season with the Browns, Stefanski led the team to its first playoff appearance since 2002 and first playoff victory in 26 years. He notched the most wins (11) by a first-year Browns head coach since Paul Brown had 12 in the team's inaugural season in 1946. Stefanski's 11 regular season wins were the most by a first-year head coach in 2020 and marked just the 11th time since 1970 a first-year coach has won 11 or more games. Stefanski was named the NFL Coach of the Year.

BUBBA VENTRONE | ASSISTANT HEAD COACH/SPECIAL TEAMS COORDINATOR

Ventrone brings 19 years of coaching and playing experience in the NFL with experience in two Super Bowls. The Pittsburgh, Pa. native joined the Browns ahead of the 2023 season and aided a special teams unit that set several franchise records including 33 made field goals and a 49.4-yard punt average and three blocked field goals. Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Ventrone spent five seasons with the Indianapolis Colts guiding the unit to a top-10 finish in his last three seasons. As an assistant special teams coach with the New England Patriots from 2015-17, he was a member of the Super Bowl LI winning team.



JIM SCHWARTZ | DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR

Schwartz is in his 16th season as an NFL defensive coordinator and his second with the Cleveland Browns. In his first season with the Browns, Schwartz won NFL Assistant Coach of the Year after coaching the defense to several NFL-leading categories including total defense (270.2 yards per game), passing defense (164.7 yards per game), third down percentage (67-of-230 for 29.1 percent) and first downs allowed (253). Ahead of his time in Cleveland, Schwartz was a defensive coordinator with the Philadelphia Eagles (2016-20), winning Super Bowl LII, Buffalo Bills (2014) and Tennessee Titans (2001-08). The Baltimore, Md. native served as the head coach of the Detroit Lions from 2009-13, coaching the team to a 10-6 season in 2011 and a playoff berth for the first time since 1999.



KEN DORSEY | OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR

After playing quarterback for the Browns from 2006-08, Dorsey rejoined the Browns with 17 years of NFL coaching and playing experience. Prior to joining the Browns, Dorsey spent five seasons with the Bills in several capacities on offense, coaching QB Josh Allen to several NFL records including becoming the first QB in NFL history with at least 4,000 passing yards, 30 passing touchdowns and eight rushing touchdowns. As the quarterbacks coach for the Carolina Panthers from 2013-17, Dorsey aided QB Cam Newton to be named 2015 NFL MVP. As a player, Dorsey was selected by the San Francisco 49ers in the seventh round of the 2003 NFL Draft after leading Miami (Fla.) to a 38-2 record and a national championship in 2001. He spent the 2003-05 seasons in San Francisco and 2006-08 with the Browns, where he started 13 games.



CHAD O'SHEA | PASS GAME COORDINATOR/WIDE RECEIVERS

O'Shea joined the Browns in 2020 and is in his 21st NFL season, winning 12 division titles, five conference championships and three Super Bowls (XLIX, LI and LIII). The Browns' offense saw Amari Cooper post back-to-back 1,000-yard seasons in 2022, the first Brown to do so. In his first season, O'Shea aided the offense to 408 points, the second most in franchise history. Previously, the Houston, Texas native spent the 2019 season as the offensive coordinator for the Miami Dolphins and 2019-18 as the New England Patriots wide receivers coach.
